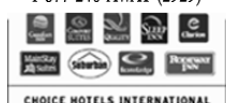

### WINTHROP PICKED AS TEAM TO BEAT IN 2008-09

After a one year hiatus, Winthrop has been voted the preseason men's basketball favorite by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Eagles are coming off their fourth consecutive Big South championship title, and received nine first-place votes and 202 total points in this year's voting. Radford, last year's seventh-place finisher, finished No. 2 in the preseason ranking with seven first-place votes and 189 points to edge out new League member Gardner-Webb, which was third with 188 points. A total of seven teams received at least one first-place vote: Winthrop (9), Radford (7), Gardner-Webb (3), Liberty (2) and High Point, Charleston Southern and VMI with one each.

### SMITH TABBED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Liberty senior **ANTHONY SMITH** has been voted the League's Preseason Men's Basketball Player of the Year. He was the only player in the nation in 2007-08 to attempt at least 200 three-point field goals and succeed on at least 40 percent of his three-point field goal attempts (41.0) and 50 percent of his overall field goal attempts (51.5). Smith ranked in five Big South individual categories last season, including No. 6 in points (16.0), No. 5 in field goal percentage (51.5) and No. 4 in three-point shooting (41.0). Smith, a 2005-06 Big South All-Freshman Team member, set Liberty records in 2007-08 for three-point field goals (84) and attempts (205). Joining Smith on the preseason team are **OMAR CARTER** (Charleston Southern), **GRAYSON FLITTNER** (Gardner-Webb), **CHAVIS HOLMES** (VMI) and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (Radford).

### SMITH NAMED PRESEASON MID-MAJOR ALL-AMERICAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **ANTHONY SMITH** was named a *Collegeinsider.com* Preseason Mid-Major All-American, becoming the second Liberty player to earn such honors. Former guard **LARRY BLAIR** earned the distinction prior to the 2006-07 season.

### WELCOME TO YOUR NEW HOME

The Big South welcomes two new members to the League in 2008-09: Gardner-Webb University and Presbyterian College. Both schools are immediately eligible for the regular-season title and post-season All-Conference honors. However, Presbyterian is not eligible for the Conference tournament as part of its transition to Division I.

### POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** enters the 2008-09 campaign as the League's active leading scorer with 1,384 career points, tied for 32nd all-time in Big South history. He is 327 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers returning are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,216) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,139). ### 20/20 VISION

For the fourth consecutive season in 2007-08, the Big South had two teams finish the season with 20 wins -- the longest such streak in Conference history. UNC Asheville won a school-record 23 games last year, followed by Winthrop with 22. The Eagles have won 20 games a Big South-record four-straight seasons.

### BOARD REPORT

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** enters the season 36 rebounds away from becoming the 49th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds. Harris would have reached the milestone last season, but suffered a season-ending injury in the eighth game of the year. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is 76 rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (351) and VMI's **WILLIE BELL** (309) could also surpass 500 career rebounds in 2007-08.

### MID-MAJOR MANIA

Winthrop and VMI both received votes in the preseason *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll entering the 2008-09 season. Last season, Winthrop and UNC Asheville made the national rankings during various times during the campaign, but never in the same week.

**A GREAT CLASS**

The 2004-05 Big South All-Freshman Team left an undeniable mark on the Conference's history, as four of the five members departed with several of the League's all-time records. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** became the League's all-time scorer (2,556 points), while **ARIZONA REID** left as the all-time rebounder (1,013). **JACK LEASURE** set the League's three-point record (411), while **CHRIS GAYNOR** took home the Big South assist record (567) and steals mark (259). One player not on the team finished as the Conference's all-time games played leader -- **MICHAEL JENKINS** (131).

**GAYNOR'S STEALS RECORD MAY BE SHORT-LIVED**

**CHRIS GAYNOR**'s Big South career record of 259 is likely the first all-time record to fall, as **VMI**'s **TRAVIS HOLMES** enters the 2008-09 season with 222 career steals -- just 37 away from Gaynor's mark. Holmes is currently seventh in Big South history, and his 2.49 career steals per game average is second-best in League history. If Holmes maintains his career average, he is on track to break Gaynor's record in **VMI**'s 15th game of year, which is scheduled for Jan. 10, 2009 at home against Coastal Carolina.

**VMI JOINS ELITE LIST IN NCAA HISTORY**

**VMI** led the nation in scoring offense for the second-straight year in 2007-08 with a 91.3 points per game average, becoming just the 11th team on record in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring in back-to-back years. If the Keydets manage to be the nation's top scoring team in 2008-09, they would be just the third program to lead in three consecutive seasons and first since Loyola Marymount from 1988-90. **BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FOURTH APPEARANCE IN ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South will again participate in the ESPNU BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 20-21. Winthrop (home), Gardner-Webb (road) and Liberty (road) will be the League's participants. The League has received two nationally-televvised broadcasts the past two seasons. Winthrop is 2-1 all-time in the event, while Liberty is 0-1. Gardner-Webb will make its first-ever appearance in the BracketBusters.

**2007-08 BIG SOUTH MEN'S BASKETBALL MAKES POSTSEASON HISTORY**

For the first time in League history, the Big South Conference had two men's basketball teams playing in the postseason in the same year in 2007-08. Winthrop received the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while UNC Asheville was the Conference's first-ever participant in the NIT.

**PEELING AWAY THE LAYERS**

Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** became the first head coach in League history to lead two Big South members to the NCAA Tournament in 2007-08 when Winthrop advanced to the "Big Dance" in his first year leading the Eagles. In 1996, Peele led former member UNC Greensboro to the NAAs in his first year as a head coach. In addition, he guided both programs to 20 wins in his first season at the helm (22 - Winthrop, 20 - UNC Greensboro).

**NAMES RING A BELL**

The Big South has two new players this season with distinctive basketball histories. Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** is the son of former NBA player **DELL CURRY** and the younger brother of Davidson's **STEPHEN CURRY**. Gardner-Webb welcomes junior transfer **ROY HINSON III** to the squad this year. Hinson is the son of former NBA veteran **ROY HINSON**.

**DID YOU KNOW...**

...that former Winthrop Eagle **MICHAEL JENKINS** was the No. 1 overall pick in the 2008 CBA Draft? Jenkins was selected by the Albany Patroons. Big South all-time leading scorer **REGGIE WILLIAMS** was selected in the fifth round (23rd pick overall) by the Pittsburgh Xplosion.
