Ohman averaged 21.0 points, .591 percent from the field (13-of-22) and .571 percent from beyond the arc (8-of-14) in two Big South wins last week. He matched his career-high with 26 points on 9-of-13 shooting against High Point, pulling down six rebounds, dishing out four assists and blocking two shots. He added 16 points, including 3-of-6 treys, while grabbing five rebounds against UNC Asheville. Against the Bulldogs, Ohman helped limit Asheville's leading scorer Reid Augst to four points on 1-of-10 shooting. For the week, Ohman averaged 5.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and posted two steals and three blocked shots.

#### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

##### ANDRE JONES

Guard • Winthrop

Jones collects his second-straight weekly honor after averaging 14.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists for the Eagles. He opened the week leading Winthrop to a 56-49 come-from-behind win at UNC Asheville, as he scored 10 of his game-high 15 points in the final 6:31 of play. He was 5-of-8 from the field (3-of-4 from three-point range) and added four rebounds and two steals. Jones followed that performance with a team-high 13 points at Charlotte as he went 4-of-7 from the floor (3-of-4 from three-point range). For the week, Jones shot .600 percent from the floor (9-of-15), .750 percent from long range (6-of-8) and made all four free throws.

**CURRY BREAKS BIG SOUTH FRESHMAN SCORING RECORD**

Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** scored 33 points in two games last week to push his season total to 468 -- the most points scored by a freshman in Big South Conference history. Curry broke the old record of 466 points, which was set last season by Charleston Southern's **OMAR CARTER** -- Curry's high school teammate at Charlotte Christian in Charlotte, N.C. Meanwhile, Curry is averaging 20.3 points per game, second in the Big South and the highest among all freshmen in the nation. He is looking to become the first frosh in Conference history to average 20.0 points per game, and his current average is higher than the League freshman record of 18.1 points, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1989-90.

**TWO FRESHMAN BATTLING FOR LEAGUE'S FRESHMAN 3-POINT RECORD**

VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** and Liberty's **SETH CURRY** are challenging the Big South single-season freshman record of 85 three-pointers, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05. Gabriel has made 72 three-point buckets this season, just ahead of Curry's 71 treys. Leasure concluded his career as the Conference's all-time leader with 411.

**HIGHLANDER HITS**

Radford stands a half-game out of first-place in the Conference standings with an 8-2 League record. The Highlanders have won all eight of their League games by double-digits (+16.3 average), and has collected five consecutive road wins in Conference play for the first time during its Big South membership. RU has its most Big South wins since winning nine League games in 2005-06 and is off to its best start in the Big South since a 12-2 mark in 2000-01 -- which was the last time Radford won 10 Conference games.

**WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?**

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams have won 26 of the 51 Big South games played - a .510 winning percentage. The total is more than last season's 19 Conference road wins, and the most since 28 road Conference wins in 2005-06. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South play this season, in current standings order:

**VMI MATCHES BEST 20-GAME OVERALL START IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY**

VMI's 17 wins through 20 games matches the best 20-game overall start in League history. The 1991-92 Liberty Flames -- their first season in the Big South -- first set the standard 17 seasons ago with a 17-3 record through 20 games.

**VMI'S 17 WINS MOST SINCE 1995-96**

The VMI Keydets' 17-3 record is their best start in 32 years years, while their 17 wins are the most since the 1995-96 campaign when the Keydets finished 18-10. VMI has already won its most Big South games (8) since joining the League in 2003-04.

**MR. SMITH GOES TO LYNCHBURG**

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds when he reached the rebounding milestone against High Point on Jan. 27. He is 18th in Conference annals with 1,572 points and 51st with 505 boards. VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** needs two (2) points to become the 10th player on the League's 1,500-point/500-rebound list.

**BOARD REPORT**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 28th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Jan. 3 against High Point, needs seven rebounds to become the 19th player with 700. Harris is 19th all-time with 693 and enters the week averaging a career-best and League-leading 10.4 rebounds. He is on pace to end the regular-season with 776 career rebounds, which would put him in ninth-place on the Big South's career chart.

**BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FOURTH APPEARANCE IN ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South will again participate in the ESPNu BracketBusters event this season during the week-end of February 20-21, and the match-ups will be announced Monday evening, Feb. 2. Winthrop (home), Gardner-Webb (road) and Liberty (road) will be the League's participants. The Eagles are 2-1 all-time in the event, while Liberty is 0-1. Gardner-Webb will make its first-ever appearance in the BracketBusters.

