Lloyd was red hot at the plate in last week's four games, helping the Bulldogs to a three-game sweep of Big South foe Presbyterian. He batted .611 (11-18) with a .611 on-base percentage and .889 slugging clip. Lloyd tallied five doubles, knocked in six runs and had three three-hit games. He opened the week with a 3-4 effort and a double at No. 2 North Carolina, then went 3-5 with two runs and two RBI in the series opener against Presbyterian. Lloyd went 2-4 in game two against the Blue Hose and helped Gardner-Webb finish the sweep with a 3-5 day on Sunday, including two runs, two doubles and three runs batted in. Lloyd also batted .800 with runners in scoring position (4-5) and hit .625 (5-8) when batting with two outs.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs took a 2-1 advantage in their series with UNC Asheville to open Conference play, winning the first and third games. They lost to South Carolina 6-4 in a mid-week game, but gave the Gamecocks a scare at the end with bases loaded for two batters. The Bucs did however hold off USC in the first inning, making USC leave the first scoreless for the first time the season, and the Bucs took the lead in the bottom of the inning on a homer from **TYLER THORNBURG** to make USC trail an opponent for the first time this season ... The Bucs dropped their contest to Xavier to start the week, and postponed their game at USC Upstate due to bad weather ... The Bucs will finish their suspended game against Air Force on Thursday at 12:00pm.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina has a nine-game winning streak heading into this week ... The Chanticleers went 6-0 on the week, highlighted by a pair of shutouts and a 36-run barrage ... The Chanticleers defeated Stony Brook 36-3 March 8 in the final game of the Caravelle Resort Classic. Coastal Carolina set a school record in runs scored in the win over the Seawolves. The original mark was 29 set March 25, 1982 in a 29-1 win over Voorhees. Coastal Carolina also set a school record in margin of victory (33) ... Coastal Carolina's underclassmen saw plenty of action in that win. **DUSTIN KING** went 4-for-6 with six RBI and a grand slam. **STEVE DAVIS** was 4-of-6 with three runs scored. **TUCKER FRAWLEY** was 3-for-4 with two RBI ... **TAYLOR MOTTER** was the only position starter to play all nine innings. He went 5-for-7 with five runs scored ... Coastal Carolina gave up just four hits in two games Friday night in wins over Albany and Stony Brook ... **BOBBY GAGG** had an outstanding performance in the 3-1 win over The Citadel. Gagg did not allow a hit until the sixth inning and in total gave up just three hits and one run with five strikeouts ... The closest game of the week came against Creighton on Saturday. The Chants had an 8-5 lead heading into the ninth, but Darin Ruf's two-run home run made it a one-run game. Creighton then got runners on first and second, before **NICK McCULLY** struck out the final two Bluejays looking to end the game.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb swept its first Big South Conference series, topping Presbyterian three times at home on Masters Field ... GWU has now swiped 28 bases in 33 attempts on the season, which keeps the 'Dogs on pace to break its current school season record set last season. GWU is currently on a regular-season pace for 151 stolen bases ... **BROCK MILLER** stole four bases during the GWU-PC series and leads the Big South with 10 bags in 12 attempts ... Miller has stolen 64 career bases ... Freshmen have combined to post three of Gardner-Webb's four saves on the 2009 season to date ... The GWU pitching staff fanned 23 batters in its three games vs. Presbyterian, and issued just seven walks in 27.0 innings of work ... After a three-game losing streak that saw GWU struggle at the plate with RISP (runners in scoring position), the 'Dogs batted a sizzling .489 with runners in scoring position vs. Presbyterian.

HIGH POINT

High Point lost four of their five contests last week, picking up their lone win against ACC member Duke on March 5 ... In the win, **MIKE CALDWELL** threw seven innings and allowing just one run on six hits. He picked up his team leading second win of the season and has two-of-the-four Panther victories this year ... The offense was led by **KYLE MAHONEY** and **BILL MANION** who each had a pair of hits including a homerun and drove in four runs apiece ... **BILLY ALVINO** had his 12-game hitting streak snapped in the second game of the three-game series with Winthrop ... **ALFIE WHEELER** currently has the longest hitting streak for HPU, which stands at seven games ... **JEFF COWAN** is in a tie for third all-time on the HPU hit list ... In all four of HPU's wins this year, the opposing team has scored first.

