EDDIE ROHAN • Sophomore Winthrop • C/OF/1B Youngstown, Ohio

Rohan provided clutch hitting to help Winthrop to a 3-2 record against three prominent opponents last week. He hit safely in all five games and .350 (7-20) for the week with three home runs, one double, a .409 on-base average and an .850 slugging percentage. He opened the week 1-3 at Southern California and then went 2-4 with a double and home run in Winthrop's 5-2 win over Georgia Southern. Two of his three homers came in the Eagles' 6-4 victory over No. 10 Coastal Carolina on Saturday. The first homer against CCU put Winthrop ahead 4-1, while his second home run of the day gave Winthrop a 5-4 lead. Rohan batted .308 in the Coastal Carolina series and helped Winthrop to the 2-games-to-1 series win over the Chanticleers.

Henderson tossed a complete game win on Saturday afternoon vs. UNC Asheville. The right-hander scattered five hits, striking out six while allowing two runs (one earned). Henderson also worked a scoreless inning in relief at Virginia Tech last Wednesday, notching a strikeout while allowing one hit. Henderson's line last week: 2 GP, 1-0, 0.90 ERA, 10 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO, .162 opponents' batting average. He has now thrown four complete games in his career, including two in Big South action.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs had a very up and down week last week. They took the Auburn Tigers into 13 innings but lost by one run in the end ... Their Conference series against Gardner-Webb resulted in two wins and a loss, winning the first and third games. COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went through its first losing week of the season, going 2-3, which included a series loss at Winthrop ... The Chanticleers opened the week with a 5-2 win over Tennessee. AUSTIN FLEET struck out six in six innings, allowing just a run, to pick up the win, while JOSE IGLESIAS and DAVID ANDERSON each homered for the Chanticleers ... That win was the 14th in a row for the Chants, the second-highest in school history ... The streak was snapped the next night against the College of Charleston in a 3-0 loss at home. It was the first time the Chants had been shut out since a 4-0 loss at Clemson on March 7, 2007... CODY WHEELER earned the win in the series opener against Winthrop, pitching seven innings and allowing just two earned runs with four strikeouts ... The Chants then committed five errors and mustered just six runs total in the next two contests. Anderson homered in both games, upping his season total to seven and his career total to 36 ... Coastal Carolina lost a Big South series for the first time since April 22-24, 2006 when it lost 2-of-3 games at Liberty ...
