BIG SOUTH TO APPEAR IN TWO POSTSEASON EVENTS

For the second consecutive year, the Big South Conference will have two men's basketball teams playing in the postseason in the same year. Radford received the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while Liberty will appear in the inaugural *Collegeinsider.com* Postseason Tournament (CIT).

RADFORD DRAWS NORTH CAROLINA IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Big South champion Radford will make its second NCAA Tournament appearance this week, with the first coming in 1998. The No. 16-seeded Highlanders will face No. 1 seed North Carolina in the first round in Greensboro, N.C. It will be the Big South's fifth meeting against an ACC foe in the Big Dance, and second against the Tar Heels. In 1994, Liberty faced North Carolina in the first round. The Big South's other three ACC match-ups in the NAAs have all been against Duke (1992, 1998 and 2002).

LIBERTY PART OF INAUGURAL CIT EVENT

The Liberty Flames accepted an invitation to participate in the inaugural *Collegeinsider.com* Postseason Tournament (CIT), and will host MAAC member Rider on Tuesday night, March 17 at 7:00pm. The CIT features 16 teams not participating in the NCAA or NIT and the tournament is geared toward the top schools in the country that do not participate in one of the six power conferences. The CIT is a single-elimination tournament, consisting of four rounds, with the first three rounds being played at on-campus sites, which is determined by seeding. The inaugural championship game will be played at an on-campus site to be determined by seeding.

Liberty's appearance in the CIT marks the third postseason berth in Liberty's Division I history. The school's other two appearances in postseason beyond the Big South Tournament have come in the NCAA Tournament, with the last appearance coming in 2004. Flames head coach **RITCHIE MCKAY** is taking his third program to the postseason, as he previously directed New Mexico to the NCAA Tournament in 2005 and Colorado State to the NIT in 1999.

RADFORD CAPTURES 2009 BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE

The No. 1 seed Radford Highlanders defeated No. 2 seeded VMI, 108-94 in the Big South Tournament Championship game to advance to the NCAA Tournament. It is Radford's second berth in the Big Dance and first since 1998. The Highlanders set records for points scored in a Big South Championship game and Tournament game in the victory, and are the Conference's fifth No. 1 seed in the last six seasons to win the League Tournament. Radford also snapped a three-game losing streak in the Big South Championship game in the process.

KENON POURS IN RECORDS

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** scored a Big South Championship game record 34 points in the Keydets' loss to Radford, falling one point shy of the Tournament game record. He was 8-of-19 from three-point range -- establishing records in both categories in a title game and Tournament contest.

THE BIG MAN FROM BELARUS IS HEADED TO THE BIG DANCE

Radford junior center and Belarus native **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** will be the first Big South Player of the Year to play in the NCAA Tournament since Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** in 2002, and the third overall. Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** was the first during the Chanticleers' NCAA appearance in 1991. Meanwhile, Parakhouski is the first Big South player to be voted Conference Player of the Year and Tournament MVP the same season since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2004, and the sixth time in Big South history.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT RECAP

For the second consecutive season, the top four seeds advanced to the Semifinals of the Big South Tournament, marking the 11th time overall. The No. 1 seed advanced to the title game for the sixth-straight year, and the Championship game featured No. 1 vs. No. 2 for the 10th time in League history. VMI reached the title game for the second time in three years, while Radford made its sixth appearance in the Championship contest, tied for second-most in League history. In addition, it was also the second consecutive year and fourth time overall that two 20-win teams played for the Conference Championship -- the previous seasons were 1999, 2006 and 2008. Meanwhile, Winthrop's loss in the quarterfinals at No. 4 UNC Asheville ended the Eagles' Big South-record 12-game Tournament win streak.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI became the first team in Big South history to win two Tournament games by 20 points. The Keydets knocked off No. 7 seed Coastal Carolina, 96-76, then defeated No. 3 seed Liberty in the Semifinals, 78-58. VMI's 20-point Semifinal win was the largest in that round since March 3, 1989, when No. 2 Campbell defeated No. 6 Winthrop by 23 points, 78-55.

**BIG SOUTH MEN'S BASKETBALL
TOURNAMENT TIDBITS**

Since the Big South adopted the current home site Conference Tournament format in 2003, the home seeds are a combined 31-12 (=.721) in 43 possible home games. This total does not include games that were played on a neutral floor in 2003 (semifinals and finals) and 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 (semifinals).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 19-9 (= .679) on their home courts and have advanced to the semifinals the last two seasons.

