Harris averaged 13.7 points and 11.7 rebounds in three wins. He posted a double-double and two steals in each game. Harris scored 11 points and added 12 rebounds and four assists in a 63-55 win over East Carolina, then added 13 points and 11 boards in a victory over Emmanuel College. He concluded the week with 17 points and 12 rebounds in a win over High Point. Harris was 17-of-27 from the floor (=.630) and averaged 4.7 offensive rebounds, 2.3 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.3 blocks.

CHAVIS HOLMES

Sr. • Guard • VMI
Charlotte, N.C.

Holmes averaged 25.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals. He scored 23 points and was 6-of-12 from the field in VMI's 73-70 come-from-behind win over Richmond. He scored 20 second-half points, including VMI's final 15 points of the game. He added 27 points in a Big South win at Gardner-Webb, hitting 9-of-16 from the floor. Holmes made 15-of-28 FG (=.536) and 6-of-13 threes.

NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

STEADMAN SHORT

Forward • High Point
Simpsonville, S.C.

Short averaged 15.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in two games, posting back-to-back career-best scoring performances. He reached double figures for the first time in his career with 13 points at No. 23 Minnesota, and also pulled down a team-high seven rebounds against the Gophers. At Coastal Carolina, he tallied his first career double-double with 17 points and 13 rebounds. Short, who entered the week averaging 4.2 points and 4.0 rebounds through nine games, was 8-of-18 from the field (=.444), 14-of-22 from the line (=.636) and recorded 12 of his 20 boards on the offensive glass.

VMI OPENS CONFERENCE SEASON 3-0

The VMI Keydets are 3-0 in Big South play for the first time since joining the League in 2003-04. It is the first time the Keydets have started 3-0 in league play since 1976-77 when they were members of the Southern Conference. VMI's 3-0 start marks the sixth consecutive season that a Big South team has won its first three Conference games of the campaign. The last Big South team to open 4-0 was UNC Asheville last season, as the Bulldogs went 7-0 to begin the League slate.

TWIN PEAKS

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** are the fourth set of twins in NCAA Division I history to score a combined 3,000 points. The duo reached the milestone Saturday, Dec. 13 vs. Southern Wesleyan, and have now scored 3,097 points -- Chavis with 1,654 points and Travis with 1,443. They trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place. Below are the highest scoring twin brother combinations in NCAA Division I history. BOARD MEETING

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 28th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone this past Saturday against High Point. He ranks 28th all-time with 602 and needs 13 rebounds to pass **DON BURGESS** (Radford) for 27th place. Harris is averaging a career-best 9.9 rebounds, and is on pace to end the regular-season with 760 career rebounds, which would put him in ninth-place on the Big South's career chart. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is nine rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (442) is on pace to surpass 500 career rebounds this season as well.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** recorded his 200th career coaching win when the Bulldogs defeated Western Carolina, 81-78 on New Year's Eve. He is now 172-193 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor, in addition to winning 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81. Biedenbach is two Big South wins shy of becoming the third coach in League history with 100 wins in Big South games.

BIG SOUTH'S MAN OF STEAL SET TO JOIN ELITE CLUB

VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES**, the Big South's all-time steals leader with 268, is approaching an elite club in League annals. Once he records his 500th career rebound, he would become just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career steals. Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** is currently the lone member of the club, as he posted 1,711 points, 954 rebounds and 220 steals in his career from 1990-94. Holmes is averaging 3.83 steals per game this season, which leads the nation and is challenging the Big South single-season record of 4.07 per game, which was set by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

Nine of the 10 Big South men's basketball teams have lost a game this season by five points-or-less, with a total of 19 losses being decided by that margin -- including 16 non-Conference contests. Gardner-Webb and Liberty have posted losses of that margin a League-high four times this season. The Bulldogs lost their first three games of the season by a combined eight points, while the Flames' last four losses have been by a combined 11 points. Radford has three losses under the five-point threshold, followed by Coastal Carolina and Winthrop with two each. Charleston Southern, High Point, Presbyterian and UNC Asheville each have one loss by five points-or-less.

CRUZZIN

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 170 career blocked shots. He needs 13 blocks to tie **ERIC CUTHRELL** of former member UNC Greensboro for fifth-place at 183, and 30 rejections to become the fourth player in League history with 200 in a career. Daniels blocked a career-high eight shots against Youngstown State on Friday, Dec. 19, to jump from 10th place in Big South history to sixth.

WAS THAT A NINER I JUST HEARD?

The Big South has three players averaging at least 9.0 rebounds this season, which would mark just the second time in League history that three players averaged 9.0 rebounds in one year. Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (10.2), Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (9.9) and Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** (9.6) are the first trio over 9.5 rebounds. In 2000-01, Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** (10.10), Radford's **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** (9.97) and Radford's **CORREY WATKINS** (9.10) were the first (and last) Big South trio to average 9.0 rebounds a game.

