Harris had a monster week for the Chanticleers as they went 1-1 against the top two teams in the Big South. He averaged 23.5 points, 18.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 blocks in the two games. In Monday's overtime loss at Radford, Harris had 14 points - all in the second half and overtime, and 14 rebounds. His free throw with one second left in regulation sent the game into overtime. In Saturday's win over VMI, Harris set career-highs with 33 points and 22 rebounds and tied a career-best with six assists. He was 16-of-26 from the floor and hit his first eight shots. He also tallied nine offensive rebounds and tied the school record for rebounds in a game. Harris collected two crucial rebounds in the closing seconds and assisted on the game-winning three-pointer against the Keydets.

He opened the week with the fifth triple-double in Big South history with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in the Flames' home win over Presbyterian. He also blocked two shots and grabbed a steal against the Blue Hose. He nearly had a double-double at Charleston Southern on Saturday with nine points and a game-high 10 rebounds. Sanders finished the week with 16 assists vs. zero turnovers, and shot 70.0 percent from the floor (7-of-10).

**RADFORD JUMPS INTO FIRST-PLACE, CLINCHES TOURNAMENT HOME GAME**

Radford won its sixth consecutive game in thrilling fashion on Saturday, as **AMIR JOHNSON** drove the length of the floor and made a layup with 1.5 seconds left to lift the Highlanders to a 66-65 victory at UNC Asheville. Coupled with VMI's loss at Coastal Carolina, Radford moved into sole possession of first-place in the League standings at 12-2 and clinched a Quarterfinal home game in the Big South Tournament. It will be Radford's first home tourney game since 2006 and the team's second overall since the Big South format moved to home sites in 2002-03.

**VMI SECURES FIRST-EVER HOME BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT CONTEST**

Despite its 100-97 loss at Coastal Carolina over the weekend, the VMI Keydets also clinched a Quarterfinal home game in the upcoming Conference tournament, thanks to High Point's defeat of Gardner-Webb on Saturday. It is the first time since VMI joined the Big South in 2003-04 that the Keydets will host a Big South Tournament game, and ends the drought as the only member to not host since the home site format began in 2002-03 (with the exception of first-year members Gardner-Webb and Presbyterian).

**IT'S A THREE TEAM RACE**

The race for the Big South regular-season championship is down to Radford, VMI and Liberty. The Highlanders have matched its best start in Big South play since recording a 12-2 Big South mark in 2000-01 -- the last time it won a regular-season championship. The Keydets are still in position to win their first-ever regular-season Big South title, as they are one game back in the standings with four games to play. Liberty, which can clinch a Quarterfinal home game with its next win, is still mathematically alive, as the Flames can finish with 13 Big South victories if they win out and if the Highlanders and Keydets falter down the stretch. Liberty has won two Big South regular-season championships, but never outright. The Flames shared the crown in 1996-97 and 2003-04.

**RADFORD-VMI MATCH-UP IS THE ROYAL PURPLE TV "GAME OF THE WEEK"**

This Saturday's Big South Conference Royal Purple "Game of the Week" features the League's top two teams, as first-place Radford visits second-place VMI live at 4:00pm on MASN. **JASON KNAPP** (play-by-play) and former Georgetown head coach **CRAIG ESHERICK** (analyst) will call the action.

**RADFORD HAS CHANCE FOR BIG SOUTH FIRST**

If Radford should finish the season in first-place and claim the No. 1 seed in the Big South Conference Tournament, the Highlanders would become the first team in Big South history to improve from seventh-place the previous year to winning the regular-season title the next. The current record for worst-to-first improvement in the League is sixth-place to first-place, which was established by Coastal Carolina in 1986-87 and 1987-88. In 1986-87, the Chanticleers were sixth in the Big South standings and the League's regular-season champion the following year.

Coastal Carolina's distinction is a little misleading, as the Conference did not have its current double-round robin scheduling in 1986-87 -- that began in 1987-88. In both 1985-86 and 1986-87, the Big South standings were determined by the Dunkel rating system, as not all teams played the same number of Conference games (the Chanticleers played eight League games that year, compared to five teams playing 14). The 1997-98 and 1998-99 Winthrop Eagles could also be considered the best worst-to-first improvement, as the 1997-98 squad tied for fifth but was the No. 6 seed in the Tournament. The next season, Winthrop won its first regular-season title.

