Smith averaged 21.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 3.0 steals and shot .563 percent from three-point range (9-of-16) for the Flames last week. He scored 24 points, including 19 in the second half, to lead Liberty to a 61-56 come-from-behind victory at High Point. Against the Panthers, Smith registered three steals in the final :23 seconds to lead the comeback. He also scored eight straight points to bring the Flames within one after trailing by nine with 1:43 remaining. Smith then tallied 18 points and pulled down 12 rebounds in a double-overtime loss to Radford. He also dished out five assists against the Highlanders and hit three crucial three-point buckets after halftime to keep Liberty in the game.

NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

ANDRE JONES

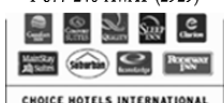
Guard • Winthrop

Jones averaged 18.0 points and 3.5 assists in two games for the Eagles. He scored back-to-back career-highs as he had 15 points in a win at Charleston Southern and 21 points at Coastal Carolina. He connected on 6-of-10 field goals and 3-of-4 from the line against the Buccaneers, along with four assists. Jones then went 8-of-14 from the floor, including 4-of-7 from long range, against the Chanticleers, in addition to three assists and two steals. Jones finished the week 14-of-24 from the field (=.583) and 4-of-8 from beyond the arc (=.500), and has now scored in double figures in three straight games and four of his last five.

HOLMES TWINS MAKE NCAA DIVISION I HISTORY

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the highest scoring twin brother combination in NCAA Division I history this past Saturday, as they scored a combined 47 points to help Big South-leading VMI to a 92-85 win over High Point. The duo entered the game needing 38 points to break the Division I record of 3,252, which was set by another VMI duo - **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** from 1987-90. Chavis (1,776) and Travis (1,486) have now combined for 3,262 career points.

REVISED LISTING ACCELERATES RECORD FOR TWINS

In a newly revised scoring list verified by the NCAA on Friday, Jan. 23, former VMI guards **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** (1987-90) were officially deemed the Division I record holders at 3,252 points collectively. **JOHNNY** and **EDDIE O'BRIEN**, who had been considered the all-time leading scorers among twins in Division I at 3,262 points before the revision, were deemed to have played at Seattle University for two seasons (1951 and 1952) during which the school participated at the NCAA College Division level, the forerunner to modern day Division II. Therefore, the O'Brien's, who scored a combined 3,970 points during their three years in Seattle, in fact scored just 1,446 points while competing at the NCAA University Division level, regarded as Division I.

BIG SOUTH ROYAL PURPLE "GAME OF THE WEEK" RESUMES SATURDAY ON MASN

The Big South Conference Royal Purple "Game of the Week" resumes this Saturday when Charleston Southern visits Coastal Carolina live at 9:00pm on MASN. Baltimore Orioles announcer **JIM HUNTER** (play-by-play) and former Georgetown great **MARK TILLMON** (analyst) will call the action.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks when he reached the milestone this past Saturday against Winthrop. BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL JOINS ELITE CLUB

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is the second player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 200 career steals. He joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in the exclusive club. Spinks posted 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 344 assists and 220 steals in his Big South Hall of Fame career from 1990-94. Holmes surpassed 500 career rebounds this past Saturday vs. High Point, becoming the 50th player in Big South history to reach that milestone. He added 11 assists against the Panthers to move to 302 career helpers. Holmes ranks 25th in history with 1,486 points and first all-time with 272 steals.

MR. SMITH GOES TO LYNCHBURG

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** needs three rebounds to become the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds. He is 21st in Conference annals with 1,534 points and three caroms shy of becoming the 51st player (and second within a week) with 500 rebounds. **TRAVIS HOLMES** needs 14 points to become the 10th player on the League's 1,500-point/500-rebound list.

VMI'S 16 WINS MOST SINCE 1995-96

The VMI Keydets' 16-3 record is their best start in 32 years years, while their 16 wins are the most since the 1995-96 campaign when the Keydets finished 18-10. VMI has already won its most Big South games (8) since joining the League in 2003-04.

HIGHLANDER HITS

Radford stands in second-place at the Conference's halfway point with a 7-2 League record. It is the Highlanders' best start in the Big South since a 12-2 mark in 2000-01. Radford has won all seven of its League games by double-digits (+15.9 average), and has collected four consecutive road wins in Conference play for the first time since the 1998-99 season.

