**JAMARCO WARREN**  
Soph. • G • Charleston Southern  
Gainesville, Ga.

Warren averaged 25.3 points, .622 percent from the floor (28-of-45) and .593 percent from three-point range (16-of-27) in leading the Buccaneers to a 2-1 record last week. In CSU's victory over Furman, Warren scored 28 points off the bench on 10-of-15 shooting, including 6-of-9 from long range. In a 10-point loss to College of Charleston, Warren led the Buccaneers with 20 points. He concluded his week with another 28-point performance in Charleston Southern's victory over Toccoa Falls, hitting all six of his three-point attempts and finishing the night 10-of-12 from the field. Warren also averaged 2.3 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.7 steals in the three games.

#### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

**JOSHUA HENLEY**  
Forward • Gardner-Webb

Henley averaged 15.5 points and 10.0 rebounds for the Bulldogs in two games last week. He scored 16 points on 6-of-6 shooting and added eight rebounds at Longwood. He followed that performance with 15 points and 12 rebounds in 40 minutes at No. 12 Oklahoma, out-muscling a much bigger front line in Norman. For the week, the 6-4 Henley averaged 3.5 offensive rebounds and was 11-of-15 from the floor ( = .733 percent), 8-of-11 from the line ( = .727 percent) and recorded a blocked shot in each game.

**UNC ASHEVILLE DEFEATS LIBERTY IN EARLIEST LEAGUE OPENER IN HISTORY**

UNC Asheville defeated Liberty 84-56 last Tuesday, Nov. 18, in the earliest Big South opener in League history. Freshman **J.P. PRIMM** scored a game-high 21 points for the Bulldogs, and nearly collected a triple-double, as he finished with seven rebounds and seven assists. The game was played at 2:00pm and was broadcast nationally on ESPN as part of the network's 24 Hour College Basketball Marathon.

**KEYDETS ENJOYING MID-MAJOR MANIA**

VMI is ranked No. 22 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, up from last week's No. 25 position. This is the first season the Keydets have been ranked in the 10-year-old poll, and it is the fifth consecutive season the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25. UNC Asheville received four votes in this week's ranking, its first recognition of the season and first since being ranked in the Top 25 in 2007-08. Winthrop, which received votes the first two weeks, did not receive any plaudits this week. Meanwhile, VMI garnered a Top 25 vote in the *Associated Press* national ranking for the second consecutive week.

**TWIN PEAKS**

VMI senior twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** have combined to score 2,767 career points, the fourth-most by a twin brother combination in NCAA history. Chavis has 1,463 points, while Travis has 1,304. The duo needs 233 points to become the fourth set of twins with 3,000 combined points, and trail **HORACE** and **HARVEY GRANT** (3,231) for third-place.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is two wins away from 200 career coaching victories as a college head coach. He is 169-186 in 12-plus seasons as the Bulldogs' mentor, and won 29 games as head coach of the Davidson Wildcats from 1978-81. Biedenbach is three wins shy of becoming the third coach in League history with 100 wins in Big South games.

**BOARD REPORT**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is six rebounds away from becoming the 49th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds. Harris would have reached the milestone last season, but suffered a season-ending injury in the eighth game of the year. Meanwhile, VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** is 56 rebounds away from 500, and would become the 35th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (364) and VMI's **WILLIE BELL** (332) could also surpass 500 career rebounds in 2008-09.

**POINT OF ORDER**

VMI senior **CHAVIS HOLMES** is the League's active leading scorer with 1,463 career points, good for 25th all-time in Big South history. He is 248 points away from entering the League's all-time Top 10. Other active 1,000-point scorers are **TRAVIS HOLMES** (1,304) and **ANTHONY SMITH** (1,177). **COAST-TO-COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina will play in an exempt tournament for the first time since the 1991-92 season as the Chanticleers will have four games set in three different sites over the Thanksgiving break in the Global Sports Classic. Coastal Carolina will actually play two games on campus sites to open the tourney, then travel to Las Vegas to play two games in the Thomas and Mack Center. The Chants faced Florida State this past Friday and visit Cincinnati tonight, then play Western Illinois Friday and either Texas-Pan American or North Carolina A&T on Saturday. Coastal Carolina's last exempt tournament was the Great Alaska Shootout in 1991. The Chanticleers will travel 7,187 miles during the Global Sports Classic.