GREENBERG, BAUCOM FINALISTS FOR HUGH DURHAM AWARD

Radford head coach **BRAD GREENBERG** and VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** are among the 10 finalists for the 2009 Hugh Durham Award. The two join **RANDY BENNETT** (St. Mary's), **TODD BOZEMAN** (Morgan State), **ED CONROY** (The Citadel and former Coastal Carolina assistant coach), **BEN JACOBSON** (Northern Iowa), **SAUL PHILLIPS** (North Dakota State), **J.P. PIPER** (Nicholls State), **RANDY RAHE** (Weber State) and **BRAD STEVENS** (Butler). The Big South is the lone Conference with two finalists. The winner will be presented with the award at the 2009 Final Four in Detroit.

3 X 20

The Big South Conference has three 20-win teams for just the third time in League history. VMI has won 24 games this season -- second-most in school history and tied for the third-highest win total in Conference annals. Liberty has 22 wins this year, its most since winning 23 games in 1996-97. Radford surpassed the 20-win plateau during the Big South Tournament and enters the NAAs with 21 wins, its highest victory output since 22 wins in 1991. The two previous times the Big South had three 20-win teams were 1993-94 and 1985-86.

ADDITIONAL 20-WIN NOTES

VMI (22) and Liberty (21) each won 20 games during the regular-season, just the third time in League history that two Big South teams won 20 regular-season games in the same season. In 1990-91, Coastal Carolina and Radford each tallied 20 wins prior to the postseason tournament, and Winthrop and High Point reached 20 regular-season wins in 2006-07.

HIGHLANDERS ESTABLISH CONFERENCE ROAD WIN RECORD

Radford won a Big South-record nine Conference road games this season, capping a perfect 9-0 League mark away from home in 2008-09. The last Big South team to go undefeated on the road in Big South play was Winthrop in 2006-07 (7-0). Seven road Conference wins was the previous record in the Big South Conference.

THE BIG SOUTH'S BEST WORST-TO-FIRST

Radford is the first team in Big South history to improve from seventh-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The previous worst-to-first improvement in the League was sixth-place to first-place, which was established by Coastal Carolina in 1986-87 and 1987-88. In 1986-87, the Chanticleers were sixth in the Big South standings and the League's regular-season champion the following year.

BIG SOUTH COLLECTS NABC ALL-DISTRICT HONORS

The Big South placed five players on the NABC's All-District 3 Team. VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** were First-Team honorees, while Gardner-Webb's **GRAYSON FLITTNER**, Liberty's **SETH CURRY** and Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** landed on the Second-Team. The five are among the 240 student-athletes from 24 districts nationally to be honored, and are now eligible for the State Farm Coaches' Division I All-America teams that will be announced April 4.

COMPETITIVE BALANCE

Seven of the 10 Big South members went .500 in Conference play in 2008-09, the most in League history. The previous best was six teams, which was accomplished in 1993-94 (10 playing members) and 1986-87 (8 playing members). However, the Conference did not have its current double-round robin scheduling in 1986-87, as the Big South standings were determined by the Dunkel rating system since not all the teams played the same number of Conference games.

CHEAPER BY THE DOZEN

For the first time since 2005-06 and for just the third time in Big South history, three teams won at least 12 Conference games in the same season. Radford tied the Big South record for most League wins with 15, while VMI collected 13 Conference wins this year. Liberty won its 12th Big South game in its regular-season finale at Radford. The Big South record for most teams with at least 12 Conference wins is four, which occurred in 1993-94.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN** was voted to the *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-America First-Team this season. It is the third consecutive year that the Big South has had a men's basketball Academic All-American and seventh overall. Linn was one of a League-record three student-athletes on the 2009 *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-Team. Charleston Southern senior **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** and Radford's **PHILLIP MARTIN** were also honored at the District level.

EXECUTIVE BOARD

For the first time in Big South history, three players grabbed 300 rebounds in the same season. Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** broke the single-season record of 342 during the Chanticleers' quarterfinal game at VMI and ended the season at 352. However, Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** surpassed Harris in the Big South Championship game on March 7, and enters the NCAA Tournament with a record 359. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is the final member of the 300-rebound club with 309. All three players own double-digit averages -- the first trio in Big South history to accomplish this feat in the same year. Below is a look at the Conference's 300-rebound seasons:

