He opened the week with a 4-4 performance on Tuesday against The Citadel, including a double and triple, in PC's 12-6 win - the Blue Hose's first victory over the Bulldogs since 1928. Grammer then opened the series against UNC Asheville with a 5-5 game on Thursday with four RBI, and added three hits and three RBI in PC's wins on Friday and Saturday. He also tossed 1.2 scoreless innings in Friday's 10-7 win to record the save. For the week, Grammer scored six runs, drove in 10, had one double, two triples and slugged .944 percent.

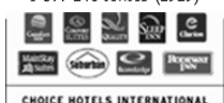

On Saturday against No. 22 Coastal Carolina, Roberts entered in relief and kept the Buccaneers in the game. He tossed 3.2 innings and gave up just two hits and one earned run, while striking out five batters in the eventual 3-1 loss. Coastal Carolina Head Coach **GARY GILMORE** picked up his 800th career victory Thursday night in the 9-1 win over Charleston Southern. Gilmore now has an 802-392 career record in 20 seasons as a head coach ... Coastal Carolina went 10-0 in its season-ending homestand, including a three-game sweep of Charleston Southern this past week ... The Chants received stout pitching all three days, allowing just four earned runs in 27 innings (1.33 ERA) ... Junior **NICK McCULLY** got the weekend off to a hot start, pitching seven strong innings and allowing an unearned run with five strikeouts in the 9-1 win. McCully has now moved into first in the Big South in earned-run average ... **CODY WHEELER** then threw seven innings and struck out nine in Friday's 6-4 win ... **ANTHONY MEO** struck out seven in five innings in the 3-1 win on Saturday ... The Chants held Charleston Southern to a .165 batting average on the series ... **DAVID ANDERSON's** home run on Friday was the 48th in his Coastal Carolina career, tying him with **TOM ROMANO** for the top spot on the school's career home run list ... Coastal Carolina also won its 12th Big South regular-season championship in school history after winning on Friday ... 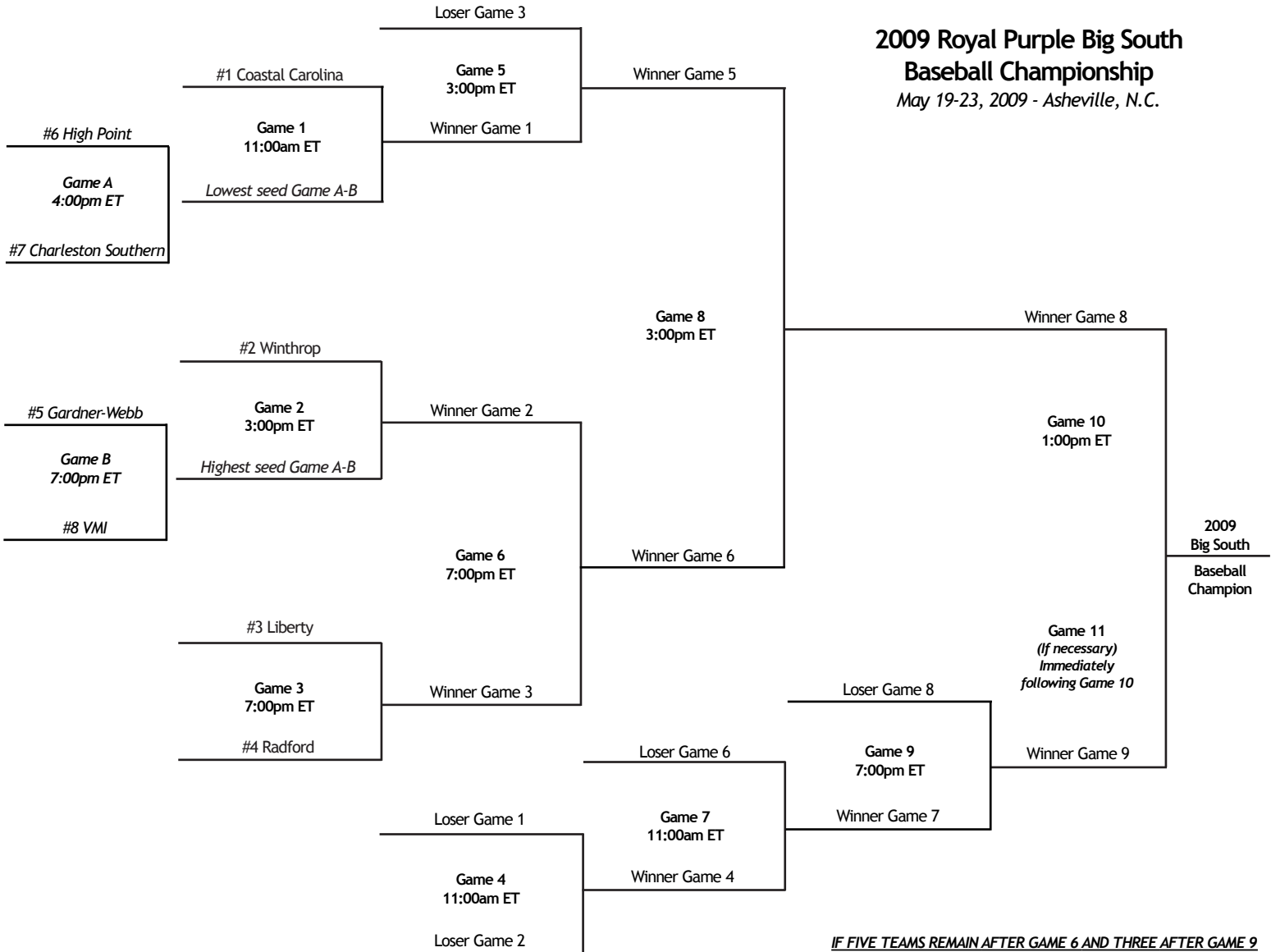