**VMI GOING FOR NATIONAL SCORING THREE-PEAT**

VMI leads the nation in scoring with 95.9 points per game and is looking to become just the third team since 1948 to lead the NCAA in scoring offense three consecutive years. The Keydets would join Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) on the list.

**KEYDETS ESTABLISH SINGLE-GAME THREE-POINT RECORD**

VMI converted 24 three-point field goals against Southern Virginia on Jan. 29, breaking its own single-game Big South record of 22, set against Lees-McRae on Dec. 6, 2006. The Keydets were four away from the national single-game record. VMI is averaging 14.05 three-pointers per game this season, which is pacing ahead of its national record of 13.39 set during the 2006-07 campaign. The Keydets are on pace to conclude the regular-season with 407 threes, which would make them the first team in NCAA history to make 400 three-pointers in two different seasons.

**CLOSE ENCOUNTERS**

Nine of the 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game this season by five points-or-less, with a total of 30 losses being decided by that margin -- 16 non-Conference contests and 14 League games. Liberty and Coastal Carolina have posted losses of that margin a League-high five times this season. Five of Liberty's seven losses have been by a combined 12 points, while the Chanticleers have dropped four of those close games in Conference games. Gardner-Webb and High Point is next with four losses by the five-point margin, followed by Radford, Winthrop and Charleston Southern with three each. Presbyterian has two losses by five points-or-less, and UNC Asheville has one.

**TWO ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

Through 51 Big South Conference games, 29 have been decided by at least 10 points (56.7 percent), while 14 have been decided by five points-or-less. The average margin of victory for the League season after 51 games is 10.84 points.

**DEEP THREE-FISHING**

Three Big South players remain on pace to make more than 100 three-point field goals this season. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** is tracking at 122 three-pointers this season, which would fall just shy of the Big South single-season record of 125. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is on pace for 106, while VMI freshman **KEITH GABRIEL** is on target for 104 by the end of the regular-season. Liberty frosh **SETH CURRY** is on pace for 96. The Big South record for most players with 100 three-point field goals in the same season is two -- VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** in 2006-07.

**CRUZZIN**

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS**, who entered the season tied for 14th all-time on the Big South's career blocked shot chart, finds himself in fourth-place with 195. He is five swats away from becoming the fourth player in League history with 200 career blocks. Daniels has 56 blocked shots this season and is four away from becoming just the third player in Conference annals with three 60+ block seasons, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS**. Meanwhile, Daniels needs 20 blocked shots to move into second-place on the Big South's career list.

**AMIR AMIR, ON THE WALL**

Radford junior **AMIR JOHNSON** is 24 assists away from becoming the 17th player in Big South history 400 career assists. He enters the week with 376, good for a tie for 19th-place in history and fourth all-time on Radford's career list. Johnson needs seven assists to move into third-place in school history.

**BLOCK STEADY**

UNC Asheville leapster **JOHN WILLIAMS** is six blocked shots away from becoming the 24th player in Big South history with 100 in his career. He would become the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list, which would be the most for one school in Big South history.

**HARRIS POLL**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks when he reached the milestone Jan. 24 against Winthrop. He also became just the seventh player in Big South history with 600 rebounds, 100 steals and 100 blocks.

**NEW GUYS IN TOWN**

Big South newcomers Presbyterian and Gardner-Webb have each won six Big South games this season. The record for most League wins in the first official season as a new member is 14, set by Towson State in 1992-93. The Tigers posted a 14-2 Big South record that season.

**HOLMES SCORING**

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** enters this week again as the Big South's top scorer at 22.0 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

**AUSTIN POWERS**

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in every game of his career -- a span of 36 games. He made 57 in 16 appearances in 2007-08, and has 84 treys through 20 games this season. Kenon has 141 three-pointers in his 36 games, a 3.91 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. The NCAA career record, also based on 200 career threes, is 4.57 by Mississippi Valley's **TIMOTHY POLLARD**.

**POINT OF ORDER**

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,802 career points -- good for eighth-place on the League's all-time list. He is 55 points from surpassing Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (1,856 points) for seventh-place. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,572), **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,498) and **KENNY THOMAS** (1,050). **NEWCOMER 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Presbyterian's **BRYAN BOSTIC** surpassed the 1,000-point milestone this past Saturday against High Point, and enters this week at exactly 1,000 markers. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb junior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** is 68 points shy of 1,000 in his career.

**FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

In addition to Liberty's **SETH CURRY**, other Big South freshmen men's basketball players have impacted the Conference this season. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is third in the Big South in rebounding at 9.1 per game -- good for the national freshman lead as well, while Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is fifth at 7.6. High Point's **DAVID SINGLETON** (4.62) and UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** (4.23) are second and fourth, respectively, in the Big South in assists. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** continues to lead in assist-turnover ratio (2.32), and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is third in three-pointers per game (3.60), three-point percentage (.411), and three-pointers made (72).

**BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL JOINS ELITE CLUB**

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is the second player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 200 career steals. He joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in the exclusive club. Spinks posted 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 344 assists and 220 steals in his Big South Hall of Fame career from 1990-94. Holmes needs two points and 27 steals to become the only player in League history with 1,500 points, 500 rebounds, 300 assists and 300 steals.

**TEN MEN**

The Big South has two players averaging 10.0 rebounds this season, which would mark just the second time in League history that two players averaged that many rebounds in one year. Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (10.4) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (10.4) are rebounding at a double-digit clip. In 2000-01, Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** (10.1) and Radford's **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** (10.0) were the first (and last) Big South duo to average 10.0 rebounds a game in the same season.

**McKAY NEARING 200 CAREER WINS**

Liberty second-year head coach **RITCHIE McKAY** enters the week needing three wins for 200 in his coaching career, as he is 197-181 in his 13-plus seasons on the sidelines. All of his wins have come at the Division I level and in five different conferences (Big Sky, Big South, Mountain West, Pac-10, WAC). McKay has led the Flames to back-to-back 16-win seasons as well as a 24-3 record at the Vines Center (= .889 winning percentage). Liberty's 16 victories this year are the most by the Flames in the regular-season since 1996-97, when LU won 21 regular-season contests before the Conference Tournament.

**HOLMES TWINS MAKE NCAA DIVISION I HISTORY**

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the highest scoring twin brother combination in NCAA Division I history on Jan. 24, as they scored a combined 47 points to help VMI to a 92-85 win over High Point. The duo entered the game needing 38 points to break the Division I record of 3,252, which was set by another VMI duo -- **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** from 1987-90. Chavis (1,802) and Travis (1,498) have now combined for 3,300 career points.

**REVISED LISTING ACCELERATES RECORD FOR TWINS**

In a newly revised scoring list verified by the NCAA on Friday, Jan. 23, former VMI guards **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** (1987-90) were officially deemed the Division I record holders at 3,252 points collectively. **JOHNNY** and **EDDIE O'BRIEN**, who had been considered the all-time leading scorers among twins in Division I at 3,262 points before the revision, were deemed to have played at Seattle University for two seasons (1951 and 1952) during which the school participated at the NCAA College Division level, the forerunner to modern day Division II. Therefore, the O'Brien's, who scored a combined 3,970 points during their three years in Seattle, in fact scored just 1,446 points while competing at the NCAA University Division level, regarded as Division I.

**DOWN HOLMES COOKIN'**

In addition to their scoring exploits, VMI twins **TRAVIS** and **CHAVIS HOLMES** rank first and second, respectively, in Big South history in career steals. Travis is the all-time leader with 273, but Chavis is not far behind at 264 for a combined total of 537. Both players supplanted former Winthrop guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** this season, as Gaynor set the career record just last year with 259. Chavis has a steal in his last 33 games -- a career-best, and has totaled 104 steals during his streak for an average of 3.15. Travis has recorded a steal in his last 26 games, also a career-best streak. He has 76 thefts in that span for a 2.92 per game average. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 95 of his 107 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 90 of his 104 career games.

