### CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### SETH CURRY

Fr. • Guard • Liberty  
Charlotte, N.C.

Curry averaged 23.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and .519 percent from the floor in leading the Flames to a 3-0 record last week, including Liberty's first win over an ACC school since 1998 and a CAA program since 2002. He scored a game-high 26 points in LU's 86-82 win at Virginia, dropped in 24 points and grabbed eight rebounds vs. Coker, and scored 21 points in Liberty's double overtime win over William & Mary. Curry, who was named MVP of the Liberty Thanksgiving Classic, scored 13 of his 21 points after regulation on 7-of-8 shooting in the win over the Tribe. His trey with 18.1 seconds left in the first overtime forced a second extra session.

### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

#### JESSE SANDERS

Guard • Liberty  
Sugar Land, Texas

Sanders ran the point in the Flames' three wins last week. At Virginia, he handed out eight assists, grabbed four rebounds and did not commit a turnover in Liberty's victory over the Cavaliers. He scored 15 points on 7-of-8 shooting vs. Coker, then tallied 11 points, eight rebounds and four steals in Liberty's double overtime win over William & Mary. Sanders pulled down five offensive rebounds against the Tribe to help the Flames to 23 second chance points, and his two rebounds and a steal in the second overtime helped Liberty to a 9-0 run to close out the game. For the week, Sanders went 11-of-15 from the field (.733) and averaged 9.3 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.7 assists.

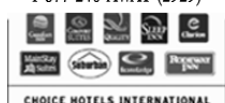

### CONFERENCE SEASON UPON US

For the first time in Big South men's basketball history, every Conference team will play a League game before January, as this week's action features eight Big South games on the slate. The last time the Big South had Conference games in the month of December was in 2000-01, when Radford-High Point (Dec. 4) and Coastal Carolina-Winthrop (Dec. 9) opened League play in the traditional final month of the year. The 1990-91 season also had Big South games in December. That year, former member Davidson hosted its new League foes UNC Asheville and Radford in the 12th month.

### UNC ASHEVILLE DEFEATS LIBERTY IN EARLIEST LEAGUE OPENER IN HISTORY

UNC Asheville defeated Liberty 84-56 on Tuesday, Nov. 18, in the earliest Big South opener in League history. Freshman **J.P. PRIMM** scored a game-high 21 points for the Bulldogs, and nearly collected a triple-double, as he finished with seven rebounds and seven assists. The game was played at 2:00pm and was broadcast nationally on ESPN as part of the network's 24 Hour College Basketball Marathon.

### BIG SOUTH TELEVISION PACKAGE TIPS OFF THIS WEEK

The Big South television package officially tips off this week with two broadcasts on the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN). The network will televise Wednesday's Winthrop at VMI contest live at 9:00pm, as well as Saturday's Gardner-Webb at Liberty game live at 3:00pm. **JASON KNAPP** (play-by-play) and former Georgetown head coach **CRAIG ESHERICK** (analyst) will call the Eagles-Keydets match-up, while Esherick and **JIM HUNTER** will handle the call for the Bulldogs-Flames affair on Saturday.

### BIG SOUTH PICKS UP BIG WINS

For the second consecutive season, the Big South Conference has posted wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) and Southeastern Conference (SEC). VMI knocked off Kentucky in the season opener on Nov. 14, while Liberty won at Virginia last week. In 2007-08, the Big South had two wins against the ACC and one victory against an SEC member. The Conference has now posted a win over an SEC school three consecutive years.

### HOME COURT STREAKS

New Big South member Presbyterian has won 13-straight home games at Templeton Center, while High Point has won its last nine home games at the Millis Center. In fact, the Panthers are 30-2 at home since the start of the 2006-07 season, including a 21-game win streak in non-Conference games. Liberty and Gardner-Webb each have won its last five home games as well.

### TWIN PEAKS

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** have combined to score 2,839 career points, the fourth-most by a twin brother combination in NCAA history. Chavis has 1,503 points, while Travis has 1,336. The duo needs 161 points to become the fourth set of twins with 3,000 combined points, and trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place.