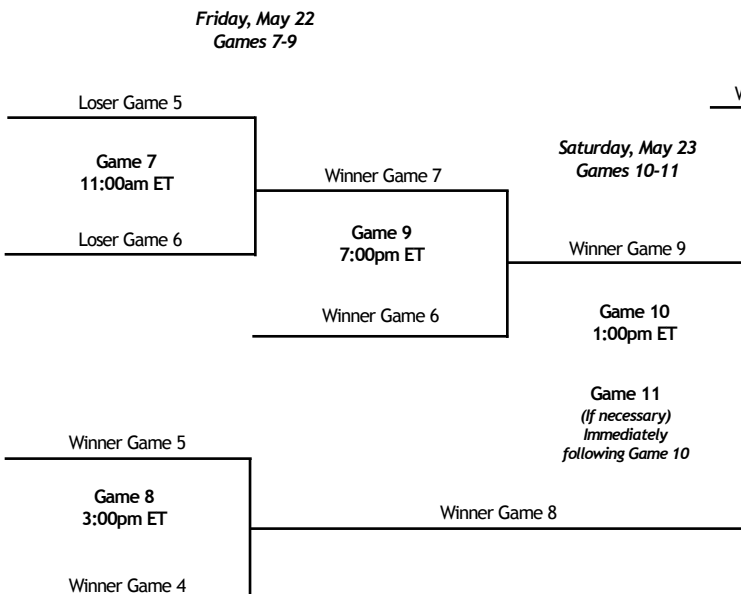

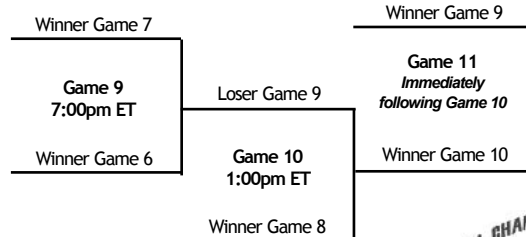
