Warley averaged a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds in two Big South wins for Liberty last week. She got her week started with 17 points on 7-of-9 from the floor and 3-of-4 from the line as Liberty downed Radford on March 5. The forward also ripped down 12 boards and posted one rejection. Three days later against High Point, Warley canned 46 percent from the floor to finish with 13 points to go along with eight rebounds, three blocks and two steals. Her presence in the paint helped the Lady Flames out-rebound their opponents 81-51, and out-score their opponents 96-24 in the post.

The seeds for the Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Tournament are determined as the regular-season came to a close on Monday, March 8. Gardner-Webb claimed the top seed with a 15-1 record in Big South play, with Liberty coming in at the No. 2 seed. Charleston Southern and High Point posted identical 9-7 records, with the Panthers earning the three seed by virtue of a coin toss as the last step in the tie-breaker procedure. There was also a tie for the fifth seed in Coastal Carolina and Winthrop with 7-9 records. Coastal Carolina swept Radford during the regular season to break the tie and pick up the No. 5 seed. In at No. 7 was Radford with a 5-11 League record and UNC Asheville rounds out the seeding with a 3-13 Conference mark.

MAD PROPS

Gardner-Webb is ranked No. 31 in the USA Today ESPN Division I Top 25 Coaches' Poll. Gardner-Webb received a season-high 15 votes in the week 15 poll to rank them No. 29.

AMANDA STULL of Coastal Carolina currently sports a 3.94 GPA in Biology and earned a spot on the 2010 *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-America squad for the third-straight season. Stull's bid to the team also marks the seventh-consecutive year the Big South has placed a women's basketball player on the teams.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She took over the 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10 as she has connected on 97 treys this season. She also became the fifth player in Big South history with 200 treys in her career with 204 triples. Tull is also ranked No. 4 in the country with 3.4 treys per outing. Her mark is currently tops on the single three-point field goal per game list.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 88 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 8 in the country with 3.1 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 5 all-time in the Big South record book with 219 career blocked shots and is second on the single season top ten.

GLASSMASTER

UNC Asheville's **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** has picked it up in the post for the Bulldogs. She is currently averaging 10.1 boards per game to rank No. 29 in the country. Her average is currently fourth on the Big South single season list. She is the only player in the Big South averaging double-digits in both scoring and rebounding.

QUEENS OF THE CAROMS

With its +15.0 rebound margin, Liberty is currently ranked No. 1 in the nation. Stanford ranks No. 2 with a +12.4 margin with the undefeated UConn Huskies in third with a +12.0 margin.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to receive the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. VIVIAN STRINGER, VAN CHANCELLOR and SYLVIA HATCHELL. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern swept its final regular season weekend by defeating Presbyterian College 53-41 and taking down Winthrop 66-62 in overtime... With the two victories, the Buccaneers end their season with a 12-4 mark at home and tied with preseason favorite High Point for third place in the final Big South standings... CSU also finished the season on a six-game win streak at home... The Bucs posted a 9-7 mark in league play, and the nine conference victories are the most by Charleston Southern in a single season... The third place finish is the second-best ever by CSU and the best finish by the Buccaneers when there are at least nine teams in the Big South... **KELSEY WASMER** averaged 15 points in the two games, including a 20-point effort in the overtime win over Winthrop... She knocked down five three-pointers and was 13-for-17 from the free-throw line... **LeCHELL RUSH** posted a career-high 20 points and four steals against PC, and she played a career-high 35 minutes against Winthrop... **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** returned from a three-game hiatus and posted 13 points and 13 rebounds against the Lady Eagles... **KATIE TULL** scored 11 points against Winthrop... **DANIELLE GIBSON** had eight points and seven rebounds against PC, and the points and two steals were both career highs.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina finished the season with a 16-12 overall mark and a 7-9 Big South Conference mark, in fifth place. In the final week of play, Coastal fell to Gardner-Webb 74-68 on Friday, March 5. They made a 12-0 run at the end, getting within four points of the Bulldogs. **SYDNEI MOSS** had a game-high 24 points and **AMANDA STULL** followed with 12 points. **DEVIN RIVERS** had a good showing, scoring 10 points and eight rebounds. In the final game of the season, the Chanticleers pulled out a 47-46 win over Presbyterian on senior night. The Chanticleers were led by **OLIVIA IRICK** with 11 and **SYDNEI MOSS** with 10 points. **DEVIN RIVERS** had nine points and four rebounds. Coastal shot a season-low 50 percent (12-for-24) from the free-throw line. The Chanticleers Stull has played in 113 games in her career, putting her second on the all-time games played list. Stull is also fourth on all-time steals with 235 in her career, and in assists seventh with 274.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb finished the regular season on a high note, defeating Coastal Carolina 74-68 on Friday night to claim the Big South Conference Regular Season Championship outright. The conference championship is the Lady Bulldogs first-ever regular season conference championship in the program's 35 year history. The Lady Bulldogs 26 wins are the most ever in a single season for a GWU wbb team in its history, while its 15 wins are the most conference wins in a single season in GWU's history. The Lady Bulldogs finished the regular season with a 14-2 home record and was a perfect 8-0 on the road in conference play this season. Gardner-Webb will head into the 2010 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Championship Tournament as the No. 1 seed and on a 14-game winning streak. The Lady Bulldogs, who advanced to the championship game last year as the No. 6 seed, will look to continue its winning ways when they will take on the No. 8 seeded UNCA Bulldogs on Friday, March 12, at 12 p.m. in the Millis Center in High Point, N.C.

