CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

A.J. TOSCANO • QB • R-Junior
Charleston Southern • Pico River, Calif.

Toscano amassed 351 yards of total offense and was responsible for five touchdowns in the Buccaneers' win at Presbyterian College. He was 18-of-32 passing for 290 yards and four touchdowns, and was the team's leading rusher with 61 yards and a score. Toscano threw a touchdown pass in each quarter and scored on an 11-yard run in the third stanza. He averaged 9.1 yards per pass attempt and did not throw an interception for the second-straight game.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JOSH NORMAN • DB • Sophomore
Coastal Carolina • Greenwood, S.C.

Norman tied a Big South single-game record with three interceptions -- all in the second half -- in Coastal Carolina's home win over Gardner-Webb. His first interception ended a GWU scoring threat deep in Coastal territory, and set up the Chanticleers' first touchdown of the second half. Norman's second pick ended Gardner-Webb's next-to-last drive on its first play, and his final interception sealed Coastal's victory as he picked off a pass in the end zone with less than 30 seconds to play. Norman now has a Big South single-season record seven interceptions on the year.

Bevins tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals against VMI Saturday, and finished with a career-best 16 points against the Keydets. Bevins averaged 40.8 yards on his four field goals, as he hit from 42, 38, 40 and 43 yards, and is now just the second player in Big South history to make four field goals in a game twice in a career. He also was perfect on 4-of-4 PAT attempts. Bevins now ranks second nationally in field goals per game (1.89) and ninth nationally in scoring (9.22 points per game).

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

LANCE BYRD • RB
Presbyterian College • Jacksonville, Fla.

In his first career start, Byrd rushed for a school-record 274 yards and two touchdowns against Charleston Southern, the second-highest single-game total in Big South history and the most in a Conference game. He established a PC Division I record with 159 rushing yards in the first half, and in the fourth quarter, he broke the 16-year school record of 254 rushing yards on a draw play. Byrd averaged 8.3 yards on his 33 carries, had 10 rushes of greater than 10 yards -- including four carries for more than 20 yards, and finished the day with 286 all-purpose yards.

TWO BY FOUR

For the first time in League history, the Big South has two teams that are 4-0 in League play. Stony Brook and Liberty are currently tied for first in the Conference standings at 4-0, and will play for at least a share of the regular-season championship the final weekend of the season on Nov. 21. Liberty is the first Big South team to open 4-0 three consecutive seasons.

BYRD IS THE WORD

Presbyterian College freshman **LANCE BYRD** rushed for a school-record 274 yards in his first career start this past Saturday against Charleston Southern, the second-highest single-game total in Big South history and the most in a Conference game. Byrd finished four yards shy of matching the record of 278 rushing yards, which was set by Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** last season as a freshman against Iona. Byrd did eclipse Gowins' Conference game rushing mark of 250 yards, which was accomplished against VMI in 2008.

IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed four players on the *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III team last week -- Liberty's **MATT BEVINS** and **CHRIS ROCCO**, Gardner-Webb's **MARIO BROWN** and Presbyterian's **MATT FREEMAN**. It is the fourth time in eight seasons that the Conference has had at least four All-District honorees.

BLAZING THE TRAIL

Liberty extended its Big South win streak to 15 games (9 home wins, 6 road victories) with its 54-14 win over VMI this past Saturday, the longest Conference win streak in League history and now the third-longest active League winning streak among FCS programs, trailing Appalachian State (18) and South Carolina State (17). Liberty, which is the only team of the three not to lose a Conference game since 2006, has set the Big South record for longest home Conference winning streak at nine, breaking the old mark of eight, which was established by Coastal Carolina from Oct. 23, 2004 - Nov. 10, 2007. Below is a closer look at the Flames' 15-game Big South streak.

TURNING 50 IS A GOOD THING

Liberty has scored 50 points against every Big South team except Stony Brook and Gardner-Webb under head coach **DANNY ROCCO**. The Flames are also the first team to score 50 points in three consecutive home Big South games, as well as post three 50-point games during the Conference season.

