He began the week with his 11th double-double of the year - a 15-point, 17-rebound performance in Radford's four-point win at Winthrop. Parakhouski followed that outing with 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting from the field and eight rebounds in Radford's victory over Presbyterian.

Augst enjoyed two strong games in leading the Bulldogs to two wins. He scored 23 points, grabbed eight rebounds and had four steals in Asheville's 103-95 overtime win at League-leading VMI last Monday. Augst was 8-of-15 from the field and 6-of-7 from the line. Against CSU, Augst dropped in 19 points - all in the second-half, dished out seven assists, collected six rebounds and set a school record with a 5-of-5 performance from three-point range. He averaged 21.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists.

A TALE OF TWO CAMPUSES

VMI and Radford sit atop the Big South standings at 10-2 with six League games left. The Keydets are looking for their first-ever Big South regular-season championship, as their previous high finish in the Conference standings since joining the Big South in 2003-04 was last season's tie for fifth-place. Radford is vying for its first Big South regular-season title since 2000-01 and fourth overall.

RADFORD HAS CHANCE FOR BIG SOUTH FIRST

If Radford should finish the season in first-place and claim the No. 1 seed in the Big South Conference Tournament, the Highlanders would become the first team in Big South history to improve from seventh-place the previous year to winning the regular-season title the next. The current record for worst-to-first improvement in the League is sixth-place to first-place, which was established by Coastal Carolina in 1986-87 and 1987-88. In 1986-87, the Chanticleers were sixth in the Big South standings and the League's regular-season champion the following year.

Coastal Carolina's distinction is a little misleading, as the Conference did not have its current double-round robin scheduling in 1986-87 -- that began in 1987-88. In both 1985-86 and 1986-87, the Big South standings were determined by the Dunkel rating system, as not all teams played the same number of Conference games (the Chanticleers played eight League games that year, compared to five teams playing 14). The 1997-98 and 1998-99 Winthrop Eagles could also be considered the best worst-to-first improvement, as the 1997-98 squad tied for fifth but was the No. 6 seed in the Tournament. The next season, Winthrop won its first regular-season title.

BIG SOUTH ROYAL PURPLE "GAME OF THE WEEK" RESUMES SATURDAY ON MASN

The Big South Conference Royal Purple "Game of the Week" resumes this Saturday when High Point visits Gardner-Webb live at 2:00pm on MASN. Baltimore Orioles announcer **JIM HUNTER** (play-by-play) and former Georgetown great **MARK TILLMON** (analyst) will call the action.

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS REVEALED

The official 2009 ESPNU BracketBusters match-ups were unveiled last Monday, Feb. 2, and for the third consecutive year the Big South will play a nationally-televised BracketBusters game. Liberty will travel to Colonial Athletic Association member Old Dominion on Saturday, Feb. 21 at 11:00am on ESPNU. Meanwhile, Winthrop will host SoCon member Appalachian State and Gardner-Webb will visit CAA member James Madison. This will be Winthrop's fourth BracketBusters appearance (2-1) and Liberty's second (0-1). Gardner-Webb is making its BracketBusters debut.

IT AIN'T OVER UNTIL IT'S OVER

Liberty has played five overtime games this season, which ties the Big South record for most overtime games in a season, but is the most played *DURING* the regular-season. In 2002-03, UNC Asheville also played five overtime games. However, the Bulldogs played three of those contests in the post-season -- two in the Big South Tournament and one in the NCAA Opening Round game. Meanwhile, of the Flames' five extra-session games this year, four have gone into double-overtime -- a first for a Big South member in League history.

NO QUIT AMONG THESE MEMBERS

With Liberty leading the way, seven of the 10 Big South members have played at least two overtime games this season, and all but High Point have played past regulation this year. Presbyterian and Radford have played three overtime games. In 2000-01, a record eight Big South members played at least two overtime contests.

VMI ON CUSP OF MATCHING FASTEST BIG SOUTH TEAM TO REACH 20 WINS

With a victory in its next game, VMI would match the Big South record for the fastest team to win 20 games. The 19-4 Keydets have a chance to win 20 of their first 24 games, equaling the Big South record first set by Liberty in 1991-92 and tied by Winthrop in 2006-07. After their respective 20-4 starts, the Flames finished with a 22-7 overall mark, while the Eagles won a Big South single-season record 29 games and ended the year at 29-5.

