3 IN THE POST SEASON

For the first time in Big South history the League has placed three women's basketball teams in post season play. Liberty earned the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship and will play Kentucky on March 20. Gardner-Webb took home the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT and will play at Charlotte on March 18. Charleston Southern accepted the WB's invitation and will host Appalachian State in the first round of the inaugural event.

LADY FLAMES LOOK IN

In the field of 64 in the NCAA championship the Lady Flames rank in the top 15 in eight statistical categories. Liberty is currently No. 1 in the field in rebound margin, second in the field in scoring defense, third in FG percentage, sixth in scoring margin, 12th in steals per game, 11th in three-point FG defense, 14th in FG percentage defense and has the 14th best win/loss percentage.

LADY BULLDOGS STILL PULLING IN VOTES

The Lady Bulldogs have consistently earned votes in the USA TODAY ESPN Division I Top 25 Coaches Poll all season. Gardner-Webb spent two weeks during the season with 15 votes and ranked as high as No. 29 in the country.

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** crossed a milestone as she put in her 1,000th career point. The accomplishment came against Presbyterian on Feb. 22.

ARE YOU SMARTER THAN A 5TH GRADER?

AMANDA STULL of Coastal Carolina currently sports a 3.94 GPA in Biology and earned a spot on the 2010 ESPN *The Magazine* Academic All-America squad for the third-straight season. Stull's bid to the team also marks the seventh-consecutive year the Big South has placed a women's basketball player on the teams.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She took over the 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10 as she has connected on 97 treys this season. She also became the fifth player in Big South history with 200 treys in her career with 204 triples. Tull is also ranked No. 6 in the country with 3.2 treys per outing. Her mark is currently tops on the single three-point field goal per game list.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 91 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 12 in the country with 2.9 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 5 all-time in the Big South record book with 222 career blocked shots and is second on the single season top ten.

GLASSMASTER

UNC Asheville's **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** has picked it up in the post for the Bulldogs. She is currently averaging 10.1 boards per game to rank No. 29 in the country. Her average is currently fourth on the Big South single season list. She is the first player in the Big South to finish the season with a double-double average since the 2004-05 season.

QUEENS OF THE CAROMS

With its +15.0 rebound margin, Liberty is currently ranked No. 1 in the nation. No. 1 seed and undefeated UConn ranks No. 2 with a +12.4 margin with the No. 1 seed Stanford in third with a +11.9 margin.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to receive the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. **VIVIAN STRINGER**, **VAN CHANCELLOR** and **SYLVIA HATCHELL**. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern ended its season one win shy tying the school record for wins in a single campaign...The Buccaneers did, however, tie the mark for most victories at home as they finished with a 12-4 mark inside CSU Field House... CSU finished the season with 256 made three-pointers, which was four shy of tying the school and conference record set last season by Charleston Southern... **KATIE TULL** finished the season with 97 made three's, which broke the Big South record and shattered the school record... She is one of just five players in conference history with at least 200 career made three's... Lone senior **TINA DeCARVALHO** finished her career with 110 career games played and 47 career starts... **KELSEY WASMER** finished the 2009-10 campaign as the scoring champion in league play with a Big South-best 15.9 points per game... Wasmer and Tull each made the All-Conference Second Team, and Helen Terry earned a spot on the All-Freshman Team... Wasmer was also named to the All-Academic Team.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers defeated Charleston Southern in the quarterfinals of the Big South Tournament, 52-44. It was the first time Coastal has been to the semifinals since 2005-06 season. The Chants were led by a 26-point effort from junior **SYDNEI MOSS**... Senior **AMANDA STULL** finished the game with 13 points, seven rebounds, six steals and five assists. **KATIE WHITE** had a strong performance with a career-high 11 rebounds, five blocks and four points... The Chants then took on No. 1 Gardner-Webb. They battled with the Bulldogs, taking a 22-21 lead at half time, but the Bulldogs' Margarette Roundtree was unstoppable as part of a 14-2 run in the second half, ending the Chanticleers trip in the Big South Tournament, 64-56. Moss finished the game with 19 points and seven rebounds. She was three points shy of breaking 1,000 points. Stull followed with 15 points, five rebounds and two steals in the game... Stull made her mark in the Coastal Carolina record books as she broke the three-point field goal percentage with .471. She also is fourth in single season for steals with 88. For her career Stull is No. 1 with 115 games-played, four in steals with 243 and sixth in steals with 279. White also finished third in single season blocks with 54.

