He also had a 1.100 slugging percentage and a .619 on-base average. In Friday's 11-6 win over Gardner-Webb, Rice went 5-5 with two home runs, a double, four RBI and two runs scored. He had multiple hits and scored a run in four of the five games, and ended the week with a 2-4, three RBI performance in Sunday's 10-4 win over the Bulldogs. Rice raised his batting average 65 points during the week.

Coastal Carolina had six home runs in the 11-6 series opener against Gardner-Webb. **ADAM RICE** had two of them and drove in four in his 5-for-5 day ... Asheville won the final game of the set, which was started immediately after the continued game ... High Point also dropped two non-conference matchups to Campbell 16-7, and Appalachian State 4-3 (11 innings). The loss to ASU was the Panthers first loss in extra innings this season (2-1) ... Against Presbyterian, closer **JEREMY BERG** picked up two saves, including coming in with a first and third situation and striking out the only batter he saw in the 6-5 victory Friday night.