MORE ON THE HIGHLANDERS

Radford, which received a vote in last week's *Collegeinsider.com* Top 25 Mid-Major poll, is tied for first-place in the Conference standings with a 10-2 League record -- its best start in Big South play since recording a 12-2 Big South mark in 2000-01. The Highlanders have won nine of their 10 League victories by double-digits (+16.3 average in those games), and has collected six consecutive road wins in Conference play for the first time during its Big South membership. RU has won 10 Big South games for the first time since the 12 League wins in 2000-01, and for the seventh time overall.

PLAYING BOARD GAMES

Gardner-Webb freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** is the nation's leading freshman rebounder at 9.61 cars per game. He has 221 rebounds in 23 contests, and is approaching the Big South's freshman records for rebounding in a season. Henley needs 42 rebounds to break the freshman rebound record of 262, set by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in 1990-91. In addition, Henley's per game average is pacing ahead of Spinks' League freshman record of 9.36.

KEYDETS ALSO APPROACHING HISTORICAL WINS

VMI has won 10 Big South games, its most Conference wins since winning 10 as Southern Conference members in 1995-96 and tied for the most League wins in school history. In addition, VMI is on the verge of its first 20-win season in 31 years, as the 1977-78 Keydets (21 wins) were the last to do so.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams have won 31 of the 62 Big South games played -- a .500 winning percentage. It is the most Conference road wins since the Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule). SWEEPING ON THE JOB

With 17 Conference series in the books already, 11 have resulted in season sweeps (64.7 percent). VMI, Radford and Presbyterian have each swept two Big South opponents this season.

CURRY HAS ONE FRESHMAN RECORD, LOOKING FOR ANOTHER

With 505 points, Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** is the highest scoring frosh in Big South history. He broke the League's single-season freshman record of 466 points Jan. 31 against UNC Asheville, bettering the mark set last season by Charleston Southern's **OMAR CARTER** -- Curry's high school teammate at Charlotte Christian in Charlotte, N.C. Meanwhile, Curry is averaging 20.2 points per game, second in the Big South and the highest among all freshmen in the nation. He is looking to become the first frosh in Conference history to average 20.0 points per game, and his current average is higher than the League freshman record of 18.1 points, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1989-90.

TWO FRESHMEN BATTLING FOR LEAGUE'S FRESHMAN 3-POINT RECORD

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** and Liberty's **SETH CURRY** are challenging the Big South single-season freshman record of 85 three-pointers, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05. Both Gabriel and Curry enter this week with 74 three-pointers. Leasure concluded his career as the Conference's all-time leader with 411.

BABY LET'S CRUZ

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** became the fourth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots when he eclipsed the milestone on Saturday, Feb. 7 vs. Coastal Carolina. Daniels, who entered the season tied for 14th all-time, has 63 swats on the season -- just the third player in Conference annals with three 60+ block seasons. He joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** on the list. The Conference's top four career shot blockers are listed below, and Daniels needs 14 to move into second-place in history.

VMI GOING FOR NATIONAL SCORING THREE-PEAT

VMI leads the nation in scoring with 96.4 points per game and is looking to become just the third team since 1948 to lead the NCAA in scoring offense three consecutive years. The Keydets would join Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) on the list.

GOOD COMPANY

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds when he reached the rebounding milestone against High Point on Jan. 27. Six days later, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the 10th player on the League's 1,500-point/500-rebound list when he eclipsed the scoring milestone against UNC Asheville on Feb. 2. Smith is 18th in Conference annals with 1,588 points and 50th with 517 boards. Holmes is 19th all-time in League history with 1,575 points and 49th with 520 rebounds.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 19th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Feb. 4 at Presbyterian. Harris, who enters the week with five consecutive double-doubles (16.0 points, 12.8 rebounds in that span), is now 14th in League history with 717 career boards. He is averaging a career-best 10.5 rebounds, and is one pace to end the regular-season with 780 career rebounds, which would put him in ninth-place on the Big South's career chart. Harris is now just one of six players in Big South history with 700 career rebounds, 100 career blocked shots and 100 career steals.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford junior **AMIR JOHNSON** is 12 assists away from becoming the 17th player in Big South history 400 career assists. He enters the week with 388, good for 17th-place in history and third all-time on Radford's career list.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville leapster **JOHN WILLIAMS** is two blocked shots away from becoming the 24th player in Big South history with 100 in his career. He would become the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list, which would be the most for one school in Big South history.

