Kenon put together back-to-back career high games last week in VMI's two wins. He helped the Keydets overcome the absence of leading scorers Chavis and Travis Holmes by pouring in a then career-high 26 points, including 6-of-9 three-pointers, in VMI's three-point win at Charleston Southern. Against Coastal Carolina and with Travis Holmes still out, Kenon surpassed his career-best with 29 points and canned 7-of-12 from long range. For the week, Kenon averaged 27.5 points, .619 percent from beyond the three-point arc (13-of-21), .545 percent overall from the field, and added 3.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.

CHRIS STEPHENSON



Stephenson enjoyed a breakout week for the Bulldogs, as he helped lead Asheville to a road win at Gardner-Webb with a then career-high 10 points, career-best six rebounds and career-best seven assists. He led a Bulldog comeback at Radford with a career-high 14 points, plus six rebounds, two assists and two steals in an overtime loss to the Highlanders. For the week, Stephenson averaged 12.0 points, was 11-of-13 from the free throw line (=.733) and averaged 6.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.0 steals.

VMI EXTENDS CONFERENCE START TO 5-0

The VMI Keydets are 5-0 in Big South play for the first time since joining the League in 2003-04. It is the first time the Keydets have started 5-0 in league play since 1976-77 when they were members of the Southern Conference. VMI's 5-0 start marks the fifth consecutive season that a Big South team has won its first five Conference games of the campaign. The last Big South team to open 6-0 was UNC Asheville last season, as the Bulldogs went 7-0 to begin the League slate.

VMI'S WIN STREAK REACHES NINE

The Keydets defeated Coastal Carolina this past Saturday for their ninth-straight win, the program's first nine-game winning streak since the 1977-78 season when VMI won 10 consecutive games. The victory also gives the Keydets 12 wins in their last 13 games. That is VMI's best winning streak since winning 13-of-14 during the 1977-78 season, and the fourth-longest winning streak in Keydet history. The victory continues the squad's best start since 1976-77, and its best opening stretch at home (7-0) since 1995-96, as the team remains undefeated at Cameron Hall.

TWIN PEAKS

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** are the fourth set of twins in NCAA Division I history to score a combined 3,000 points. The duo reached the milestone Saturday, Dec. 13 vs. Southern Wesleyan, and have now scored 3,132 points -- Chavis with 1,689 points and Travis with 1,443. They trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place. Below are the highest scoring twin brother combinations in NCAA Division I history. BOARD MEETING

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 28th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Jan. 3 against High Point. He now ranks 27th all-time with 624 and enters the week needing four rebounds to pass **KEENAN MANN** (Augusta) for 26th place. Harris is averaging a career-best 10.0 rebounds, and is on pace to end the regular-season with 764 career rebounds, which would put him in ninth-place on the Big South's career chart. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is nine rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (460) is on pace to surpass 500 career rebounds this season as well.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** recorded his 200th career coaching win when the Bulldogs defeated Western Carolina, 81-78 on New Year's Eve. He is 173-195 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor, in addition to winning 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81. Biedenbach is one Big South win shy of becoming the third coach in League history with 100 wins in regular-season Big South games.

BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL SET TO JOIN ELITE CLUB

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES**, who has missed the past three games due to injury, is approaching an elite club in League annals. The Big South's all-time steals leader with 268, Holmes is nine rebounds away from 500 in his career, and once he reaches the milestone, he would become just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career steals. Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** is currently the lone member of the club, as he posted 1,711 points, 954 rebounds and 220 steals in his career from 1990-94. Holmes is averaging 3.83 steals per game this season, which leads the nation and is challenging the Big South single-season record of 4.07 per game, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87.

CRUZZIN

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 179 career blocked shots. He needs four blocks to tie **ERIC CUTHRELL** of former member UNC Greensboro for fifth-place at 183, and 21 rejections to become the fourth player in League history with 200 in a career. Daniels blocked a career-high eight shots against Youngstown State on Friday, Dec. 19, to jump from 10th place in Big South history to sixth.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

Nine of the 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game this season by five points-or-less, with a total of 25 losses being decided by that margin -- including 16 non-Conference contests. Liberty has posted losses of that margin a League-high five times this season, as their last five losses have been by a combined 12 points. Gardner-Webb is next with four, followed by Radford, Coastal Carolina and Winthrop with three each. Charleston Southern, High Point and Presbyterian each have two losses by five points-or-less.