NORM!

Coastal Carolina sophomore **JOSH NORMAN** tied the Big South single-game record with three interceptions this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb. The three picks pushed his season total to seven, breaking the Big South single-season record of six, which was set by former Chanticleer **QUINTON TEAL** in 2004 and matched by Charleston Southern's **PHILLIP ASHLEY** last season. Norman now has nine career interceptions to rank fifth all-time in Big South history and fourth on Coastal's career chart.

RECORD RETURN

Charleston Southern's **ANTWAIN HARVEY** recorded the longest interception return in Big South history this past Saturday at Presbyterian College when he picked off a **TIM WEBB** pass deep in the end zone and returned it 100 yards for a touchdown. He is the second FCS player with a 100-yard interception return this season. The previous record INT return in the Big South was 94 yards by Liberty's **ERICK HARRIS** against Norfolk State in 2002.

KID IN THE HALL

Gardner-Webb junior running back **PATRICK HALL** rushed for two touchdowns this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina to move into a tie for the Big South touchdown lead with nine. It was Hall's League-leading fourth multi-TD game of the season. Hall has scored a touchdown in 11 of his 29 career games, with seven of those 11 being multi-TD performances.

HONEST ABE

VMI senior RB **HOWARD ABEGESAH** moved into fourth-place all-time in Big South history in career rushing yards in Week 9 vs. Charleston Southern, and enters the final two weeks of the season with 2,662 career rushing yards. Abegesah is 338 rushing yards away from the Big South's 3,000-yard club, and needs to average 169.0 yards in his final two games to reach the milestone.

THE BUC STOPS HERE

Charleston Southern's 46 points at Presbyterian College this past Saturday was its most-ever in a Big South game. The Buccaneers also returned four interceptions for 153 yards against the Blue Hose, the second-highest return yardage total in League history and the most-ever in a Conference game. Charleston Southern (485) and Presbyterian (530) combined for 1,015 yards of offense, the fourth-most in a Big South game and the 11th highest total overall. The teams combined for 78 points, the sixth-highest combined total in a League tilt.

BENNETT ONE WIN AWAY FROM 50

Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT** is just one victory away from 50 wins as the Chanticleers' head coach.

HE'S NOT PLAYING LIKE A COLT

Stony Brook sophomore QB **MICHAEL COULTER** is the first player in Big South history to throw two touchdown passes in six consecutive games, as he has recorded 12 of his 14 TD passes in the Seawolves' last half-dozen outings. In his last five games, Coulter has thrown for 1,216 yards (243.2 average), 10 TDs and has a 152.7 efficiency rating as Stony Brook has gone 4-1. Coulter has thrown a TD in all but one game this season, including his last seven contests.

HE SHOULD CONSIDER CHANGING HIS NAME TO BARRY ALLEN

Liberty true freshman RB **ALDREAKIS ALLEN** is tied for the Big South lead with nine touchdowns this season, all rushing. No TRUE freshman has ever led the Big South in touchdowns scored. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** tied for the Conference lead with 14 rushing touchdowns as a redshirt-freshman in 2003. Meanwhile, Allen is two rushing scores away from tying the Big South true freshman record of 11, set by Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** last season.

MR. ALL-PURPOSE

VMI senior **TIM MAYPRAY** played his final Big South game this past weekend in the Keydets' loss at Liberty. The Big South's all-time leader with 5,808 all-purpose yards, Maypray amassed 3,396 yards against Big South members. He is currently fourth among active Division I FCS players in all-purpose yards, and is third in all-purpose yards per play with a career average of 9.98. Below is a breakdown of Maypray's yardage and respective rank in Big South history, as well as his career total against every Big South team. Maypray is the only player in League annals with 1,000 rushing, receiving and kickoff return yards.

