ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI Jr. • Center • Radford Minsk, Belarus

Parakhouski averaged 23.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and an impressive 85.0 percent from the field (17-of-20) in two wins last week. He opened his week with 29 points and eight rebounds in Radford's road win at Charleston Southern. He scored 20 points in the second half and finished 9-of-11 from the floor and 11-of-16 from the free throw line. Parakhouski backed that effort with his 14th double-double of the season with 17 points and 10 rebounds in a victory at VMI. He was 8-of-9 from the field and also assisted on three baskets.

JOHN WILLIAMS Soph. • Forward • UNC Asheville Raleigh, N.C.

Williams averaged 25.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 6.0 blocked shots and 76.0 percent from the field (19-of-25) in two wins last week. He scored a career-high 32 points against High Point, grabbed 10 rebounds and blocked five shots against the Panthers while going 11-of-14 from the field and 10-of-14 from the line. On Saturday vs. Coastal Carolina, Williams tallied 18 points on 8-of-11 shooting and blocked a career-best seven shots in the victory.

NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

CHASE HOLMES Guard • Presbyterian Spartanburg, S.C.

Holmes averaged 19.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in two games for the Blue Hose. He poured in a career-high 24 points and grabbed six rebounds in Presbyterian's win over VMI, while going 10-of-17 from the field. Against Charleston Southern, Holmes tallied 15 points and six rebounds in a narrow loss to the Buccaneers. For the week, Holmes was 16-of-29 from the field (= .552 percent), 7-of-10 from the charity stripe (= .700) and averaged 1.5 assists and 1.5 steals.

RADFORD WINS 2008-09 REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP

With its 97-90 win at VMI Saturday, the Radford Highlanders clinched the Big South regular-season championship and No. 1 seed in next week's Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship. It is Radford's first regular-season crown since 2000-01 and its fourth overall. The Highlanders are guaranteed a postseason appearance in the NIT should they fall short in winning the Conference Tournament.

FROM ALMOST-WORST TO FIRST

Radford is the first team in Big South history to improve from seventh-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The previous worst-to-first improvement in the League was sixth-place to first-place, which was established by Coastal Carolina in 1986-87 and 1987-88. In 1986-87, the Chanticleers were sixth in the Big South standings and the League's regular-season champion the following year.

Coastal Carolina's distinction is a little misleading, as the Conference did not have its current double-round robin scheduling in 1986-87 -- that began in 1987-88. In both 1985-86 and 1986-87, the Big South standings were determined by the Dunkel rating system, as not all teams played the same number of Conference games (the Chanticleers played eight League games that year, compared to five teams playing 14). The 1997-98 and 1998-99 Winthrop Eagles could also be considered the previous best worst-to-first improvement, as the 1997-98 squad tied for fifth but was the No. 6 seed in the Tournament. The next season, Winthrop won its first regular-season title.

HIGHLANDERS ESTABLISH CONFERENCE ROAD WIN RECORD

Radford won a Big South-record nine Conference road games this season, capping a perfect 9-0 League mark away from home in 2008-09. The last Big South team to go undefeated on the road in Big South play was Winthrop in 2006-07 (7-0). Seven road Conference wins was the previous record in the Big South Conference.

HIGHLANDERS HAVE A CHANCE TO BREAK LEAGUE'S HIGH WATER WIN MARK

At 14-2 with two Big South games left, Radford has a chance to tie and break the Big South record for most Conference wins in a season. The League mark is 15 wins, set by Towson State in 1993-94 (15-3) and tied by Winthrop in 2004-05 (15-1).

ALL FOUR HOME SEEDS DETERMINED

The four home seeds in the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship have been determined. Following No. 1 Radford, VMI, Liberty and UNC Asheville will host quarterfinal games on Tuesday, March 3. Liberty and Asheville are hosting for the second consecutive seasons, while Radford is hosting for the first time since 2005-06 and second time overall since the Big South changed its tournament format to home sites in 2002-03. VMI is hosting for the first time since joining the Conference in 2003-04.