**VMI TIES LEAGUE RECORD FOR FASTEST TEAM TO WIN 20 GAMES**

VMI's win over Charleston Southern on Monday, Feb. 9 was its 20th victory in its first 24 games, matching the Big South record for the fastest team to win 20 games. The record was first set by Liberty in 1991-92 and tied by Winthrop in 2006-07. After their respective 20-4 starts, the Flames finished with a 22-7 overall mark, while the Eagles won a Big South single-season record 29 games and ended the year at 29-5.

**20/20 VISION**

At 19-8, Liberty has a chance to record 20 regular-season wins for the first time since 1996-97, and its third overall as members of the Big South. Should the Flames reach the mark before the Conference tournament, they would join VMI (20-5) to mark just the third time in League history that two teams won 20 regular-season games in the same season. In 1990-91, Coastal Carolina and Radford each tallied 20 wins prior to the postseason tournament, and Winthrop and High Point reached 20 regular-season wins in 2006-07.

**MORE ON THE HIGHLANDERS**

Radford, which has received votes in the past two *Collegeinsider.com* Top 25 Mid-Major polls, is one Big South win away from tying the school record of 13, set in 1993-94 (13-5 League record). The Highlanders have won nine of their 12 Big South victories by double-digits (+16.3 average in those games), and has collected seven consecutive road wins in Conference play for the first time during its Big South membership. The last Big South team to win seven-straight road Conference games was Winthrop, which won eight consecutive League road tilts from Feb. 25, 2006 to Feb. 24, 2007.

**BIG SOUTH ON NATIONAL STAGE THIS WEEKEND WITH BRACKETBUSTERS**

The Big South's ESPN BracketBusters match-ups features the League's third consecutive season on national television, as Liberty will visit Colonial Athletic Association member Old Dominion Saturday at 11:00am on ESPN. The Big South is 1-1 in its televised appearances in the event. Meanwhile, Winthrop will host SoCon member Appalachian State and Gardner-Webb will visit CAA member James Madison. This will be Winthrop's fourth BracketBusters appearance (2-1) and Liberty's second (0-1). Gardner-Webb is making its BracketBusters debut.

**TRIPLE THREAT**

Liberty freshman **JESSE SANDERS** recorded just the fifth triple-double in Big South history when he scored 10 points, grabbed 10 rebounds and dished out 10 assists in Liberty's 69-48 victory over Presbyterian last Wednesday, Feb. 11. Thanks goes to **WILLIAM JOHNSON** for providing this information to the Big South Conference. Mr. Johnson has assisted the NCAA in compiling triple-double research over the past few years.

**IT AIN'T OVER UNTIL IT'S OVER**

Liberty has played five overtime games this season, which ties the Big South record for most overtime games in a season, but is the most played *DURING* the regular-season. In 2002-03, UNC Asheville also played five overtime games. However, the Bulldogs played three of those contests in the post-season -- two in the Big South Tournament and one in the NCAA Opening Round game. Meanwhile, of the Flames' five extra-session games this year, four have gone into double-overtime -- a first for a Big South member in League history.

**NO QUIT AMONG THESE MEMBERS**

With Liberty leading the way, eight of the 10 Big South members have played at least two overtime games this season -- matching a Big South record that was set in 2000-01. In fact, all but High Point have played past regulation this year. Radford has played four overtime games this season, while Coastal Carolina, Presbyterian and UNC Asheville have three extra session games.

**PLAYING BOARD GAMES**

Gardner-Webb freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** is the nation's leading freshman rebounder at 10.0 carsoms per game. He has 249 rebounds and is approaching the Big South's freshman records for rebounding in a season. Henley needs 14 rebounds to break the freshman rebound record of 262, set by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in 1990-91. In addition, Henley's per game average is pacing ahead of Spinks' League freshman record of 9.36.

