Liberty • Charlottesville, Va.

Brown led Liberty in rushing and receiving and scored three touchdowns to lead the Flames past Gardner-Webb, 51-28. He caught 10 passes for a school-record 198 yards -- the fourth-highest single-game total in Big South history, and scored on an 80-yard pass play that broke the game open. He rushed 11 times for 52 yards and two first quarter scores that gave Liberty an early 14-7 lead. Brown finished the day with 265 all-purpose yards in helping the Flames secure at least a share of the Big South football championship with one week remaining.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CHRIS KUZDALE • DB • Sophomore
Charleston Southern • Tampa, Fla.

Kuzdale had two key interceptions and three pass break-ups in helping Charleston Southern defeat Stony Brook in overtime. His first interception came in the end zone towards the end of the first half that ended Stony Brook's scoring threat and preserved CSU's 20-17 lead. Kuzdale's second pick was on the first play of overtime, giving the Bucs the opportunity to win. He also had a pass break-up on a third-and-goal from the 1-yard line that forced SBU to kick a game-tying field goal in the fourth quarter instead of allowing the go-ahead touchdown. Kuzdale also broke up a pass in the fourth quarter on a third down that forced a punt.

Paglia connected on three of his four field goal attempts, with all four attempts coming from beyond 40 yards, and finished the day with 12 points in leading Charleston Southern past Stony Brook. His first field goal of the day was a school-record 51-yarder that gave CSU a 17-14 lead in the second quarter. He added a 46-yarder four minutes later to extend the lead to 20-14, and later hit the game-winning 43-yard field goal in overtime. Paglia also averaged 67.2 yards on six kickoffs with two touchbacks.

Byrd recorded his second consecutive 100-yard rushing game with a team-high 148 yards at Coastal Carolina. He averaged 6.7 yards per carry, had seven carries over 10 yards -- including a long of 30, and accounted for nine of PC's 11 rushing first downs. Byrd also gained 46 yards on a team-high six receptions to finish the day with 194 all-purpose yards for the Blue Hose.

BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP GAME SET FOR SATURDAY

Preseason Big South favorite Liberty moved to 5-0 in Big South action with its 51-28 win at Gardner-Webb this past Saturday and has clinched at least a share of the 2009 Conference crown -- its third-straight League title. The Flames need to win at Stony Brook Saturday for the outright title, which would be Liberty's unprecedented third consecutive outright Big South championship. If Stony Brook wins, the Seawolves and the Flames would be co-champions. Saturday's game will be the fourth season finale in League history that will decide the Big South champion.

TURNING 50 IS A GOOD THING

Liberty has now scored 50 points against every Big South team except Stony Brook under head coach **DANNY ROCCO**. The Flames are also the first team to score 50 points in three consecutive Big South games, as well as post four 50-point games during the Conference season.

BLAZING THE TRAIL

Liberty extended its Big South win streak to 16 games (9 home wins, 7 road victories) with its 51-28 win over Gardner-Webb this past Saturday, the longest Conference win streak in League history and the third-longest active League winning streak among FCS programs, trailing Appalachian State (19) and South Carolina State (18). Liberty, which is the only team of the three not to lose a Conference game since 2006, has set Big South records for longest home Conference winning streak (9) and longest road Conference win streak (7). Below is a closer look at the Flames' 16-game Big South streak.

A FIRST TIME FOR ANYTHING

The Big South had its first team return an opening kickoff for a touchdown this past Saturday, as it was done twice -- and within seconds of each other. With a 1:30pm start against Stony Brook, Charleston Southern's **DEON LEE** returned the opening kickoff 89 yards for a touchdown 12 seconds into the game. With a 1:30pm start against Liberty, Gardner-Webb's **DAVID MONTGOMERY** returned the opening kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown to give GWU an early 7-0 lead at 14:40. Montgomery's kickoff return is the longest in Conference history, and was the first time Liberty allowed a kickoff return for a touchdown in a Big South game. It was the League's second 100-yard play in two weeks, as Charleston Southern's **ANTWAIN HARVEY** returned an interception 100 yards for a touchdown at Presbyterian College in Week 10.

