TRAVIS HOLMES
Sr. • Forward • VMI

Holmes averaged 23.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 7.0 assists and 5.0 steals in leading VMI to a 2-0 record in Big South play last week. Against Winthrop, Holmes helped snap the Keydets' nine-game losing streak to the Eagles with 21 points on 9-of-15 from the field (=.600), in addition to seven rebounds, seven assists, four steals and no turnovers. At UNC Asheville, Holmes poured in 26 points on 8-of-13 from the floor (=.615) and 8-of-9 from the free throw line, while contributing seven assists and six steals. He combined with twin brother Chavis Holmes to score 16 points in a key 24-16 second half run over the Bulldogs.

Curry averaged 20.3 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists in helping Liberty to a 2-1 record last week. He scored 22 points in the Flames' overtime victory over George Mason, hitting a three-pointer with 17.7 seconds left to send the game into the extra session. He scored five of Liberty's eight points in overtime, including a heavily-contested 18-footer with 40.6 seconds left to put Liberty up for good. Against Gardner-Webb Saturday, Curry scored 15 points while double-teamed throughout the day. He added six rebounds and five assists, including two key helpers in the closing minutes. In Sunday's five-point loss at Clemson, he scored a team-high 24 points on 9-of-16 FG, including 6-of-9 three-pointers.

LOOK WHO IS 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding this past Saturday, VMI and Big South newcomer Presbyterian emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Keydets have opened Conference action 2-0 for the second-straight year. PC is the fourth new member in League history to open 2-0 in Big South play.

FIRST-TIMERS

Big South newcomers Presbyterian and Gardner-Webb each won their Conference debut game last week, becoming the eighth and ninth new member in Big South history, respectively, to win its first official Conference game. In fact, new members are now 9-2 all-time in their Big South debut games. Presbyterian is the first newcomer to start 2-0 since Birmingham-Southern started 2-0 in 2003-04. Elon opened 3-0 in its first official season of 1999-00, while Towson State holds the Big South record for best Conference start by a new member at 6-0 in 1992-93. Unlike Birmingham-Southern (2001-02), High Point (1998-99), Elon (1998-99) and UNC Greensboro (1992-93), Presbyterian is included in the Big South standings in its first year of membership.

NOT SO MARGINAL

Of the first nine Big South Conference games, five games were decided by at least 17 points, while just one was decided by three points. The average margin of victory for the nine games was 15.0 points. Three teams own an average scoring margin of at least 10.0 points in League games -- VMI (+13.5), Presbyterian (+10.0) and Charleston Southern (+10.0). League play resumes on Saturday, January 3.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams won five of the first nine Big South games played. The total is already 26.3 percent of last year's 19 road Conference wins. VMI and Presbyterian each won their first two League games away from home.

LIBERTY BURNING THROUGH IN-STATE RIVALS

For the first time since the 1999-00 season, Liberty has defeated three non-Conference intra-state Division I programs. The Flames have knocked off Virginia, William & Mary and George Mason this season, their first Virginia trifecta since defeating James Madison, Richmond and Virginia Tech in 1999-00. The victories over UVA, W&M and GMU were part of a five-game win streak, which was Liberty's longest since winning six consecutive games in the early part of the 2006-07 campaign.

30 ROCK

Presbyterian snapped its 30-game road losing streak with its 59-43 victory at Army last Monday. It was the Blue Hose's first road victory at the Division I level, and first road win since the 2006-07 campaign. Presbyterian continued its road winning ways with Big South wins at Coastal Carolina and High Point to conclude the week. The current three-game road win streak is PC's longest since winning four-straight away from home in '06-07.

BIG SOUTH MAKES ITS OWN MID-MAJOR HISTORY

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll. Liberty, which received votes last week, debuted in the rankings at No. 13, while VMI moved up four spots to No. 21 this week. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons. SNAP, CRACKLE, POP

VMI and Radford each ended long losing streaks to Winthrop last week. The Keydets snapped a nine-game losing streak to the Eagles on Dec. 3, while Radford ended a 12-game skid against Winthrop on Dec. 6.

FRESHMEN SENSATIONS

Several Big South freshmen men's basketball players have made an immediate impact on the Conference after almost a month into the season. Liberty's **SETH CURRY** is second in the Big South in scoring at 21.4 points and leads all freshman in the nation in scoring. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is leading the Big South in rebounds with 10.1 per game, while UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is tops in the League in assists with 6.50. Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is first in the Conference with 3.71 offensive rebounds per game. Primm and Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** are among the leaders in assist-turnover ratio, while VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is among the League leaders in three-pointers, three-pointers per game, and three-point percentage.

HOLMES ON CUSP OF BREAKING STEALS RECORD

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is just 10 steals away from breaking the Big South's career record of 259, which was established just last season by Winthrop point guard **CHRIS GAYNOR**. Holmes is second in League history with 250 career steals after jumping from fourth-place last week. He is averaging 3.50 steals this season, and is on pace to break Gaynor's mark at Army on Dec. 21.

TWIN PEAKS

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** have combined to score 2,928 career points, the fourth-most by a twin brother combination in NCAA history. Chavis has 1,545 points, while Travis has 1,383. The duo needs 72 points to become the fourth set of twins with 3,000 combined points, and trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place.

BOARD REPORT

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 49th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Western Illinois on Nov. 28. He is now 46th in history with 529 career boards. Harris would have reached the milestone last season, but suffered a season-ending injury in the eighth game of the year. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is 36 rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (407) and VMI's **WILLIE BELL** (353) could also surpass 500 career rebounds in 2008-09.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,545 career points, the 21st player in Big South history with 1,500 career points. He holds the 18th position and is 166 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,383) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,291). COMING IN 2009-10...

