### NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern suffered a 1-4 week after splitting a doubleheader with USC Upstate and dropping three games against conference foe Winthrop. The bats were silenced for the Bucs in game one against the Spartans, letting a slim lead slip away before a final 2-1 loss. CSU responded nicely however, with an 8-0 victory in five innings after thirteen hits as a team. The weekend series saw the Bucs jump out to an early lead in all three games, but the Eagles rallied each time to take the sweep. In game one, CSU posted a run in the first, only to be met by nine Winthrop runs in the third. The Bucs tallied two more runs in the fifth, but the Eagle offense didn't slow down, taking an 11-3 win. It was more of the same in game two, with Winthrop putting up a four run second inning en route to a 6-2 win. The final game of the series had some late heroics from both teams, but ultimately CSU came up short again. Another 4-1 score had the Eagles on top after two innings, but the Bucs were poised for the comeback in the sixth inning. GAIL MATSUSHIMA sent out a three run homer to tie the game and JAMIE WELLONS made it back-to-back home runs with the go ahead run. The comeback just wasn't meant to be, as Winthrop came through with a walk-off two-run home run to end the game in the bottom of the seventh with a 6-5 score. This week, CSU will look to bounce back with games against Georgia Southern on the road and Gardner-Webb at home.

#### **COASTAL CAROLINA**

Although Coastal Carolina was swept in a weekend series against Radford, freshman pitcher IVY MCCRANIE gave the Chanticleers a shot to win. In her last five appearances, McCranie has a 2.13 ERA with 14 strikeouts in 23 innings... Coastal Carolina's lone seniors, BRITTANY BIRNBAUM and KELSEY RIFFEL hit a combined 11 for 30 (.366) last week.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

The Bulldogs won its second consecutive Big South series this weekend, taking two out of three games from Liberty. Gardner-Webb defeated the Flames 2-1 in the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday and then used a three-run seventh to pick up a 6-5 come from behind win in game two. The Bulldogs 6-5 walk-off win, an RBI single off the bat of freshman MCKENZIE MORENUS, was the fifth walk-off win for Gardner-Webb this season.

#### LIBERTY

The Lady Flames went 1-4 on the week, all road games, dropping two contests to James Madison and taking one of three games from Gardner-Webb in Big South action. Senior **BETH BENNETT** recorded two home runs for the week, and drove in four runs in Saturday's win over Gardner-Webb. Pitcher **TIFFANI SMITH** went 1-1 for the week with a 1.70 ERA. As a team, the Lady Flames have recorded more than five hits in six of the last seven games, and have hit a home run in five of the last seven.

#### **PRESBYTERIAN**

The Blue Hose split a pair of conference games this week against Winthrop. MARY GORDON tossed a one-hit shutout in the 1-0 win over Longwood Friday evening. KATIE ANDERSON is currently in the midst of a six-game hitting streak, which is the longest on the team this season. PC returns to action Monday at 6 p.m. in the final game of the series against Winthrop. The Blue hose then host nine straight home games to conclude the home portion of the slate.

#### **RADFORD**

The Highlanders went 3-2 last week, rebounding from a doubleheader sweep at Marshall with a three-game conference series sweep over Coastal Carolina. With three home runs last week, Radford has hit 42, tying for the third best season in school history. They have also stolen 81 bases, matching 2003 total for fourth best. In game two at Marshall, freshman **LEIGH GODFREY** tied a school record scoring four runs for the second time this season as well tying the single-game mark for stolen bases with three.

#### WINTHROP

LISA KINGSMORE had a good week. She entered the week 12th nationally with a .451 batting average and by the end of the double-header on Saturday, she was batting .468. On Saturday before the first game of the double-header, Kingsmore was recognized for her NFCA All-American Team selection last year with a banner that will be draped over the right field fence as she became the first Lady Eagle softball player to ever be named an All-American. And to top of the day, Kingsmore hit a two-run walk-off homer in the second game to help Winthrop win both games on the day. Kingsmore, TESSA THOMAS and MALLORY HOGAN were all recognized on Saturday for Senior Day. These three have meant so much to the program over the course of their careers and have helped take the program to another level. All three have recorded 100 or more RBI in their career. It is the first time in school history that three players with 100 career RBI have played together in the same season. Thomas added another accolade to her incredible career as she passed Janiva Willis on Saturday for the most runs scored in school history with 175. Thomas and Kingsmore are still battling for the all-time leader in hits. Kingsmore leads as of Sunday with 264 and Thomas is at 258. Winthrop as a team entered the week averaging 1.0 home runs a game, which ranked 20th nationally. This past week in five games the Lady Eagles hit seven, with Kingsmore, TAYLOR WRIGHT and VÉRONICA BERRIE hitting two each. Winthrop has hit 16 home runs in just eight Big South games. Kingsmore is currently riding a 16-game hit streak that started back on Mar. 12 in the win over North Carolina State. During the streak she's batting .509 with 11 runs, four doubles, four home runs, 20 RBI, has five walks and has not struck out a single time. Inspite of the injury bug going through the Lady Eagles team this season, players have been stepping up. This last week Winthrop hit .312 as a team in five games and eight different players had at least one RBI as the team went 4-1.
