SETH CURRY

Curry averaged 25.0 points in two games last week, helping Liberty to a 2-0 record. He scored a team-high 15 points in a 68-55 victory over Coastal Carolina, then poured in a career-high 35 points on 10-of-15 shooting in the Flames' 91-80 defeat of first-place VMI. Curry scored 20 points in the first-half at VMI and finished the day 4-of-6 from three-point range and a perfect 11-of-11 from the free throw line. On the week, Curry shot .536 percent from the floor (15-of-28), .941 percent from the charity stripe (16-of-17) and averaged 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 steals. Curry also received his second "Diaper Dandy of the Week" honor this season from ESPN's Dick Vitale for his performance last week.

Dickey averaged 19.0 points in the Bulldogs' two games last week. He scored 15 points and grabbed seven rebounds off the bench in Asheville's 61-59 victory over High Point. Dickey was a bright spot in a loss at Winthrop, as he scored 23 points in 25 minutes. He was 6-of-8 for the floor -- including 4-of-5 three-pointers, and was 7-of-9 from the free throw line. For the week, Dickey shot .611 from the field (11-of-18), .545 from long range (6-of-11) and .769 percent from the charity stripe (10-of-13), while averaging 4.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 steals.

FIRST-PLACE SHOWDOWN SET FOR NEWLY RENOVATED DEDMON CENTER

Radford and VMI enter the week tied for first in the Big South standings with 6-1 League records, and the two teams will face each other for the first time this season on Wednesday night, Jan. 21. The game will open Radford's renovated Dedmon Center. The Highlanders played its first nine home games at 575-seat Peters Hall, and went 6-3 in their cozy temporary home.

HITTING THE HIGH NOTES

Radford has won six consecutive Big South games for the first time since opening the 1999-00 Big South slate with six straight wins. The Highlanders have won each of those six games by double figures, the best such stretch by a League team in one season since former member Birmingham-Southern won nine consecutive Big South games by at least 10 points in 2005-06. The last time Radford won seven Big South games in succession was during a 14-game streak that overlapped the 1998-99 and 1999-00 seasons. The Highlanders, which have won six Conference games for the first time since winning nine League contests in 2005-06, concluded the 1998-99 Big South campaign with eight consecutive regular-season Conference wins.

DESPITE FIRST LEAGUE LOSS, VMI'S 6-0 START HAS HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

VMI became the 15th team in Big South history to start League play 6-0 following the Keydets' 90-75 win over Presbyterian on Jan. 12. VMI's undefeated start was snapped this past Saturday at home vs. Liberty. Of the previous 14 teams that started the Conference season 6-0, 12 went on to win or share the regular-season title, while seven won the Big South Tournament championship. Another two reached the Conference title game. It was the first time the Keydets started 6-0 in league play since 1976-77 when they were members of the Southern Conference. VMI's 6-0 start marks the fourth consecutive season that a Big South team won its first six Conference games of the campaign.

ANOTHER VMI WIN STREAK DOUSED BY FLAMES

VMI's win streak reached 10 consecutive games before ending against Liberty this past Saturday. It was the program's longest winning streak since the 1977-78 season when VMI won 10 consecutive games that season as well.

TWIN PEAKS

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** are the fourth set of twins in NCAA Division I history to score a combined 3,000 points. The duo reached the milestone Saturday, Dec. 13 vs. Southern Wesleyan, and have now scored 3,173 points -- Chavis with 1,730 points and Travis with 1,443. They trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place. Below are the highest scoring twin brother combinations in NCAA Division I history, according to the NCAA. BOARD MEETING

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 28th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Jan. 3 against High Point, ranks 24th all-time with 646 and enters the week needing 15 rebounds to pass **JEFF DANIELS** (Charleston Southern) for 23rd place. Harris is averaging a career-best 10.1 rebounds and is on pace to end the regular-season with 767 career rebounds, which would put him in ninth-place on the Big South's career chart.

