### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**TOMMY BEECHER • QB • R-Senior**  
 Liberty • Concord, N.C.

Beecher was nearly perfect in Liberty's victory over Presbyterian College, as he completed 15-of-17 passes (-88.2 percent) for 159 yards and two touchdowns. He was responsible for a third touchdown with a 5-yard scamper in the first quarter. Beecher, who entered the game with just one touchdown pass in six previous appearances, finished with a 205.62 passing efficiency rating against the Blue Hose, as well as 169 yards of total offense. His 88.2 completion percentage is the highest by a Big South quarterback in a game with between 15-19 completions.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**ARIN WEST • DB • Junior**  
 Stony Brook • Toms River, N.J.

West was a key factor in a Stony Brook defense that held Gardner-Webb to almost 80 yards under its season average on offense, and just 14 points scored. He made 11 tackles (five solo), with eight coming in the first half, including one that held GWU from a first down. In the second half, West recovered a fumble and returned it 16 yards for a touchdown that tied the game at 14-14. On Gardner-Webb's next series, he forced another fumble that ended GWU's drive at the SBU 21-yard line. West added a pass break-up on Gardner-Webb's final drive of the day.

It was the only chance to return a kick that VMI gave him, and it was the longest of his 10 career punt returns. Ivey added a 2-yard touchdown run later in the period to give the Buccaneers a 21-14 lead.

Holloway enjoyed a breakout game against Presbyterian College, as he recorded career highs with 12 carries and 99 rushing yards to lead the Flames' rushing attack. Holloway more than doubled his rushing total of 86 yards entering the game, and posted his second multi-touchdown game of the season.

**AND THEN THERE WERE TWO...**

For the sixth time in the last seven seasons, the Big South has a team that is 4-0 in League play, as the Stony Brook Seawolves sit atop the Conference standings at 4-0 following their 24-14 win at Gardner-Webb this past weekend. Meanwhile, Liberty improved to 3-0 in the Big South this season, and enters this week with a chance to become the first team in Big South history to open Conference action 4-0 in three consecutive seasons.

**VMI, LIBERTY MEET IN FINAL "ROYAL PURPLE BIG SOUTH GAME OF THE WEEK" TELECAST**

The final "Royal Purple Big South Game of the Week" television broadcast is set for this weekend, as the VMI-Liberty game from Lynchburg will air live on the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN) beginning at 7:00pm. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **RAY JONES** (analyst) will call all the action. The game will be simulcast on WWMB-CW 21 in Conway/Myrtle Beach.

**BLAZING THE TRAIL**

Liberty extended its Big South win streak to 14 games (8 home wins, 6 road victories) with its 55-19 win over Presbyterian College this past Saturday, the longest Conference win streak in League history and now the third-longest active League winning streak among FCS programs, trailing Appalachian State (17) and South Carolina State (16). Liberty, which is the only team of the three not to lose a Conference game since 2006, has tied the Big South record for longest home Conference winning streak at eight. Coastal Carolina won eight consecutive Big South home games from Oct. 23, 2004 - Nov. 10, 2007. Below is a closer look at the Flames' 14-game Big South streak.

**HE'S NOT PLAYING LIKE A COLT**

Stony Brook sophomore QB **MICHAEL COULTER** is the first player in Big South history to throw two touchdown passes in six consecutive games, as he has recorded 12 of his 14 TD passes in the Seawolves' last half-dozen outings. In his last five games, Coulter has thrown for 1,216 yards (243.2 average), 10 TDs and has a 152.7 efficiency rating while Stony Brook is 4-1. Coulter has thrown a TD in all but one game this season, including his last seven contests.

**HONEST ABE**

VMI senior RB **HOWARD ABEGESAH** moved into fourth-place all-time in Big South history in career rushing yards this past weekend vs. Charleston Southern. He rushed for 160 yards against the Buccaneers -- his second-straight game with at least 160 -- to push his career total to 2,587 and move past Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL**, who gained 2,479 yards from 2005-08. Abegesah is 413 rushing yards away from the Big South's 3,000-yard club, and needs to average 137.7 yards in his final three games to reach the milestone.

**FULL MONTY**

Gardner-Webb senior RB **DAVID MONTGOMERY** caught four passes vs. Stony Brook this past weekend, pushing his career total to 69 to become the Big South's career leader for most receptions by a running back. Montgomery passed former Gardner-Webb rusher **JERMAINE BOSTON** (2002-05), who held the mark with 68 receptions.

**BUCKING THE TREND**

Charleston Southern is third in the Big South in rushing offense with 160.6 yards per game, its highest average since the 2000 season when the Buccaneers averaged 179.8 rushing yards a contest. In the last five games alone, CSU has gained 1,024 yards on the ground, a 204.8 average in that span. In Week 8, the Bucs rushed for 185 yards against Liberty, the most allowed by the Flames against a Conference foe other than VMI since Coastal Carolina rushed for 213 yards in 2007.