NORM!

Coastal Carolina sophomore **JOSH NORMAN** has intercepted a pass in his last three games, totaling six during that stretch -- including a Big South single-game record tying three interceptions against Gardner-Webb in Week 10. He has a League season record of eight interceptions this year, breaking the previous record of six, which was set by former Chanticleer **QUINTON TEAL** in 2004 and matched by Charleston Southern's **PHILLIP ASHLEY** last season. Norman now has 10 career interceptions to tie for fourth all-time in Big South history and third on Coastal's career chart.

BYRD IS THE WORD

In his last two games, Presbyterian College freshman **LANCE BYRD** has rushed for 422 yards, pushing his season total to 640 and moving into fourth among the Big South's rushing leaders this season. He rushed for a school-record 274 yards in his first career start in Week 10 against Charleston Southern, the second-highest single-game total in Big South history and the most in a Conference game.

OH THANK HEAVENS FOR BEVINS

Liberty sophomore **MATT BEVINS** has set the Big South single-season record for field goals made. He kicked three more this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb to push his season total to 20, besting the old mark of 17 by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003. Bevins now ranks first in the FCS in field goals per game with 2.00, and has made eight consecutive field goals on two occasions this season. He has kicked at least two field goals in five-straight games, going 14-of-16 in that span, and posted his fourth 10-point kicking game of the season against the Runnin' Bulldogs (third-straight). Bevins, who now has six 10-point kicking games in his young career, leads the Big South with 98 points scored -- just four away from breaking the League's single-season kick scoring record of 101 points, which was set by Liberty **NOAH GREENBAUM** in 2007.

RUNNING IN THE HALL

Gardner-Webb junior running back **PATRICK HALL** rushed for a 66-yard touchdown against Liberty this past Saturday to become the seventh player in Big South history with 20 career rushing scores. Hall, who is tied for the Big South lead with 10 touchdowns this season, has scored a touchdown in 12 of his 30 career games, with seven being multi-TD performances.

HONEST ABE

VMI senior RB **HOWARD ABEGESAH**, who moved into fourth-place all-time in Big South history in career rushing yards in Week 9 vs. Charleston Southern, enters his final game with 2,773 career rushing yards and needs 227 to join the Big South's 3,000-yard club.

BENNETT TURNS 50

Coastal Carolina head coach **DAVID BENNETT** recorded his 50th win as head coach of the Chanticleers with this past Saturday's 41-37 win over Presbyterian College. He is the Big South's all-time leader in coaching victories since the Conference began football in 2002.

HE DOES THIS A LOT

Gardner-Webb senior QB **STAN DOOLITTLE** is fifth all-time in Big South history with 481 career completions, and is 19 shy from becoming just the third QB in Big South history with 500 in a career. He will likely pass Liberty's **BROCK SMITH** (484) and Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (486) in his final collegiate game this week at Presbyterian College. Meanwhile, Doolittle is 83 passing yards away from 5,000 in his career, which would make him the seventh QB in League history to accomplish this feat.

MR. ALL-PURPOSE

VMI senior **TIM MAYPRAY** enters his final collegiate game this week needing 38 yards for 6,000 career all-purpose yards. The Big South's all-time leader with 5,962, Maypray amassed 3,396 yards against Big South members. He is currently fourth among active Division I FCS players in all-purpose yards, and is fifth in all-purpose yards per play with a career average of 9.99. Below is a breakdown of Maypray's yardage and respective rank in Big South history, as well as his career total against every Big South team. Maypray is the only player in League annals with 1,000 rushing, receiving and kickoff return yards.

ADVANTAGE: MAYPRAY

VMI senior **TIM MAYPRAY** is the Big South's career leader in kickoff returns (94) and kickoff return yards (2,072), as well as the League's record holder for combined kickoff/punt returns (119) and combined kickoff/punt return yardage (2,342). Charleston Southern junior **GERALD STEVENSON**, who originally broke the Big South career record for most combined kickoff/punt return yards in Week 2, trails Maypray in all four categories, but has not returned a kick since Week 7 at Gardner-Webb, a span of four games. However, Stevenson has one more year of eligibility in 2010. Below is a look a breakdown of each player's combined kick return totals.