PHOTO FINISH

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (482) and VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** (491) are approaching the 500-rebound milestone, and the first player to the plateau would be the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Both are also approaching 1,500 career points as well, and the Conference currently has just eight players in its history with 1,500 points and 500 rebounds.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the third coach in League history with 100 wins in regular-season Big South games on Jan. 13 when the Bulldogs defeated High Point. His 100 Conference game wins are behind **RON BRADLEY** (109) and **GREGG MARSHALL** (104) for the most in Big South annals. Biedenbach, who won his 200th career game on Dec. 31, 2008 against Western Carolina, is now 203-247 in his head coaching career, including a 174-196 mark in his 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor.

BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL SET TO JOIN ELITE CLUB

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES**, who has missed the past five games due to injury, is approaching an elite club in League annals. The Big South's all-time steals leader with 268, Holmes is nine rebounds away from 500 in his career, and once he reaches the milestone, he would become just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career steals. Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** is currently the lone member of the club, as he posted 1,711 points, 954 rebounds and 220 steals in his career from 1990-94.

CRUZZIN

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** blocked four shots against Radford this past Saturday to pass UNC Greensboro's **ERIC CUTHRELL** for fifth-place in Big South history. Daniels' career total stands at 186, and he needs four blocks to tie **C.J. WALKER** of UNC Asheville for fourth-place at 190. Daniels, who blocked a career-high eight shots against Youngstown State on Friday, Dec. 19 to jump from 10th place to sixth, needs 14 rejections to become the fourth player in League history with 200 in a career.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

Nine of the 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game this season by five points-or-less, with a total of 26 losses being decided by that margin -- including 16 non-Conference contests. Liberty has posted losses of that margin a League-high five times this season, as their last five losses have been by a combined 12 points. Gardner-Webb is next with four, followed by Radford, Coastal Carolina, High Point and Winthrop with three each. Charleston Southern and Presbyterian each have two losses by five points-or-less.

TEN MEN

The Big South has two players averaging 10.0 rebounds this season, which would mark just the second time in League history that two players averaged that many rebounds in one year. Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (10.3) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (10.1) are averaging double figures. In 2000-01, Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** (10.1) and Radford's **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** (10.0) were the first (and last) Big South duo to average 10.0 rebounds a game in the same season.

DOWN HOLMES COOKIN'

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** has 256 career steals and is three away from tying **CHRIS GAYNOR** for second all-time in League history with 259. He has a steal in his last 30 games - a career-best, and has totaled 96 steals during his streak for an average of 3.20. Meanwhile, twin brother and injured Big South all-time steals leader **TRAVIS HOLMES** has recorded a steal in his last 23 games, a career-best streak. He has 71 thefts in that span for a 3.09 per game average. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 92 of his 104 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 87 of his 101 career games.

ART OF THE DEAL

Radford junior 6-11 center **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** is one of the reasons why Radford is 6-1 in its last seven games. He is averaging 15.1 points and 12.1 rebounds during that stretch, which includes five double-doubles and double-figure scoring each game. He is also shooting 51.2 percent from the floor (42-of-82) and 71.0 percent from the free throw line (22-of-31).

WINTHROP RISING

Winthrop is 3-2 in its last five games and scored a season-high 87 points this past Saturday vs. UNC Asheville. It was the most points scored by the Eagles in a Big South game since netting 88 against the Bulldogs on Feb. 3, 2007 in the Justice Center. Winthrop's 20-point win over the Bulldogs this past Saturday was their largest margin of victory in a Conference contest since a 22-point victory vs. Coastal Carolina on Jan. 26, 2008 - a span of 16 League games.

THOMAS NETS 1,000TH CAREER POINT

Radford senior **KENNY THOMAS** became the 90th player in Big South history and 23rd in Radford history to score 1,000 career points when he reached the milestone Saturday at High Point. The last Highlander to reach 1,000 points was **CHRIS OLIVER** in 2006.