**A DAY AT THE BEECH**

Liberty QB **TOMMY BEECHER** recorded the highest single-game completion percentage by a Big South quarterback in a game with between 15-19 completions, as he was 15-of-17 passing for an 88.2 clip against Presbyterian College this past weekend. He also threw his first touchdown passes since the season opener at West Virginia. In his last four games, Beecher has been nearly flawless, as he is completing 80.0 percent of his passes (64-of-80) for 677 yards, along with a 156.83 efficiency rating.

**HE DOES THIS A LOT**

Gardner-Webb senior QB **STAN DOOLITTLE** moved past former teammate **DEVIN CAMPBELL** for fifth-place in Big South history with 447 career completions. Campbell completed 440 passes during his GWU career from 2005-08. Doolittle is 53 completions away from becoming just the third QB in Big South history with 500 in a career. In front of him are Liberty's **BROCK SMITH** (484) and Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (486). Meanwhile, Doolittle is 407 passing yards away from 5,000 in his career.

**HE DOES THIS A LITTLE**

Gardner-Webb senior QB **STAN DOOLITTLE** has thrown just two interceptions in 249 pass attempts this season, one of two QBs in the Football Championship Subdivision with 2-or-less INTs with more than 200 pass attempts. The other is Appalachian State's **ARMANTI EDWARDS**, who has thrown only one pick in 215 attempts thus far.

**HE SHOULD CONSIDER CHANGING HIS NAME TO BARRY ALLEN**

In a flash, Liberty true freshman RB **ALDREAKIS ALLEN** has taken over the Big South lead with nine touchdowns this season, all rushing. No TRUE freshman has ever led the Big South in touchdowns scored. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** tied for the Conference lead with 14 rushing touchdowns as a redshirt-freshman in 2003. Meanwhile, Allen is two rushing scores away from tying the Big South true freshman record of 11, set by Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** last season.

**MR. ALL-PURPOSE**

VMI senior **TIM MAYPRAY** will play his final Big South game this week when the Keydets travel to Liberty. The Big South's all-time leader with 5,600 all-purpose yards, Maypray broke the Conference record in Week 4 at No. 1 Richmond. He is fourth among active Division I FCS players in all-purpose yards, and is third in all-purpose yards per play with a career average of 9.96. Below is a breakdown of Maypray's yardage and respective rank in Big South history, as well as his career total against every Big South team (3,188 yards total). Maypray is the only player in League annals with 1,000 rushing, receiving and kickoff return yards.

**GROUND GAINER**

Charleston Southern WR **GERALD STEVENSON**, who became the eighth player in Big South history with 3,000 career all-purpose yards in Week 4 against North Greenville, is now fifth all-time with 3,635 in his career after passing Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (3,595 yards from 2005-08) and Gardner-Webb's **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (3,614 from 2004-07) this past weekend. Stevenson needs 148 to surpass Liberty's **DRE BARNES** (3,782 from 2002-04) for fourth all-time, and 365 to become the fourth player with 4,000 in a career.

**ADVANTAGE MAYPRAY**

VMI senior **TIM MAYPRAY** is the Big South's career leader in kickoff returns (84) and kickoff return yards (1,850), as well as the League's record holder for combined kickoff/punt returns (107) and combined kickoff/punt return yardage (2,122) -- for now. Charleston Southern junior **GERALD STEVENSON**, who originally broke the Big South career record for most combined kickoff/punt return yards in Week 2, trails Maypray in all four categories, but has one more year of eligibility in 2010. Below is a look a breakdown of each player's combined kick return totals.

**GETTING THEIR KICKS**

Liberty's **MATT BEVINS**, Gardner-Webb's **RYAN GATES** and Stony Brook's **WES SKIFFINGTON** are tied for the Big South lead with 13 field goals this season -- just four away from tying the single-season record of 17, which was set by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003. Gates needs two more field goals to become the first player in Big South history with 15 in back-to-back seasons. Skiffington is 13-of-14 on field goal attempts this season, and his 92.9 success rate is pacing ahead of the League record of 84.6 percent (based on 10 field goals made), set by VMI's **BARRETT WAY** in 2005 (11-of-13). Meanwhile, a Big South-record five placekickers have made at least 10 field goals this season.

**HE IS THE ONLY ONE**

Presbyterian College RB **TRANDON DENDY** is the only player in the Big South to lead his team in rushing in every game this season. He has racked up 85, 14, 44, 147, 59, 106, 47 and 52 yards in PC's eight games for 554 rushing yards. He also scored a touchdown in five-straight -- the second-longest streak in the Big South this year. Dendy is looking to become just the second player in the Conference's football history to lead his team in rushing in every game of the season. VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** led the Keydets in rushing in all 12 games of the 2003 season, VMI's first year in the Big South.

