**BIG SOUTH KICKS OFF TELEVISION PACKAGE**

The 2009 Big South Television package kicks off this Saturday and features Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb live on SportSouth and Fox College Sports Pacific at 11:30am ET. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **BRIAN JORDAN** (analyst) will call the action. It will be the first of three Big South "Game of the Week" broadcasts this season, as the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN) will air next week's Coastal Carolina at Stony Brook contest, and the Nov. 7 VMI at Liberty tilt.

**THIRD-AND-TWO**

Saturday will be the third and final week featuring Conference openers, as Charleston Southern and Liberty begin their Big South schedules. Charleston Southern is 3-4 in Big South openers, and will open its Big South slate against Gardner-Webb for the second-straight year. It also is the first time that the Bucs are opening Conference play on the road since 2005. Liberty is 4-3 in League openers, and is looking to win three consecutive openers for the first time.

**1-0 BIG SOUTH TEAMS**

Coastal Carolina opened League play this past weekend with a 20-6 victory over VMI, and is 1-0 for the first time since 2007 and fifth time overall. The last time Coastal Carolina was 2-0 in League action was its playoff year of 2006. Gardner-Webb is 1-0 in League play for the first time since 2007, which was the last time the Runnin' Bulldogs started 2-0 in Big South action. Stony Brook is 1-0 for the first time since beginning its Big South affiliation last year.

**BLAZING THE TRAIL**

Liberty opens League play Saturday with its Big South-record 11-game Conference win streak in tow. During the current run, the Flames have scored at least 30 points in each game and is averaging 40.8 points, while holding their League brethren to 17.6 points. In that span, Liberty has won six consecutive home Big South games, a streak that began Nov. 11, 2006, and five on the road. The last team to defeat the Flames in a Big South contest was... Coastal Carolina in 2006 (W, 28-26 in Conway).

**PLAYING WITH FIRE**

Saturday's Coastal Carolina-Liberty matchup features the two stingiest defenses in the Big South. The Chanticleers are first in the League and fifth in the nation in scoring defense at 13.80 points allowed. Liberty is second to the Chants (and 23rd nationally) at 17.40. Coastal Carolina is first in the Big South in total defense (263.00), first in pass efficiency defense (93.93) and first in pass defense (126.20). Liberty is second in total defense (317.20), third in pass efficiency defense (128.38) and third in pass defense (170.40).

**DAILY DOUBLE**

Coastal Carolina is the first Big South team to achieve the following feat against two consecutive FCS opponents -- gain more than 400 yards of offense and limit the opposition to less than 250. In Week 4 against North Carolina A&T, the Chanticleers gained 414 yards and held the Aggies to 239. This past weekend against VMI, Coastal Carolina amassed 418 offensive yards and limited the Keydets to 243.

**MR. ALL-PURPOSE**

VMI senior **TIM MAYPRAY** became the Big South's all-time leader in all-purpose yards in Week 4 at No. 1 Richmond, and currently stands at 5,090 in his career. Maypray remains second among active Division I FCS players in all-purpose yards per play with a career average of 10.16. Bucknell's A.J. Kizekai is first at 11.22. Below is a breakdown of Maypray's yardage and respective rank in Big South history. He is the only player in League annals with 1,000 rushing, receiving and kickoff return yards.

**SHIP SHAPE**

Charleston Southern extended its home winning streak to seven games following its 47-10 win over Savannah State in Week 5. In that span, the Buccaneers are averaging 27.9 points while holding their opponents to 9.3 (195-65), including two shutouts. The streak is the third-longest home winning streak in Big South history. The second-longest home win streak is 11, while the League record is 12 consecutive home wins, accomplished by both Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern.