HOME RUN

Coastal Carolina concluded its home schedule with a perfect 5-0 record, its first undefeated home slate since 2005 and third overall (7-0 in 2004 and 5-0 in 2005). The Chanticleers are the first Big South team to post a perfect record at home three times since Big South football began in 2002.

IT'S NOT OVER UNTIL... WELL, YOU KNOW

Charleston Southern and Stony Brook played the first overtime Conference game since the 2005 season this past Saturday, and the Buccaneers prevailed, 30-27. Charleston Southern is now 3-0 in overtime games since 2002, winning in double-overtime against Coastal Carolina 2005 and The Citadel in 2006. The CSU-SBU game was just the fourth Big South contest to go past regulation.

DON'T RUSH THROUGH THIS NOTE

The Big South had a record six 100-yard rushers this past Saturday, as **EDWIN GOWINS** (177), **CONTE CUTTINO** (163), **TOMMY FRASER** (157), **LANCE BYRD** (148), **HOWARD ABEGESAH** (111) and **CAM JONES** (100) reached the century mark on the ground. The previous high was five players, which occurred on Sept. 29, 2007. Gowins and Cuttino combined for 340 rushing yards at Charleston Southern, the second time this season they collectively gained more than 200 and seventh time overall. Stony Brook is 5-2 in those games following its OT loss to the Bucs.

KICK STAND

Gardner-Webb's **RYAN GATES** needs two more field goals to become the first player in Big South history with 15 in back-to-back seasons. Stony Brook's **WESLEY SKIFFINGTON** is 15-of-17 on field goal attempts this season, and his 88.2 success rate is pacing ahead of the League record of 84.6 percent (based on 10 field goals made), set by VMI's **BARRETT WAY** in 2005 (11-of-13). Meanwhile, a Big South-record five placekickers have made at least 10 field goals this season.

HUGHES RUSH

VMI senior QB **KYLE HUGHES** moved into third-place on the Big South's all-time QB rushing list this past Saturday at Army. Hughes, who became the fourth quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 8 at Presbyterian College, has rushed for 1,239 yards from his quarterback position.

POINT OF ORDER

VMI has scored a point in its last 59 games -- the longest run in the history of the program and the second-longest scoring streak in Big South history. Liberty's current streak stands at 51 games, while Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 40 games. Gardner-Webb has not been blanked in 21 consecutive contests, followed by Stony Brook (15), Coastal Carolina (9) and Charleston Southern (7).

NORTHERN EXPOSURE

Stony Brook senior RB **CONTE CUTTINO** is the first player in school history with 3,000 career rushing yards, and his school record total now stands at 3,518 (1,906 in the Big South), sixth-highest among the 11 active FCS players with 3,000 career rushing yards. Cuttino needs 94 yards to become the 10th player with 2,000 rushing yards in the Big South. Teammate **EDWIN GOWINS** became the ninth player to surpass the milestone this past Saturday at Charleston Southern, and now has 2,035 rushing yards in 20 career games. Gowins ranks fourth among active FCS players with 101.75 yards per game.

IN THE LEAD

VMI senior RB **HOWARD ABEGESAH** continues to lead the Big South in rushing yards with 877 -- 152 yards away from his nearest competitor. Abegesah led the Big South in rushing in 2007 with 1,121, and if he can maintain his hold on the top spot, he would become just the second player to lead the Big South in rushing twice. Liberty's **DRE BARNES** was the Big South's leading rusher in 2002 and 2003. Abegesah needs 123 rushing yards to become the fourth player in League annals with two 1,000-yard rushing seasons.

HIDE TIDE

Coastal Carolina's 41 points against Presbyterian College this past Saturday was the most by the Chanticleers since scoring 41 points in the 2007 season finale at Charleston Southern. It was CCU's most points at home since scoring 42 against VMI that same season on Oct. 27.