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** concluded the season tied for seventh-place in Big South history with 816 career rebounds, and will enter the 2009-10 season needing just 198 caroms to break the all-time record of 1,013, which is held by **ARIZONA REID**. Harris reached the 800 rebound milestone in the Chanticleers' regular-season finale at Winthrop, Feb. 28, and this season alone he surpassed the 500, 600, 700 and 800-career rebound plateaus. Harris grabbed at least 10 rebounds against every Big South opponent, and recorded a double-double against every League team. He had his League-best 11 consecutive double-double streak end at VMI on March 3. Harris averaged 11.35 rebounds per game this season -- the second-highest season average in League history. Charleston Southern's **OLIVER JOHNSON** averaged a record 11.41 rebounds in 1986-87.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the fourth player since the 2006-07 season and sixth in Big South history to amass 2,000 career points. He eclipsed the milestone at High Point on Feb. 28, and concluded the Conference Tournament at 2,065. Meanwhile, Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** became the 92nd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club, surpassing the milestone in the Big South Championship game against VMI, March 7. CURRY SCORES TWO BIG SOUTH FRESHMAN RECORDS, CLOSING IN ON THIRD

Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** has two Big South freshman records this season, and is closing in on a third. He is the highest scoring freshman in League history with 680 points -- the 7th most in a season in Big South annals, and shattering the previous best of 466 points. Curry also drained 99 three-pointers this season, breaking the old mark of 85. Curry is averaging 20.6 points per game, second in the Big South and the highest among all freshmen in the nation. He is looking to become the first frosh in Conference history to average 20.0 points per game, and his current average is higher than the League freshman record of 18.1 points, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1989-90.

BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL IN A CLUB ALL BY HIMSELF

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** recorded his 300th career steal in the Keydets' regular-season finale at High Point, Feb. 28, to become just the ninth player in NCAA Division I history with 1,500 career points, 500 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 300 career steals. Holmes has 1,733 points, 590 rebounds, 360 assists and 309 steals. Others on the list include Maryland's **JUAN DIXON**, Ball State's **BONZI WELLS** and Providence's **ERIC MURDOCK**.

HOLMES SCORING

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the Big South's scoring leader this year with 22.0 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

IT AIN'T OVER UNTIL IT'S OVER

Liberty has played five overtime games this season, which ties the Big South record for most overtime games in a season, but is the most played *DURING* the regular-season. In 2002-03, UNC Asheville also played five overtime games. However, the Bulldogs played three of those contests in the post-season -- two in the Big South Tournament and one in the NCAA Opening Round game. Meanwhile, of the Flames' five extra-session games this year, four have gone into double-overtime -- a first for a Big South member in League history.

NO QUIT AMONG THESE MEMBERS

All 10 Big South members have played an overtime game this season. With Liberty leading the way, eight of the 10 Big South members have played at least two overtime games this season -- matching a Big South record that was set in 2000-01. Radford and UNC Asheville have played four overtime games this season, while Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian have three extra session games.

BABY LET'S CRUZ

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 222 career blocked shots. Daniels, who entered the season tied for 14th all-time, had a career-high 83 swats on the season -- the 9th-highest single-season total in Big South history, and his second consecutive season with 70+ blocks. Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** is the Conference's all-time leader with 366.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford junior **AMIR JOHNSON** leads the Big South in assists per game with 5.28, and is looking to become the first Highlander to lead the League in helpers since **RIAN EVERETTE** averaged a Conference-best 4.4 in 1997-98. Johnson enters the NCAA Tournament with 435 career assists, which ranks 13th all-time in Big South history. Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** is the Big South's career assist leader with 567 -- just 132 ahead of Johnson's total.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-sophomore **JOHN WILLIAMS** is 16th in Big South history with 127 career blocked shots after recording 10 in his two Tournament games. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history.

ROAD WARRIORS

During Conference play this season, the road teams won 42 of the 90 Big South games played -- a .467 winning percentage. It is the most Conference road wins since the Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule).

SWEEPING ON THE JOB

Of the 45 Conference series played this year, 26 resulted in season sweeps (57.8 percent). Radford swept six opponents, followed by VMI with four and Liberty and Winthrop with three sweeps each. In addition, the Highlanders, Keydets and Flames were NOT swept by a Conference opponent this year.

VMI GOING FOR NATIONAL SCORING THREE-PEAT

VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with 93.8 points per game and is looking to become just the third team since 1948 to lead the NCAA in scoring offense three consecutive years. The Keydets would join Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) on the list.

KEYDETS PACING AHEAD OF THEIR OWN NCAA RECORD

VMI averaged 13.69 three-pointers per game this season, which is pacing ahead of its national record of 13.39 set during the 2006-07 campaign. The Keydets have made 438 three-pointers this year, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history with more than 400 treys in a season twice. VMI established the national record of 442 three-point field goals in 2006-07.