**CONFERENCE SEASON HEATS UP IN FEBRUARY**

The 21 Big South Conference games from Feb. 2-14 were decided by an average margin of 7.1 points, with 17 of the contests decided under 10 points -- including five overtime games. In a contrast to most of the season, the *HOME* team won 13 times in that span ( =.619 winning percentage). The average margin of victory for the League season after 72 games is 9.74. Of the 72 games, 33 have been decided by at least 10 points (45.8 percent), while 24 have been decided by five points-or-less.

**FLOOR GENERAL**

Radford junior **AMIR JOHNSON** became the 17th player in Big South history with 400 career assists, as he reached the milestone with his final handout at UNC Asheville this past Saturday. Johnson is third all-time on Radford's career list, and is on pace to move up to at least 14th-place on the Big South's career list when the season is complete.

**BARBOUR SHOP**

High Point freshman **NICK BARBOUR** has burst onto the scene in the last three weeks. In his last seven games, Barbour is averaging 25.3 points and during the span scored 30 points in back-to-back games -- the first Big South player to do so in 2008-09. He is making 49.1 percent of his field goals during the current stretch (57-of-116) and hitting 46.9 percent from three-point range (23-of-49). Barbour has scored 20 points in his last four outings and has shot better than 50 percent from the field in five of the last seven contests.

**HARRIS POLL**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Feb. 4 at Presbyterian, has entered the Conference's all-time Top 10 following his 22-rebound performance against VMI this past Saturday. Harris is 10th in Big South annals with 753 boards and is 47 rebounds away from becoming the eighth player in League history with 800. Harris, who enters the week with seven consecutive double-doubles (18.1 points, 14.3 rebounds), is averaging a career-best 11.12 rebounds per game -- the second-highest season average in League history. Charleston Southern's **OLIVER JOHNSON** averaged a record 11.41 rebounds in 1986-87.

**BLOCK STEADY**

UNC Asheville leapster **JOHN WILLIAMS** became the 24th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Wednesday, Feb. 11 at Gardner-Webb. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history. Williams enters this week with 104 career rejections.

**KEYDETS SCORE HISTORICAL WINS**

VMI has won 11 Big South games, its most Conference wins in school history. The previous high was 10 as Southern Conference members in 1995-96. In addition, VMI has recorded its first 20-win season in 31 years, as the 1977-78 Keydets (21 wins) were the last to do so.

**WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?**

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams have won 34 of the 72 Big South games played -- a .472 winning percentage. It is the most Conference road wins since the Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule). **SWEEPING ON THE JOB**

With 27 Conference series in the books already, 18 have resulted in season sweeps (66.7 percent). Radford has swept four opponents, followed by VMI with three sweeps.

**CURRY HAS ONE FRESHMAN RECORD, LOOKING FOR ANOTHER**

With 555 points, Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** is the highest scoring frosh in Big South history. He broke the League's single-season freshman record of 466 points Jan. 31 against UNC Asheville, bettering the mark set last season by Charleston Southern's **OMAR CARTER** -- Curry's high school teammate at Charlotte Christian in Charlotte, N.C. Curry needs 79 points to enter the Big South's single-season Top 10 scoring leaders. Meanwhile, Curry is averaging 20.6 points per game, second in the Big South and the highest among all freshmen in the nation. He is looking to become the first frosh in Conference history to average 20.0 points per game, and his current average is higher than the League freshman record of 18.1 points, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1989-90.

**TWO FRESHMEN BATTLING FOR LEAGUE'S FRESHMAN 3-POINT RECORD**

Liberty's **SETH CURRY** and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** are challenging the Big South single-season freshman record of 85 three-pointers, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05. Curry enters this week with 80 three-pointers, just ahead of Gabriel's 78 treys. Leasure concluded his career as the Conference's all-time leader with 411.

**VMI GOING FOR NATIONAL SCORING THREE-PEAT**

VMI leads the nation in scoring with 95.9 points per game and is looking to become just the third team since 1948 to lead the NCAA in scoring offense three consecutive years. The Keydets would join Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) on the list.

**KEYDETS PACING AHEAD OF THEIR OWN NCAA RECORD**

VMI is averaging 13.64 three-pointers per game this season, which is pacing ahead of its national record of 13.39 set during the 2006-07 campaign. The Keydets are on pace to conclude the season with at least 409 threes, and are looking to become the first team in NCAA history to make 400 three-pointers in two different seasons.