**HARRIS POLL**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 19 blocked shots away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. In addition, Harris will likely become the 11th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots and 500 career rebounds.

**GAYNOR'S STEALS RECORD MAY BE SHORT-LIVED**

Former Winthrop point guard **CHRIS GAYNOR**'s Big South career record of 259 steals -- established just last season, is likely to be the first all-time record to fall in 2008-09, as VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES**' 236 career steals are just 23 away from Gaynor's mark. Holmes is currently fifth in Big South history, and needs three more to move into fourth place. He is averaging 4.25 steals per game this season, and is on target to break Gaynor's steals records on Dec. 13 vs. Southern Wesleyan.

**CRUZZIN**

High Point redshirt-junior **CRUZ DANIELS** has moved into a tie for 12th all-time in Big South history with 145 career blocked shots. Daniels is tied with **JOHN JAMES**, who had 145 blocks for former member Towson State from 1992-94. Daniels needs 11 swats to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

High Point is 29-2 in the Millis Center since the start of the 2006-07 season, including a 20-game non-Conference home win streak. HPU has won its last 12 home openers as well.

**EXTREME MAKEOVER**

Radford is playing its home men's basketball games temporarily in Peters Hall on campus while renovations continue at the Dedmon Center. The Highlanders opened the season with a 74-55 victory over Brevard to improve to 31-4 in home openers, and is now 71-18 (=.798) all-time in games played at Peters Hall, including 2-0 this season.

**TANGLED WEBB**

Gardner-Webb has lost its first three games of the season by a combined eight points. The Bulldogs posted their closest loss to a nationally-ranked team this past Saturday, leading for much of the second half before falling by four points to No. 12 Oklahoma. Gardner-Webb suffered a one-point loss at Longwood earlier in the week, and dropped its season opener at Virginia Tech by three points.

**HITTING THE HIGH NOTES**

Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** moved into 10th place on Radford's all-time assist chart with two helpers at Virginia last Friday (Nov. 21). Meanwhile, Radford and **ERIC HALL** set a new John Paul Jones Arena record for blocks in the game against the Cavaliers. Hall tied his career-high with six blocked shots, while the Highlanders swatted away 10 shots on the night.

**UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY**

Winthrop's 1-3 start is the worst for the Eagles since they started 1-7 in the 1997-98 season, and their three-straight losses marks the first time that has happened since the 2003-04 season.

**ROCK AROUND THE BLOCK TONIGHT**

VMI's 12 blocked shots against Stevenson last week erased a 17-year old Cameron Hall record established when the Keydets rejected 10 Bluefield shots on January 22, 1992. **CHAVIS HOLMES** had a career-high four blocks against Stevenson.

**VMI OPENS SEASON WITH MONUMENTAL WIN**

VMI opened the 2008-09 men's basketball season with a resounding 111-103 victory at Kentucky, the school's first win over an SEC opponent since 1975-76 when the Keydets upset No. 9 Tennessee, 81-75 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Six players scored in double figures against the Wildcats, led by **TRAVIS HOLMES**' career-high 30 points. Holmes was 10-of-13 from the floor and 9-of-9 from the free throw line. The win marked the third consecutive season that a Big South member has defeated an SEC member.

**MORE ON VMI'S SEASON-OPENING VICTORY**

VMI's 111-103 win at Kentucky was the Keydets' first in a season-opener away from Cameron Hall since knocking off Roanoke 64-50 at the UVA Tipoff on Nov. 25, 1977. It was the first season opening win in a "true" road setting since a 55-52 win at Hampden-Sydney in the 1955-56 opener. In addition, the Kentucky victory was the first season-opening win for coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** in his four seasons at VMI.

**BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FOURTH APPEARANCE IN ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South will again participate in the ESPNU BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 20-21. Winthrop (home), Gardner-Webb (road) and Liberty (road) will be the League's participants. The League has received two nationally-televised broadcasts the past two seasons. Winthrop is 2-1 all-time in the event, while Liberty is 0-1. Gardner-Webb will make its first-ever appearance in the BracketBusters.
