CHAVIS HOLMES

Holmes averaged 24.5 points, 3.5 assists, 3.5 steals and 3.0 rebounds in leading VMI to two wins last week. He scored 23 points on 7-of-13 shooting in the Keydets' win over Campbell, in addition to four rebounds, four steals and two assists. Against Southern Wesleyan, Holmes scored a team-high 26 points on 9-of-13 from the field (=.692) and was a perfect 7-of-7 from the free throw line. He also had five assists, two blocked shots and three assists in the victory. For the week, Holmes was 16-of-26 from the field (=.615) and 13-of-15 from the line (=.867).

HOLMES BREAKS STEALS RECORD

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the Big South's all-time steals leader last week after collecting 14 in two games. He entered the week needing 10 steals to break **CHRIS GAYNOR**'s League career record of 259. Holmes broke the record with his third steal against Southern Wesleyan this past Saturday. His record career total now stands at 264. Holmes is averaging 4.20 steals per game this season, which leads the nation and is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 4.07.

BIG SOUTH MAKES ITS OWN MID-MAJOR HISTORY

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, with Liberty and VMI holding the distinction. Liberty is ranked No. 12 this week after making its first-ever appearance in the poll last week at No. 13. VMI sits in the No. 21 position this week after holding the No. 21 spot last week. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons. TWIN PEAKS

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** are the fourth set of twins in NCAA Division I history to score a combined 3,000 points. The duo reached the milestone this past Saturday vs. Southern Wesleyan. Chavis has 1,594 points, while Travis has 1,417. They trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place.

BOARD REPORT

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 49th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Western Illinois on Nov. 28, ranks 41st in League history with 546 career boards. He is 54 rebounds shy of becoming the 28th player in Conference annals with 600. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is 20 rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (407) could also surpass 500 career rebounds in 2008-09.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,594 career points, good for 17th place in Big South history. He is 117 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,417) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,291). HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 10 blocked shots away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Once he reaches the block milestone, he will become the 11th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots and 500 career rebounds. Harris also has 107 steals to his credit as well.

CRUZZIN

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** ranks 10th all-time in Big South history with 161 career blocked shots. He moved into the top 10 with four swats against Limestone last Wednesday. Daniels needs five blocked shots to jump into fifth-place, and is 39 blocks away from becoming the fourth player with 200 in a career.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is one win away from 200 career coaching victories as a college head coach. He is 170-191 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor, and won 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81. Biedenbach is three Big South wins shy of becoming the third coach in League history with 100 wins in Big South games.

WARREN'S THREE-POINT BUFFET

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** is tied for the League lead with 35 three-point field goals, and is challenging the Big South single-season record for three-pointers per game. His 4.38 treys per game average is just below the record of 4.42, set by Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** in 1993-94. He has made at least five three-pointers in a game three times this season (nine in his career), and has drained a trey in 10-straight games. Warren is currently shooting a blistering .493 percent from three-point range (35-of-71) thus far.

ARTISTIC IMPRESSION

Radford junior center **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** hauled in a season-high 20 rebounds last week vs. Duquesne. He is the first Big South player with a 20-rebound game since High Point's **ARIZONA REID** had a League-record 25 against VMI on Feb. 24, 2007. Parakhouski is the first Highlander with 20 rebounds in a game since **AARON GILL** had 21 against Winthrop on Jan. 2, 2003.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** ranks ninth in Big South history with 243 career three-pointers, and needs 11 treys to move into a tie with Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** for eighth (254). High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 27th in Conference annals with 172, and needs 28 triples to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers.

HOME COOKIN'

New Big South member Presbyterian has won 13-straight home games at Templeton Center, and looks to extend that streak this week vs. UC Davis on Wednesday, Dec. 17. Liberty has won its last seven games at the Vines Center, and Flames' head coach **RITCHIE MCKAY** has a career 18-2 mark inside the Vines Center (=,900), including 5-0 this season. Meanwhile, High Point saw its 22-game non-Conference win streak come to end this past Saturday against Towson.

LIBERTY BURNS THROUGH IN-STATE RIVALS

For the first time since the 1999-00 season, Liberty has defeated three non-Conference intra-state Division I programs. The Flames have knocked off Virginia, William & Mary and George Mason this season, their first Virginia trifecta since defeating James Madison, Richmond and Virginia Tech in 1999-00. The victories over UVA, W&M and GMU were part of a five-game win streak, which was Liberty's longest since winning six consecutive games in the early part of the 2006-07 campaign.

30 ROCK

Presbyterian snapped its 30-game road losing streak with its 59-43 victory at Army on Dec. 1. It was the Blue Hose's first road victory at the Division I level, and first road win since the 2006-07 campaign. Presbyterian continued its road winning ways with Big South wins at Coastal Carolina and High Point to conclude the week. The three-game road win streak was PC's longest since winning four-straight away from home in '06-07.

AMIR AMIR, ON THE WALL

Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** became the 40th player in Big South history with 300 career assists when he surpassed the milestone last week vs. Duquesne. He then handed out 10 helpers against James Madison to push his career total to 317 entering this week, good for 31st in League history. Johnson needs 83 assists to become the 17th Big South player with 400 career assists.

LOOK WHO IS 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding Dec. 6, VMI and Big South newcomer Presbyterian emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Keydets have opened Conference action 2-0 for the second-straight year. PC is the fourth new member in League history to open 2-0 in Big South play.

FIRST-TIMERS

Big South newcomers Presbyterian and Gardner-Webb each won their Conference debut game earlier this month, becoming the eighth and ninth new member in Big South history, respectively, to win its first official Conference game. In fact, new members are now 9-2 all-time in their Big South debut games. Presbyterian is the first newcomer to start 2-0 since Birmingham-Southern started 2-0 in 2003-04. Elon opened 3-0 in its first official season of 1999-00, while Towson State holds the Big South record for best Conference start by a new member at 6-0 in 1992-93. Unlike Birmingham-Southern (2001-02), High Point (1998-99), Elon (1998-99) and UNC Greensboro (1992-93), Presbyterian is included in the Big South standings in its first year of membership.

NOT SO MARGINAL

Of the first nine Big South Conference games, five games were decided by at least 17 points, while just one was decided by three points. The average margin of victory for the nine games was 15.0 points. Three teams own an average scoring margin of at least 10.0 points in League games -- VMI (+13.5), Presbyterian (+10.0) and Charleston Southern (+10.0). League play resumes on Saturday, January 3.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams won five of the first nine Big South games played. The total is already 26.3 percent of last year's 19 road Conference wins. VMI and Presbyterian each won their first two League games away from home.

FRESHMEN SENSATIONS

Several Big South freshmen men's basketball players are making an immediate impact on the Conference after a month into the season. Liberty's **SETH CURRY** is second in the Big South in scoring at 21.4 points and leads all freshman in the nation in scoring. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is challenging for the League-lead in rebounds, and is currently third with 8.9 per game. UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is tops in the Big South in assists with 6.11. Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is third in the Conference with 3.63 offensive rebounds per game.