**CAN'T SAY THEY HAVE**

Gardner-Webb and Liberty are the lone teams to have not allowed a kickoff return for a touchdown in Big South games. Gardner-Webb's streak is at 29 games following its Big South opener against VMI, while Liberty's streak is 28 entering its League opener this weekend. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina holds the Big South's longest streak of not allowing a punt return touchdown in a Conference game at 26 games. The last time the Chanticleers allowed a punt return touchdown in a League game was in their first-ever Big South contest, Oct. 4, 2003 against Gardner-Webb.

**30 ROCK**

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is fourth all-time in Big South history with 33 career touchdowns and is approaching an elite group. Maypray, whose eight-game touchdown scoring streak (8 R, 3 P, 1 PR = 12 total) came to an end at Coastal Carolina, needs to reach the end zone seven more times to become the fourth member of the Big South's 40-touchdown club. Ahead of him are **JEROME SIMPSON** (44), **RA-SHAD JENNINGS** (46) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (47).

**CALL HIM TOUCHDOWN TIM**

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is the only player in Big South history, and the only active player in FCS, to score a rushing touchdown, receiving touchdown, kickoff return touchdown, punt return touchdown and pass for a touchdown. In addition, he is the only player in League history with at least 10 touchdown rushing (18) and receiving (12). Meanwhile, Maypray needs just two points to become the seventh player in League history with 200 career points scored.

**GO-GO-GOWINS**

Stony Brook sophomore RB **EDWIN GOWINS** has four rushing touchdowns this season, and has scored 12 of his 15 career scores in his last eight outings. His four running TDs in 2009 have gone for an average of 35.5 yards (39-27-44-32), and in his career, Gowins is averaging 35.6 yards per rushing touchdown (breakdown: 22 - 20 - 72 - 49 - 3 - 3 - 29 - 62 - 36 - 65 - 32 - 39 - 27 - 44 - 32). All but two of his 15 career scores have gone for at least 20 yards, with a career long of 72.

**HEADING THEM OFF AT THE PASS**

Coastal Carolina, which led the Big South in pass defense efficiency from 2004-07, is back atop the League in the category. The Chanticleers have a pass defense efficiency rating of 93.93, which is currently the second-lowest in a single-season in the Big South. Coastal Carolina is first in the League with 10 interceptions, and has allowed just four TD passes this year.

**GROUND GAINER**

Charleston Southern WR **GERALD STEVENSON**, who became the eighth player in Big South history with 3,000 career all-purpose yards in Week 4 against North Greenville, ranks seventh all-time with 3,284 in his career. He needs 312 yards to pass Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (2005-08) for sixth-place.

**KICK STARTERS**

Charleston Southern junior WR **GERALD STEVENSON**, who broke the Big South career record for most combined kickoff and punt return yards in Week 2, has not returned a kick in his past two games and is in jeopardy of losing his record, as VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is just five yards away from matching his combined yardage total. Maypray has surpassed Stevenson for second in Big South history with 90 combined kick returns, and is four punt/kickoff returns shy of tying the Big South career record of 94. Below is a look a breakdown of each player's combined kick return totals.

**GOLDEN GATES BRIDGE**

Gardner-Webb sophomore K **RYAN GATES**, who became the eighth kicker in Big South history with 100 career points when he reached the milestone in Week 2 at Western Carolina, is seventh all-time with 114. He needs six points to move into sixth-place. Meanwhile, Gates is already sixth in League annals with 24 career field goals, and owns four career 10-point kicking games, tied for third-most in Big South history.

**WILD WILD WES**

Stony Brook redshirt-freshman **WESLEY SKIFFINGTON** tied two Big South single-game records vs. Presbyterian in Week 5, as he made four field goals against the Blue Hose and finished with 16 points. He is just the second player with four field goals in a Conference game, while his 16 points are the most by a kicker in a League contest.

**BENNETT APPROACHING COACHING MILESTONE**

Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT** is two wins away from 50 victories as the Chanticleers' head coach.

