Parakhouski averaged 25.0 points and 13.5 rebounds in two games last week while shooting 65.5 percent (19-of-29) from the floor. He opened the week with 11 points and eight rebounds in a win against High Point, then tied a Dedmon Center record with 39 points in Radford's setback to Liberty in Saturday's regular-season finale. He scored 25 points after intermission and grabbed 19 rebounds for his 15th double-double of the season. Parakhouski was 15-of-19 from the floor against the Flames and added nine free throws.

Henley helped Gardner-Webb to two key wins last week. In the Runnin' Bulldogs' win over Presbyterian, Henley netted a double-double with 10 points and 17 caroms. In Saturday's win over Charleston Southern, he dished off five assists in the game's first 10 minutes and finished with four points, nine rebounds and a career-high six assists with just one turnover. On the week, Henley averaged 7.0 points, 13.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and was 7-of-10 from the floor (=70.0 percent). He also became the first freshman in Big South history to collect 300 rebounds in a single-season.

TOURNAMENT TIME IS HERE

The 2009 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship tips off Tuesday, March 3 with three quarterfinal games in Virginia and one in the mountains of North Carolina. Radford, VMI, Liberty and UNC Asheville are the top four seeds, and went a combined 25-11 (.694) at home during the Conference season. Liberty and Asheville are hosting for the second consecutive seasons, while Radford is hosting for the first time since 2005-06 and second time overall since the Big South changed its tournament format to home sites in 2002-03. VMI is hosting for the first time since joining the Conference in 2003-04. The bottom four seeds -- Winthrop, Gardner-Webb, Coastal Carolina and High Point went 13-23 (.361) away from home during the League season.

HISTORY ON ITS SIDE?

Radford will have home court advantage throughout the 2009 Conference Tournament as the No. 1 seed. The Big South began having its No. 1 seed host throughout the postseason in 2004, and since that time, the No. 1 seed has reached the Championship game every year for five-straight years, winning four titles. Last year was the first time that the Big South's No. 1 seed did not win the Conference Tournament.

WINTHROP'S RECORD HOSTING RUN ENDS

Unless they are part of upsets in the Conference Tournament and host the championship game, the Winthrop Eagles will not host a Big South Tournament game this season. Winthrop was the only Big South team to play a home tournament game every year of the current format -- a total of six-straight seasons.

COMPETITIVE BALANCE

Seven of the 10 Big South members went .500 in Conference play in 2008-09, the most in League history. The previous best was six teams, which was accomplished in 1993-94 (10 playing members) and 1986-87 (8 playing members). However, the Conference did not have its current double-round robin scheduling in 1986-87, as the Big South standings were determined by the Dunkel rating system since not all the teams played the same number of Conference games.

CHEAPER BY THE DOZEN

For the first time since 2005-06 and for just the third time in Big South history, three teams won at least 12 Conference games in the same season. Radford tied the Big South record for most League wins with 15, while VMI collected 13 Conference wins this year. Liberty won its 12th Big South game in its regular-season finale. The Big South record for most teams with at least 12 Conference wins is four, which occurred in 1993-94.

FROM ALMOST-WORST TO FIRST

Radford is the first team in Big South history to improve from seventh-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The previous worst-to-first improvement in the League was sixth-place to first-place, which was established by Coastal Carolina in 1986-87 and 1987-88. In 1986-87, the Chanticleers were sixth in the Big South standings and the League's regular-season champion the following year.

Coastal Carolina's distinction is a little misleading, as the Conference did not have its current double-round robin scheduling in 1986-87 -- that began in 1987-88. In both 1985-86 and 1986-87, the Big South standings were determined by the Dunkel rating system, as not all teams played the same number of Conference games (the Chanticleers played eight League games that year, compared to five teams playing 14). The 1997-98 and 1998-99 Winthrop Eagles could also be considered the previous best worst-to-first improvement, as the 1997-98 squad tied for fifth but was the No. 6 seed in the Tournament. The next season, Winthrop won its first regular-season title.

