Yoder batted .500 (9-18) in helping VMI to a 3-2 mark last week, including its first series win over Winthrop in Rock Hill. In the Keydets' 10-inning loss at Old Dominion, Yoder hit a 2-run homer to account for all of VMI's scoring against the Monarchs. He then went 2-3 with two RBI in VMI's 6-5 win over Norfolk State, which snapped the Keydets' eight-game losing streak. Yoder recorded an RBI in VMI's one-run loss to Winthrop in the series opener, then went 5-5 with two runs and a double in a 6-5 win in game two. He followed that with a pair of runs, including the game-winner, in Sunday's series clinching victory over the Eagles. Yoder struck out just once in 20 plate appearances and added two walks, two stolen bases, two sacrifice bunts and was hit by three pitches in recording a .609 on-base percentage in addition to a .722 slugging percentage.

High Point went 1-4 last week despite scoring 49 runs in its five games played. The Panthers' lone win came against Wake Forest, a 12-5 victory. **BILL MANION** had the first of his two five-hit games during the week against the Demon Deacons ... The Panthers almost doubled their season home run output last week, coming into the week with just seven home runs on the year, but hit six throughout the week. **MAX FULGINITI** and **ALFIE WHEELER** hit their first career home runs against East Tennessee State. Fulginiti had two in one contest. He also ran his hitting streak to 30-games, three shy of breaking the Big South record of 32 ... **JEFF COWAN** broke the HPU all-time hits record and runs scored record over the weekend as well.
