Gilmore hit .500 (8-16) last week and helped the Chanticleers to a three-game Big South sweep of League-leading Liberty. He opened his week going 2-3 with a double and home run at the College of Charleston. He then went 3-4 with two bunt singles, two RBI, three stolen bases and three runs scored in Coastal Carolina's win over Wake Forest. Gilmore had a two-run single in the fifth inning of game one against Liberty that started the Chanticleers come-from-behind win. He also walked three times in the series opener. Gilmore ended his week with a 2-3 day and an RBI in Sunday's win. For the week, Gilmore scored five runs, knocked in six, drew four walks, stole five bases and posted a .750 slugging percentage and .591 on-base aver-

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers are coming off a 4-1 week that included a three-game sweep of Big South-leading Liberty ... The Chants started the week with a 13-7 loss to the College of Charleston, but have reeled off four straight victories heading into final exams ... DAVID ANDERSON had three home runs on the week and now has 18 on the season and 47 in his career. He is just one home run back of tying TOM ROMANO for the career home run lead at Coastal Carolina. Anderson is the second-leading home run hitter in Big South Conference history. Winthrop's JASON COLSON (1998-01) is the League's career leader with 53. Anderson is looking to become the first player in Big South history with two 20-home run seasons ... Friday's game against Liberty was televised by ESPNU. A national audience saw the Chants come back from a 6-1 deficit to win 13-7. Three runs apiece in the fifth and sixth innings and a four-run eighth fueled the comeback ... NICK MCCULLY is now 4-1 with a 1.73 ERA and 45 strikeouts in 41.2 innings pitched ... TYLER BORTNICK was 3-for-4 with three RBI as the Chanticleers completed the sweep with a 7-2 victory ... Coastal Carolina loves Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field, as the Chanticleers are now 24-3 at home this season. Coastal Carolina has won all nine Big South games at home ... BOBBY GAGG and MATT REIN both earned their first saves of the season this past weekend. Gagg wrapped up Saturday's win, striking out a batter in two-thirds of an inning, while Rein went the final 2.2 innings on Sunday, striking out two batters ... Coastal Carolina now is a game behind Liberty and Winthrop in the Big South standings, but will play three more conference games than the Flames and Eagles. LIBERTY

With one more victory, Liberty will reached 30 wins for the fifth consecutive season, and the first two years under head coach JIM TOMAN. Last season, the Flames recorded four-straight seasons of 30 wins or more. It was the first time in the 36-year history of the program that Liberty accomplished the four-year feat ... For the second-straight year, the Flames have set a school record for being hit by a pitch in a season. Liberty batters were hit four times over the weekend to bring the Flames' season total to 86. The mark breaks last year's 82 times ... Despite tying his career-high with nine strikeouts Saturday, LHP SHAWN TEUFEL saw his consecutive starts with a win streak come to an end at six.