NEW GUYS IN TOWN

Big South newcomers Presbyterian and Gardner-Webb have each won seven Big South games this season. The last new member to win 10 Big South games in their official inaugural season was Birmingham-Southern in 2003-04 (12 wins). The record for most League wins in the first official season as a new member is 14, set by Towson State in 1992-93. The Tigers posted a 14-2 Big South record that season.

SUMMER TIME IN FEBRUARY

UNC Asheville's **REID AUGST** scored his 1,000th career point in the Bulldogs' victory over Charleston Southern this past Saturday, becoming the 91st player in Big South history and 24th in Asheville history to reach the milestone.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,861 career points -- good for seventh-place on the League's all-time list. He is 33 points from surpassing Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (1,893 points) for sixth-place. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,588), **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,575), **KENNY THOMAS** (1,057), and **REID AUGST** (1,008). HOLMES SCORING

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** enters this week again as the Big South's top scorer at 21.7 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

Nine of the 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game this season by five points-or-less, with a total of 35 losses being decided by that margin -- 19 League games and 16 non-Conference. Liberty and Coastal Carolina have posted losses of that margin a League-high six times this season. Six of Liberty's eight losses have been by a combined 17 points (2.8 average), while the Chanticleers have dropped five of those close games in Conference action. Winthrop and High Point are next with five losses by the five-point margin, followed by Gardner-Webb (4), Radford (3), Charleston Southern (3), Presbyterian (2) and UNC Asheville (1).

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS PART II

The first 11 Big South Conference games from Feb. 2-7 were decided by an average margin of 6.8 points, with nine of the contests were decided under 10 points. The average margin of victory for the League season after 62 games is 10.13. Of the 62 games, 31 have been decided by at least 10 points (50.0 percent), while 19 have been decided by five points-or-less.

BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL IN A CLUB ALL BY HIMSELF

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is the first player in Big South history with 1,500 career points, 500 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 250 career steals.

AUSTIN POWERS

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in every game of his career -- a span of 39 games. He made 57 in 16 appearances in 2007-08, and has 92 treys through 23 games this season. Kenon has 149 three-pointers in his 39 games, a 3.82 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. The NCAA career record, also based on 200 career threes, is 4.57 by Mississippi Valley's **TIMOTHY POLLARD**.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

In addition to Liberty's **SETH CURRY** and **JOSHUA HENLEY**, other Big South freshmen men's basketball players have impacted the Conference this season. Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is sixth in the League in rebounding at 7.3. High Point's **DAVID SINGLETON** (4.65), UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** (4.29) and Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (4.28) are second, third and fourth, respectively, in the Big South in assists. Sanders continues to lead in assist-turnover ratio (2.33), and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is fourth in three-pointers per game (3.22), fifth in three-point percentage (.381), and tied for third in three-pointers made (74).

DEEP THREE-FISHING

Two Big South players remain on pace to make more than 100 three-point field goals this season. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** is tracking at 116 three-pointers this season, which would be third-most in a season. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is on pace for 102, while VMI freshman **KEITH GABRIEL** is on target for 93 by the end of the regular-season. Liberty frosh **SETH CURRY** is on pace for 92. The Big South record for most players with 100 three-point field goals in the same season is two -- VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** in 2006-07.

BROTHERS IN ARMS

In addition to their scoring exploits, VMI twins **TRAVIS** and **CHAVIS HOLMES** rank first and second, respectively, in Big South history in career steals. Travis is the all-time leader with 282, but Chavis is not far behind at 275 for a combined total of 557. Both players supplanted former Winthrop guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** this season, as Gaynor set the career record just last year with 259. Chavis' consecutive games streak with a steal ended at 34 games on Feb. 4 at Winthrop. During that time, he recorded 109 steals for an average of 3.21 steals per game. Meanwhile, Travis has recorded a steal in his last 29 games, also a career-best streak. He has 85 thefts in that span for a 2.93 per game average. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 97 of his 110 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 93 of his 107 career games.