**THREE'S COMPANY**

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is in sole possession of eighth-place in Big South history with 270 career three-pointers, and needs five treys to catch **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina) for seventh-place at 275. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 23rd in Conference annals with 198, and needs two triples to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** ranks 27th all-time with 191.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s 101 career regular-season Big South wins are third-most in League history. He trails Radford's **RON BRADLEY** (109) and Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (104) on the all-time Conference win list. This season, Biedenbach recorded two milestone victories in less than two weeks of each other. He notched his 200th career coaching win Dec. 31 vs. Western Carolina, and collected his 100th regular-season Big South win Jan. 13 vs. High Point.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern got back on track with two wins last week, snapping a 10-game slide. The first win came against Morris College, and five players reached double-figures in the victory ... **OMAR CARTER** exploded out of a slump to post a double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds. He followed that up with a 24-point, 10-rebound performance in the Bucs' win at Coastal Carolina ... The Buccaneers will try to keep the win streak going when they host High Point on Monday. On Saturday, the Bucs will head to Asheville to attempt a split with the Bulldogs.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina lost two heartbreakers in Kimbel Arena this past week, falling by five to Gardner-Webb and by two to Charleston Southern ... Coastal Carolina is now 0-5 in games decided by five points-or-less ... **STEVEN SEXTON** scored Coastal Carolina's first 14 points on his way to a 25-point performance against Gardner-Webb. The senior was 8-of-14 from the field, 6-of-12 from three-point range and 3-of-4 from the free-throw line ... Senior **MARIO SISINNI** moved into Coastal Carolina's top-10 list in assists. He now has 258 assists in his career, passing **GREG SMITH** (1994-97) for the 10th spot.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb is just 1-3 now in Big South Conference games at home, its worst start in Conference on the home floor since starting 0-4 at home in Atlantic Sun play during the 2005-06 season. GWU rebounded to finish fourth in the A-Sun that season ... Gardner-Webb has balanced its poor home performances with stellar play on the road against the League, going 5-2 in those games so far ... **GRAYSON FLITTNER** missed the final 12 minutes of the win at Coastal Carolina last week, and did not play in the loss to Radford (Jan. 31) ... **JOSHUA HENLEY** posted his sixth double-figures rebounding game of the season vs. Radford.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point dropped a pair of hard fought road contests last week ... The Panthers seven-game Conference losing streak is their longest since a seven-game skid in 2002-03 ... After playing at Charleston Southern Monday, High Point will close the regular-season playing five of its final seven games at home in the Millis Center.

**LIBERTY**

Five of Liberty's seven Conference wins have been by double-figures ... Freshman point guard **JESSE SANDERS** has recorded six games this season without a turnover. Sanders leads the Big South in assist-to-turnover ratio ... Liberty scored more bench points against UNC Asheville (15) on Saturday than the last previous four games combined.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

Brian Bostic netted his 1,000th career point Jan. 31 against High Point, opening the scoring with the three points he needed to reach the plateau ... PC placed four players in double-figures in the win as the team shot 52 percent from the floor and 43.8 percent from behind the three-point line ... **AL' LONZO COLEMAN** led the way with 17 points while **TRAVIS SLIGH** had eight points and seven rebounds ... The Blue Hose return to action Wednesday when they host Coastal Carolina before embarking on a two-game trip through Virginia as the squad plays at Radford and Liberty.

**RADFORD**

Radford finished January 7-1 ... The Highlanders are off to their best start in Big South play since recording a 12-2 Conference mark during the 2000-01 season ... It's been 30 years since Radford has strung together six-straight triumphs away from home. That streak came during the Highlanders' school record 19-game winning streak in 1978-79 ... Even though two of Radford's victories required overtime, each of its 11 wins have come by double figures.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

The Bulldogs have lost two straight, despite great comebacks in the second half against Winthrop and Liberty ... **SEAN SMITH** scored a career-high 28 points at Liberty Saturday and tied a school-record with eight three-pointers ... **JOHN WILLIAMS** came close to two double-doubles during the week with eight points and 10 rebounds vs. Winthrop and nine points and nine rebounds at Liberty ... **REID AUGST** needs just 34 points for 1,000 for his career ... The Bulldogs complete a two-game road trip at VMI on Monday night ... Asheville has played 14 of its last 20 games on the road and will play four of its next five games at Justice Center.

**VMI**

Senior **TRAVIS HOLMES** is just two points away from reaching 1,500 career points. He can become the first VMI player in both school and Big South history to amass 1,500 points, 500 rebounds, 250 assists, and 250 steals. He has already surpassed the other three thresholds ... VMI continued its streak last week of forcing at least 17 turnovers while not committing more than its opponents in each game this season ... VMI has four players averaging at least 16 points a game this season and is the only team in the country that can make that claim ... VMI has won 16 of its last 18 games -- the program's best such win streak since 1978.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop got to .500 in League play with a 56-49 win at UNC Asheville. Winthrop's defense held the Bulldogs to just one 3-point field goal over the final nine minutes and outscored Asheville 16-3 during that stretch ... Freshman guard **ANDRE JONES** scored 10 of the Eagles' final 16 points in that win. Jones has now scored in double-figures in five-straight games (15.4 per game average) ... The Eagles still have a chance to win 10 Big South regular-season games for the 10th straight year. To do that, they need to win five of their final eight League games.
