NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern did not participate in any games last week as they took a break for finals. The Lady Bucs garnered the No. 4 seed in this week's Big South Softball Championship presented by Texas Roadhouse and will play No. 5 Gardner-Webb at 10:00am on May 7.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Sophomore **MICHELLE EVANS** had the best weekend of the Chants at the plate, as she went 5-for-11 with a pair of doubles, a home run and three RBI, and slugged a solid .909 in the three-game set ... Evans and fellow sophomore **ASHLEY PISONE** entered the weekend tied for the team lead with three home runs, and left the weekend tied with four as both hit dingers in the weekend set with the Lady Flames.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs will enter its first ever Big South Softball Championship as the No. 5 seed. Gardner-Webb was 6-12 during conference play in its first year as Big South members and posted a 5-10 record against the Big South Softball Championship tournament field. The Bulldogs will look to make waves in its first BSC Championship appearance, as the young GWU squad is led by junior first-baseman CHRISTA FULLWOOD ... Fullwood finished the regular season hitting a stellar .438 and is enters the championship tournament on a ten game hitting streak.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames ended the regular season with a sweep of Coastal Carolina, 8-1, 8-3 and 11-9. J'NAE JEFFERSON is now on a 12-game hitting streak, the longest on the team this season, and batted .471 on the week with eight hits and five RBIs. Freshman KELLY STRICKLAND had two two-homer performances this week, both against Coastal Carolina, batting .400 with six hits and nine RBI's with a 1.333 slugging percentage. Liberty recorded a season-high 12 hits in the final win over the Chanticleers, as five Liberty starters had multiple-hit games. The Lady Flames enter this week's Big South Championship as the No. 3 seed for the third time since 1994.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose finished their season with an 18-27 overall record and a 5-13 mark in Big South play.

RADFORD

Radford claimed its first ever Big South regular season championship and top seed for the Conference tournament. The Highlanders finished with a league record 16-2 mark in Big South play and are 29-4 in league play the last two seasons. Radford had a record breaking week: The Highlanders set a new team home run record, finishing the regular season with 59. It is the fifth consecutive season they have increased the record... Sophomore KRISTEN SHIFFLETT hit her 11th and 12th home runs at ETSU, tying the single-season mark held by MELISSA PICKEL (1995) and ASHLEY TAYLOR (2007)... Freshman LEIGH GODFREY hit the first ever inside the park home run at ETSU... Godfrey also set new freshman marks for hits (71) and runs (51) last week... MICKEY DEAN has recorded 127 wins at Radford, tying AMY KVILHAUG (2003-06) for career coaching victories record... CHELSEA KELLEY became just the fourth Highlander pitcher to record 20 wins

WINTHROP

TAYLOR WRIGHT became the third player on the team this season to have a double-figure hit streak as it now stands at 11 games. The streak began in the second game at 13th ranked North Carolina. The Lady Eagles captured a school best 15th league victory on Sunday in the win over Coastal Carolina. Last year Winthrop set the school record with 14 (14-1 in the league). Senior LISA KINGSMORE had an incredible streak come to an end on Sunday at Coastal Carolina. Kingsmore almost made it through all 18 conference games without a single strike out, but in her first at-bat on Sunday, she was called out looking in her 60th at-bat. She finished the conference season with a .516 average to go along with 19 runs, six doubles, seven home runs, 26 RBI. She had one strikeout and 11 walks. This past week the Lady Eagles stepped up offensively and on the mound. Winthrop averaged 8.8 runs per game and had a team ERA of 2.03. The offense came from the entire line-up as nine different players had 3 RBI or more. There were six players with 5 RBI or more and three players with 7 RBI or more. In 2004, Winthrop set a school record with 52 home runs in 67 games. So far this season Winthrop has 49 total home runs in 45 games. The potential to break the record in fewer games was there, but the Lady Eagles lost 13 games to rain this year and with an average of over one home run per game, it was likely to be broken. Lisa Kingsmore and TESSA THOMAS lead the team with nine each.