HOLMES FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Big South all-time steals leader **TRAVIS HOLMES** has recorded a steal in his last 23 games, a career-best streak that dates back to last season. He has 71 thefts in that span for a 3.09 per game average. Meanwhile, twin brother **CHAVIS HOLMES** has moved into third in Big South history with 244 career steals. He has a steal in his last 27 games -- matching his career-long, and has totaled 84 steals during his streak for an average of 3.11. In their respective careers, Chavis has recorded a steal in 89 of his 101 career appearances, while Travis has recorded a steal in 87 of his 101 career games.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is four blocked shots away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Once he reaches the milestone, he will become just the seventh player in Big South history with 600 rebounds, 100 steals and 100 blocks. Here is a look at the individuals on the list:

POINT OF ORDER

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** became the 17th player in Big South history with 1,600 career points and is the League's active leading scorer with 1,654 career points -- good for 13th place in Big South history. He is 57 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,443) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,417). WARREN'S THREE-POINT BUFFET

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** leads the League with 53 three-point field goals, and is challenging the Big South single-season record for three-pointers per game. His current 4.42 treys per game average matches the record of 4.42, set by Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** in 1993-94. Warren has made at least five three-pointers in a game five times this season (11 times in his career), and has drained a trey in a career-best 14-straight games. Warren is currently shooting .482 percent from three-point range (53-of-110) thus far.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

Several Big South freshmen men's basketball players are already making an impact in the Conference this season. Liberty's **SETH CURRY** is third in the Big South in scoring at 20.3 points and leads all freshman in the nation in scoring. Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** is third in the Big South in rebounding at 9.6 per game -- leading all freshman nationally as well, while Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is fourth at 7.9. UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is second in the Big South in assists with 5.07. Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** leads in assist-turnover ratio (2.43), and VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is second in three-pointers per game (3.69) and three-point percentage (.432), and third in three-pointers made (48).

HOME COOKIN'

Liberty has won its last nine home games at the Vines Center, the longest active home winning streak in the Big South. Flames' head coach **RITCHIE MCKAY** has a career 20-2 mark inside the Vines Center (=.909), including 7-0 this season. VMI has won all six of its home games thus far this season, and Winthrop is 65-7 (=.903) at home in regular-season Big South games since 1998-99.

THREE'S COMPANY

VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** ranks ninth in Big South history with 249 career three-pointers, and needs five treys to move into a tie with Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** for eighth (254). High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is 26th in Conference annals with 180, and needs 20 triples to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (164) and VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** (159) are also approaching the 200 career three-point field goal milestone.

SPEAKING OF THREE-POINTERS...

A record four Big South players are on pace to make more than 100 three-point field goals this season. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is on pace for 128 -- which would break the Big South single-season record of 125, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2005-06. Liberty freshman **SETH CURRY** is tracking at 105 treys for the year, while VMI teammates **KEITH GABRIEL** and **AUSTIN KENON** each are on target for 107 three-pointers. The Big South record for most players with 100 three-point field goals in the same season is two -- VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** and Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS** in 2006-07.

BIG SOUTH MAKES ITS OWN MID-MAJOR HISTORY

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference has two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, with Liberty and VMI holding the distinction. Liberty is ranked No. 15 in this week's poll, while VMI sits in the No. 13 position -- its highest-ever ranking. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons. FIRST MATE

Charleston Southern sophomore **JAMARCO WARREN** is the Big South's leading scorer with 21.3 points per game. He is looking to become the first CSU player to average 20.0 points per game since **BRETT LARRICK** averaged 20.0 points in 1996-97, which was also the last time a Buccaneer player led the Big South in scoring average.

BLOCK PARTY

High Point University broke the Big South single-game record for blocked shots when the Panthers recorded 17 blocks against Youngstown State on Dec. 19. The previous record was 16, set by UNC Asheville vs. Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Gardner-Webb nearly matched High Point's effort the following night against Anderson, as the GWU Bulldogs blocked 14 shots, which is the fourth-highest block total in a game in Big South history.

AUSTIN POWERS

VMI sophomore **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in every game of his career -- a span of 29 games. He made 57 in 16 appearances in 2007-08, and has 48 treys through 13 games this season. Kenon has made 105 three-pointers in his 29 games, a 3.62 per game average.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE?

With home court advantage at stake for the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, the road teams have won eight of the first 14 Big South games played. The total is already 42.1 percent of last year's 19 road Conference wins.

NOT SO MARGINAL

Of the first 14 Big South Conference games, nine games were decided by at least 10 points, while just three have been decided by four points-or-less. The average margin of victory for the League season after 14 games is 12.5 points.

