**GRAYSON FLITNER**  
Jr. • Guard • Gardner-Webb

Flittner averaged 22.5 points and 5.0 assists in leading the Bulldogs to two wins last week. He scored a season-high 31 points in Gardner-Webb's 96-90 road win at Western Carolina, knocking down 8-of-14 from the floor, 5-of-10 from three-point range and a career-best 10-of-10 free throws. He also recorded five assists and five rebounds in the victory. Flittner then added 14 points in just 22 minutes of action against Ferrum as he made 3-of-4 treys and 3-of-3 free throws. He also handed out five assists. For the week, he was 12-of-22 from the floor (=.545), 8-of-14 from long range (=.571) and 13-of-13 from the charity stripe, extending his consecutive free throw streak to 20.

### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

**JOSHUA HENLEY**  
Forward • Gardner-Webb  
Madison, Tenn.

Henley came off the bench in Gardner-Webb's two victories last week. He had eight points on 4-of-4 shooting plus four rebounds in 23 minutes at Western Carolina. In his next outing against Ferrum, the 6-foot-4 Henley pulled down a career-high 21 rebounds in just 23 minutes of action - including 16 on the defensive end to limit any second chance opportunities. Henley also had two assists and one blocked shot in the win. Henley's 21 rebounds were the most by a GWU player since Thomas Sanders had 23 last season vs. USC Upstate.

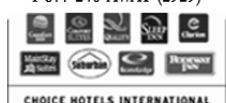

**CLOSE ENCOUNTERS**

Nine of the 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game this season by five points-or-less, with a total of 16 games being decided by that margin -- including 15 non-Conference contests. Gardner-Webb, Liberty and Radford have posted losses of that margin a League-high three times this season. The Bulldogs lost their first three games of the season by a combined eight points, while the Flames' last three losses have been by a combined nine points. Two of the Highlanders' three losses by five points-or-less were by just two points. Coastal Carolina has two losses under the five-point threshold, with Charleston Southern, High Point, Presbyterian, UNC Asheville and Winthrop with one each.

**TWIN PEAKS**

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** are the fourth set of twins in NCAA Division I history to score a combined 3,000 points. The duo reached the milestone Saturday, Dec. 13 vs. Southern Wesleyan, and have now scored 3,028 points -- Chavis with 1,604 points and Travis with 1,424. They trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place.

**BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL**

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** became the Big South's all-time steals leader on Saturday, Dec. 13 against Southern Wesleyan, breaking the old record of 259 held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR**. Holmes' record career total now stands at 266. He is averaging 4.00 steals per game this season, which leads the nation and is challenging the Big South single-season record of 4.07. Holmes is on pace for 116 steals this season, which would break the Conference's season record of 114, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87.

**HOLMES FOR THE HOLIDAYS**

Big South all-time steals leader **TRAVIS HOLMES** has recorded a steal in his last 22 games, a career-best streak that dates back to last season. He has 69 thefts in that span for a 3.14 per game average. Meanwhile, twin brother **CHAVIS HOLMES** has moved into fifth in Big South history with 240 career steals. He has a steal in his last 25 games, totalling 80 during his streak for an average of 3.20. Chavis' longest steals streak is 27 games from Feb. 23, 2006 to Feb. 10, 2007. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 87 of his 99 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 86 of his 100 career games.

**BOARD REPORT**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 49th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds Nov. 28 against Western Illinois, is tied for 36th in League history with 567 career boards. He is 33 rebounds shy of becoming the 28th player in Conference annals with 600. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is 14 rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (421) could also surpass 500 career rebounds in 2008-09.

**POINT OF ORDER**

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** became the 17th player in Big South history with 1,600 career points this past weekend at Army, and is the League's active leading scorer with 1,604 career points -- good for a tie for 15th place in Big South history. He is 107 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,424) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,339). **CRUZZIN**

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** blocked a career-high eight shots against Youngstown State on Friday, Dec. 19, to increase his career total to 169. He jumped from 10th place in Big South history to sixth place. Daniels needs 14 blocked shots to tie **ERIC CUTHRELL** of former member UNC Greensboro for fifth-place at 183, and 31 rejections to become the fourth player in League history with 200 in a career.

**BIG SOUTH MAKES ITS OWN MID-MAJOR HISTORY**

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, with Liberty and VMI holding the distinction. Liberty is ranked No. 15 in this week's poll after peaking at No. 12 last week. VMI sits in the No. 19 position this week, it's highest ranking in the poll. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons. **HARRIS POLL**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is nine blocked shots away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Once he reaches the block milestone, he will become the 11th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots and 500 career rebounds. Harris also has 112 steals to his credit as well, and would become just the seventh player in League history with 500 rebounds, 100 blocks and 100 steals.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is one win away from 200 career coaching victories as a college head coach. He is 170-193 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor, and won 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81. Biedenbach is three Big South wins shy of becoming the third coach in League history with 100 wins in Big South games.

**WARREN'S THREE-POINT BUFFET**

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** leads the League with 43 three-point field goals, and is challenging the Big South single-season record for three-pointers per game. His 4.30 treys per game average is just below the record of 4.42, set by Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** in 1993-94. Warren has made at least five three-pointers in a game four times this season (10 times in his career), and has drained a trey in 12-straight games. Warren is currently shooting .478 percent from three-point range (43-of-90) thus far.