ADVANTAGE: MAYPRAY

VMI senior **TIM MAYPRAY** is the Big South's career leader in kickoff returns (89) and kickoff return yards (1,969), as well as the League's record holder for combined kickoff/punt returns (114) and combined kickoff/punt return yardage (2,239) -- for now. Charleston Southern junior **GERALD STEVENSON**, who originally broke the Big South career record for most combined kickoff/punt return yards in Week 2, trails Maypray in all four categories, but has one more year of eligibility in 2010. Below is a look a breakdown of each player's combined kick return totals.

OH THANK HEAVENS FOR BEVINS

Liberty sophomore **MATT BEVINS** tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals this past Saturday vs. VMI, and now has 17 on the year -- tying the single-season Big South record, which was first set by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003. Bevins posted his third 10-point kicking game of the season against the Keydets and now has five in his young career. He leads the Big South with 83 points scored, which is tied for the third-highest kick scoring total in League history.

KICK STAND

Gardner-Webb's **RYAN GATES** needs two more field goals to become the first player in Big South history with 15 in back-to-back seasons. Stony Brook's **WESLEY SKIFFINGTON** is 13-of-14 on field goal attempts this season, and his 92.9 success rate is pacing ahead of the League record of 84.6 percent (based on 10 field goals made), set by VMI's **BARRETT WAY** in 2005 (11-of-13). Meanwhile, a Big South-record five placekickers have made at least 10 field goals this season.

BUCKING THE TREND

Charleston Southern is third in the Big South in rushing offense with 164.4 yards per game, its highest average since the 2000 season when the Buccaneers averaged 179.8 rushing yards a contest. In the last six games alone, CSU has gained 1,219 yards on the ground for a 203.2 average, and is 4-2 in that span. In Week 8, the Bucs rushed for 185 yards against Liberty, the most allowed by the Flames against a Conference foe other than VMI since Coastal Carolina rushed for 213 yards in 2007.

HUGHES RUSH

VMI senior QB **KYLE HUGHES**, who became the fourth quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 8 at Presbyterian College, needs nine rushing yards to pass Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (1,182 yards from 2002-05) for third-place on Big South's all-time QB rushing list. Hughes is one of two QBs in Big South history to rush for 100 yards and pass for 100 yards in a game twice. Former Coastal Carolina and current Miami Dolphin **TYLER THIGPEN** is the other.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI has scored a point in its last 58 games -- the longest run in the history of the program and the second-longest scoring streak in Big South history. Liberty's current streak stands at 50 games, while Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 39 games. Gardner-Webb has not been blanked in 20 consecutive contests, followed by Stony Brook (14), Coastal Carolina (8) and Charleston Southern (6).

NORTHERN EXPOSURE

Stony Brook senior RB **CONTE CUTTINO** is the first player in school history with 3,000 career rushing yards, and his school record total now stands at 3,355 (1,743 in the Big South), seventh-highest among the nine active FCS players with 3,000 career rushing yards. Meanwhile, teammate **EDWIN GOWINS** has 1,858 rushing yards in 19 career games, and ranks sixth among active FCS players with 97.8 yards per game.

IN THE LEAD

VMI senior RB **HOWARD ABEGESAH** continues to lead the Big South in rushing yards with 766 -- 212 yards away from his nearest competitor. Abegesah led the Big South in rushing in 2007 with 1,121, and if he can maintain his hold on the top spot, he would become just the second player to lead the Big South in rushing twice. Liberty's **DRE BARNES** was the Big South's leading rusher in 2002 and 2003. Abegesah needs 234 rushing yards to become the fourth player in League annals with two 1,000-yard rushing seasons.

CAN'T SAY THEY HAVE

Gardner-Webb and Liberty are the only teams to have not allowed a kickoff return for a touchdown in a Big South game, a span of 32 games each. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina holds the Big South's longest streak of not allowing a punt return touchdown in a Conference game at 29 games. The last time the Chanticleers allowed a punt return touchdown in a League game was in their first-ever Big South contest, Oct. 4, 2003 against Gardner-Webb.