**TREASURE CHEST**

For the first time since the Big South began football in 2002, Charleston Southern recorded back-to-back games with 500 yards of total offense. The Buccaneers amassed 516 in Week 4 vs. North Greenville, and 528 in Week 5 against Savannah State. For the second consecutive week, Charleston Southern collected 200 yards both rushing and passing. Prior to the North Greenville game, the last time CSU achieved this feat was during the 2005 campaign.

**MR. 3,000**

Stony Brook senior RB **CONTE CUTTINO** became the first player in school history with 3,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone against Presbyterian in Week 5. Cuttino's school record total now stands at 3,101 (1,489 in the Big South), and he is one of just seven active players in FCS with 3,000 career rushing yards. Meanwhile, teammate **EDWIN GOWINS** surpassed 1,500 career yards against Brown in Week 3, and has 1,721 rushing yards in just 16 career games (107.6 yards per game).

**SACK LUNCH**

Coastal Carolina senior **PHILLIP OBOH** leads the Big South with 4.0 quarterback sacks, and is tied for fourth on the Big South's all-time list with 14.0 in his career. Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is the all-time leader with 20.5. Meanwhile, GWU freshman **MATTHEW GOODS** is tied for second in the Big South with 3.5 sacks and is challenging to become the first Bulldog to lead the League in sacks since Johnston in 2006.

**YOU CAN CALL IT A SUCCESSFUL ROAD TRIP**

Gardner-Webb went 2-2 during its four-game road stretch, with the losses against FBS-members N.C. State and Buffalo. The Runnin' Bulldogs were just the second Big South team in League history to play four consecutive road games in one season. Former member Elon was the first to do so in the Big South's first football season in 2002, going 0-4.

**HE IS THE ONLY ONE**

Presbyterian College RB **TRANDON DENDY** is the only player in the Big South to lead his team in rushing in every game this season. He has racked up 85, 14, 44, 147, 59 yards and 106 yards in PC's six games for a Big South League-leading 455 rushing yards. Dendy is looking to become just the second player in the Conference's football history to lead his team in rushing in every game of the season. VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** led the Keydets in rushing in all 12 games of the 2003 season, VMI's first year in the Big South.

**GOING FOR TWO... HUNDRED**

Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** (138) and **CONTE CUTTINO** (62) combined for 200 rushing yards in a game for the first time this season when they finished with exactly 200 against Presbyterian College in Week 5. It is the sixth time the duo has combined for 200 rushing yards in a game, with Stony Brook going 5-1 in those games.

**IN CASE YOU WERE WONDERING...**

Liberty DT **TREY JACOBS** is tied with VMI's **ERIC HALL** (2003-06) for first in the Big South history with five career blocked kicks.

**HE IS HUGHES**

VMI senior QB **KYLE HUGHES** sits in fourth-place on the Big South's all-time quarterback rushing list with 869 in his career, and is 131 yards shy of becoming the fourth Big South QB with 1,000 career rushing yards. In Week 4 at No. 1 Richmond, Hughes had his second career game with both 100 rushing and 100 passing yards when he rushed for 133 yards and threw for 141. He joined Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** as the only players in Big South history to accomplish this feat twice.

**POINT OF ORDER**

VMI has scored a point in its last 54 games -- the longest run in the history of the program. Liberty's current streak stands at 44 games, while Presbyterian has not been shutout in its last 36 games. Gardner-Webb has not been blanked in 16 consecutive contests, followed by Stony Brook (11), Coastal Carolina (4) and Charleston Southern (2).

**RUSH WEEK**

VMI has not had an individual rush for 100 yards in back-to-back games, the first such occurrence since the 2007 season (Sept. 15 at James Madison and Sept. 22 at Lehigh). The Keydets managed just 168 rushing yards at Coastal Carolina this past weekend, their fewest rushing yards in a Big South game since 2005, when VMI gained just 39 yards on the ground at Coastal Carolina on Oct. 29, 2005.