20/20 VISION

Less than a week after Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** became the first Big South player with a 20-rebound game in 22 months, Gardner-Webb freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** grabbed 21 rebounds against Ferrum on Saturday, Dec. 20. Parakhouski's effort was the most in the Conference since High Point's **ARIZONA REID** had a League-record 25 against VMI on Feb. 24, 2007, and was the first Highlander with 20 rebounds in a game since **AARON GILL** had 21 against Winthrop on Jan. 2, 2003.

THE FURY OVER CURRY CONTINUES

Liberty's **SETH CURRY** continues to attract national attention, as he has been the subject of several feature pieces and television interviews during the first six weeks of the 2008-09 season. Curry was named **DICK VITALE's** "Diaper Dandy of the Week" on Dec. 1 for his play against Virginia, Coker and William & Mary. His latest recognition comes from *FOXSports.com* national college basketball writer **JEFF GOODMAN**, who placed Curry on his All-Freshman squad based on play after the first third of the season.

BIG SOUTH PICKS UP BIG WINS

For the second consecutive season, the Big South Conference has posted wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) and Southeastern Conference (SEC). VMI knocked off Kentucky in the season opener on Nov. 14, while Liberty won at Virginia on Nov. 25. In 2007-08, the Big South had two wins against the ACC and one victory against an SEC member. The Conference has now posted a win over an SEC school three consecutive years.

COMING IN 2009-10...

At its recent Fall meeting, the Big South Council of Chief Executive Officers voted to approve a change in the Big South men's basketball Conference schedule. Beginning with the 2009-10 season, the Big South will utilize a Thursday-Saturday format for its League slate.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern hosted Virginia Tech on Dec. 29 and nearly came away with the upset victory, as the Bucs led the majority of the first half and were up by three points in the closing minutes ... **JAMARCO WARREN** led CSU with 22 points and seven assists against the Hokies ... Warren has led CSU in scoring in all but one game this season ... **GIEDRIUS KNYSAS** stepped in for the injured **BILLY BLACKMON** in two games last week and averaged 13.0 points on 11-of-13 shooting to go along with 6.5 rebounds ... CSU hosts VMI Monday before beginning a three-game road trip Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

After starting 1-6, Coastal Carolina has gone 6-1 in its last seven games ... Coastal Carolina's four-game winning streak is its longest since winning five-in-a-row from Jan. 2-10, 2007 ... During the four-game win streak, **MARIO SISINNI** is averaging 15.0 points and 3.5 assists ... The Chanticleers lead the Big South in field goal defense, three-point defense and in defensive rebounds ... **STEVEN SEXTON** scored a career-high 22 points in the win over High Point, which included four three-pointers ... The Chanticleers wrap-up a four-game homestand Monday night against Radford before starting a three-game road trip this weekend.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU is averaging 89.8 points in its last four contests (3-1 record) ... Freshman **JOSHUA HENLEY** came off the bench vs. VMI and posted another double-figure rebounding game, pulling down 15 boards in just 24 minutes ... Gardner-Webb shot just 11 free throws vs. VMI, a season-low for a home game ... Despite its recent home loss, the Bulldogs are 16-4 in their last 20 home games, dating back to the 2006-07 season.

HIGH POINT

High Point made its season debut on TV when its game at No. 23 Minnesota was televised on ESPNU ... Freshman **STEADMAN SHORT** posted back-to-back career high scoring nights in the last two outings, including a team-high 17 points at Coastal Carolina ... HPU has used eight different starting lineups in 13 games this season, with **EUGENE HARRIS** and **DAVE SINGLETON** starting every game ... The Panthers will conclude a three-game road stretch at Winthrop on Wednesday before playing a home for the first time in a month on Saturday.

LIBERTY

With 304 points already this season, freshman **SETH CURRY** is now the fifth-highest scoring frosh in Liberty history ... Curry scored 30 points vs. Northern Colorado on Dec. 22, becoming the first freshman in Liberty's Division I era to score at least 30 points in a regular-season game (**JAMAAL BENNETT** tallied 35 points in the quarterfinals of the 1999 Big South Tournament) ... All five Liberty starters have a positive assist-to-turnover ratio: **JESSE SANDERS** (56-to-23), **KYLE OHMAN** (37-to-29), **ANTHONY SMITH** (31-to-30), Curry (29-to-24) and **BROLIN FLOYD** (22-to-20).

PRESBYTERIAN

After being on the road for the previous three games, Presbyterian returned home for its Big South home opener against Radford. The Blue Hose suffered a 65-55 loss, resulting in the first home loss for PC since moving to Division I and snapping a 14-game home win streak ... **PIERRE MILLER** led the team in scoring for the first time this season with 15 points against the Highlanders, while recording a career-high three steals.

RADFORD

Radford is looking to string together back-to-back road victories for the first time in almost three years ... **AMIR JOHNSON** has moved into fourth on Radford's all-time assists chart ... **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** ranks 16th nationally in rebounds and has recorded three-straight double-doubles -- averaging 15.7 points and 14.3 rebounds in that span.