30 ROCK

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is fourth all-time in Big South history with 37 career touchdowns and is approaching an elite group. Maypray, who became just the sixth player in Big South annals with 20 career rushing touchdowns in Week 7, needs to reach the end zone three more times to become the fourth member of the Big South's 40-touchdown club. Ahead of him are **JEROME SIMPSON** (44), **RASHAD JENNINGS** (46) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (47).

BIG SOUTH STAT OF THE WEEK

Liberty has scored on its first possession seven times in nine games this season, the best mark among the Big South members. In fact, the Flames have scored on their first possession the last five games (3 touchdowns, 2 field goals). The overall total could be eight, as Liberty missed a field goal attempt on its first possession against North Carolina Central on Sept. 12.

Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Stony Brook and VMI each have scored on their respective first possessions three times, while Presbyterian College has managed to score only once on its first possessions this season.

CROWD PLEASERS

Liberty has set the Big South single-season record for average attendance, as the Flames averaged 14,931 fans in six home games this season. The old record average was 14,190, set by Liberty in 2007. This season, the Flames drew the largest home crowd in program and Big South Conference history in Week 2, as 16,112 fans witnessed the Flames' 35-10 victory over North Carolina Central. In addition, this past Saturday's crowd of 15,208 for the VMI game was the largest crowd for a Big South contest.

NOVEMBER SWEEPS

Coastal Carolina and Liberty are the winningest Big South teams (not including Stony Brook and Presbyterian College) in the month of November since 2003. The Chanticleers own the highest regular-season winning percentage at .750 (15-5), while the Flames have won the most games in November (17) in the same span. Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003.

KICK IT

Big South placekickers are a combined 34-of-39 on field goals from 30-39 yards, an 87.2 percentage. Five teams -- Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Liberty, Stony Brook and VMI -- are currently perfect from that distance this season. Overall, Big South placekickers are 72-of-96 on field goal attempts this season for an all-time League-best 75.0 percentage, pacing ahead of the current top season percentage of 67.5 percent (2007). The 72 field goals are the most combined total among the Big South programs in one season. Last season, the seven Conference members combined for 70 field goals.

AUDIBLE

Coastal Carolina ran 88 plays against Gardner-Webb this past Saturday, the most in the League since Presbyterian ran 93 plays against VMI in 2008. It was the most plays in a Big South game since VMI ran 95 against Gardner-Webb in 2007, and the third-highest play total in a League contest.

PERRY III IS XIX, AND XV

Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III**, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 1,000 career receiving yards when he eclipsed the milestone vs. Charleston Southern in Week 7, became the 15th player in League history (and sixth GWU player) with 100 career catches when he reached the mark this past weekend at Coastal Carolina. The redshirt-sophomore has 101 receptions for 1,215 yards in just 20 career games.

EVEN STEVEN

Charleston Southern junior WR **GERALD STEVENSON** became the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 career receiving yards when he surpassed the milestone against Liberty in Week 8. He is the fifth Buccaneer player on the list, and has 1,211 yards on 99 career receptions. His next reception will make him the fourth CSU player with 100 catches in the Big South's football history. Meanwhile, Stevenson is now fourth all-time with 3,813 all-purpose yards in his career after passing Liberty's **DRE BARNES** (3,782 from 2002-04) this past weekend. He needs 187 yards to become the fourth player with 4,000 in a career.

TACKLE BOX

Gardner-Webb reshirt-senior LB **MARIO BROWN** surpassed 300 career tackles this past weekend at Coastal Carolina, as his 12 stops pushed his career total to 301. He is the seventh player in League history to tackle this milestone, and he needs eight stops to jump into fourth-place in League history. Teammate **JEFFERY WILLIAMS** has 286 career stops and is 14 hits shy of joining Brown in the 300-tackle club.