30 ROCK

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is fourth all-time in Big South history with 38 career touchdowns and is approaching an elite group. Maypray needs to reach the end zone just two more times to become the fourth member of the Big South's 40-touchdown club. Ahead of him are **JEROME SIMPSON** (44), **RASHAD JENNINGS** (46) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (47).

BIG SOUTH STAT OF THE WEEK

The Big South's seven members have combined to score 988 points through 18 League games, an average of 54.9 combined points entering the final weekend of the season.

The 54.9 combined average is higher than last season's average of 50.1 in 15 official Conference games involving six members (PC was not an official Conference opponent in 2008).

Meanwhile, 579 points have been scored in the last nine Big South games, a combined average of 63.4 points in that span.

THE LAST ONE STANDING

Gardner-Webb is the only Big South member to have not allowed a kickoff return for a touchdown in a Big South game, a span of 33 games. The Runnin' Bulldogs shared the mark with Liberty at 32 games until this past Saturday when GWU returned the opening kickoff for a score against the Flames. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina holds the Big South's longest streak of not allowing a punt return touchdown in a Conference game at 30 games. The last time the Chanticleers allowed a punt return touchdown in a League game was in their first-ever Big South contest, Oct. 4, 2003 against Gardner-Webb.

NOVEMBER SWEEPS

Coastal Carolina and Liberty are the winningest Big South teams (not including Stony Brook and Presbyterian College) in the month of November since 2003. The Chanticleers own the highest regular-season winning percentage at .762 (16-5), while the Flames have won the most games in November (18) in the same span. Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003.

KICK IT

Big South placekickers are a combined 35-of-40 on field goals from 30-39 yards, an 87.5 percentage. Five teams -- Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Liberty, Stony Brook and VMI -- are currently perfect from that distance this season. Overall, Big South placekickers are 82-of-109 on field goal attempts this season for an all-time League-best 75.2 percentage, pacing ahead of the current top season percentage of 67.5 percent (2007). The 82 field goals are the most combined total among the Big South programs in one season. Last season, the seven Conference members combined for 70 field goals.

CROWD PLEASERS

Liberty has set the Big South single-season record for average attendance, as the Flames averaged 14,931 fans in six home games this season. The old record average was 14,190, set by Liberty in 2007. This season, the Flames drew the largest home crowd in program and Big South Conference history in Week 2, as 16,112 fans witnessed the Flames' 35-10 victory over North Carolina Central. In addition, the home finale crowd of 15,208 for the VMI game was the largest crowd for a Big South contest.

III RECEIVING NOTES ON PERRY

Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** is the fifth player in Big South history with 50 receptions in back-to-back seasons, and the first to accomplish this feat in his freshman and sophomore seasons. Perry III has 107 receptions for 1,277 yards in just 20 career games. He became the 19th player in Big South history with 1,000 career receiving yards in Week 7 vs. Charleston Southern and the 15th player in League history (and sixth GWU player) with 100 career catches in Week 10 at Coastal Carolina.

EVEN STEVEN

Charleston Southern junior WR **GERALD STEVENSON** became the 16th player in Big South history with 100 career receptions when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday against Stony Brook. He is the fourth CSU player with 100 catches in the Big South's football history. Stevenson had eight receptions for 76 yards against the Seawolves, pushing his career totals to 107 catches and 1,287 receiving yards. Meanwhile, Stevenson is fourth all-time with 3,883 all-purpose yards in his career and needs 117 yards to become the fourth player with 4,000 in a career.

BIG BROWN

Gardner-Webb reshirt-senior LB **MARIO BROWN**, who became the seventh player in Big South history with 300 career tackles in Week 10 at Coastal Carolina, is tied for fourth in League annals with 308 entering his final collegiate contest. His next tackle will give him sole possession of fourth-place for good, as the third-highest total is 348 by Liberty's **MANNY ROJAS** from 2003-06.