WINTHROP'S RECORD HOSTING RUN ENDS

Unless they are part of upsets in the Conference Tournament and host the championship game, the Winthrop Eagles will not host a Big South Tournament game this season. Winthrop was the only Big South team to play a home tournament game every year of the current format -- a total of six-straight seasons.

DOG POUND

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs have won 10 Big South games in consecutive seasons for just the second time in school history. The previous time was in 1996-97 and 1997-98 when Asheville won 11 Conference games in both years.

LIBERTY-RADFORD MATCH-UP IS THE FINAL ROYAL PURPLE TV "GAME OF THE WEEK"

This Saturday's Big South Conference Royal Purple "Game of the Week" features regular-season champion Radford against Liberty at the Dedmon Center live at 6:00pm on MASN. **JASON KNAPP** (play-by-play) and former Georgetown head coach **CRAIG ESHERICK** (analyst) will call the action in the League's "Game of the Week" season finale.

20/20 VISION

The 20-9 Liberty Flames have won 20 regular-season wins for the first time since 1996-97, and their third overall as members of the Big South. Liberty and the 20-7 VMI Keydets mark just the third time in League history that two Big South teams have won 20 regular-season games in the same season. In 1990-91, Coastal Carolina and Radford each tallied 20 wins prior to the postseason tournament, and Winthrop and High Point reached 20 regular-season wins in 2006-07.

RADFORD GRABS CONFERENCE-GAME REBOUND RECORD

Radford grabbed a Big South Conference game record 65 rebounds in its win at VMI, out-rebounding the Keydets by a 65-26 advantage. The previous League game record was 61, set by Liberty two years to the day on Feb. 21, 2007 -- also against VMI. Radford's total was one rebound off the Conference's overall game record of 66 and matched two other squads for second-highest in any contest.

BIG SOUTH MISSES MID-MAJOR TRIPLE CROWN

The Big South Conference nearly enjoyed its first-ever trifecta in last week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Radford was No. 26 in the poll and fell just seven (7) points in joining VMI (No. 15) and Liberty (No. 21) in the rankings. For 11 consecutive weeks, the Big South has had two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons, while this is the first time in League history that two teams have appeared in the weekly rankings. IT AIN'T OVER UNTIL IT'S OVER

Liberty has played five overtime games this season, which ties the Big South record for most overtime games in a season, but is the most played *DURING* the regular-season. In 2002-03, UNC Asheville also played five overtime games. However, the Bulldogs played three of those contests in the post-season -- two in the Big South Tournament and one in the NCAA Opening Round game. Meanwhile, of the Flames' five extra-session games this year, four have gone into double-overtime -- a first for a Big South member in League history.

NO QUIT AMONG THESE MEMBERS

All 10 Big South members have played an overtime game this season following High Point's extra session contest against UNC Asheville last Wednesday. With Liberty leading the way, eight of the 10 Big South members have played at least two overtime games this season -- matching a Big South record that was set in 2000-01. Radford and UNC Asheville have played four overtime games this season, while Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian have three extra session games.

PLAYING BOARD GAMES

Gardner-Webb freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY**, who is the nation's leading freshman rebounder at 10.2 caroms per game, broke the Big South freshman rebound record of 262 on Feb. 18 vs. Winthrop. The previous record was established by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in 1990-91. In addition, Henley's per game average is pacing ahead of Spinks' League freshman record of 9.36. Henley is 24 rebounds away from 300 this season.

CONFERENCE SEASON HEATS UP IN FEBRUARY

The 29 Big South Conference games played this month have been decided by an average margin of 6.79 points, with 24 of the contests decided under 10 points -- including six overtime games. In a contrast to most of the season, the HOME team has won 16 times in February (=.552 winning percentage). The average margin of victory for the overall League season after 80 games is 9.38. Of the 80 games, 34 have been decided by at least 10 points (42.5 percent), while 28 have been decided by five points-or-less.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is the fifth player in League annals to grab 300 rebounds in a season. His 315 boards this season are third-most in a campaign and have vaulted him into ninth-place in Big South history with 779 career rebounds. Harris needs eight rebounds to move into eighth-place and 21 boards to become the eighth-player in League history with 800. Harris enters this week with nine consecutive double-doubles (19.2 points, 14.0 rebounds) and is averaging 11.25 rebounds per game -- the second-highest season average in League history. Charleston Southern's **OLIVER JOHNSON** averaged a record 11.41 rebounds in 1986-87.