RUSHING UPDATE

Gardner-Webb junior **PATRICK HALL** is the 27th player in Big South history to crack the Big South's career 1,000-yard rushing list. HE DOES THIS A LOT

Gardner-Webb senior QB **STAN DOOLITTLE** is fifth all-time in Big South history with 456 career completions. He is 44 completions away from becoming just the third QB in Big South history with 500 in a career. In front of him are Liberty's **BROCK SMITH** (484) and Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (486). Meanwhile, Doolittle is 304 passing yards away from 5,000 in his career.

FULL MONTY

Gardner-Webb senior RB **DAVID MONTGOMERY** became the Big South's career leader for most receptions by a running back in Week 9 vs. Stony Brook with his 69th career catch. He surpassed former Gardner-Webb rusher **JERMAINE BOSTON** (2002-05), who held the mark with 68 receptions. Montgomery's record total stands at 70.

THE KEYS TO SUCCESS

VMI is second in the Big South in rushing defense at 130.9 yards per game, and is the only Big South team this season to not allow an opponent to rush for 200 yards in a game. In Week 8 at Presbyterian College, the Keydets held the Blue Hose to 36 rushing yards, the fewest the Keydets have allowed in a Big South game since joining the Conference in 2003. It was their lowest amount allowed to an opponent since VMI held St. Francis (Pa.) to minus-2 rushing yards in the 2008 season opener.

BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Liberty leads the Big South in both scoring offense (35.1) and scoring defense (16.2), a feat they accomplished in 2007. If the Flames can maintain its hold on both categories, they would become the first Big South team to lead the Conference in scoring offense and scoring defense in the same season twice. Meanwhile, Liberty is looking for its fourth consecutive League scoring defense title.

GO-GO-GOWINS

Stony Brook sophomore RB **EDWIN GOWINS'** four rushing TDs this season have gone for an average of 35.5 yards (39-27-44-32), and in his career, Gowins is averaging 35.6 yards per rushing touchdown (breakdown: 22 - 20 - 72 - 49 - 3 - 3 - 29 - 62 - 36 - 65 - 32 - 39 - 27 - 44 - 32). All but two of his 15 career scores have gone for at least 20 yards, with a career long of 72. Gowins scored 12 of his 15 career scores during a nine-game stretch from Nov. 1, 2008 - Oct. 10, 2009.

CALL HIM TOUCHDOWN TIM

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is the only player in Big South history, and the only active player in FCS, to score a rushing touchdown, receiving touchdown, kickoff return touchdown, punt return touchdown and pass for a touchdown. In addition, he is the only player in League history with at least 20 rushing touchdowns (22) and 10 receiving touchdowns (12). Meanwhile, Maypray became the seventh player in League history to reach the 200-point plateau when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 7 against Stony Brook. Maypray now has 222 career points -- which is fourth-most by a non-kicker.

FB-YES

The Big South is playing a League-record eight games against FBS opponents in 2009. The previous high was five, just last year. Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb each played two FBS foes this season.

POLLSTERS

Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Liberty, Stony Brook and VMI all received votes in *The Sports Network* Top 25 poll the week of Sept. 8, marking the first time in League history that every Big South football team received Top 25 consideration in one season. Charleston Southern, Coastal, GWU, LU, SBU and Presbyterian received votes in *The Sports Network's* preseason poll.

BIG SOUTH GETS BIGGER IN 2009

The Big South football membership is at seven members in 2009, including six Division I programs for the second-straight year. Presbyterian College, which is in the final two years of its transition to Division I, is now considered an official Conference opponent in the Big South this year, and the Blue Hose will count in the standings. The addition gives the Big South a six-game Conference schedule for the first time in League history. However, PC will not be eligible for the Big South football championship until it becomes a full-fledged member of NCAA Division I in 2011.

THE COUNTDOWN BEGINS TO THE BIG SOUTH'S AUTOMATIC BID IN 2010

The Big South Conference is just one year away from receiving an automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs. As part of the NCAA's expansion of the FCS Playoffs to 20 teams beginning in 2010, the Big South was granted an automatic bid to the playoffs that same year. The Big South's six Division I playing members are eligible to receive an at-large playoff berth in 2009.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS (4-5, 2-2 Big South)