HIGH POINT

High Point clinched the No. 3 seed in the Big South tournament after losing 73-48 at Liberty in the team's regular season finale. Junior **FRANCES FIELDS** and sophomore **SHAMIA BROWN** each scored nine points for HPU in the loss. The Panther offense struggled against the aggressive Liberty defense, shooting just 34 percent (16-47) from the field while being held to its second-lowest point total of the season. High Point will play Winthrop on Friday at 7:30 p.m. in the first round of the Big South tournament. The Panthers split the two games against the Eagles this season with both teams winning on their home floor.

LIBERTY

Liberty ended the regular season on a seven-game winning streak, the Lady Flames' third string of at least five consecutive wins this season ... The Lady Flames are seeded No. 2 in the Big South Championship for only the second time. Last time Liberty earned the No. 2 seed, in 1997, the Lady Flames claimed their first of 12 Big South Championship titles ... Liberty's 66-33 victory over Radford on Friday was the Lady Flames' 200th all-time win at the Vines Center ... **AVERY WARLEY** grabbed her 500th career rebound during the second half of the Radford contest, becoming the 21st player in school history to reach the milestone ... The Lady Flames have recorded 22 double-digit victories among their 24 wins this season.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College ends the season one step above last year's last place finish and also one place above the coaches preseason prediction. The Blue Hose tripled their 2008-09 conference win total and set a new Division I school record with five overall wins. RADFORD

Radford enters the 2009-10 Big South Tournament with 32-13 all-time record in tournament play. The Highlanders are 3-2 against their first round opponent Liberty. The last two contests between the teams resulted in buzzer beaters. Radford upended LU, 57-55, on a Kelli Darden bucket in the 2006-07 semifinals. A year later, the Megan Frazee sent the Lady Flames to the championship with a 66-65 victory. In Radford's regular season finale, **KYMESHA ALSTON** reached the 900-point plateau.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville set a school and Big South record going 23-of-23 from the free throw line in its 73-66 loss to Winthrop on Friday night. Red-shirt junior **KIANA RAINEY** continued her late-season surge as she scored a career-high 16 points and tied a career-best 10 rebounds against the Eagles. **KENDALL SHEPARD** add 13 points and six assists in the defeat. Asheville will be the #8 seed in the Big South Conference Tournament on Friday and play top-seed Gardner-Webb at Noon.

WINTHROP

Winthrop will be the sixth seed in the Big South Tournament for the fifth time in school history. The Lady Eagles are 2-2 all-time as the sixth seed with their most recent match-up against the three seed coming in 2002 when they defeated Radford 54-50. Since head coach **BUD CHILDERS** arrival in 2004-05, his teams have posted a 4-1 record in the first round of the tournament with the only loss coming in his first season. Since then Winthrop has made four straight semi-final appearances. The Lady Eagles face High Point, which the two teams have only ever met once in post season history. That meeting came in 2007 when Winthrop became the first ever eight seed to knock off the number one seed (57-50 win). **Kaitlyn Rubino**, who attended Wando High School, played in front of a home crowd on Monday for the first time since the walk-on became a member of the Lady Eagle basketball team and is now a starter. Rubino put up seven points, two assists and a steal to go along with a career-high nine rebounds. **SHANICE COLE** and **JESSICA FANSLER** both finished up the regular season with solid performances. Cole had 11 points, five rebounds and tied a career-high with six assists. Fansler led Winthrop against CSU with 14 points to go along with three assists and a career-high three blocks.