CURRY SCORES SECOND BIG SOUTH FRESHMAN RECORD, CLOSING IN ON THIRD

With four three-pointers Saturday at Old Dominion, Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** broke the Big South freshman record for three-point field goals in a season. Curry's 88 treys this season eclipses the record of 85, which was established by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05. Curry is already the highest scoring frosh in Big South history with 601 points (he broke the League's single-season freshman record of 466 points Jan. 31 against UNC Asheville, bettering the mark set last season by Charleston Southern's **OMAR CARTER** -- Curry's high school teammate at Charlotte Christian in Charlotte, N.C.). Curry needs 33 points to enter the Big South's single-season Top 10 scoring leaders. Meanwhile, Curry is averaging 20.7 points per game, second in the Big South and the highest among all freshmen in the nation. He is looking to become the first frosh in Conference history to average 20.0 points per game, and his current average is higher than the League freshman record of 18.1 points, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1989-90.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford junior **AMIR JOHNSON**, who became the 17th player in Big South history with 400 career assists on Feb. 14 against UNC Asheville, is tied with Coastal Carolina's **ALVIN GREEN** for 15th-place in Conference annals with 411 career handouts. Johnson is third all-time on Radford's career list, and is on pace to move up to at least 14th-place on the Big South's career list when the season is complete.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville leapster **JOHN WILLIAMS** became the 24th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Wednesday, Feb. 11 at Gardner-Webb. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history. Williams enters this week with 116 career rejections to rank 19th in Conference annals.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams have won 39 of the 80 Big South games played -- a .488 winning percentage. It is the most Conference road wins since the Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule). VMI GOING FOR NATIONAL SCORING THREE-PEAT

VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with 94.2 points per game and is looking to become just the third team since 1948 to lead the NCAA in scoring offense three consecutive years. The Keydets would join Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) on the list.

KEYDETS PACING AHEAD OF THEIR OWN NCAA RECORD

VMI is averaging 13.56 three-pointers per game this season, which is pacing ahead of its national record of 13.39 set during the 2006-07 campaign. The Keydets are on pace to conclude the season with at least 407 threes, and are looking to become the first team in NCAA history to make 400 three-pointers in two different seasons.

BABY LET'S CRUZ

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** is now third all-time in Big South history with 208 career blocked shots and needs seven to move into second-place. Daniels, who entered the season tied for 14th all-time, has 69 swats on the season -- just the third player in Conference annals with three 60+ block seasons. He joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** on the list. Daniels is one rejection shy of having back-to-back 70 block seasons.

GOOD COMPANY

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds when he reached the rebounding milestone against High Point on Jan. 27. Six days later, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the 10th player on the League's 1,500-point/500-rebound list when he eclipsed the scoring milestone against UNC Asheville on Feb. 2. Smith is 14th in Conference annals with 1,648 points and tied for 47th with 530 boards. Holmes is 15th all-time in League history with 1,640 points and tied for 41st with 548 rebounds.