**BABY LET'S CRUZ**

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** became the fourth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots when he eclipsed the milestone on Saturday, Feb. 7 vs. Coastal Carolina. Daniels, who entered the season tied for 14th all-time, has 65 swats on the season -- just the third player in Conference annals with three 60+ block seasons. He joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** on the list. The Conference's top four career shot blockers are listed below, and Daniels needs 11 to move into second-place in history.

**GOOD COMPANY**

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds when he reached the rebounding milestone against High Point on Jan. 27. Six days later, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the 10th player on the League's 1,500-point/500-rebound list when he eclipsed the scoring milestone against UNC Asheville on Feb. 2. Smith is tied for 15th in Conference annals with 1,622 points and 49th with 524 boards. Holmes is 17th all-time in League history with 1,615 points and 47th with 530 rebounds.

**NEW GUYS IN TOWN**

Big South newcomers Presbyterian and Gardner-Webb have each won seven Big South games this season. If both teams win out the rest of the season, PC would finish with 11 Conference wins, while Gardner-Webb would collect 10 Big South victories. The last new member to win 10 Big South games in its official inaugural season was Birmingham-Southern in 2003-04 (12 wins). The record for most League wins in the first official season as a new member is 14, set by Towson State in 1992-93. The Tigers posted a 14-2 Big South record that season.

**POINT OF ORDER**

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,912 career points -- good for sixth-place on the League's all-time list. He is 88 points away from becoming the Big South's sixth 2,000-point scorer. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,622), **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,615), **KENNY THOMAS** (1,083), and **REID AUGST** (1,047). **CLOSE ENCOUNTERS**

VMI suffered its first loss of the season by five points-or-less, meaning that all 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game by that margin this season. A total of 40 losses have been decided by five points-or-less -- 24 League games and 16 non-Conference. Coastal Carolina has posted losses of that margin a League-high seven times this season, including six in Conference action. Liberty has six such defeats, and those six have been by a combined 17 points (2.8 average). Winthrop, Gardner-Webb and High Point are next with five losses by the five-point margin, followed by Radford (3), Charleston Southern (3) and Presbyterian (3), UNC Asheville (2) and VMI (1).

**HOLMES SCORING**

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** continues to lead the Big South in scoring at 22.0 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

**BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL IN A CLUB ALL BY HIMSELF**

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is the first player in Big South history with 1,500 career points, 500 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 250 career steals. Holmes is 11 steals away from becoming the League's first player with 300 takeaways.

**AUSTIN POWERS**

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in every game of his career -- a span of 41 games. He made 57 in 16 appearances in 2007-08, and has 95 treys through 25 games this season. Kenon has 152 three-pointers in his 41 games, a 3.71 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. The NCAA career record, also based on 200 career threes, is 4.57 by Mississippi Valley's **TIMOTHY POLLARD**.

**FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

In addition to Liberty's **SETH CURRY** and **JOSHUA HENLEY**, other Big South freshmen men's basketball players have impacted the Conference this season. Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is seventh in rebounding at 7.0. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (4.56), High Point's **DAVID SINGLETON** (4.40) and UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** (4.35) are second, third and fifth, respectively, in the Big South in assists. Sanders continues to lead in assist-turnover ratio (2.67), and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is third in three-pointers per game (3.12), fourth in three-point percentage (.380), and fourth in three-pointers made (78).

**DEEP THREE-FISHING**

Two Big South players remain on pace to make more than 100 three-point field goals this season. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** needs five more treys for 100 and is tracking at 110 three-pointers this season. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is on pace for 103. Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** is on target for 92 by the end of the regular-season, while VMI frosh **KEITH GABRIEL** is on pace for 90. However, Curry and Gabriel will have at least one Conference Tournament game to add to their totals. The Big South record for most players with 100 three-point field goals in the same season is two -- VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** in 2006-07.