TEN MEN

The Big South has two players averaging 10.0 rebounds this season, which would mark just the second time in League history that two players averaged that many rebounds in one year. Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (10.2) and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (10.0) are averaging double figures. In 2000-01, Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** (10.1) and Radford's **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** (10.0) were the first (and last) Big South duo to average 10.0 rebounds a game in the same season.

HOLMES FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Big South all-time steals leader **TRAVIS HOLMES** has recorded a steal in his last 23 games, a career-best streak that dates back to last season. He has 71 thefts in that span for a 3.09 per game average. Meanwhile, twin brother **CHAVIS HOLMES** has moved into third in Big South history with 248 career steals. He has a steal in his last 28 games - a career-best, and has totaled 88 steals during his streak for an average of 3.14. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 90 of his 102 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 87 of his 101 career games.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is four blocked shots away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Once he reaches the milestone, he will become just the seventh player in Big South history with 600 rebounds, 100 steals and 100 blocks. Here is a look at the individuals on the list:

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** became the 17th player in Big South history with 1,600 career points and is the League's active leading scorer with 1,689 career points -- good for 11th place in Big South history. He is 11 points from becoming the 11th player with 1,700 points and 22 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,457) and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,443). Radford's **KENNY THOMAS** is 32 points away from becoming the 90th player in League history with 1,000 career points. FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

Several Big South freshmen men's basketball players are already making an impact in the Conference this season. Liberty's **SETH CURRY** is third in the Big South in scoring at 20.4 points and leads all freshman in the nation in scoring. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is third in the Big South in rebounding at 8.9 per game -- tied for the national freshman lead as well, while Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is fourth at 8.1. UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is second in the Big South in assists with 4.88. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** leads in assist-turnover ratio (2.26), and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is third in three-pointers per game (3.47) and in three-point percentage (.416), and fourth in three-pointers made (52).

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams have won 14 of the first 24 Big South games played - a .583 winning percentage. Last season, 19 Conference games were won by the road team.

TWO ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Through 24 Big South Conference games, 13 have been decided by at least 10 points, while nine have been decided by four points-or-less. The average margin of victory for the League season after 24 games is 10.04 points.

WARREN'S THREE-POINT BUFFET

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** is second in the League with 60 three-point field goals, and is challenging the Big South single-season record for three-pointers per game. His current 4.29 treys per game average is just behind the record of 4.42, set by Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** in 1993-94. Warren has made at least five three-pointers in a game five times this season (11 times in his career), and has drained a trey in a career-best 16-straight games. Warren is currently shooting .462 percent from three-point range (60-of-130) thus far.

HOME COOKIN'

Liberty has won its last 10 home games at the Vines Center, the longest active home winning streak in the Big South, and the Flames' longest home winning streak since an 11-game streak last season. Liberty head coach **RITCHIE MCKAY** has a career 21-2 mark inside the Vines Center (=.913), including 8-0 this season. VMI has won all seven of its home games thus far this season, and Winthrop is 65-8 (=.890) at home in regular-season Big South games since 1998-99.

HITTING THE HIGH NOTES

Radford has won four consecutive Big South games for the first time since winning four straight during the 2005-06 season. The last time the Highlanders strung together five consecutive League triumphs was in February of 2002. To go along with their current streaks, the Highlanders are off to their best start in League play since beginning the 1999-00 Big South slate 6-0.

EXTREME MAKEOVER, HOME EDITION

Radford's home game Monday night, Jan. 12 against Charleston Southern will conclude the Highlanders temporary stay in Peters Hall, as RU is slated to return to the renovated Dedmon Center on Wednesday, Jan. 21 against VMI.

MY HARRIS TEETER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** scored 30 points and grabbed 16 rebounds this past Saturday at VMI, becoming the first Big South player to surpass those totals in a game since High Point's **ARIZONA REID** had 32 points and 25 rebounds against the Keydets on Feb. 24, 2007.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** is tied with Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** for eighth in Big South history with 254 career three-pointers. Holmes needs 21 treys to catch **KEKE HICKS** (Coastal Carolina) for seventh-place at 275. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 26th in Conference annals with 184, and needs 16 triples to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (171) and VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** (159) are also approaching the 200 career three-point field goal milestone.

SPEAKING OF THREE-POINTERS...

A record four Big South players are on pace to make more than 100 three-point field goals this season. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is on pace for 124 -- which would fall one shy of the Big South single-season record of 125, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2005-06. Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** is tracking at 100 treys for the year, as is VMI frosh **KEITH GABRIEL**. Keydet sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** is on target for 118 three-pointers. The Big South record for most players with 100 three-point field goals in the same season is two -- VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** in 2006-07.

