She closed out the with three strikeouts in four innings pitched against the Blue Hose on March 28. For the week, Vetter allowed just three runs and nine hits in 17 innings pitched. NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern started off hot in the Big South this week, splitting a doubleheader with Coastal Carolina before sweeping Presbyterian in a three game series, for a 4-1 week in the conference. CSU improved to 19-18 and 5-1 in the conference, moving past the .500 mark for the first time since Feb. 14th. The Bucs started off the week with a trip to Raleigh, N.C. to play ACC member, N.C. State. CSU dropped a 9-0 contest to the Wolfpack, but used the game as a tune up for the remainder of the week. The Bucs had five unanswered runs in game one vs. Coastal Carolina for a 5-2 final score, before dropping a 4-3 contest in game two. In the first day of competition with Presbyterian, a pair of shutouts led to 9-0 and 4-0 victories for CSU. The Bucs completed the sweep, holding on for a 3-2 victory. Sondra Vetter was the story of the week, recording a 3-0 record, 1.24 ERA and 21 strike-outs in three starts. BRITTANY GIANNINI stepped up for her best week of the season, leading the team with a .462 batting average, .769 slugging percentage and .563 on base percentage. AMY TRENKAMP had a team best eight hits, including two triples and a double. MEGAN HALL also posted six hits and led the team with five RBIs. CSU will have a light week next week, heading to Liberty for a three game series on the weekend.

COASTAL CAROLINA

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs snapped a three-game losing streak with two one run wins over Appalachian State in non-conference action on Tuesday. **CHRISTA FULLWOOD** scored what proved to be the game winning run in game one by way of a smart base running play in which she scored on the App. State pitcher and catcher who were not playing attention to her on third base. In game two, Fullwood blasted a walk-off grand slam over the left field wall to give the Bulldogs the 9-8 win. On Sunday against Radford, the Bulldogs blasted four homeruns over the doubleheader, but it wasn't enough as Radford outscored the 'Dogs in the offensive slugfest, winning 8-5 and 15-6.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 1-3 for the week, splitting a doubleheader at home against Hampton, 0-2 and 5-1, and dropping two games to Winthrop, 1-9 and 5-7. The third game of the Winthrop series is scheduled for Monday, March 30 at 1 p.m. in Rock Hill, S.C. Three Lady flames recorded home runs in the 5-1 victory over Hampton: J'NAE JEFFERSON, BETH BENNETT and KAYLEE WEST. In the 7-5 loss to Winthrop, Danielle Howard batted 3-for-4 with an RBI and two runs scored, while AMBER DEPASQUALE was 2-for-3 with an RBI and two runs scored, and both players hit home runs. Also driving in runs in the loss were ASHLEY BENSINGER and West.

PRESBYTERIAN

RADFORD

A couple of school records were tied in Radford's Big South opening series at Gardner-Webb. In game one, the Highlanders stole seven bases, tying a mark that was set on Feb. 29. 2004 at Norfolk State. In game two, LEIGH GODFREY became only the second Highlander to record five hits in a game, matching MELISSA PICKEL, who achieved the mark on March 23, 1996. She, along with KRISTEN SHIFFLETT, tied the the single-game record for runs scored with four apiece. Godfrey has recorded a hit in her last seven at bats and nine of her last 10. In the first 20 games of her collegiate career, she has reached base in 18 games, tallied a hit in 15 and scored a run in 14. Radford has hit 33 home runs this season, the fourth most in school history. Freshman NICHOLE BEALL is currently on a teamhigh 10-game hitting streak. During that time, she is batting .441 (15-34) with four doubles, three triples, three home runs, 14 RBI, 10 runs scored and a 1.000 slugging pct.

WINTHROP

Winthrop hit six home runs in its 9-1 victory over Liberty on Sunday. It hit two more in the second game for eight on the day. The six is the most ever by a Winthrop team under head coach MARK COOKE. The team has hit nine home runs in the last three games and has scored 25 runs (8.3 runs a game). TESSA THOMAS and LISA KINGSMORE continue their battle for the school's all-time leader in hits. They both reached the 250 mark over the weekend as Kingsmore leads 253-250. Thomas is also closing in on a few other career marks. She is just two RBI behind third place all-time and seven behind the all-time leader in runs scored. MEGAN EVANS picked up her 52nd and 53rd career victory over the weekend and is closing in on SHAHNA ASHARD, who is third all-time with 55 wins.