**BROTHERS IN ARMS**

In addition to their scoring exploits, VMI twins **TRAVIS** and **CHAVIS HOLMES** rank first and second, respectively, in Big South history in career steals. Travis is the all-time leader with 289, but Chavis is not far behind at 281 for a combined total of 570. Both players supplanted former Winthrop guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** this season, as Gaynor set the career record just last year with 259. Chavis' consecutive games streak with a steal ended at 34 games on Feb. 4 at Winthrop. During that time, he recorded 109 steals for an average of 3.21 steals per game. Meanwhile, Travis has recorded a steal in his last 31 games, also a career-best streak. He has 92 thefts in that span for a 2.97 per game average. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 99 of his 112 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 95 of his 109 career games.

**McKAY GETS 200TH CAREER WIN**

Liberty second-year head coach **RITCHIE McKAY** won his 200th career game as a collegiate head coach when Liberty won 95-80 at Charleston Southern on Saturday, Feb. 14. He is 200-182 in his 13 seasons on the sidelines, and the second Big South coach to reach 200 career wins this season, joining UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**. All of McKay's wins have come at the Division I level and in five different conferences (Big Sky, Big South, Mountain West, Pac-10, WAC). McKay has led the Flames to at least 16 wins in both seasons as head coach, as well as a 26-3 record at the Vines Center (= .897 winning percentage). Liberty's 19 victories this year are the most by the Flames in the regular-season since 1996-97, when LU won 21 regular-season contests before the Conference Tournament.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is now tied for second all-time in League history with 104 career regular-season Big South wins. He has matched Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** for the second-most Conference wins. Former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** is the all-time leader with 109 regular-season Big South wins. This season, Biedenbach recorded two milestone victories in less than two weeks of each other. He notched his 200th career coaching win Dec. 31 vs. Western Carolina, and collected his 100th regular-season Big South win Jan. 13 vs. High Point.

## THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is in sole possession of seventh-place in Big South history with 282 career three-pointers, and needs seven treys to catch **RAYMOND ARRINGTON** (Radford) for sixth-place at 289. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the 23rd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he surpassed the threshold Saturday at Charleston Southern. His 201 treys are ahead of High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS**, who reached 200 against Coastal Carolina the week before on Feb. 7.

## TEN MEN

The Big South has three players averaging 10.0 rebounds this season, which would mark the first such occurrence in League history. Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (11.1), Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (11.0) and Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** (10.0) are rebounding at a double-digit clip.

## HOLMES TWINS OWN PIECE OF NCAA DIVISION I HISTORY

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the highest scoring twin brother combination in NCAA Division I history on Jan. 24, as they scored a combined 47 points to help VMI to a 92-85 win over High Point. The duo entered the game needing 38 points to break the Division I record of 3,252, which was set by another VMI duo -- **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** from 1987-90. Chavis (1,912) and Travis (1,615) have now combined for 3,527 career points.

## IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed a League-record three student-athletes on the 2009 *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-Team. Charleston Southern senior **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS**, Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN** and Radford's **PHILLIP MARTIN** were honored, and all three individuals advance to the national ballot with the opportunity to earn Academic All-America status.

## BIG SOUTH CONTINUES DOUBLE TEAM IN MID-MAJOR POLL

For 10 consecutive weeks, the Big South has had two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll. VMI was ranked No. 12 last week, while Liberty held the No. 23 position. In addition, Radford has received votes the past two weeks. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons, while this is the first time in League history that two teams have appeared in the weekly rankings. CSU struggled with its second consecutive 0-2 week, after giving VMI all it could handle on the road and falling victim to the hot shooting of Liberty at home. Against the Keydets, the Bucs were up nine with 7:10 remaining in the game ... Against Liberty, **JAMARCO WARREN** broke CSU's single-season record for three-point field goals, after hitting five in the game ... The Bucs will have a pair of home games this week, as they try to qualify for the Big South Tournament.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina has had an unprecedented last six games go down to the last possession. The Chanticleers fell 71-67 in overtime to Radford, while junior **MARIO EDWARDS** hit a three-pointer as time expired to give the Chants a 100-97 win over Big South leader VMI ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** now has three 30-plus point scoring performances against the Keydets in his career ... Edwards had a career-high 28 points in the VMI win ... Coastal Carolina closes out the home portion of its schedule Monday night and will celebrate Senior Night prior to its game with Liberty.

#### GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb is in the midst of its longest losing streak (three games) since early December ... Freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** is averaging 10.0 rebounds per game through 25 games, and has pulled down at least 14 cars on in four-straight ... **GRAYSON FLITTNER** played for the first time in more than two weeks vs. High Point, but was visibly rusty, going 0-for-7 from the floor and just 2-for-4 from the free throw stripe.

#### HIGH POINT

High Point picked up a pair of Big South victories last week. It marked the first back-to-back wins for the Panthers this season ... HPU has now won three of its last four games ... The Panthers recorded their first season sweep of Winthrop in program history ... HPU's win at GWU was the squad's third road win in League play, marking the second most road "W"s in Big South play in Panthers history ... High Point has topped the 60-point mark in seven straight games after reaching the mark just once in the previous seven contests ... HPU will close the regular season with three of its final four games at the Millis Center.

#### LIBERTY

Liberty will attempt to tally 20 victories for the fifth time in program history, the third time in the Division I era and the first time since the 1996-97 season ... **JESSE SANDERS** completed the first triple-double in Liberty's Division I era. Sanders tallied 10 points, 10 rebounds and dished out 10 assists versus no turnovers in Liberty's 69-48 triumph over Presbyterian ... **SETH CURRY** extended his consecutive free throws streak to 34-straight following his 14-of-14 performance in two games last week.

#### PRESBYTERIAN

PC will take on VMI Monday evening at home before hitting the road for two games at Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb over the next nine days ... **AL LONZO COLEMAN** posted a double-double effort against Winthrop, notching 20 points and 16 rebounds in the game. He averaged 16.5 points and 11.5 rebounds last week.

#### RADFORD

Radford's next win would match the Highlanders' school record for Big South triumphs in a season (13-5 in 1993-94) ... To go along with their current six-game spurt, the Highlanders have won seven-straight road games ... Radford is on its longest road winning streak since 1978-79 and is looking to win eight consecutive away from home for the first time in program history.

#### UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville had its three-game winning streak snapped in heartbreaking fashion at home Saturday with a 66-65 loss to Radford ... **REID AUGST** just missed a career-high with 28 points in an 87-78 overtime win over Gardner-Webb Wednesday night. Two of the Bulldogs' last three wins have occurred in overtime ... **JOHN WILLIAMS** had his third double-double of the year against Gardner-Webb.

#### VMI

Despite tying or setting a season-low in four categories, VMI was still able to manage a win at home against Charleston Southern on Feb. 9. Against the Bucs, VMI hit just seven 3-pointers, forced 15 turnovers, and had only one player score 15-or-more points and got zero points from its bench, but VMI finished the game with a 19-4 run to win the game 82-76. It marked the fourth time this year VMI had rallied to win the game after trailing at the half ... Saturday's 100-97 setback at Coastal Carolina was the first time VMI had lost a game after leading at the half. VMI was 15-0 in those games prior to the CCU contest. VMI had also been 17-0 after holding the lead with 5:00 to go in the game ... **KEITH GABRIEL** broke out of a slump with 18 points against Charleston Southern, as he hit 6-of-9 shots from the field, including four 3-pointers. It was the most threes he had hit in a game since nailing six treys against Southern Virginia on Jan. 29.

#### WINTHROP

Winthrop broke a five-game losing streak overall and a four-game skid in Big South play with a 50-47 home win over PC on Valentine's Day ... Not since the 1997-98 season had the Eagles lost as many as four-straight Big South games ... The loss at High Point means that Winthrop's Big South record-setting streak of consecutive seasons with 10-or-more Conference wins will end this year at nine ... **CAMERON STANLEY**, who had been in a 2-of-23 3FG shooting slump, connected on 2-of-4 vs. PC and led the Eagles with 16 points ... **CHRIS MALCOLM** saw his consecutive made field goals streak of 12 end during the High Point game. He was 12-of-14 over a five-game stretch.

### BIG SOUTH MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT TIDBITS

Since the Big South adopted the current home site Conference Tournament format in 2003, the home seeds are a combined 25-12 (=.676) in 37 possible home games. This total does not include games that were played on a neutral floor in 2003 (semifinals and finals) and 2006, 2007 and 2008 (semifinals).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 15-9 (=.625) on their home courts after last year's top four seeds were all victorious for the first time in the same season.