**A RACE FOR NO. 19**

Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** enters the week with 973 career receiving yards, just 27 away from becoming the 19th player in Big South history with 1,000. Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** also is approaching the milestone with 944 (56 shy). If Perry should eclipse the mark Saturday against Charleston Southern, he would be the sixth GWU player on the Big South's career 1,000-yard receiving list. If Stevenson reaches the milestone Saturday, he would be the fifth Buccaneer player on the list.

**PORT AUTHORITY**

Stony Brook WR **DONALD PORTER** became the first player in Big South football history with two 50-yard touchdown receptions in the same game when he accomplished the feat vs. Presbyterian College in Week 5. Porter hauled in a 59-yard touchdown pass in the second quarter, then added a 60-yard TD catch and run in the fourth quarter.

**TACKLE BOX**

Gardner-Webb senior LB **MARIO BROWN** is the Big South's active leading career tackler with 269 career stops. He needs 31 hits to become just the seventh player in League history with 300 career tackles. Teammate **JEFFERY WILLIAMS** has 266 career tackles in 27 career games (9.85 per game), and is 34 tackles away from 300.

**HE'S THE REAL O'NEAL**

Coastal Carolina junior RB **ERIC O'NEAL** rushed for 78 yards this past Saturday against VMI to become the 25th player in Big South history with 1,000 in a career. O'Neal is currently at 1,050. Meanwhile, **EDWIN GOWINS** needs 49 rushing yards to crack the Big South's top 10 leaders, and VMI senior **HOWARD ABEGESAH** is 14 yards away from unseating Coastal Carolina's **PATRICK HALL** for sixth on the career list. **A DAY AT THE BEACH**

Coastal Carolina rushed for 304 yards in Week 4 vs. North Carolina A&T, its first game over 300 rushing yards since gaining 302 against Towson last season. The Chanticleers have gained 300 yards on the ground 13 times in their existence, tied with VMI for the most in Big South history, and are 13-0 in those games. Coastal Carolina has posted at least one 300-yard rushing game in every season since its inception in 2003.

**SWEET SIX-HUNDRED**

Stony Brook gained 623 yards of offense in its Big South opener against Presbyterian in Week 5, the third time in a seven-game span that the Seawolves amassed 600 offensive yards. SBU is the first Big South team with three games over 600, and its total against PC was the second-highest in a Conference game. Coastal Carolina owns the League game record with 638 against Gardner-Webb in 2006.

**FB-YES**

The Big South is playing a League-record eight games against FBS opponents in 2009. The previous high was five, just last year. Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb each are playing two FBS foes this season.

**POLLSTERS**

Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Liberty, Stony Brook and VMI all received votes in *The Sports Network* Top 25 poll the week of Sept. 8, marking the first time in League history that every Big South football team received Top 25 consideration in one season. Charleston Southern, Coastal, GWU, LU, SBU and Presbyterian received votes in *The Sports Network's* preseason poll.

**MEET THE CANDIDATE**

Gardner-Webb LB **JEFFERY WILLIAMS** is one of 20 candidates on the preseason Buck Buchanan Award list, marking the third consecutive season and fourth overall a Big South student-athlete has been named an official candidate for the national Defensive Player of the Year award in FCS.

**BIG SOUTH GETS BIGGER IN 2009**

The Big South football membership is at seven members in 2009, including six Division I programs for the second-straight year. Presbyterian College, which is in the final two years of its transition to Division I, is now considered an official Conference opponent in the Big South this year, and the Blue Hose will count in the standings. The addition gives the Big South a six-game Conference schedule for the first time in League history. However, PC will not be eligible for the Big South football championship until it becomes a full-fledged member of NCAA Division I in 2011.

**THE COUNTDOWN BEGINS TO THE BIG SOUTH'S AUTOMATIC BID IN 2010**

The Big South Conference is just one year away from receiving an automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs. As part of the NCAA's expansion of the FCS Playoffs to 20 teams beginning in 2010, the Big South was granted an automatic bid to the playoffs that same year. The Big South's six Division I playing members are eligible to receive an at-large playoff berth in 2009.