At its recent Fall meeting, the Big South Council of Chief Executive Officers voted to approve a change in the Big South men's basketball Conference schedule. Beginning with the 2009-10 season, the Big South will utilize a Thursday-Saturday format for its League slate.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is two wins away from 200 career coaching victories as a college head coach. He is 169-191 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor, and won 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81. Biedenbach is three Big South wins shy of becoming the third coach in League history with 100 wins in Big South games.

WARREN'S THREE-POINT BUFFET

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** leads the Big South with 33 three-point field goals, and his 4.71 treys per game average is pacing ahead of the League record of 4.42, set by Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** in 1993-94. Warren is currently shooting a blistering .516 percent from three-point range (33-of-64) thus far.

EXTREME MAKEOVER

Radford is playing its home men's basketball games temporarily in Peters Hall on campus while renovations continue at the Dedmon Center. The Highlanders opened the season with a 74-55 victory over Brevard and is now 72-19 (.791) all-time in games played at Peters Hall, including 3-1 this season.

BIG SOUTH HONORED, BABY!!

ESPN's **DICK VITALE** has bestowed his weekly awards on the Big South twice this season. Vitale first recognized VMI's victory at Kentucky as his "Co-Shock of the Week" on Nov. 17. Last week, Vitale named Liberty's **SETH CURRY** his "Diaper Dandy of the Week" for his play against Virginia, Coker and William & Mary.

MOUNTAIN MEN

UNC Asheville scored 100 points in a Big South game for the first time since 1994-95 with 105 points in a losing cause against VMI this past Saturday. Asheville and VMI combined for 219 points, tied for the fourth-most in a Big South game in League history. In addition, the Bulldogs' 16 three-point field goals in the game tied for fifth-most in a Conference contest, while their three-point percentage of 57.1 percent is ninth-best in a League tilt (VMI's percentage of 55.6 in the game is 10th). The Bulldogs also recorded 29 assists against the Keydets, tied for fifth-most.

HITTING THE HIGH NOTES

With 299 career assists, Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** is one away from becoming the 40th player in Big South history with 300 in a career. Johnson ranks seventh on Radford's all-time assist chart as well. Meanwhile, **ERIC HALL** is 10th in school history with 66 career blocked shots.

BIG SOUTH PICKS UP BIG WINS

For the second consecutive season, the Big South Conference has posted wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) and Southeastern Conference (SEC). VMI knocked off Kentucky in the season opener on Nov. 14, while Liberty won at Virginia on Nov. 25. In 2007-08, the Big South had two wins against the ACC and one victory against an SEC member. The Conference has now posted a win over an SEC school three consecutive years.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FOURTH APPEARANCE IN ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the ESPNU BracketBusters event this season during the week-end of February 20-21. Winthrop (home), Gardner-Webb (road) and Liberty (road) will be the League's participants. The League has received two nationally-televised broadcasts the past two seasons. Winthrop is 2-1 all-time in the event, while Liberty is 0-1. Gardner-Webb will make its first-ever appearance in the BracketBusters.

SMITH NAMED PRESEASON MID-MAJOR ALL-AMERICAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **ANTHONY SMITH** was named a *Collegeinsider.com* Preseason Mid-Major All-American, becoming the second Liberty player to earn such honors. Former guard **LARRY BLAIR** earned the distinction prior to the 2006-07 season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell to 18-6 all-time in Big South openers with its 56-53 overtime loss to Presbyterian last Wednesday. Coastal Carolina's bench combined for 29 points against the Blue Hose. **ANTHONY BREEZE** led the Chants with 14 points, while **STEVEN SEXTON** went a perfect 3-of-3 from three-point range and added 13 points ... The Chanticleers are now 23-18 all-time in overtime games, including 1-1 this season ... Coastal Carolina is idle this coming week for final exams, and returns to action Saturday at home against Southern Virginia.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU used the same starting lineup for consecutive games for the first time all season at Radford and Liberty ... Gardner-Webb saw two major point swings, one good and one bad, in its pair of Big South games last week. In the 91-71 win at Radford, GWU trailed by 12 early and used a 35-point swing to go up by as many as 23 in the second half. In the loss at Liberty, the Bulldogs led by nine midway through the first half only to see Liberty take advantage of an 18-point swing ... Gardner-Webb has had a lead in the final five minutes in four of its five losses this season on the road ... The Bulldogs continue a tough road slate this week with games at Wichita State and Kansas State.

Radford's win over Winthrop snapped a 12-game losing streak to the Eagles. It was also the Highlanders' largest margin of victory (21) over a Big South foe since defeating VMI 101-77 (24 points) in 2006 ... The Highlanders have had two players score 20 points in the same game in each of the past two games ... Junior **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** has been Radford's leading scorer four times, and averages 19.3 points when he leads the team in scoring.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville fell twice last week, losing at No. 10 Tennessee and to League rival VMI ... The Bulldogs had five players score in double figures against the Keydets as **REID AUGST** scored a career-high 29 points. **JASON RIDENHOUR** enjoyed the first double-double of his career with 15 points and 13 rebounds ... Freshman **J.P. PRIMM** just missed tying the school record for assists as he finished with 13 against VMI, one off the school record of 14 ... Asheville set a school-record for three-pointers with 16 against the Keydets ... UNC Asheville plays once this week, hosting Division II power Catawba on Saturday.

VMI
