With a win on March 5 the Lady Bulldogs can clinch the championship out right ... The Liberty Lady Flames have clinched the No. 2 seed in the upcoming championship. The rest of the field will be sorted out later on this week with a full release of the brackets announced after all the regular-season games are completed.

Gardner-Webb is ranked No. 31 in the USA Today ESPN Division I Top 25 Coaches' Poll. Gardner-Webb recieved a season-high 15 votes in the week 15 poll to rank them No. 29.

AMANDA STULL of Coastal Carolina currently sports a 3.94 GPA in Biology and earned a spot on the 2010 ESPN *The Magazine* Academic All-America squad for the third-straight season. Stull's bid to the team also marks the seventh-consecutive year the Big South has placed a women's basketball player on the teams.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She took over the 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10 as she has connected on 94 treys this season. She also became the fifth player in Big South history with 200 treys in her career with 201 triples. Tull is also ranked No. 4 in the country with 3.5 treys per outing. Her mark is currently tops on the single three-point field goal per game list.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 88 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 9 in the country with 3.1 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 5 all-time in the Big South record book with 219 career blocked shots and is second on the single season top ten.

GLASSMASTER

UNC Asheville's **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** has picked it up in the post for the Bulldogs. She is currently averaging 10.3 boards per game to rank No. 26 in the country. Her average is currently ninth on the Big South single season list. She is the only player in the Big South averaging double-digits in both scoring and rebounding.

QUEENS OF THE CAROMS

With its +14.6 rebound margin, Liberty is currently ranked No. 1 in the nation. Stanford ranks No. 2 with a +12.9 margin with the undefeated UConn Huskies in third with a +12.3 margin.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to recieve the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two (tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantasitc Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. **VIVIAN STRINGER**, **VAN CHANCELLOR** and **SYLVIA HATCHELL**. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern dropped its lone contest of the week to league leader Gardner-Webb and fell to 15-12 on the season... The 15 wins remain the second most in a single season in CSU history... The Buccaneers are currently alone in fourth place at 7-7 in the league standings with two games to play... **KATIE TULL** scored 16 points and grabbed four rebounds in 38 minutes against the Lady Bulldogs... She knocked down four three's and broke the Big South record for made three-pointers in a single season as she has now drained 94 treys this year... She also now has 201 career three's, making her just the fifth player in Big South history to record at least 200 treys... The junior guard is currently 23 made three's shy of breaking the school record for career three's and 63 three's shy of breaking the conference record for career three's... Running mate **KELSEY WASMER** continued her hot stretch, scoring a team-high 17 points, while also burying three treys and hauling in four boards in 37 minutes... Over the last nine games, Wasmer has reached 17 points in all but one game and has reached 20 points four times... She has increased her scoring average on the season from 9.8 ppg to 13.1 ppg over the last nine games and her 16.1 ppg during conference action leads the league... Along the way she has earned her first two Big South Player of the Week honors.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers finished its road swing with a loss to Winthrop 47-39. The Chanticleers struggled shooting throughout the game, especially in the second half with a season-low 14.8 percent from the field (4-for-27). The Chanticleer have only been successful on the road three times this season and only once in Big South play. In the game, junior **SYDNEI MOSS** led the team with 12 points. Senior **KENDRA REYNOLDS** and Junior **KATIE AHAUS** both had eight points, while Reynolds led the team with eight rebounds. The Chants might have struggled from the floor, but missed just one free-throw (7-for-8) in the game finishing with 87.5 percent.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb pushed its winning streak to 13 in a row and claimed at least a share of Big South Conference Regular Season Championship with its 63-54 win over Charleston Southern on Saturday afternoon. The Lady Bulldogs never trailed in the contest, while CSU never got closer than nine points in the final 20 minutes of play in the win. The win was also the GWU women's basketball program's 400th win and marks the first ever regular season championship over its 35 year history. GWU's 25 total wins is the most wins by a GWU team in a single season, while its 14 conference wins is the most conference wins in a single season in its history. GWU finished the year with 14 home wins, the most in one season since going NCAA Division I in 2000-01. The Lady Bulldogs will look to clinch the Big South Conference Regular Season Championship outright this week, as GWU will wrap up its regular season slate at Coastal Carolina on March 5 at 7 p.m.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers dropped their only game of the week, falling at Winthrop by a score of 56-50. HPU forced 19 turnovers and outrebounded the Eagles, 36-32, but shot just 29.6 percent (16-54) from the field. Sophomore **SHAMIA BROWN** led High Point with 13 points and eight rebounds and junior **FRANCES FIELDS** added 12 points. The Panthers scored 17 of their 50 points from the free throw line, going 17-21 from the stripe.

LIBERTY

Liberty won Big South road games at UNC Asheville and Presbyterian College over the weekend, extending its overall winning streak to five and its road winning streak to seven games... The Lady Flames have now posted a trio of winning streaks of five games or longer this season... Liberty's next home victory will be its 200th all-time triumph at the Vines Center, as the Lady Flames are 199-53 all-time at the facility, including 11-2 this season.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose are mired in a six-game losing streak with the final two games of the 2009-10 season remaining. PC will look to end a 41-game road losing streak against both Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina. **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** leads PC in scoring with 10.7 points per game.

RADFORD

Radford snapped an eight-game skid with a 70-60 victory at Presbyterian on Saturday. The Highlander put four players in double figures, including career highs from Victoria Hamilton (18) and Kaylyn Crosier (17). Two days later, Radford got another career-high from freshman **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON**, who tallied 20 points on 5-of-9 shooting from three-point land. The Bulldogs finished the season at home against Winthrop on Friday night. Junior forward **KIANA RAINEY** had a solid week with a career-high 13 points vs. Liberty and first career double-double vs. Radford with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

SHANICE COLE scored a career-best 24 points to lead Winthrop to a Senior Day victory over High Point on Saturday. In the process Cole reached the 600 career point mark. It was the fifth 20-point game of the season.