BOARD MEETING

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 28th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Jan. 3 against High Point, needs 37 rebounds to become the 19th player with 700. Harris is 23rd all-time with 663 and enters the week needing 13 rebounds to pass **MARK HAILEY** (Winthrop) and **MAURICE INGRAM** (Coastal Carolina) for 22nd place. Harris is averaging a career-best 10.0 rebounds and is on pace to end the regular-season with 763 career rebounds, which would put him in ninth-place on the Big South's career chart.

CRUZZIN

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS**, who entered the season tied for 14th all-time on the Big South's career blocked shot chart, finds himself in fourth-place with 194. He is six swats away from becoming the fourth player in League history with 200 career blocks. Daniels has 55 blocked shots this season and is five away from becoming just the third player in Conference annals with three 60+ block seasons, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS**. Meanwhile, Daniels needs 21 blocked shots to move into second-place on the Big South's career list.

CURRY'S GETTING FRESH

Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** is averaging 20.7 points per game, second in the Big South and the highest among all freshmen in the nation. Curry is looking to become the first frosh in Conference history to average 20.0 points per game, and his current average is higher than the League freshman record of 18.1 points, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1989-90. In addition, Curry (435 points) is 32 points away from breaking the Big South freshman scoring record of 466 points, which was set last season by Charleston Southern's **OMAR CARTER** -- Curry's former high school teammate.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

In addition to Liberty's **SETH CURRY**, other Big South freshmen men's basketball players are already making an impact in the Conference this season. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is third in the Big South in rebounding at 9.3 per game -- good for the national freshman lead as well, while Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is fifth at 7.7. High Point's **DAVID SINGLETON** (4.74) and UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** (4.45) are second and third, respectively, in the Big South in assists. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** leads in assist-turnover ratio (2.11), and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is third in three-pointers per game (3.47) and in three-point percentage (.402), and tied for third in three-pointers made (66).

TEN MEN

The Big South has two players averaging 10.0 rebounds this season, which would mark just the second time in League history that two players averaged that many rebounds in one year. Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (10.5) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (10.0) are averaging double figures. In 2000-01, Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** (10.1) and Radford's **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** (10.0) were the first (and last) Big South duo to average 10.0 rebounds a game in the same season.

DOWN HOLMES COOKIN'

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is now second in League history with 261 career steals, supplanting former Winthrop guard **CHRIS GAYNOR**, who set the career record just last year with 259. Chavis has a steal in his last 32 games - a career-best, and has totaled 101 steals during his streak for an average of 3.16. Meanwhile, twin brother and Big South all-time steals leader **TRAVIS HOLMES** has recorded a steal in his last 25 games, also a career-best streak. He has 75 thefts in that span for a 3.00 per game average. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 94 of his 106 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 89 of his 103 career games.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

Nine of the 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game this season by five points-or-less, with a total of 28 losses being decided by that margin -- 16 non-Conference contests and 12 League games. Liberty has posted losses of that margin a League-high five times this season, as five of their seven losses have been by a combined 12 points. Gardner-Webb and High Point is next with four, followed by Radford, Coastal Carolina, Winthrop and Charleston Southern with three each. Presbyterian has two losses by five points-or-less, and UNC Asheville has one.

TWO ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Through 44 Big South Conference games, 26 have been decided by at least 10 points, while 12 have been decided by five points-or-less. The average margin of victory for the League season after 44 games is 11.02 points.

THOMAS NETS 1,000TH CAREER POINT

Radford senior **KENNY THOMAS** became the 90th player in Big South history and 23rd in Radford history to score 1,000 career points when he reached the milestone at High Point on Jan. 17. The last Highlander to reach 1,000 points was **CHRIS OLIVER** in 2006.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** became the 11th player in Big South history with 1,700 career points and is the League's active leading scorer with 1,776 career points -- good for eighth-place on the League's all-time list. He is 80 points from surpassing Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (1,856 points) for seventh-place. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,534), **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,486) and **KENNY THOMAS** (1,031). BURNIN' DOWN THE HOUSE

For the second time this year, Radford has ended a Big South member's home winning streak. The Highlanders snapped Liberty's 11-game home winning streak at the Vines Center this past Saturday. It was the Flames' longest home winning streak since an 11-game streak last season. On Jan. 3, Radford ended Presbyterian's 14-game home winning streak at the Templeton Center.

DEEP THREE-FISHING

Three Big South players are on pace to make more than 100 three-point field goals this season. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** is tracking at 122 three-pointers this season, which would fall just shy of the Big South single-season record of 125. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is on pace for 113, while VMI freshman **KEITH GABRIEL** is on target for 101 by the end of the regular-season. Liberty frosh **SETH CURRY** is on pace for 97. The Big South record for most players with 100 three-point field goals in the same season is two -- VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** in 2006-07.