NEW GUYS IN TOWN

Big South newcomer Presbyterian has won eight Big South games this season. If the Blue Hose can win out the rest of the season, they would finish with 10 Conference wins. The last new member to win 10 Big South games in its official inaugural season was Birmingham-Southern in 2003-04 (12 wins). The record for most League wins in the first official season as a new member is 14, set by Towson State in 1992-93. The Tigers posted a 14-2 Big South record that season.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,960 career points -- good for sixth-place on the League's all-time list. He is 40 points away from becoming the Big South's sixth 2,000-point scorer. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,648), **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,640), **KENNY THOMAS** (1,119), and **REID AUGST** (1,077). Below is a look at where each player ranks in League history, as well as additional players with a chance to surpass 1,000 career points before the season is out:

NEWCOMER 1,000-POINT CLUB

Presbyterian's **BRYAN BOSTIC** hit the 1,000-point milestone Jan. 31 against High Point, and enters this week with 1,053 career markers. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb junior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** is 49 points shy of 1,000 in his career.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

All 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost at least two games by five points-or-less this season. A total of 44 losses have been decided by that margin -- 28 League games and 16 non-Conference. Coastal Carolina has posted losses of that margin a League-high eight times this season, including seven in Conference action. In fact, of the Chanticleers last six losses, five have been by a combined 17 points. Six of Liberty's nine losses have been five points-or-less, with those six by a combined 17 points (2.8 average). Gardner-Webb and High Point have also lost six games by the five-point margin, followed by Winthrop (5), Presbyterian (4), Radford (3), Charleston Southern (3), UNC Asheville (2) and VMI (2).

HOLMES SCORING

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** continues to lead the Big South in scoring at 22.2 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL IN A CLUB ALL BY HIMSELF

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is the only player in Big South history with 1,500 career points, 500 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 250 career steals. Holmes is three steals away from becoming the League's first player with 300 takeaways.

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER OUTAGE

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** saw his consecutive games streak with a three-pointer end at 41 games when he went 0-of-3 from long range at Presbyterian on Monday, Feb. 16. In that span, which was his first 41 career games, he was 152-of-373 (=.408 percent) from beyond the arc. Kenon has started a new streak, and now has 154 career treys in 43 career appearances for a 3.58 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. The NCAA career record, also based on 200 career threes, is 4.57 by Mississippi Valley's **TIMOTHY POLLARD**.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

In addition to Liberty's **SETH CURRY** and **JOSHUA HENLEY**, other Big South freshmen men's basketball players have impacted the Conference this season. Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is seventh in the League in rebounding at 7.0. UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** (4.57), High Point's **DAVID SINGLETON** (4.50) and Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** (4.46) are second, third and fourth, respectively, in the Big South in assists. Sanders continues to lead in assist-turnover ratio (2.50), and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is fifth in three-pointers per game (3.00), fifth in three-point percentage (.367), and fifth in three-pointers made (81).

DEEP THREE-FISHING

Entering the final week of the regular-season, VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** needs three more treys for 100 this season, while Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is eight triples shy of the century mark with three games this week. If both players reach 100 three-pointers, it would mark just the second time in Big South history that two players made 100 three-point field goals in the same season. VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** were the first in 2006-07. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SETH CURRY** is 12 three-pointers away from 100 with at least three games left in 2008-09.

BROTHERS IN ARMS

In addition to their scoring exploits, VMI twins **TRAVIS** and **CHAVIS HOLMES** rank first and second, respectively, in Big South history in career steals. Travis is the all-time leader with 297, but Chavis is not far behind at 285 for a combined total of 582. Both players supplanted former Winthrop guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** this season, as Gaynor set the career record just last year with 259. Travis has recorded a steal in his last 33 games, a career-best streak. He has 100 thefts in that span for a 3.03 per game average. Chavis' consecutive games streak with a steal ended at 34 games on Feb. 4 at Winthrop. During that time, he recorded 109 steals for an average of 3.21 steals per game. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 101 of his 114 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 97 of his 111 career games.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 105 career regular-season Big South wins, moving past Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** this past Saturday. Marshall had 104 Conference wins. Former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** is the all-time leader with 109 regular-season Big South wins. This season, Biedenbach recorded two milestone victories in less than two weeks of each other. He notched his 200th career coaching win Dec. 31 vs. Western Carolina, and collected his 100th regular-season Big South win Jan. 13 vs. High Point.