AMIR AMIR, ON THE WALL

Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON**, who became the 40th player in Big South history with 300 career assists when he surpassed the milestone on Dec. 10 vs. Duquesne, now owns 350 career helpers entering this week, good for a tie for 26th in League history. Johnson needs 50 assists to become the 17th Big South player with 400 career assists.

FIRST MATE

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** is vying for the Big South scoring title, as he is currently second at 21.6 -- just 0.2 behind VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES**. Warren is looking to become the first CSU player to average 20.0 points per game in a season since **BRETT LARRICK** averaged 20.0 points in 1996-97, which was also the last time a Buccaneer player led the Big South in scoring average.

AUSTIN POWERS

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in every game of his career -- a span of 31 games. He made 57 in 16 appearances in 2007-08, and has 61 treys through 15 games this season. Kenon has 118 three-pointers in his 31 games, a 3.81 per game average.

BIG SOUTH CONTINUES DOUBLE TEAM IN MID-MAJOR POLL

For the sixth consecutive week, the Big South has two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll. VMI is ranked No. 11 this week -- its highest-ever ranking and the highest this season for a Big South member. Liberty sits in the No. 21 position, its first week out of the top 20 since appearing in the rankings on Dec. 8. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons, while this is the first time in League history that two teams have appeared in the weekly rankings. CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU dropped two games last week to move into a six-game slide, including three in Conference play. The other three came against Cincinnati, Florida State and Virginia Tech ... **JAMARCO WARREN** averaged 23.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists last week ... **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** has come on strong in the place of the injured **BILLY BLACKMON**, as he averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 boards while shooting better than 72 percent from the floor ... Freshman **JOEL LAMB** made his first career start vs. Liberty and went on to average 6.5 points and 7.5 rebounds for the week.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers lost a heartbreaking 103-102 contest at VMI, as **STEVEN SEXTON**'s last second jumper was ruled a two-pointer ... Coastal Carolina set or tied 14 career highs in the VMI game, including **MARIO SISINNI**'s 20 points and **JOSEPH HARRIS**' 16 rebounds ... The 29 assists by the Chants against the Keydets were just three off a school record, set Dec. 28, 2005 against Ohio Valley ... Harris is 18th in the nation in rebounds (10.0 per game), and is the shortest player in the top-20 at 6-5. He is two-tenths of a rebound behind 7-3 **HASHEEM THABEET** of UConn.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb remains winless in League play at home, but is 2-1 on the road in its first Big South Conference season ... GWU won for the first time all season when scoring less than 70 points with its 60-57 win at High Point ... **AURYN MacMILLAN** averaged 12.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 1.0 blocks in two games last week ... **GRAYSON FLITTNER** (20), **AARON LINN** (20) and **NATE BLANK** (10) combined to score 83 percent of GWU's offense at High Point. A season-low five players scored in the HPU win, as MacMillan (seven) and **JON MOORE** (three) rounded out the production ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have four players averaging 10.0 points in Big South action.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers grinded out a 42-40 road victory at Winthrop last week, which marked the program's first-ever win at the Winthrop Coliseum. **CRUZ DANIELS** scored a putback with just two seconds left to secure the historic win. The 40 points scored by Winthrop were the fewest points scored by a Division I opponent against the Panthers ... High Point recorded 10 blocked shots vs. Gardner-Webb, marking the squad's second double-digit performance of the season ... The Panthers have used nine starting lineups in 15 games this year, with 10 players starting at least one contest.

LIBERTY

Liberty is the fourth-youngest team in the nation at 19.31 years per player average. Freshman have played 61 percent of the minutes, tops in the country ... **ANTHONY SMITH** is on pace to become the ninth player in school history with 1,000 points and 500 career rebounds, and the fourth in the program's Division I era ... All of Liberty's five starters have a positive assist-to-turnover ratio: **JESSE SANDERS** (61-to-27), **KYLE OHMAN** (43-to-31), Smith (37-to-35), **SETH CURRY** (32-to-29) and **BROLIN FLOYD** (26-to-21) ... Curry went coast-to-coast with :04 seconds left and sank a three-pointer to force a second overtime at Presbyterian last week.

The Blue Hose knocked off Liberty 67-66 in double overtime before dropping an overtime affair to Winthrop.