HIGH OCTANE

Liberty has scored a Big South-record 238 points during the Conference season, besting the previous mark of 191 points, which Liberty established in 2007 during a four-game Big South season. The 2009 Flames are averaging 47.6 points through five League games, just below the Conference-game record scoring average of 47.8 set by the 2007 Flames. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored at least 10 points in five consecutive quarters and 10 of its last 12 periods. Furthermore, the Flames have scored in double figures in 41-straight games, one shy of the tying the Big South record. Coastal Carolina scored at least 10 points in 42 consecutive games from Sept. 24, 2005 - Nov. 15, 2008.

BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

Liberty leads the Big South in both scoring offense (36.7) and scoring defense (17.4), a feat they accomplished in 2007. If the Flames can maintain its hold on both categories, they would become the first Big South team to lead the Conference in scoring offense and scoring defense in the same season twice. Meanwhile, Liberty is looking for its fourth consecutive League scoring defense title.

RATE OF RETURN

Gardner-Webb returned nine kickoffs for 285 yards against Liberty this past Saturday, a Big South single-game team record for most kickoff return yards. The Runnin' Bulldogs averaged 31.6 yards per return.

GO-GO-GOWINS

Stony Brook sophomore RB **EDWIN GOWINS'** six rushing TDs this season have gone for an average of 28.8 yards (39-27-44-32-14-17), and in his career, Gowins is averaging 33.3 yards per rushing touchdown (breakdown: 22 - 20 - 72 - 49 - 3 - 3 - 29 - 62 - 36 - 65 - 32 - 39 - 27 - 44 - 32 - 14 - 17). All but four of his 17 career scores have gone for at least 20 yards, with a career long of 72. Gowins rushed for 12 touchdowns in a nine-game stretch from Nov. 1, 2008 - Oct. 10, 2009.

FULL MONTY

Gardner-Webb senior RB **DAVID MONTGOMERY** is the Big South's career leader for most receptions by a running back with 75. He broke the record of 68, set by former Gardner-Webb rusher **JERMAINE BOSTON** (2002-05), in Week 9 vs. Stony Brook. Montgomery has four touchdown receptions on his last 13 catches after scoring none on his first 62 receptions.

A DAY AT THE BEECH

In five Conference games, Liberty QB **TOMMY BEECHER** is 84-of-114 passing for 929 yards and six touchdowns with zero interceptions. Beecher is completing 73.7 percent of his passes against Big South foes and is averaging 185.8 passing yards a game in addition to a 159.51 efficiency rating. Overall, Beecher owns a 68.8 completion percentage, the second-highest single-season clip in Big South history and just below the record of 69.9 percent set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** in 2006.

THE KEYS TO SUCCESS

VMI is second in the Big South in rushing defense at 136.4 yards per game, and is the only Big South team this season to not allow an opponent to rush for 200 yards in a game. In Week 8 at Presbyterian College, the Keydets held the Blue Hose to 36 rushing yards, the fewest the Keydets have allowed in a Big South game since joining the Conference in 2003. It was their lowest amount allowed to an opponent since VMI held St. Francis (Pa.) to minus-2 rushing yards in the 2008 season opener.

CALL HIM TOUCHDOWN TIM

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is the only player in Big South history, and the only active player in FCS, to score a rushing touchdown, receiving touchdown, kickoff return touchdown, punt return touchdown and pass for a touchdown. In addition, he is the only player in League history with at least 20 rushing touchdowns (22) and 10 receiving touchdowns (13). Meanwhile, Maypray became the seventh player in League history to reach the 200-point plateau when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 7 against Stony Brook. Maypray now has 228 career points -- which is fourth-most by a non-kicker.

FB-YES

The Big South played a League-record eight games against FBS opponents in 2009. The previous high was five, just last year. Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb each played two FBS foes this season.

IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed four players on the 2009 *ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-District III* team -- Liberty's **MATT BEVINS** and **CHRIS ROCCO**, Gardner-Webb's **MARIO BROWN** and Presbyterian's **MATT FREEMAN**. It is the fourth time in eight seasons that the Conference has had at least four All-District honorees.