TV TUNER

For the fourth consecutive year, ESPNU will televise the Big South Tournament Semifinals live from the site of the No. 1 seed, while ESPN2 will broadcast the Championship game live from the arena of the highest remaining seed. **MIKE GLEASON** and former Duke standout **JAY WILLIAMS** will call the Semifinals from Radford, while **BOB WISCHUSEN** and **MARK ADAMS** will once again handle the announcing duties of the title game.

HIGHLANDERS ESTABLISH CONFERENCE ROAD WIN RECORD

Radford won a Big South-record nine Conference road games this season, capping a perfect 9-0 League mark away from home in 2008-09. The last Big South team to go undefeated on the road in Big South play was Winthrop in 2006-07 (7-0). Seven road Conference wins was the previous record in the Big South Conference.

**BIG SOUTH MEN'S BASKETBALL
TOURNAMENT TIDBITS**

Since the Big South adopted the current home site Conference Tournament format in 2003, the home seeds are a combined 25-12 (.676) in 37 possible home games. This total does not include games that were played on a neutral floor in 2003 (semifinals and finals) and 2006, 2007 and 2008 (semifinals).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 15-9 (.625) on their home courts after last year's top four seeds were all victorious for the first time in the same season.

DOG POUND

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs have won 10 Big South games in consecutive seasons for just the second time in school history. The previous time was in 1996-97 and 1997-98 when Asheville won 11 Conference games in both years.

BIG SOUTH'S MID-MAJOR MANIA

The Big South Conference nearly enjoyed its first-ever trifecta in the Feb. 16 *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Radford was No. 26 in the poll and fell just seven (7) points shy in joining VMI (No. 15) and Liberty (No. 21) in the rankings. The Highlanders did crack the poll last week, coming in at No. 23. However, Liberty fell out of the rankings. Still, the Big South has had two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll for 12 consecutive weeks now. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons, and this is the first time in League history that two teams have appeared together in the weekly rankings. ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN** was voted to the *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-America First-Team last week. It is the third consecutive year that the Big South has had a men's basketball Academic All-American and seventh overall. Linn was one of a League-record three student-athletes on the 2009 *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-Team. Charleston Southern senior **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** and Radford's **PHILLIP MARTIN** were also honored at the District level.

CONFERENCE SEASON HEATS UP IN FEBRUARY

The 39 Big South Conference games played in the month of February were decided by an average margin of 7.95 points, with 31 of the contests decided under 10 points -- including six overtime games. In a contrast to most of the season, the HOME team won 23 times in February (=.590 winning percentage). The average margin of victory for the overall League season (90 games) was 8.96. Of the 90 games, 37 were decided by at least 10 points (41.1 percent), while 32 were decided by five points-or-less.

EXECUTIVE BOARD

For the first time in Big South history, three players have grabbed 300 rebounds in the same season. Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** leads the Big South with 339 boards, followed by Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (320) and Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** (302). All three players are rebounding at a double-digit clip, which would mark the first trio in Big South history to accomplish this feat in the same year. Meanwhile, Harris needs just four rebounds to break the League's single-season record of 342, set just last season by High Point's **ARIZONA REID**. 20/20 VISION

The 21-10 Liberty Flames have won 20 regular-season wins for the first time since 1996-97, and their third overall as members of the Big South. Liberty and the 22-7 VMI Keydets mark just the third time in League history that two Big South teams have won 20 regular-season games in the same season. In 1990-91, Coastal Carolina and Radford each tallied 20 wins prior to the postseason tournament, and Winthrop and High Point reached 20 regular-season wins in 2006-07.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the eighth player in Big South history with 800 career rebounds when he reached the milestone in the Chanticleers' regular-season finale at Winthrop, Feb. 28. This season alone Harris reached the 500, 600, 700 and 800-career rebound milestone, and he grabbed at least 10 rebounds against every Big South opponent. In fact, Harris recorded a double-double against every League team and enters the Conference Tournament with 11 consecutive double-doubles (17.9 points, 13.6 rebounds). He is averaging 11.30 rebounds per game -- the second-highest season average in League history. Charleston Southern's **OLIVER JOHNSON** averaged a record 11.41 rebounds in 1986-87.