GOOD COMPANY

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds when he reached the rebounding milestone against High Point on Jan. 27. Six days later, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the 10th player on the League's 1,500-point/500-rebound list when he eclipsed the scoring milestone against UNC Asheville on Feb. 2. Fast forward to the conclusion of the Conference Tournament and Holmes is 10th in scoring with 1,733 points and 32nd with 590 rebounds, while Smith is 13th in history with 1,703 points and 38th in rebounds with 568.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

All 10 Big South men's basketball teams lost at least two games by five points-or-less this season. A total of 48 losses were decided by that margin -- 32 League games and 16 non-Conference. Coastal Carolina posted losses of that margin a League-high nine times this season, including eight in Conference action. In fact, six of the Chanticleers' last nine losses were by a combined 21 points. High Point dropped seven games by five points-or-less, including two against the Conference's top two teams during the final week of the regular-season. Six of Liberty's 10 losses were five points-or-less, with those six by a combined 17 points (2.8 average). Gardner-Webb also lost six games by the five-point margin, followed by Winthrop (5), Presbyterian (4), Charleston Southern (4), Radford (3), UNC Asheville (2) and VMI (2).

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has 119 three-pointers this season, the second-highest single-season total in Big South history, and just six from reaching the record of 125, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2005-06. Kenon has made a three-pointer in 47 of his 48 career games, including 41-straight to open his collegiate career. He has 176 career treys for a 3.67 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. The NCAA career record, also based on 200 career threes, is 4.57 by Mississippi Valley's **TIMOTHY POLLARD**.

RAIN MEN

A Big South record four men's basketball players made 90 three-point field goals in 2008-09. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** led the way with 119, followed by Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and Liberty's **SETH CURRY** with 99, and Flames' guard/forward **KYLE OHMAN** with 97. The previous record was three players with at least 90 3-pointers, established in 2006-07 (**CHAVIS HOLMES** - 108, **MICHAEL JENKINS** - 100, **JACK LEASURE** - 90).

BROTHERS IN ARMS

In addition to their scoring exploits, VMI twins **TRAVIS** and **CHAVIS HOLMES** rank first and second, respectively, in Big South history in career steals. Travis is the all-time leader with 309, but Chavis is not far behind at 304 for a combined total of 613. Both players supplanted former Winthrop guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** this season, as Gaynor set the career record just last year with 259. Travis' career-best 36-straight games with a steal ended in the Semifinals against Liberty. He recorded 108 thefts in that span for a 3.00 per game average. Chavis' consecutive games streak with a steal ended at 34 games on Feb. 4 at Winthrop. During that time, he recorded 109 steals for an average of 3.21 steals per game. In their respective careers, Chavis recorded a steal in 106 of his 119 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 101 of his 115 career games.

DOG POUND

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs won 10 Big South games in consecutive seasons for just the second time in school history. The previous time was in 1996-97 and 1997-98 when Asheville won 11 Conference games in both years.

KEYDETS SCORE HISTORICAL WINS

VMI won 13 Big South games, its most Conference wins in school history. The previous high was 10 as Southern Conference members in 1995-96. In addition, VMI recorded its first 20-win season in 31 years, as the 1977-78 Keydets (21 wins) were the last to do so.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals, as he surpassed the plateau in the Keydets' quarterfinal game against Coastal Carolina. He ranks fourth all-time with 306. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the 23rd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he surpassed the threshold Feb. 14 at Charleston Southern, and his 212 treys are 18th in League history. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 19th with 211. He reached the 200 three-point milestone Feb. 7 against Coastal Carolina.

HOLMES TWINS OWN PIECE OF NCAA DIVISION I HISTORY

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the highest scoring twin brother combination in NCAA Division I history on Jan. 24, as they scored a combined 47 points to help VMI to a 92-85 win over High Point. The duo entered the game needing 38 points to break the Division I record of 3,252, which was set by another VMI duo -- **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** from 1987-90. Chavis (2,065) and Travis (1,733) have combined for 3,798 career points.