**TONIGHT ON 20/20**

Less than a week after Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** became the first Big South player with a 20-rebound game in 22 months, Gardner-Webb freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** grabbed 21 rebounds against Ferrum on Saturday, Dec. 20. Parakhouski's effort was the most in the Conference since High Point's **ARIZONA REID** had a League-record 25 against VMI on Feb. 24, 2007, and was the first Highlander with 20 rebounds in a game since **AARON GILL** had 21 against Winthrop on Jan. 2, 2003.

**THREE'S COMPANY**

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** ranks ninth in Big South history with 243 career three-pointers, and needs 11 treys to move into a tie with Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** for eighth (254). High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 26th in Conference annals with 174, and needs 26 triples to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (160) and VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** (157) are also approaching the 200 career three-point field goal milestone.

**HOME COOKIN'**

New Big South member Presbyterian has won 14-straight home games at Templeton Center following its 82-69 win over UC Davis on Wednesday, Dec. 17. PC's next home game is Jan. 3, 2009 vs. Radford. Liberty has won its last eight games at the Vines Center, and Flames' head coach **RITCHIE McKAY** has a career 19-2 mark inside the Vines Center ( = .905), including 6-0 this season.

**AMIR AMIR, ON THE WALL**

Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** became the 40th player in Big South history with 300 career assists when he surpassed the milestone on Dec. 10 vs. Duquesne. His career total stands at 320 entering this week, good for 31st in League history. Johnson needs 80 assists to become the 17th Big South player with 400 career assists.

**FRESHMEN SENSATIONS**

Several Big South freshmen men's basketball players are already making an impact in the Conference this season. Liberty's **SETH CURRY** is third in the Big South in scoring at 19.7 points and leads all freshman in the nation in scoring. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is the Big South's leading rebounder at 9.5 per game. UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is tops in the Big South in assists with 5.45. Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is third in the Conference with 3.50 offensive rebounds per game. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** leads in assist-turnover ratio, and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is second in three-pointers made (40), threes per game (3.64), and three-point percentage (.435).

**THE FURY OVER CURRY CONTINUES**

Liberty's **SETH CURRY** continues to attract national attention, as he has been the subject of several feature pieces and television interviews during the first six weeks of the 2008-09 season. Curry was named **DICK VITALE's** "Diaper Dandy of the Week" on Dec. 1 for his play against Virginia, Coker and William & Mary. His latest recognition comes from *FOXSports.com* national college basketball writer **JEFF GOODMAN**, who placed Curry on his All-Freshman squad based on play after the first third of the season.

**LIBERTY BURNS THROUGH IN-STATE RIVALS**

For the first time since the 1999-00 season, Liberty has defeated three non-Conference intra-state Division I programs. The Flames have knocked off Virginia, William & Mary and George Mason this season, their first Virginia trifecta since defeating James Madison, Richmond and Virginia Tech in 1999-00. The victories over UVA, W&M and GMU were part of a five-game win streak, which was Liberty's longest since winning six consecutive games in the early part of the 2006-07 campaign.

**30 ROCK**

Presbyterian snapped its 30-game road losing streak with its 59-43 victory at Army on Dec. 1. It was the Blue Hose's first road victory at the Division I level, and first road win since the 2006-07 campaign. Presbyterian continued its road winning ways with Big South wins at Coastal Carolina and High Point to conclude the week. The three-game road win streak was PC's longest since winning four-straight away from home in '06-07.

**LOOK WHO IS 2-0**

With the first set of Big South games concluding Dec. 6, VMI and Big South newcomer Presbyterian emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Keydets have opened Conference action 2-0 for the second-straight year. PC is the fourth new member in League history to open 2-0 in Big South play.

**FIRST-TIMERS**

Big South newcomers Presbyterian and Gardner-Webb each won their Conference debut game earlier this month, becoming the eighth and ninth new member in Big South history, respectively, to win its first official Conference game. In fact, new members are now 9-2 all-time in their Big South debut games. Presbyterian is the first newcomer to start 2-0 since Birmingham-Southern started 2-0 in 2003-04. Elon opened 3-0 in its first official season of 1999-00, while Towson State holds the Big South record for best Conference start by a new member at 6-0 in 1992-93. Unlike Birmingham-Southern (2001-02), High Point (1998-99), Elon (1998-99) and UNC Greensboro (1992-93), Presbyterian is included in the Big South standings in its first year of membership.

**NOT SO MARGINAL**

Of the first nine Big South Conference games, five games were decided by at least 17 points, while just one was decided by three points. The average margin of victory for the nine games was 15.0 points. Three teams own an average scoring margin of at least 10.0 points in League games -- VMI (+13.5), Presbyterian (+10.0) and Charleston Southern (+10.0). League play resumes on Saturday, January 3.

CSU is idle until Dec. 29, when the Buccaneers host Florida State at the North Charleston Coliseum. The game will be televised by FSN South.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina ended a 32-game non-Conference road losing streak with its 69-52 win at Georgia State on Dec. 20. The streak dated back to Nov. 22, 2003. The game also was the 1,000th career game in the coaching career of **CLIFF ELLIS** ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** had 10 of his 14 rebounds against Georgia State in the first half.