PLAYING BOARD GAMES

Gardner-Webb freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY**, who is the nation's leading freshman rebounder at 10.4 caroms per game, is the first freshman in Big South history to grab 300 rebounds in a season. He broke the Big South freshman rebound record of 262 on Feb. 18 vs. Winthrop, which was held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in 1990-91. In addition, Henley's per game average will break Spinks' League freshman record of 9.36.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the fourth player since the 2007 season and sixth in Big South history to amass 2,000 career points. He eclipsed the milestone at High Point on Feb. 28, and enters the Conference Tournament at 2,003. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,673), **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,673), **KENNY THOMAS** (1,163), and **REID AUGST** (1,081). Below is a look at where each player ranks in League history, as well as additional players with a chance to surpass 1,000 career points during the Conference Tournament:

CURRY SCORES SECOND BIG SOUTH FRESHMAN RECORD, CLOSING IN ON THIRD

Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** has two Big South freshman records this season, and is closing in on a third. He is the highest scoring freshman in League history with 640 points -- the 10th most in a season in Big South annals, and shattering the previous best of 466 points. Curry has also drained 95 three-pointers this season, breaking the old mark of 85. Curry is averaging 20.6 points per game, second in the Big South and the highest among all freshmen in the nation. He is looking to become the first frosh in Conference history to average 20.0 points per game, and his current average is higher than the League freshman record of 18.1 points, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** in 1989-90.

BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL IN A CLUB ALL BY HIMSELF

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** recorded his 300th career steal in the Keydets' regular-season finale at High Point, Feb. 28, to become just the ninth player in NCAA Division I history with 1,500 career points, 500 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 300 career steals. Holmes currently has 1,673 points, 568 rebounds, 347 assists and 302 steals. Others on the list include Maryland's **JUAN DIXON**, Ball State's **BONZI WELLS** and Providence's **ERIC MURDOCK**.

HOLMES SCORING

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** enters the Big South Tournament as the Big South's scoring leader with 22.1 points per contest. If he should finish as the League's scoring leader, it would mark the third consecutive season that VMI produced the Big South's individual scoring champion. The first and last school to have the Conference's scoring leader for three-straight seasons was Coastal Carolina from 1992-93 to 1994-95.

IT AIN'T OVER UNTIL IT'S OVER

Liberty has played five overtime games this season, which ties the Big South record for most overtime games in a season, but is the most played *DURING* the regular-season. In 2002-03, UNC Asheville also played five overtime games. However, the Bulldogs played three of those contests in the postseason -- two in the Big South Tournament and one in the NCAA Opening Round game. Meanwhile, of the Flames' five extra-session games this year, four have gone into double-overtime -- a first for a Big South member in League history.

NO QUIT AMONG THESE MEMBERS

All 10 Big South members have played an overtime game this season. With Liberty leading the way, eight of the 10 Big South members have played at least two overtime games this season -- matching a Big South record that was set in 2000-01. Radford and UNC Asheville have played four overtime games this season, while Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian have three extra session games.

BABY LET'S CRUZ

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** is now second all-time in Big South history with 218 career blocked shots. Daniels, who entered the season tied for 14th all-time, has 79 swats on the season -- the 11th-highest single-season total in Big South history, and his second consecutive season with 70+ blocks. Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** is the Conference's all-time leader with 366.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford junior **AMIR JOHNSON**, who became the 17th player in Big South history with 400 career assists on Feb. 14 against UNC Asheville, is tied with former Highlander **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** for 14th-place in Conference annals with 417 career handouts. Johnson leads the Big South in assists per game with 5.21, and is looking to become the first Highlander to lead the League in helpers since **RIAN EVERETTE** averaged a Conference-best 4.4 in 1997-98.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville leapster **JOHN WILLIAMS** became the 24th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Wednesday, Feb. 11 at Gardner-Webb. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history. Williams enters the Conference Tournament with 117 career rejections to rank 19th in Conference annals.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams won 42 of the 90 Big South games played -- a .467 winning percentage. It is the most Conference road wins since the Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule). VMI GOING FOR NATIONAL SCORING THREE-PEAT

VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with 94.3 points per game and is looking to become just the third team since 1948 to lead the NCAA in scoring offense three consecutive years. The Keydets would join Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) on the list.