LIBERTY

Liberty swept a four-game series with Temple this past weekend. The Flames hit 11 home runs during the four-game set and had 16 doubles ... Friday, Liberty won 12-2 in its home opener at Worthington Stadium. The victory ran the Flames record in home openers at the facility to 27-5 ... In game one of Saturday's doubleheader, pinch hitter **DOUG BREAN** hit the first pitch he saw over the right field wall for a grand slam. Liberty hit four home runs, the most by the Flames in a contest since Feb. 18, 2007 ... Liberty batters were also hit by a pitch a school record seven times in the 18-9 Flames' victory ... In the second game Saturday, senior catcher **ERROL HOLLINGER** and junior right fielder **CASEY BROWN** connected on back-to-back home runs in the fifth inning.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose battled hard, but dropped all three games in their Big South Conference opening weekend at League newcomer Gardner-Webb. **GABE GRAMMER** belted out a team-best .615 average.

RADFORD

The series sweep for Radford was its first since March 1-2, 2008, when the Highlanders took three in a row from Evansville at home ... Radford's offensive outburst in Game 2 on Saturday, a 26-1 win in seven innings, was just off the pace of a pair of single-game school records: the 26-run total (28 is the record) and the five home runs (7) ... The Highlanders plated 44 runs, hit six homers, hit .427/.509/.709, knocked 47 hits and drew 17 walks against Canisius, a team that won 41 games in 2008 ... Outside of the 26-1 clubbing, Radford needed eighth and ninth-inning comebacks to take games ... **MARIO DUARTE**'s .778/.800/1.333 weekend paced the Radford hitters, driving in eight runs in nine plate appearances ... **JEFF KEMP** launched the first two homers of his career on Saturday, including a walk-off grand slam in a 6-3 Game 1 win ... Kemp finished the weekend .600/.643/1.300 at the plate with two homers and 10 driven in. He added nine weekend assists in the field, going 1.000 ... The Highlanders got their second win of the season from a starting pitcher when right-hander **AERIK TAYLOR** went six innings in Game 2, allowing one run on seven hits and striking out five.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldog offense came to life at Charleston Southern over the weekend. Asheville hit eight home runs in the three game series including four by **JUSTIN SCHUMER**. Schumer went 8-for-15 (.533) with four home runs and nine RBI. He slugged 1.333 collecting 20 total bases. Schumer has homered in each of the last three games. The UNC Asheville record for consecutive home runs is four set by **BRAIN SHEHAN** ... **CATLIN CARTER** hit .389 (7-18) and **CODY BUCH** hit .357 (5-14) on the week ... **REED KREISER** hit two more home runs over the weekend and Buch and **DANNY BAATZ** also left the yard.

VMI

After opening the season 1-6, the Keydets bounced back by winning four of five last week against William & Mary and Rider ... VMI sophomore **SAM ROBERTS** cranked the first three home runs of his career last weekend against Rider, the latter of which gave him a win on the mound.

WINTHROP

The Eagles opened the 2009 Big South Conference portion of their schedule with a three-game sweep of the High Point Panthers at Coy O. Williard Stadium. Winthrop also dropped a non-conference road game at Georgia Southern 5-4, but came back the next afternoon to defeat East Tennessee State 8-4 ... Freshman **KEN MONTEITH** picked up his first career victory as an Eagle in the victory against ETSU, while freshman **TYLER MIZENKO** earned his first two collegiate saves in 4-3 and 3-1 victories over the Panthers ... The Eagles are currently hitting .329 as a team, while allowing opponents to an average of .247 ... The Winthrop pitching staff also currently has an ERA of 3.68 on the season ... In the 8-4 victory over High Point on Sunday, the Eagles pounded out a total of 17 hits with a total of nine players earning base hits ... The Eagles currently have six players hitting at least .300 on the season, while one player has an average over .400 ... Four players have 11 RBI or more and six have posted 12 or more hits.