GARDNER-WEBB

For the second straight year, the Lady Bulldogs saw its last second shot rim off and the Liberty Lady Flames escape with a victory in the Big South Championship Game. However, this time the Lady Bulldogs season will not end on that note, as Coach Reeves and his squad will be playing in a postseason tournament for the first time in Gardner-Webb's NCAA Division I history. The Lady Bulldogs 2009-10 season was one for the ages, as the Lady Bulldogs shattered records, set new marks and put the program on a level that it had never reached before. Gardner-Webb went 15-1 in conference play to win the Big South Conference Regular Season Title, the program's first regular season conference title in its 35-year history. The Lady Bulldogs 28 wins is a new record for the most in a single season by a GWU women's basketball team in GWU's history and ties the most wins for a Big South Conference team in the history of the Big South. The Lady Bulldogs 28 win season marks the first time since 1995-96 that the women's basketball team has had 20 or more wins, while its 16-game winning streak is the longest in the program's NCAA Division I history. Gardner-Webb went a perfect 8-0 on the road in conference play and posted a record of 14-2 away from Paul Porter Arena, including wins at Purdue, Liberty, Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern, all firsts. The Lady Bulldogs posted a 14-2 record at home with the 14 home wins setting a new GWU record for a single season, while its 13 non-conference wins surpasses its previous record of 11 wins in its DI history. Gardner-Webb also received some national attention, as the Lady Bulldogs received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top-25 Coaches Poll 15 weeks out of the season, receiving as many as 15 votes three different times. Senior **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** climbed into GWU history this season, as she became the 14th member of the 1,000 point club and became GWU's NCAA Division I all-time leading scorer with 1,335 points in her career, which also sits in sixth-place all-time. Junior guard **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** became Gardner-Webb's NCAA Division I leader in career assists this season, as she has now tallied 383 dimes over her three years at GWU. Gardner-Webb's Margaret Roundtree was named the Big South Player of the Year, while head coach **RICK REEVES** was tabbed the Big South Coach of the Year for the fourth time in his career and his first at GWU.

HIGH POINT

The High Point University advanced to the semifinals of the Big South Women's Basketball tournament where the Panthers fell to Liberty, 73-55. Sophomore **SHAMIA BROWN** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 11.5 points and eight rebounds per contest. In the quarterfinals, the third-seeded HPU squad played No. 6 Winthrop. High Point trailed by three with three seconds left, but freshman **ERIN REYNOLDS** ended up with the ball on an inbounds play from the Panthers' own end zone and banked in a 35-foot three pointer at the buzzer to send the game to overtime. High Point took an early lead in the extra period and hang on for a 68-65 win. Brown recorded a double-double with 15 points and 14 rebounds for HPU. Against the Flames, High Point held an eight-point lead late in the first half but LU gradually pulled away in the second for the 73-55 win. Junior **JURICA HARGRAVES** was High Point's top scorer with 10 points.

LIBERTY

Liberty won its third consecutive title at the Big South Women's Basketball Championship and its 13th conference crown in the last 14 seasons ... The Lady Flames are now 13-0 in Big South Championship title game appearances ... **DEVON BROWN** was named tournament MVP, after averaging 21.3 ppg in Liberty's three victories and hitting the game-winning shot with 4.2 seconds remaining in the championship game against Gardner-Webb ... **AMBER MAYS**, the Lady Flames' lone senior, joined Brown on the All-Tournament team ... At 27-5, Liberty is one win away from tying the school and Big South Conference records for most victories in a single season ... The Lady Flames have won 10 consecutive games and 20 of their last 21, entering the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship ... A couple individuals achieved career milestones during the Lady Flames' Big South Championship run over the weekend ... Brown and Mays both went over the 500-point mark for their careers, while Brown set Liberty's freshman rebounding record with 268 boards.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College ends the season one step above last year's last place finish and also one place above the coaches preseason prediction. The Blue Hose tripled their 2008-09 conference win total and set a new Division I school record with five overall wins. Next season, PC will look to snap a 46-game losing streak away from the friendly confines of Clinton.

RADFORD

Radford concluded its season at the Big South Tournament last week. Redshirt senior Kymesha Alston earned all-conference recognition for the first time in her career with a second team nod. In three seasons with the Highlanders (77 games), she tallied 751 points, 469 rebounds, 85 steals and 48 blocks. For her entire four-year career (105 games), Alston netted 908 points, grabbed 573 rebounds, recorded 112 steals and blocked 65 shots. For the majority of the season, the Highlanders ranked in the NCAA's top 30 in steals and forced 20 or more turnovers in 16 contests this season which included a season-high 37 against Southern Virginia.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville finished its season with a strong effort against top-seeded Gardner-Webb, 76-64 on Friday afternoon. **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** enjoyed her 13th double-double of the season with 17 points and 11 rebounds. Montgomery finished the season averaging a double-double, the first player in Big South history to accomplish such a feat since Katie Feenstra in the 2004-05 campaign.

WINTHROP

SHANICE COLE was named to the 2010 Big South All-Tournament Team after an impressive game against third-seeded High Point as she nearly led the Lady Eagles to an upset victory on Friday. Cole scored 30 points and pulled down 12 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season. She is the seventh player in school history to be voted to the All-Tournament Team at the conference championship and just the third in the last 13 seasons. On Thursday evening Cole was named to the First Team All-Big South, becoming just the seventh different player voted to the first team in school history. She is also just the third player in Big South history to be named to the All-Tournament team after losing in the first round. The other two are Elisa Fellers (1999) and Jessica Guarnieri (2001), both from UNC Asheville. Winthrop has placed Kim Segars (1988), Anne Cox (1996), Jennifer Churchill (1996, 1997), Stephanie Pannell (2002) and Ashley Fann (2005, 2006) on the all-tournament team. Her 30 point game left her three points shy of 700 career points. **SHELLY HANKINS** had two steals in the game against High Point, finishing her career with 182. That puts her in a tie for 7th on Winthrop's all-time steals list. Winthrop finished the season with a scoring defense average of 56.3 points per game. It is the lowest average by opponents in Winthrop's history at the Division I level.