KEYDETS PACING AHEAD OF THEIR OWN NCAA RECORD

VMI is averaging 13.69 three-pointers per game this season, which is pacing ahead of its national record of 13.39 set during the 2006-07 campaign. The Keydets need three more three-point field goals to become the first team in NCAA history to make 400 three-pointers in two different seasons.

NEWCOMER 1,000-POINT CLUB

Presbyterian's **BRYAN BOSTIC** hit the 1,000-point milestone Jan. 31 against High Point, and finishes his career with 1,088 career markers. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb junior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** is 31 points shy of 1,000 in his career.

GOOD COMPANY

Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds when he reached the rebounding milestone against High Point on Jan. 27. Six days later, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the 10th player on the League's 1,500-point/500-rebound list when he eclipsed the scoring milestone against UNC Asheville on Feb. 2. Both are tied for 12th in Conference annals with 1,673 points. Holmes is 37th with 568 boards, while Smith is 43rd with 549.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

All 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost at least two games by five points-or-less this season. A total of 48 losses have been decided by that margin -- 32 League games and 16 non-Conference. Coastal Carolina has posted losses of that margin a League-high nine times this season, including eight in Conference action. In fact, of the Chanticleers last eight losses, six have been by a combined 21 points. High Point has dropped seven games by five points-or-less, including two against the Conference's top two teams during the final week of the regular-season. Six of Liberty's 10 losses have been five points-or-less, with those six by a combined 17 points (2.8 average). Gardner-Webb has also lost six games by the five-point margin, followed by Winthrop (5), Presbyterian (4), Charleston Southern (4), Radford (3), UNC Asheville (2) and VMI (2).

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** saw his consecutive games streak with a three-pointer end at 41 games when he went 0-of-3 from long range at Presbyterian on Monday, Feb. 16. In that span, which was his first 41 career games, he was 152-of-373 (=.408 percent) from beyond the arc. Kenon has started a new streak at three games, and now has 163 career treys in 46 career appearances for a 3.54 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. The NCAA career record, also based on 200 career threes, is 4.57 by Mississippi Valley's **TIMOTHY POLLARD**.

DEEP THREE-FISHING

VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** enters the Conference Tournament this week with 106 three-point field goals, tied for seventh-most in a Big South single-season. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** fell one triple shy of the century mark. However, Liberty's **SETH CURRY** needs five three-point field goals in the Big South Tournament to reach 100, while teammate **KYLE OHMAN** is nine away from the mark. The Big South is looking for its second duo to have 100 three-pointers in the same season, as VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** were the first in 2006-07. The Big South has never had three players top 100 treys in the same year.

BROTHERS IN ARMS

In addition to their scoring exploits, VMI twins **TRAVIS** and **CHAVIS HOLMES** rank first and second, respectively, in Big South history in career steals. Travis is the all-time leader with 302, but Chavis is not far behind at 290 for a combined total of 592. Both players supplanted former Winthrop guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** this season, as Gaynor set the career record just last year with 259. Travis has recorded a steal in his last 35 games, a career-best streak. He has 105 thefts in that span for a 3.00 per game average. Chavis' consecutive games streak with a steal ended at 34 games on Feb. 4 at Winthrop. During that time, he recorded 109 steals for an average of 3.21 steals per game. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 103 of his 116 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 99 of his 113 career games.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 106 career regular-season Big South wins. He moved past Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (104) on Wednesday, Feb. 18 with his 105th victory Conference victory. Former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** is the all-time leader with 109 regular-season Big South wins. This season, Biedenbach recorded two milestone victories in less than two weeks of each other. He notched his 200th career coaching win Dec. 31 vs. Western Carolina, and collected his 100th regular-season Big South win Jan. 13 vs. High Point.