### BOARD REPORT

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 49th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Western Illinois on Nov. 28. He is now 47th in history with 523 career boards. Harris would have reached the milestone last season, but suffered a season-ending injury in the eighth game of the year. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is 46 rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (383) and VMI's **WILLIE BELL** (342) could also surpass 500 career rebounds in 2008-09.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is two wins away from 200 career coaching victories as a college head coach. He is 169-189 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor, and won 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81. Biedenbach is three Big South wins shy of becoming the third coach in League history with 100 wins in Big South games.

**GAYNOR'S STEALS RECORD MAY BE SHORT-LIVED**

Former Winthrop point guard **CHRIS GAYNOR**'s Big South career record of 259 steals -- established just last season, is likely to be the first all-time record to fall in 2008-09, as VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES**' 240 career steals are just 19 away from Gaynor's mark. Holmes is currently fourth in Big South history, and needs three more to move into second place. He is averaging 3.00 steals per game this season, and is on target to break Gaynor's steals records on Jan. 3 at Gardner-Webb.

**POINT OF ORDER**

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,503 career points, the 21st player in Big South history with 1,500 career points. He holds the 21st position and is 208 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,336) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,236). **HARRIS POLL**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 16 blocked shots away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. In addition, Harris will likely become the 11th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots and 500 career rebounds.

**CRUZZIN**

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** ranks 12th all-time in Big South history with 150 career blocked shots. Daniels needs five swats to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10 and 50 blocks to become the fourth player with 200 in a career.

**BIG SOUTH ENJOYING MID-MAJOR MANIA**

VMI is ranked No. 25 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, the third consecutive week the Keydets have been ranked. VMI, which is appearing in the poll for the first time, was No. 22 last week. It is the fifth consecutive season the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25. Liberty, coming off its 3-0 week that featured a win at Virginia, received votes in the poll for the first time this season and found itself in the 28th position. Meanwhile, VMI garnered a Top 25 vote in the *Associated Press* national ranking for two consecutive weeks following its victory at Kentucky. Below is a week-by-week look at the Mid-Major poll:

**EXTREME MAKEOVER**

Radford is playing its home men's basketball games temporarily in Peters Hall on campus while renovations continue at the Dedmon Center. The Highlanders opened the season with a 74-55 victory over Brevard and is now 71-18 (= .798) all-time in games played at Peters Hall, including 2-0 this season.

**HITTING THE HIGH NOTES**

Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** moved into a tie for eighth place on Radford's all-time assist chart with six helpers at Navy on Nov. 28. With 286 career assists, he is 14 away from becoming the 40th player in Big South history with 300 career assists. Meanwhile, **ERIC HALL** is 10th in school history with 64 career blocked shots following his two deflections at Navy.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

In the Buccaneers' overtime win over North Florida, CSU trailed for much of the game, including a six-point deficit with two minutes remaining. **JAMARCO WARREN** and **OMAR CARTER** hit back-to-back threes to send the game into overtime, and Charleston Southern outscored the Ospreys, 12-4 in the extra session, led by **TOVI BAILEY's** six points ... The Buccaneers open Big South play Monday night at High Point, then take a 12-day break for final exams.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Sophomore **ANTHONY BREEZE** was named to the 10-player Global Sports Classic All-Tournament Team. He averaged 12.0 points and 7.8 rebounds in the four games of the tournament. Breeze scored nine points in the final 2:14 of regulation and overtime in the Chanticleers' 69-60 win over Western Illinois. His tip-in with two seconds remaining sent the game into overtime ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** had 27 points, 13 rebounds, three steals and two blocked shots against the Leathernecks. He scored 16 points in the first half and helped the Chants to a season-high 55.8 percent from the field in the win.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

GWU continues to battle the injury bug, as five of the team's top eight players have combined to miss 12 games worth of action through the season's first month ... **NATE BLANK** came back from an early season injury to average 14.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists in two games last week, netting 20 points and seven dimes in his first start of the season vs. Virginia-Wise ... **JONATHAN MOORE** made his first two career starts last week, averaging 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds ... Freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** has pulled down at least 10 rebounds in four of the Bulldogs' first five games.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point continued its home dominance with a 100-50 victory over Montreat after dropping a hard-fought loss at South Florida ...
