Cooke batted .462 (6-13) with six RBI in three games over the weekend, helping the Bulldogs to a 2-1 series win over High Point. He belted two home runs, a double and a triple for a 1.154 slugging percentage. In Sunday's series clincher, Cooke put GWU up 6-0 with a two-run single in the fourth, and cushioned a 6-5 lead with a two-run home run in the sixth. In the series opener Friday, Cooke had a run-scoring triple, and in game two, went 2-3 with a home run, two walks and two runs scored. On Sunday, Cooke surpassed 250 career hits, becoming the first known two-sport athlete in NCAA Division I history to accumulate 250 tackles in football (281), 250 hits in baseball (250), 150 runs scored in baseball (169) and 75 stolen bases (92).

Wheeler retired the first nine batters of the game and had four 1-2-3 innings. He also allowed just one Keydet to third base. He fanned nine batters (one off his career high) and tossed his third game this season with one hit or less when pitching seven or more innings. ## COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers have secured a Top 4 seed in the upcoming Royal Purple Big South Baseball Championship ... Coastal Carolina improved to 27-3 on the season at home with a three-game sweep of Big South foe VMI ... The Chanticleers had a 24-hit barrage in the series opener, defeating the Keydets 20-7 ... **ADAM RICE** hit for the cycle in the game, wrapping up the feat by the fourth inning. Rice singled and doubled in the first, as the Chants sent 15 men to the plate in the nine-run first. He then homered in the third, his sixth of the season, and completed the cycle with a triple to center field, the first of his career. The last Chant to hit for the cycle was **DAVID SAPPELT** at High Point on April 14, 2007 ... Rice and **TYLER BORTNICK** each went 4-for-4 in the win, while **DAVID ANDERSON** was 3-for-6 at the plate ... Pitching took over on Sunday, as the Chants gave up just seven hits in 18 innings pitched ... **ANTHONY MEO** struck out a career-high 10 batters in the 4-2 win in the nightcap. He allowed just three hits and a run in six innings of work ... Coastal Carolina hit .400 in the series, with **JOSE IGLESIAS** hitting four doubles in the first two games ... Coastal Carolina head coach **GARY GILMORE** is now just one win away from recording 800 career wins. He has a 799-392 career record heading into the three-game series against Charleston Southern ... Coastal Carolina's .334 team batting average is currently seventh-highest in a Big South single-season. With their game at Virginia Tech cancelled due to rain, Tuesday night, Liberty had the entire week off ...