McKAY GETS 200TH CAREER WIN

Liberty second-year head coach **RITCHIE McKAY** won his 200th career game as a collegiate head coach when Liberty won 95-80 at Charleston Southern on Saturday, Feb. 14. He is 202-184 in his 13 seasons on the sidelines, and the second Big South coach to reach 200 career wins this season, joining UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**. All of McKay's wins have come at the Division I level and in five different conferences (Big Sky, Big South, Mountain West, Pac-10, WAC). McKay has led the Flames to at least 16 wins in both seasons as head coach, as well as a 26-4 record at the Vines Center (= .867 winning percentage). Liberty's 21 victories this year are the most by the Flames in the regular-season since 1996-97, when LU won 21 regular-season contests before the Conference Tournament.

KEYDETS SCORE HISTORICAL WINS

VMI won 13 Big South games, its most Conference wins in school history. The previous high was 10 as Southern Conference members in 1995-96. In addition, VMI has recorded its first 20-win season in 31 years, as the 1977-78 Keydets (21 wins) were the last to do so.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is tied for fourth in Big South history with 296 career three-pointers, and needs four treys to become the fourth player with 300. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** became the 23rd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he surpassed the threshold Feb. 14 at Charleston Southern. His 209 treys are 18th in League history. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is the other active Big South player with 200 career three-pointers with 207. He reached the milestone Feb. 7 against Coastal Carolina.

HOLMES TWINS OWN PIECE OF NCAA DIVISION I HISTORY

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the highest scoring twin brother combination in NCAA Division I history on Jan. 24, as they scored a combined 47 points to help VMI to a 92-85 win over High Point. The duo entered the game needing 38 points to break the Division I record of 3,252, which was set by another VMI duo -- **RAMON** and **DAMON WILLIAMS** from 1987-90. Chavis (2,003) and Travis (1,673) have now combined for 3,676 career points.

TRIPLE THREAT

Liberty freshman **JESSE SANDERS** recorded just the fifth triple-double in Big South history when he scored 10 points, grabbed 10 rebounds and dished out 10 assists in Liberty's 69-48 victory over Presbyterian on Feb. 11. Thanks goes to **WILLIAM JOHNSON** for providing this information to the Big South Conference. Mr. Johnson has assisted the NCAA in compiling triple-double research over the past few years.

VMI TIES LEAGUE RECORD FOR FASTEST TEAM TO WIN 20 GAMES

VMI's win over Charleston Southern on Monday, Feb. 9 was its 20th victory in its first 24 games, matching the Big South record for the fastest team to win 20 games. The record was first set by Liberty in 1991-92 and tied by Winthrop in 2006-07. After their respective 20-4 starts, the Flames finished with a 22-7 overall mark, while the Eagles won a Big South single-season record 29 games and ended the year at 29-5.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern failed to qualify for the Big South Tournament for the first time, as the Buccaneers lost the tiebreaker for the eighth and final seed ... After going winless in Conference road games the past two seasons, CSU won twice away from home against League foes in 2008-09 ... **OMAR CARTER** averaged 15.5 points and 9.4 rebounds in his final 11 games of the season to conclude the year sixth in the Conference in rebounding at 7.9.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina is looking for its first semifinal appearance since 2005-06 when the Chanticleers advanced to the Championship game ... This is the first meeting between Coastal Carolina and VMI in the Big South Tournament. During the regular-season, the two teams had two epic battles. The Keydets won a 103-102 thriller in Lexington, Jan. 10. **STEVEN SEXTON** banked a shot at the buzzer, but it was ruled that his foot was on the three-point line, giving VMI the victory. Then in Conway, **MARIO EDWARDS** hit a three-pointer as time expired to give Coastal Carolina a 100-97 victory on Feb. 14 ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** owns a career 19.2 points per game average in six meetings against VMI.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb will be the sixth seed in a League tournament for the second season in a row ... GWU was the No. 6 seed in 2008 for the Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament, their final year in that Conference ... GWU defeated No. 3 Stetson, 82-63, in its last No. 6/No. 3 tournament matchup (last season) ... In the regular-season series against Liberty, six players averaged double figures scoring, while **JOSHUA HENLEY** averaged 13.0 rebounds ... **AARON LINN** is the school's first men's basketball first-team Academic All-America selection since the move to NCAA Division I in 2000.