FRESHMAN THREE-POINT RECORD WITHIN REACH

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** and Liberty's **SETH CURRY** each are 19 three-point field goals away from tying the Big South single-season freshman record of 85 three-pointers, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05. Leasure concluded his career as the Conference's all-time leader with 411.

AMIR AMIR, ON THE WALL

Radford junior **AMIR JOHNSON** is 29 assists away from becoming the 17th player in Big South history 400 career assists. He enters the week with 371, good for 21st place in history and fourth all-time on Radford's career list. Johnson needs 12 assists to move into third-place in school history.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FOURTH APPEARANCE IN ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the ESPNU BracketBusters event this season during the week-end of February 20-21. Winthrop (home), Gardner-Webb (road) and Liberty (road) will be the League's participants. The League has received two nationally-televised broadcasts the past two seasons. Winthrop is 2-1 all-time in the event, while Liberty is 0-1. Gardner-Webb will make its first-ever appearance in the BracketBusters. The match-ups are slated to be announced on Monday, Feb. 2.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is in sole possession of eighth-place in Big South history with 264 career three-pointers, and needs 11 treys to catch **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina) for seventh-place at 275. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 26th in Conference annals with 191, and needs nine triples to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (185) and VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** (161) are also approaching the 200 career three-point field goal milestone.

FIRST MATE

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** is vying for the Big South scoring title, as he is currently third at 19.9 -- just 1.9 points behind leader **CHAVIS HOLMES** of VMI. Warren, who has made a three-point field goal in his last 20 games, is looking to become the first CSU player to average 20.0 points per game in a season since **BRETT LARRICK** averaged 20.0 points in 1996-97, which was also the last time a Buccaneer player led the Big South in scoring average.

AUSTIN POWERS

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in every game of his career -- a span of 35 games. He made 57 in 16 appearances in 2007-08, and has 80 treys through 19 games this season. Kenon has 137 three-pointers in his 35 games, a 3.91 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. The NCAA career record, also based on 200 career threes, is 4.57 by Mississippi Valley's **TIMOTHY POLLARD**.

HOLMES SCORING

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** enters this week as the Big South's top scorer at 21.9 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the third coach in League history with 100 wins in regular-season Big South games on Jan. 13 when the Bulldogs defeated High Point. He now has 101 Conference game wins, which trails **RON BRADLEY** (109) and **GREGG MARSHALL** (104) for the most in Big South annals. Biedenbach, who won his 200th career game on Dec. 31, 2008 against Western Carolina, is now 204-248 in his head coaching career, including a 175-197 mark in his 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor.

In the second half at UNC Asheville, **TRAVIS SLIGH** scored all 16 of his team-high points, just two off his career-high ... Coleman averaged a double-double in his last two games (12.0 points, 13.5 rebounds) ... The Blue Hose are off until Saturday's game when they host High Point.

RADFORD

After playing its first nine home games at Peters Hall, Radford re-opened the Dedmon Center last Wednesday evening against VMI in front of 3,066 fans ... Including this past Saturday's double-overtime win at Liberty, Radford has played in seven overtime games the last two seasons and has recorded a 5-2 mark in those contests.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville ended a two-game losing streak with a 68-58 victory against Presbyterian Saturday night ... **REID AUGST** and **JOHN WILLIAMS** led the way for Asheville with 15 points each. Williams also had eight rebounds and five blocked shots ... The Bulldogs have won 24 of their last 28 home games ... **MATT DICKEY** had a career-high seven assists and five steals in the Bulldogs' win over Presbyterian ... Augst has scored in double figures 17 times this season.

TRAVIS HOLMES returned to the lineup after missing five games with an injury, and averaged 21.5 points, 9.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds in his first two games back. WINTHROP

Winthrop got career-high scoring performances from **MANTORIS ROBINSON** (22) and **ANDRE JONES** (21), but it was not enough for the Eagles to overcome Coastal Carolina on the road ... Robinson collected his first career double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds vs. the Chanticleers ... Earlier in the week at Charleston Southern, Robinson was 7-of-7 from the field, and scored six points and grabbed three rebounds in the final two minutes to lead the Eagles to a two-point victory ... Winthrop's 13 losses is the most since the 2000-01 season when the Eagles finished 18-13 ... At the halfway point, Winthrop's hopes of continuing its League record of consecutive seasons with 10-or-more Big South wins is in jeopardy, as the Eagles need to win six of the final nine Conference games to extend the streak to 10 years.