HOME SWEET HOME

Liberty has won its last 11 home games at the Vines Center, the longest active home winning streak in the Big South, and the Flames' longest home winning streak since an 11-game streak last season. Liberty head coach **RITCHIE MCKAY** has a career 22-2 mark inside the Vines Center (=.917), including 9-0 this season. VMI won its first eight home games of the season, and Winthrop is 66-9 (=.880) at home in regular-season Big South games since 1998-99.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is in sole possession of eighth-place in Big South history with 258 career three-pointers, and needs 17 treys to catch **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina) for seventh-place at 275. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 26th in Conference annals with 186, and needs 14 triples to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (176) and VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** (159) are also approaching the 200 career three-point field goal milestone.

SPEAKING OF THREE-POINTERS...

Two Big South players are on pace to make more than 100 three-point field goals this season. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** are tracking at 116 three-pointers each, which would match the third-highest single-season total in Big South history. Meanwhile, VMI freshman **KEITH GABRIEL** is on pace for 99 by the end of the regular-season, while Liberty frosh **SETH CURRY** is on target for 96. The Big South record for most players with 100 three-point field goals in the same season is two -- VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** in 2006-07.

AMIR AMIR, ON THE WALL

Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON**, who became the 40th player in Big South history with 300 career assists when he surpassed the milestone on Dec. 10 vs. Duquesne, now owns 359 career helpers entering this week, good for 25th in League history. Johnson needs 41 assists to become the 17th Big South player with 400 career assists.

FIRST MATE

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** is vying for the Big South scoring title, as he is currently third at 20.2 -- just 1.4 points behind leader **CHAVIS HOLMES** of VMI. Warren is looking to become the first CSU player to average 20.0 points per game in a season since **BRETT LARRICK** averaged 20.0 points in 1996-97, which was also the last time a Buccaneer player led the Big South in scoring average.

AUSTIN POWERS

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in every game of his career -- a span of 33 games. He made 57 in 16 appearances in 2007-08, and has 68 treys through 17 games this season. Kenon has 125 three-pointers in his 33 games, a 3.79 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08.

HOLMES SCORING

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** enters this week as the Big South's top scorer at 21.6 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU dropped two games last week to move into an eight-game slide, including five in Conference play ... The Buccaneers open a three-game homestand on Tuesday ... Saturday's loss at Presbyterian featured seven ties and 20 lead changes, but an eight-minute scoring drought to end the game doomed the Bucs ... **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** averaged 10.0 points and 5.5 rebounds last week, while freshman **KELVIN MARTIN** contributed 11.5 points and 5.5 boards in the two games.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina ended its three-game road swing with a 77-55 loss to Gardner-Webb. Earlier in the week, the Chants fell to Liberty, 68-55 ... **LOGAN JOHNSON** had a career-high eight assists in the Liberty loss, then had nine points against Gardner-Webb ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** had double-digit rebounds in both games and now has 11 games of 10-or-more rebounds ... For the third-straight week, the Chanticleers will play on Monday night, opening a four-game homestand against UNC Asheville.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb won its first home Conference game of the season and improved to 3-0 in League play on the road last week with a victory at Winthrop ... Freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** grabbed 18 rebounds (nine offense, nine defense) in the Coastal Carolina victory. It was his Big South-leading third game with 15+ rebounds this season ... **AARON LINN** scored 12 points, handed out six assists and recorded eight steals vs. the Chanticleers.

HIGH POINT

The three rookies are among the team's top scorers with Short ranking second in rebounds, Singleton topping the squad in assists and steals and Barbour ranking second in 3FG and serving as HPU's spark off the bench ... The Panthers continue to be one of the Big South's top defensive teams, ranking first in points allowed and blocked shots and second in FG percentage.

LIBERTY

ANTHONY SMITH currently sits fourth all-time in the Liberty annals in minutes played.