HIGH POINT

High Point is the No. 8 seed for the just the second time since joining the Big South Conference, the first coming in 2003 ... High Point has reached the semifinals in each of the last five seasons ... Freshman **NICK BARBOUR** finished the regular-season with 11 straight double-digit scoring performances ... R-Junior **CRUZ DANIELS** finished the regular-season on a high note, pulling down a career best 20 rebounds in finale vs. VMI. He also set a HPU single-season blocked shot record with 79 ... In the regular-season series against Radford, Barbour averaged 18.5 points in High Point's two losses to the Highlanders.

LIBERTY

Liberty is a home seed for the third consecutive season and the sixth time in the seven years of the Conference's current home site format ... **KYLE OHMAN** averaged 22.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in the season series against Gardner-Webb ... **SETH CURRY**'s school-record for consecutive free throws was snapped at 41 on Saturday at Radford ... Liberty won at regular-season champion Radford on Feb. 28 -- just its fourth victory at Radford in a series history that dates back to 1975 ... As a team, the Flames have 292 three-point field goals this season, breaking the team record set last season when **RITCHIE McKAY**'s inaugural team connected on 288 attempts.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian finished its inaugural season in the Big South tied for fifth at 9-9, and was 12-17 overall ... The Blue Hose are not eligible for the Big South Tournament due to its transition to Division I, but is included in the regular-season standings, statistics and Conference honors, as well as being factored into the League's tiebreaking process ... Sophomore **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** finished 10th in the League in scoring with 10.5 points and ranked fourth with 8.4 rebounds a game. In League contests, Coleman averaged 9.6 points.

RADFORD

In the season series against High Point, **KENNY THOMAS** averaged 17.5 points and 7.0 rebounds ... The Highlanders have won 14 of their last 16 games and is the No. 1 seed for the fourth time in school history ... **ART PARAKHOUSKI** tied a Dedmon Center record with 39 points against Liberty on Feb. 28. Parakhouski also broke Radford's single-season rebounding record with his 19 against the Flames.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville is a home seed for the second-straight year and meets No. 5 Winthrop in a rematch of last year's Championship game ... The Bulldogs finished fourth in the League at 10-8 after being a preseason pick to finish ninth ... UNC Asheville has won two Big South Tournament titles, including one as the No. 4 seed in 1989 ... This will be the third consecutive year that Asheville will face Winthrop in the Tournament ... The Bulldogs are looking for their first win over the Eagles in postseason play since 2004, when No. 6 Asheville won at No. 3 Winthrop in the quarterfinals, 49-46 ... In the two meetings in the regular-season, **MATT DICKEY** averaged 17.0 points.

VMI

VMI is a home seed in the Big South Tournament and its No. 2 seed is its highest since joining the Big South in 2003-04 ... The Keydets are looking for just their second semifinal appearance, with the last being in 2007 when VMI reached the Championship game ... In the regular-season against Coastal Carolina, **TRAVIS HOLMES** averaged 29.5 points, while twin brother **CHAVIS HOLMES** averaged 26.5 ... VMI's 22 wins is tied for second-most in program history. The 1976-77 team went 26-4 and advanced to the NCAA "Sweet Sixteen".

WINTHROP

Winthrop is a road seed for the first time since the Conference Tournament format went to home sites in 2002-03. The last time the Eagles were in the bottom half of the seeding was in 1998, when Winthrop was a No. 6 seed ... Winthrop swept the regular-season series against Asheville, outscoring the Bulldogs 71.5 to 58.0, and outshooting UNC Asheville from the field, 50.0 percent to 34.0 percent ... The Eagles closed out the regular-season with a season-best five-game win streak, allowing just 53.4 points per game in that span.
