Beall hit .471 and drove in seven runs to lead her Highlanders to three wins last week. She posted three multiple hit games to finish with eight hits on the week, including two home runs. She drove in at least one run in five of the six games she played and had two games with two RBI. For the week, she posted a slugging percentage of .824 and an on-base percentage of .550. In the field, Beall recorded 15 assists and six putouts from her spot at third base. The honor marks her first Player of the Week honor this season.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Christine Murray • Junior Gardner-Webb Brampton, Ontario

Murray struck out 35 hitters and posted a 1.46 ERA as she went 3-1 for Gardner-Webb last week. She got her week started with 10 stikeouts as she held Presbyterian to just one hit to pick up the complete game shutout on April 2. She followed that performance with six strikeouts in three innings in a loss against the Blue Hose in game two. Murray rebounded two days later with 12 stikeouts in a 3-2 win over Coastal Carolina. In the game vs. the Chants, she was perfect through five innings and held the Chanticleers to just two runs and four hits. She closed out the week with seven strikeouts in GWU's 2-1 win over Coastal Carolina on April 5. For the week, Murray tossed 24 innings and allowed just five runs. The honor marks her first Pitcher of the Week plaudit this season.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern had a tough week, dropping all three games in a road series at Liberty. After tying for the best conference start in program history with a 5-1 mark, the Bucs dropped to 5-4 in the Big South with a 19-21 overall record. **MEGAN HALL** led the team with four hits on the weekend and **MEGAN LOMBARD** provided the only extra base hit for the team with a solo shot in game two. CSU will look to bounce back this week in a home doubleheader vs. USC Upstate before heading to Winthrop for another weekend series.

COASTAL CAROLINA

In two loses against Gardner-Webb over the weekend, Coastal Carolina scored only three runs on eight combined hits. However, in its one victory in game two on Saturday, the Chants scored nine runs on 14 hits ... **MICHELLE EVANS** continued her hot hitting of late, as she was 5-for-10 with a double and RBI on the weekend.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs went 3-2 over the week, all conference games. Gardner-Webb picked up its first ever Conference win as members of the Big South on Thursday, with a 2-0 win over PC. The Bulldogs set another first over the weekend, as GWU picked up its first ever Big South Conference series win, taking two out of three games from Coastal Carolina in Conway, S.C.

Eight out of the nine Liberty starters recorded hits in Sunday's 4-2 win over Charleston Southern, continuing the Lady Flames' hitting streak. Liberty has pounded out 10 or more hits in three out of the last four games, and four out of the last seven games, with 11 total hits in Sunday's contest. The Lady Flames won three consecutive Conference games over the weekend with a sweep of Charleston Southern in Lynchburg, and pitcher SARAH ELLIS picked up all three wins in the circle. Sophomore KEELY MCMILLON is currently on a five-game hitting streak, and her sixth-inning triple in Game 1 against Charleston Southern drove in two runs, setting up the 2-1 victory.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC went 4-3 last week, downing Anderson twice, Gardner-Webb once and Radford once. With the win over the Bulldogs, PC won its first-ever Big South series, winning two of three for the year. The Blue Hose have a doubleheader against Winthrop Wednesday before stepping out of Conference to take on Longwood this weekend.

RADFORD

Freshmen **NICHOLE BEALL** and **LEIGH GODFREY** are on fire right now, getting a hit in 15 of Radford's last 16 games. Beall had her team-best 12-game hitting streak snapped in game two against James Madison. During her streak, she batted .450 with four doubles, three triples, four home runs, 17 RBI and 12 runs scored. Godfrey is currently riding a nine-game streak, batting .571 (20-35) with five doubles and 13 runs scored. She has also reached base officially in 16 consecutive games and 24 of the 26 contests she has played in this season.

WINTHROP

Once again the Lady Eagles toughest opponent last week was the weather and they lost again. Winthrop's trip to the University of South Carolina was canceled due to the rain and Winthrop only played in one game, which was a 5-0 league win over Liberty on Monday. The Lady Eagles have now lost 13 games on the year, with only one of those rescheduled. TESSATHOMAS and LISA KINGSMORE continued their ongoing battle to become the school's all-time leader in hits as Thomas closed the gap last week. Thomas has 252 career hits while Kingsmore is now at 254. Thomas is in the middle of a 13-game hit streak while Kingsmore extended hers to 11 games. The injury bug continued to bite the Lady Eagles last week as CAROL REDA, CARI WOOLDRIDGE, JO-LYNN SMITH and LENNY STODDART were all unavailable for the Liberty series. The most notable player to step up in place of an absent starter has been sophomore Veronica Berrie. The left fielder is batting .333 on the year after a threegame series start against Liberty in which she was 4-for-9 with three runs, two home runs and three RBI. She was also a perfect 6-for-6 in putouts and had an assist. Hopefully all the time off can help the injured ones heal and get back to action.