**HE IS HUGHES**

VMI senior QB **KYLE HUGHES**, who became the fourth quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 8 at Presbyterian College, needs 44 rushing yards to pass Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (1,182 yards from 2002-05) for third-place on Big South's all-time QB rushing list. Hughes is one of two QBs in Big South history to rush for 100 yards and pass for 100 yards in a game twice. Former Coastal Carolina and current Miami Dolphin **TYLER THIGPEN** is the other.

**POINT OF ORDER**

VMI has scored a point in its last 57 games -- the longest run in the history of the program and the second-longest scoring streak in Big South history. Liberty's current streak stands at 49 games, while Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 38 games. Gardner-Webb has not been blanked in 19 consecutive contests, followed by Stony Brook (14), Coastal Carolina (7) and Charleston Southern (5).

**NORTHERN EXPOSURE**

Stony Brook senior RB **CONTE CUTTINO** became the first player in school history with 3,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone against Presbyterian College in Week 5. Cuttino's school record total now stands at 3,355 (1,743 in the Big South), seventh-highest among the nine active FCS players with 3,000 career rushing yards. Meanwhile, teammate **EDWIN GOWINS** surpassed 1,500 career yards against Brown in Week 3, and has 1,858 rushing yards in 19 career games to rank sixth among active FCS players with 97.8 yards per game.

**IN THE LEAD**

VMI senior RB **HOWARD ABEGESAH** has rushed for 325 yards in his last two games to take over the Big South's season rushing lead with 691 -- 137 yards away from his nearest competitor. Abegesah led the Big South in rushing in 2007 with 1,121, and if he can maintain his hold on the top spot, he would become just the second player to lead the Big South in rushing twice. Liberty's **DRE BARNES** was the Big South's leading rusher in 2002 and 2003.

**WHEN TURNING 50 IS A GOOD THING**

Liberty has now scored 50 points against every Big South team except Stony Brook and Gardner-Webb under head coach **DANNY ROCCO**. The Flames are also the first team to score 50 points in back-to-back home Big South games.

**CAN'T SAY THEY HAVE**

Gardner-Webb and Liberty are the only teams to have not allowed a kickoff return for a touchdown in a Big South game, a span of 31 games each. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina holds the Big South's longest streak of not allowing a punt return touchdown in a Conference game at 28 games. The last time the Chanticleers allowed a punt return touchdown in a League game was in their first-ever Big South contest, Oct. 4, 2003 against Gardner-Webb.

**30 ROCK**

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is fourth all-time in Big South history with 36 career touchdowns and is approaching an elite group. Maypray, who became just the sixth player in Big South annals with 20 career rushing touchdowns in Week 7, needs to reach the end zone four more times to become the fourth member of the Big South's 40-touchdown club. Ahead of him are **JEROME SIMPSON** (44), **RASHAD JENNINGS** (46) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (47).

**BIG SOUTH STAT OF THE WEEK**

*Big South placekickers are a combined 33-of-38 on field goals from 30-39 yards, an 86.8 percentage. Five teams -- Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Liberty, Stony Brook and VMI -- are currently perfect from that distance this season.*

*Overall, Big South placekickers are 65-of-87 on field goal attempts this season for an all-time League-best 74.7 percentage, pacing ahead of the current top season percentage of 67.5 percent (2007). The 65 field goals are the second-most combined total among the Big South programs in one season. Last season, the seven Conference members combined for 70 field goals.*

**PERRY III IS XIX, LOOKING TO BECOME XV**

Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III**, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 1,000 career receiving yards when he eclipsed the milestone vs. Charleston Southern in Week 7, is one reception shy of becoming the 15th player in League history (and sixth GWU player) with 100 career catches. The redshirt-sophomore has 1,186 yards on 99 receptions in just 19 career games.

**CROWD PLEASERS**

Liberty drew the largest home crowd in program and Big South Conference history in Week 2, as 16,112 fans witnessed the Flames' 35-10 victory over North Carolina Central. After five home games, the Flames are averaging 14,876 fans per game, which is pacing ahead of its Big South single-season record of 14,190 established in 2007. Liberty has surpassed 10,000 fans 26 times since Oct. 4, 2003, a span of 40 home games.

**EVEN STEVEN**

Charleston Southern junior WR **GERALD STEVENSON** became the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 career receiving yards when he surpassed the milestone against Liberty in Week 8. He is the fifth Buccaneer player on the list, and has 1,062 yards on 89 career receptions.

**TACKLE BOX**

Gardner-Webb redshirt-senior LB **MARIO BROWN** has 289 career tackles, and needs 11 to become just the seventh player in League history with 300 in a career. Teammate **JEFFERY WILLIAMS** has 279 career stops as well.