BIG SOUTH NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history through last season:

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern failed to qualify for the Big South Tournament for the first time, as the Buccaneers lost the tiebreaker for the eighth and final seed ... After going winless in Conference road games the past two seasons, CSU won twice away from home against League foes in 2008-09 ... **JAMARCO WARREN's** 99 three-pointers made set the single-season school record. The previous record was 81 by **CHRIS MOORE** just last season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina men's basketball team fell in the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Big South Tournament quarterfinals to VMI, 96-76 ... **ANTHONY BREEZE** and **STEVEN SEXTON** led the Chants with 15 points each ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** is on pace to become the second Big South player to score 1,000 career points and grab 1,000 career rebounds. He will need 53 points and 184 rebounds next season to eclipse the mark ... Harris set the Coastal Carolina record for offensive rebounds (127) and finished second in total rebounds (352) ... Harris currently is the career leader in field-goal percentage (.582) heading into next season ... Sexton tied Coastal Carolina's game played record with 119, while **MARIO SISINNI** finished 10th in career assists with 261.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb lost in the quarterfinals in its first Big South Tournament appearance, falling at No. 3 Liberty ... **JONATHAN MOORE** had 20 points off the bench for the Runnin' Bulldogs, going 7-of-11 from the field and 4-of-6 from three-point range. **AURYN MacMILLAN** grabbed a game-high 10 rebounds against the Flames ... **GRAYSON FLITTNER** enters next season needing 19 points for 1,000 in his career.

HIGH POINT

BART LUNDY will not return as head coach of the High Point University men's basketball team next year after six seasons leading the Panther program ... Freshman **NICK BARBOUR**, who averaged 14.2 points, became the first freshman in HPU's decade in Division I and just the fourth freshman since 1959 to lead the Panthers in scoring ... **CRUZ DANIELS** set a HPU single-season record with 83 blocked shots ... Freshman **DAVID SINGLETON** posted HPU single-season Top 10 totals in both assists (144 - 4th) and steals (55 - 10th) and ranked among the Big South leaders in both categories ... Junior **EUGENE HARRIS** finished the season just nine points shy of the 1,000-point mark and looks to become the 28th member of HPU's Grand Scorer Club early in 2009-10.

LIBERTY

SETH CURRY (1,208), **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,193) and **KYLE OHMAN** (1,105) rank as the top three in program history for minutes played a single season ... Curry's 680 points ranks as the sixth-most in Liberty history for a single-season and second-highest in the Division I era ... Liberty set a program record with 306 three-point field goals this year. Under head coach **RITCHIE McKAY**, Liberty is averaging 9.1 treys a game over the past two seasons ... Liberty has scored 2,500 points on the season, ranking as the third-highest total in program history ... Curry holds the program single-season record with 99 three-point field goals ... No freshman in Liberty history reached the 30-point plateau as many times as Curry's this season (4).

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian finished its inaugural season in the Big South tied for fifth at 9-9, and was 12-17 overall ... The Blue Hose are not eligible for the Big South Tournament until 2012 due to its transition to Division I, but is included in the regular-season standings, statistics and Conference honors, as well as being factored into the League's tiebreaking process ... Sophomore **AL'ONZO COLEMAN** finished 10th in the League in scoring with 10.5 points and ranked fourth with 8.4 rebounds a game. In League contests, Coleman averaged 9.6 points.

RADFORD

The Highlanders enter their second NCAA Tournament winners of 17 of their last 19 ... Radford closed the regular season with nine-straight road wins ... **KENNY THOMAS** and **AMIR JOHNSON** became the 23rd and 24th players in men's basketball history to hit the 1,000-point plateau ... Radford has won 20 games for the seventh time in the program's 35 years ... The Highlanders set team records for free throws made and rebounds in a season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs advanced to the Semifinals of the League Tournament for the third-straight year, better than any other team in the Big South during the past three years ... Asheville has advanced to the Semifinals of the Big South Tournament 10 times in the last 14 years ... **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time with 13 Big South Tournament wins ... **REID AUGST** completed his career 22nd on the school's all-time scoring list ... **JOHN WILLIAMS** had the third-most single-season blocked shots in school history with 76 ... **SEAN SMITH** has 132 career treys -- good for sixth-place on the school's all-time list ... The Bulldogs went 11-3 at home this year and are 28-6 at Justice Center over the past two years.

VMI

VMI's 24 wins are the second-most in program history. The 1976-77 team went 26-4 and advanced to the NCAA "Sweet Sixteen" ... The Keydets' 546 free throws made this season ties the Big South single-season record, which was first set by Radford in 1987-88 ... VMI is also the first Big South team to score 3,000 points two different years.

WINTHROP

Winthrop was a road seed for the first time since the Conference Tournament format went to home sites in 2002-03. The Eagles ranked first in Conference games with a 62.8 scoring defense average ... Winthrop was tops in the League with a 4.22 blocked shot average against Big South foes ... In Big South games, WU finished second in field goal defense (41.2 percent) and three-point defense (31.8).