McKAY GETS 200TH CAREER WIN

Liberty second-year head coach **RITCHIE McKAY** won his 200th career game as a collegiate head coach when Liberty won 95-80 at Charleston Southern on Saturday, Feb. 14. He is 201-183 in his 13 seasons on the sidelines, and the second Big South coach to reach 200 career wins this season, joining UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**. All of McKay's wins have come at the Division I level and in five different conferences (Big Sky, Big South, Mountain West, Pac-10, WAC). McKay has led the Flames to at least 16 wins in both seasons as head coach, as well as a 26-3 record at the Vines Center (=.897 winning percentage). Liberty's 20 victories this year are the most by the Flames in the regular-season since 1996-97, when LU won 21 regular-season contests before the Conference Tournament.

KEYDETS SCORE HISTORICAL WINS

VMI has won 11 Big South games, its most Conference wins in school history. The previous high was 10 as Southern Conference members in 1995-96. In addition, VMI has recorded its first 20-win season in 31 years, as the 1977-78 Keydets (21 wins) were the last to do so.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is in sole possession of sixth-place in Big South history with 290 career three-pointers, and needs 10 treys to become the fourth player with 300. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the 23rd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he surpassed the threshold Feb. 14 at Charleston Southern. His 209 treys are 18th in League history. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is the other active Big South player with 200 career three-pointers. He reached the milestone Feb. 7 against Coastal Carolina.

TEN MEN

The Big South has three players averaging 10.0 rebounds this season, which would mark the first such occurrence in League history. Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (11.3), Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (10.9) and Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** (10.2) are rebounding at a double-digit clip. In fact, Harris has grabbed 10 rebounds against every Big South opponent this season, including both games of a Conference series four times. Both Parakhouski and Henley need a double-figure rebounding game against specific opponents on Wednesday night to match Harris' output -- Parakhouski vs. High Point and Henley vs. Presbyterian.

HOLMES TWINS OWN PIECE OF NCAA DIVISION I HISTORY

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the highest scoring twin brother combination in NCAA Division I history on Jan. 24, as they scored a combined 47 points to help VMI to a 92-85 win over High Point. The duo entered the game needing 38 points to break the Division I record of 3,252, which was set by another VMI duo -- **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** from 1987-90. Chavis (1,960) and Travis (1,640) have now combined for 3,600 career points.

IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed a League-record three student-athletes on the 2009 *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-Team. Charleston Southern senior **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS**, Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN** and Radford's **PHILLIP MARTIN** were honored, and all three individuals advance to the national ballot with the opportunity to earn Academic All-America status.

TRIPLE THREAT

Liberty freshman **JESSE SANDERS** recorded just the fifth triple-double in Big South history when he scored 10 points, grabbed 10 rebounds and dished out 10 assists in Liberty's 69-48 victory over Presbyterian on Feb. 11. Thanks goes to **WILLIAM JOHNSON** for providing this information to the Big South Conference. Mr. Johnson has assisted the NCAA in compiling triple-double research over the past few years.

VMI TIES LEAGUE RECORD FOR FASTEST TEAM TO WIN 20 GAMES

VMI's win over Charleston Southern on Monday, Feb. 9 was its 20th victory in its first 24 games, matching the Big South record for the fastest team to win 20 games. The record was first set by Liberty in 1991-92 and tied by Winthrop in 2006-07. After their respective 20-4 starts, the Flames finished with a 22-7 overall mark, while the Eagles won a Big South single-season record 29 games and ended the year at 29-5.

In the first game vs. Radford, CSU managed a 13-5 run late in the game, but Radford held on for an 80-71 win ... CSU will compete in three games this week, starting at Winthrop Tuesday night before returning home for senior night against Coastal Carolina. The Bucs will play their regular-season finale at Gardner-Webb on Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers had their seventh-straight game decided in the last possession in an 85-82 loss to Liberty, Feb. 16 ... Coastal Carolina was down as much as 23 points in the second half at UNC Asheville, but rallied to trail by just three with 3:40 left. Asheville would end the game on an 11-3 run to take the victory ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** recorded his 17th double-double of the season, scoring 32 points and adding 12 rebounds in the UNC Asheville game. Harris now has 33 career double-doubles ... Junior **MARIO EDWARDS** had 10 assists in the Liberty game, becoming the first Chant to have 10 assists since **COLIN STEVENS** against Winthrop Feb. 4, 2006 ... Coastal Carolina ends the regular-season with road games at Charleston Southern Thursday and Winthrop Saturday.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb is in the midst of its longest losing streak since 2006-07 (5 games) ... **GRAYSON FLITTNER** needs just one more made three-point basket to reach 200 for his career ... The Runnin' Bulldogs are fighting for the No. 5 seed and host Presbyterian and Charleston Southern this week to close out the regular-season.