**RUSHING UPDATE**

**GOLDEN GATES BRIDGE**

Gardner-Webb sophomore K **RYAN GATES**, who set a Big South single-game record with 17 points kicking in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 65-0 win over Southern Virginia in Week 8, has scored 142 points in less than two seasons, good for sixth-place in Big South history. He also is tied for fourth in League annals with 29 career field goals and tied for second with five career 10-point kicking games. In addition, Gates is second all-time in Big South history with nine career field goals of 40-yards or longer. The record is 13, held by Coastal Carolina's **JOSH HOKE** (2003-06).

**THE KEYS TO SUCCESS**

VMI leads the Big South in rushing defense at 126.0 yards per game, and is the only Big South team this season to not allow an opponent to rush for 200 yards in a game. In Week 8 at Presbyterian College, the Keydets held the Blue Hose to 36 rushing yards, the fewest the Keydets have allowed in a Big South game since joining the Conference in 2003. It was their lowest amount allowed to an opponent since VMI held St. Francis (Pa.) to minus-2 rushing yards in the 2008 season opener.

**BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

Liberty leads the Big South in both scoring offense (32.8) and scoring defense (16.5), a feat they accomplished in 2007. If the Flames can maintain its hold on both categories, they would become the first Big South team to lead the Conference in scoring offense and scoring defense in the same season twice. Meanwhile, Liberty is looking for its fourth consecutive League scoring defense title.

**OH THANK HEAVENS FOR BEVINS**

Liberty's **MATT BEVINS** made a 50-yard field goal at Charleston Southern in Week 8, the first Big South kicker to make a 50-yarder in four seasons. VMI's **BARRETT WAY** was the last to do so when he kicked a 51-yarder against Gardner-Webb on Oct. 22, 2005. Bevins' distance is tied for the third-longest in League history, and he is just the fourth kicker in League history to make a 50-yard field goal, joining VMI's **MATT SHARPE** and Way, and Gardner-Webb's **HUNTER SMITH**.

**GO-GO-GOWINS**

Stony Brook sophomore RB **EDWIN GOWINS'** four rushing TDs this season have gone for an average of 35.5 yards (39-27-44-32), and in his career, Gowins is averaging 35.6 yards per rushing touchdown (breakdown: 22 - 20 - 72 - 49 - 3 - 3 - 29 - 62 - 36 - 65 - 32 - 39 - 27 - 44 - 32). All but two of his 15 career scores have gone for at least 20 yards, with a career long of 72. Gowins scored 12 of his 15 career scores during a nine-game stretch from Nov. 1, 2008 - Oct. 10, 2009.

**CALL HIM TOUCHDOWN TIM**

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is the only player in Big South history, and the only active player in FCS, to score a rushing touchdown, receiving touchdown, kickoff return touchdown, punt return touchdown and pass for a touchdown. In addition, he is the only player in League history with at least 20 rushing touchdowns (21) and 10 receiving touchdowns (12). Meanwhile, Maypray became the seventh player in League history to reach the 200-point plateau when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 7 against Stony Brook. Maypray now has 216 career points -- which is fourth-most by a non-kicker.

**BUDDY LEE**

Liberty's **KAJUAN LEE** recorded an interception in four-straight games from Sept. 26 - Oct. 24, tying the Big South record first set in 2005 by former Coastal Carolina safety and current Carolina Panther **QUINTON TEAL**. Lee is tied for the Big South lead with four picks this season, and his last three interceptions resulted in eventual touchdowns for Liberty.

**FB-YES**

The Big South is playing a League-record eight games against FBS opponents in 2009. The previous high was five, just last year. Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb each played two FBS foes this season.

**POLLSTERS**

Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Liberty, Stony Brook and VMI all received votes in *The Sports Network* Top 25 poll the week of Sept. 8, marking the first time in League history that every Big South football team received Top 25 consideration in one season. Charleston Southern, Coastal, GWU, LU, SBU and Presbyterian received votes in *The Sports Network's* preseason poll.

**BIG SOUTH GETS BIGGER IN 2009**

The Big South football membership is at seven members in 2009, including six Division I programs for the second-straight year. Presbyterian College, which is in the final two years of its transition to Division I, is now considered an official Conference opponent in the Big South this year, and the Blue Hose will count in the standings. The addition gives the Big South a six-game Conference schedule for the first time in League history. However, PC will not be eligible for the Big South football championship until it becomes a full-fledged member of NCAA Division I in 2011.

**THE COUNTDOWN BEGINS TO THE BIG SOUTH'S AUTOMATIC BID IN 2010**

The Big South Conference is just one year away from receiving an automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs. As part of the NCAA's expansion of the FCS Playoffs to 20 teams beginning in 2010, the Big South was granted an automatic bid to the playoffs that same year. The Big South's six Division I playing members are eligible to receive an at-large playoff berth in 2009.
