Holmes averaged 25.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals for the Keydets. He scored a career-high 30 points and grabbed seven rebounds in VMI's upset win at Kentucky Friday night. He hit 10-of-13 of his field goals against the Wildcats and had four steals in the win. Holmes added 20 points and four rebounds Sunday at Virginia, and went 7-of-11 from the floor. On the week, Holmes was 17-of-24 from the field (=.708), 3-of-4 from long range (=.750) and 13-of-13 from the charity stripe.

Sunday at Virginia, Gabriel contributed 14 points, grabbed four rebounds and blocked three shots. In his first two career games, Gabriel averaged 17.0 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.0 blocks and was 14-of-30 from the field (=.467).

BIG SOUTH INCLUDED IN ESPN'S 24 HOUR HOOPS MARATHON

UNC Asheville hosts Liberty Tuesday afternoon at 2:00pm in the earliest Big South opener in League history, as the game is part of ESPN's 24 Hour College Basketball Marathon. **DAVE BARNETT** (play-by-play) and **BOB WENZEL** will call the action from the Justice Center.

VMI OPENS SEASON WITH MONUMENTAL WIN

VMI opened the 2008-09 men's basketball season with a resounding 111-103 victory at Kentucky, the school's first win over an SEC opponent since 1975-76 when the Keydets upset No. 9 Tennessee, 81-75 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Six players scoring in double figures against the Wildcats, led by **TRAVIS HOLMES'** career-high 30 points. Holmes was 10-of-13 from the floor and 9-of-9 from the free throw line. VMI's win over Kentucky handed the Wildcats their first loss in a game scoring 100 points since their loss to Duke in the 1992 East Regional Final, won on a last second by **CHRISTIAN LAETTNER**. Friday's win marked the third consecutive season that a Big South member has defeated an SEC member.

MORE ON VMI'S SEASON-OPENING VICTORY

VMI's 111-103 win at Kentucky was the Keydets' first in a season-opener away from Cameron Hall since knocking off Roanoke 64-50 at the UVA Tipoff on Nov. 25, 1977. It was the first season opening win in a "true" road setting since a 55-52 win at Hampden-Sydney in the 1955-56 opener. In addition, the Kentucky victory was the first season-opening win for coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** in his four seasons at VMI.

KEYDETS ENTER MID-MAJOR MANIA

VMI is ranked No. 25 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, its first-ever ranking in the poll. It is the fifth consecutive season the Big South has had a team ranked in the Top 25. Winthrop received votes for the second-straight week, as the Eagles and Keydets received votes in the preseason poll. Meanwhile, VMI garnered a Top 25 vote in this week's *Associated Press* national ranking.

WELCOME TO YOUR NEW HOME

The Big South welcomes two new members to the League in 2008-09: Gardner-Webb University and Presbyterian College. Both schools are immediately eligible for the regular-season title and post-season All-Conference honors. However, Presbyterian is not eligible for the Conference tournament as part of its transition to Division I.

GARDNER-WEBB ALMOST PULLS OUT WIN AT VIRGINIA TECH

New Big South member Gardner-Webb, which defeated Kentucky last season, opened the 2008-09 campaign at an ACC member for just the second time ever, and lost by three points for the second time. In 2005-06, the Bulldogs lost 83-80 at defending National Champion North Carolina. GWU played Virginia Tech last Friday without forward **NATE BLANK**, who will miss at least three games due to a preseason injury.

PRESBYTERIAN MAKES BIG SOUTH DEBUT

Presbyterian College made its Big South Conference debut on national television last week, as the Blue Hose faced Duke on ESPNU as part of the 2K Sports Classic benefitting Coaches vs. Cancer. In PC's loss to the Blue Devils, **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** and **BO KING** paced the squad with 13 points each. The next night in the consolation game against Houston, Coleman recorded his first career double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds in the loss to the Cougars.

HOME SWEET HOME

High Point will make its home debut on Thursday vs. Atlanta Christian. The Panthers are 28-2 in the Millis Center over the past two seasons, including a 19-game non-Conference home win streak. HPU has won its last 11 home openers as well.

EXTREME MAKEOVER

Radford is playing its home men's basketball games temporarily in Peters Hall on campus while renovations continue at the Dedmon Center. The Highlanders opened the season with a 74-55 victory over Brevard to improve to 31-4 in home openers and 70-18 (=.795) all-time in games played at Peters Hall. Radford welcomes Bridgewater College and former standout **DON BURGESS** on Tuesday, as Burgess is in his first season as BC's head coach. A victory would give the Highlanders their first 2-0 start to a season since 2003-04.

ON FIRE

Liberty's 97-77 season-opening win against Montreat at the Vines Center this past Friday was its first win in a season opener since Nov. 17, 2000, when the Flames defeated Tusculum, 84-58, also at home. Liberty is now 19-18 all-time in season openers. Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** recorded seven steals in his collegiate debut, tying a Vines Center record. He finished the night with 23 points, becoming the fourth Liberty freshman to reach the 20-point plateau in his first college game.

DOG POUND

UNC Asheville is 2-0 for the second-straight year following wins over Belmont Abbey and Montreat. The Bulldogs got a double-double from sophomore **JOHN WILLIAMS** in the Montreat victory with 11 points and 11 rebounds. Asheville, which set a Big South record last season with 194 blocked shots, swatted away 13 shots in the first two games this season.

SMITH NAMED PRESEASON MID-MAJOR ALL-AMERICAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **ANTHONY SMITH** was named a *Collegeinsider.com* Preseason Mid-Major All-American, becoming the second Liberty player to earn such honors. Former guard **LARRY BLAIR** earned the distinction prior to the 2006-07 season. Smith sits in 15th all-time in the Liberty annals with 1,164 career points.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is three wins away from 200 career coaching victories as a college head coach. He is 168-186 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor. He won 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,431 career points, good for 29th all-time in Big South history. He is 280 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,266) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,164). BOARD REPORT

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 31 rebounds away from becoming the 49th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds. Harris would have reached the milestone last season, but suffered a season-ending injury in the eighth game of the year. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is 65 rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (360) and VMI's **WILLIE BELL** (323) could also surpass 500 career rebounds in 2008-09.

GAYNOR'S STEALS RECORD MAY BE SHORT-LIVED

Former Winthrop point guard **CHRIS GAYNOR**'s Big South career record of 259 steals -- established just last season, is likely to be the first all-time record to fall in 2008-09, as VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES**' 229 career steals are just 30 away from Gaynor's mark. Holmes is currently fifth in Big South history, and needs 10 more to move into fourth place.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FOURTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the ESPN BracketBusters event this season during the week-end of February 20-21. Winthrop (home), Gardner-Webb (road) and Liberty (road) will be the League's participants. The League has received two nationally-televised broadcasts the past two seasons. Winthrop is 2-1 all-time in the event, while Liberty is 0-1. Gardner-Webb will make its first-ever appearance in the BracketBusters.