HIGH POINT

High Point dropped a hard fought overtime decision to UNC Asheville in its only game action of the week. It was HPU's first overtime game since Jan. 20, 2007 at Charleston Southern ... **CRUZ DANIELS** (25) and **JOURDAN MORRIS** (21) both posted career best scoring performances against the Bulldogs, and it was the second time this year that the Panthers have had two players top 20 points in the same game... Freshman **NICK BARBOUR** extended his double-digit scoring streak to eight games with 14 points vs. Asheville ... The Panthers have played eight games this season decided by five points-or-less ... HPU closes the regular season with three games in six days.

LIBERTY

SETH CURRY is the sixth different Flame in program history to tally at least 600 points in a season and the third in the Division I era. Curry (88) also passed teammate **ANTHONY SMITH's** three-point record (84) set in 2008. Meanwhile, Curry has made 38-straight free throws, breaking **KARL HESS** (1980) and **MATT HILDEBRAND's** (1992) school-record of 37 ... Anthony Smith's 209 career three-point field goals ranks No. 3 all-time in the Liberty record books, while **KYLE OHMAN** ranks fifth with 148 ... Anthony Smith is set to become Liberty's all-time games played leader on Tuesday vs. VMI when he appears in his 123rd career game ... Liberty can clinch the No. 2 seed with a victory over VMI on Tuesday.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose held VMI to 38 points below its season average last Monday en route to a 63-57 victory in the Templeton Center. In the game, rookie **CHASE HOLMES** erupted for 24 points while **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** just missed a double-double, tallying 12 points and nine rebounds.

RADFORD

The Highlanders have set a school record for Conference wins in a campaign (14) ... Radford has won eight straight and 13 of its last 14 ... Radford's nine road victories this season is also a school record ... The Highlanders are tied with UConn for the longest road win streak in the country (nine) ... Radford has placed at least four players in double figures 15 times this season ... Three Highlanders recorded double-doubles at VMI.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs will be either the third or fourth seed in next week's Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship ... Asheville won at High Point for the first time in five years when it recorded an 81-78 overtime win ... The Bulldogs went 10-3 at home this season and are 27-6 at the Justice Center over the last two years ... Freshman **QUINARD JACKSON** came off the bench in the Coastal Carolina game and grabbed a career-best nine rebounds.

VMI

VMI's three-game losing streak is the longest of the season ... Senior guard **CHAVIS HOLMES** needs 40 points to surpass the 2,000 career point scoring mark and become the fourth VMI player to accomplish that feat ... VMI and Virginia Tech are the only Division I schools to boast three players who have scored 30 points-or-more against a Division I opponent this year. VMI's contributors are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (two times), Chavis Holmes (three times) and **KEITH GABRIEL** (one time) ... Freshman guard **RON BURKS** continued his improved scoring output in February with a career-high 15 points at Presbyterian on Feb. 16. He hit four three-pointers in the game, giving him nine treys over a three-game span.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is on a season-best three-game winning streak after capturing a 65-63 victory over Appalachian State in the ESPNU BracketBusters on Saturday. It is the fourth-straight year Winthrop has been in a BracketBusters game and holds an all-time mark of 3-1 ... During the three-game win streak, **JUSTIN BURTON** has scored in double-figures in all three games, including a 16-point performance that helped Winthrop pull off a road win at Gardner-Webb.