McKAY NEARING 200 CAREER WINS

Liberty second-year head coach **RITCHIE McKAY** enters the week needing two wins for 200 in his coaching career, as he is 198-182 in his 13-plus seasons on the sidelines. All of his wins have come at the Division I level and in five different conferences (Big Sky, Big South, Mountain West, Pac-10, WAC). McKay has led the Flames to at least 16 wins in both seasons as head coach, as well as a 25-3 record at the Vines Center (=.893 winning percentage). Liberty's 17 victories this year are the most by the Flames in the regular-season since 1996-97, when LU won 21 regular-season contests before the Conference Tournament.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s 103 career regular-season Big South wins are third-most in League history. He is one League victory shy of tying for Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** for second-place at 104. Former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** is the all-time leader with 109 regular-season Big South wins. This season, Biedenbach recorded two milestone victories in less than two weeks of each other. He notched his 200th career coaching win Dec. 31 vs. Western Carolina, and collected his 100th regular-season Big South win Jan. 13 vs. High Point.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is in sole possession of seventh-place in Big South history with 278 career three-pointers, and needs 11 treys to catch **RAYMOND ARRINGTON** (Radford) for sixth-place at 289. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** became the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers this past Saturday against Coastal Carolina. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** needs seven treys for 200 in his career.

KEYDETS ESTABLISH SINGLE-GAME THREE-POINT RECORD

VMI converted 24 three-point field goals against Southern Virginia on Jan. 29, breaking its own single-game Big South record of 22, set against Lees-McRae on Dec. 6, 2006. The Keydets were four away from the national single-game record. VMI is averaging 13.70 three-pointers per game this season, which is pacing ahead of its national record of 13.39 set during the 2006-07 campaign. The Keydets are on pace to conclude the regular-season with 397 threes, and are looking to become the first team in NCAA history to make 400 three-pointers in two different seasons.

TEN MEN

The Big South has two players averaging 10.0 rebounds this season, which would mark just the second time in League history that two players averaged that many rebounds in one year. Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (10.6) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (10.5) are rebounding at a double-digit clip. In 2000-01, Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** (10.1) and Radford's **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** (10.0) were the first (and last) Big South duo to average 10.0 rebounds a game in the same season.

HOLMES TWINS OWN PIECE OF NCAA DIVISION I HISTORY

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the highest scoring twin brother combination in NCAA Division I history on Jan. 24, as they scored a combined 47 points to help VMI to a 92-85 win over High Point. The duo entered the game needing 38 points to break the Division I record of 3,252, which was set by another VMI duo -- **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** from 1987-90. Chavis (1,861) and Travis (1,575) have now combined for 3,436 career points.

Against UNC Asheville, CSU led by as many as 12 points in the first half, but could not stay with the Bulldogs. **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** recorded a double-double for the second time this year with 11 points and a career-high 13 rebounds in the game ... Coastal Carolina ends its three-game road trip Monday night at Radford and returns home for its final home stand Saturday afternoon against VMI.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb averaged a strong 91.5 ppg last week in two games, but allowed 92.0 ppg defensively in a pair of high-paced games ... Junior guard **CJ HAILEY** scored a career-high 26 points at VMI, including 20 in the first half. Hailey's previous career-high total was 16 points vs. Coastal Carolina on Jan. 17 ... Gardner-Webb is 1-0 this season in overtime games following its double-overtime win over Liberty on Feb. 4.

HIGH POINT

High Point picked up its second Big South road victory of the year and snapped a seven-game losing skid with a win at Charleston Southern ... HPU also dropped a heartbreaker in the final seconds to Coastal Carolina at home ... Four of the Panthers' losses in League play have been by five points-or-less ... R-Junior **CRUZ DANIELS** pulled down a career best 15 rebounds vs. Coastal Carolina and averaged a double-double (10.5 ppg/11.5 rpg) in two games last week ... Junior **EUGENE HARRIS** became the first HPU player to make 200 3-pointers in a career ... HPU hosts Winthrop on Wednesday looking for its first-ever season sweep of the Eagles.

LIBERTY
