Roundtree posted two 20-point games as she put in 24 points against Radford on Feb. 10 and recorded 24 points in the win over Asheville on Feb. 15. Against High Point on Feb. 13, she posted a 13-point, 11 rebound double-double. Roundtree averaged 9.0 rebounds per game during the three-game span and recorded four assists, five steals and three blocks.

TOP DOGS

With its win over Liberty on Feb. 8, Gardner-Webb secured possession of No. 1 in the Big South standings. The win at the Vines Center snapped a 17-game home winning streak for the Lady Flames, dating back to the 2007 season. Gardner-Webb took both games in the regular-season series with Liberty becoming just the second team in Carey Green's 11 seasons to do so.

MAD PROPS

For the third-straight week, Gardner-Webb is ranked No. 30 in the USA Today ESPN Division I Top 25 Coaches' Poll. Gardner-Webb received a season-high 13 votes in the week 13 poll.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She currently has 87 treys on the season. If she stays on pace she will likely take over the No. 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10. She is currently No. 2 on the single season list. Tull is also ranked No. 3 in the country with 3.6 treys per outing. Her mark is currently tops on the single three-point field goal per game list.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 78 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 10 in the country with 3.0 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 5 all-time in the Big South record book with 209 career blocked shots and is ranked 7th the single season top ten.

GLASSMASTER

UNC Asheville's **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** has picked it up in the post for the Bulldogs. She is currently averaging 10.4 boards per game to rank No. 20 in the country. Her average is currently ninth on the Big South single season list. She is the only player in the Big South averaging double-digits in both scoring and rebounding.

QUEENS OF THE CAROMS

With its +15.2 rebound margin, Liberty is currently ranked No. 1 in the nation. Stanford ranks No. 2 with a +13.4 margin with the undefeated UConn Huskies in third with a +12.8 margin.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to receive the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two (tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantasitc Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. **VIVIAN STRINGER**, **VAN CHANCELLOR** and **SYLVIA HATCHELL**. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern disposed of Coastal Carolina 72-65 in its only action of the week... CSU scored 17 of the final 20 points to overcome a seven-point deficit with 2:53 to play... The Buccaneers have now won three straight and five of their last six... The three-game conference winning streak is the longest of coach **JULIE GOODENOUGH's** four-year tenure, and is the longest since 2004-05 for the Bucs... CSU split the season series with the Chanticleers for the second-straight year, and now move to 28-43 in the all-time series... The win moved CSU into a tie with High Point for third place in the league as of Saturday... **KELSEY WASMER** scored 26 on 9-of-14 shooting to lead all scorers... The point total was two off her career high and was the highest she's ever scored against a Big South opponent... She also grabbed seven rebounds, dished out three assists, knocked down two treys and went 6-of-7 from the free-throw line in 36 minutes... **KATIE TULL** scored 12 points for CSU and hit three three-pointers... **HELEN TERRY** came off the bench to add 12 points, knocking down both three-pointers and both free throws... **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** filled up the stat sheet with 10 points, seven rebounds, four assists and two steals in a career-high 34 minutes.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers fell to Charleston Southern on Saturday, Feb. 13, 72-65. Coastal had four players in double figures, **AMANDA STULL**, **KENDRA REYNOLDS** and **SYDNEI MOSS** with 13 and **OLIVIA IRICK** with 10. Coastal shot 51.9 percent from the field, the second highest this season, and went 8-for-9 (.889) from the charity stripe. The Chants have yet to win a conference game on the road.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb overcame its toughest week of the season, as the Lady Bulldogs went 4-0 in League play last week. The Lady Bulldogs played four road games in seven days and came away with four wins, pushing its win total to 22 wins the second most in school history. Gardner-Webb took sole possession of first-place on Monday, February 8, as the Lady Bulldogs won at Liberty 56-59, sweeping the Liberty Lady Flames on the regular season. Gardner-Webb ended the Lady Flames 10 game winning streak and its 18 conference home game winning streak. With the snow postponing its game at Radford to Wednesday, February 10, the Lady Bulldogs overcame very tough traveling conditions on the way up to Radford, Va. and outlasted the Highlanders 84-80 in double overtime, avenging its lone conference loss of the season. Playing its third game in less than a week on Saturday afternoon at High Point, Gardner-Webb ran out to a huge 23 point lead in the second half and held the Panthers off for the 74-66 road win. GWU then turned around two days later to travel to Asheville, N.C. to take on UNCA on Monday night. The Lady Bulldogs never trailed in the contest and came away with a 74-63 win, its fourth conference road win in seven days. With the four road wins last week, GWU picked up three season series sweeps, improved to 11-1 in conference play and remain unbeaten on the road at 7-0 in conference action.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 1-1 on the week, falling to Gardner-Webb, 66-74, before rebounding to beat Radford, 88-74. In the Panthers first game, HPU fell behind by 23 in the second half before rallying to within eight at the end of the game. High Point outscored GWU 26-12 in the final seven minutes. The Panthers ended their four-game losing streak on Monday with an 88-74 win over Radford. HPU had five players finish in double figures, led by junior **LATEISHA DEAN** who tied her career high with 20 points. The 88 points scored by High Point was the team's highest point total of the season. Junior **MACKENZIE MAIER** finished the game with seven blocks, tying her own HPU DI single-game record for the fifth time in the conference season.

LIBERTY

Liberty set program records for fewest points allowed (18) and lowest opponent field goal percentage (.119) during a 52-18 win at Winthrop Monday evening ... As a result, the Lady Flames have still not lost back-to-back Big South Conference games since Feb. 20 and 22, 1997 ... **EVERY WARLEY** became the 50th Lady Flame ever to score 500 career points, reaching the milestone during the first half of Monday's game ... Liberty could reach a program milestone during this weekend's home contests against Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern ... The Lady Flames are one win shy of 200 Big South Conference regular-season victories since joining the conference in 1991 ... Liberty is 94-6 in its last 100 February games, dating back to the 1997 Big South Championship.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College won its third consecutive game early last week to extend the team's longest Division I winning streak to three games. The last time PC had a winning streak that long was late in the 2005-06 season, PC's next to last year in Division II. The Blue Hose's bid for a season sweep over UNC Asheville was foiled after PC's nine-point halftime lead evaporated and the Blue Hose eventually fell by seven points to the Bulldogs.

RADFORD

Radford's swarming defense has forced 20-plus miscues in 14 games this season after Winthrop coughed it up 25 times on Feb. 13. Radford has forced a season-high 37 miscues against Southern Virginia, along with 26 against Presbyterian and then No. 11 North Carolina this season. Last season, the Highlanders forced 20-plus mistakes in 15 contests and 19.8 turnovers per game. Radford's 84-80 double overtime loss to Gardner-Webb on Feb. 10 was its first overtime game since March 14, 2008 (51 games) and its 40th in program history. In its last OT affair, RU defeated UNC Asheville, 72-64 in double OT in the first round of the Big South Championships. It was the first overtime for head coach **TAJAMA NGONGBA**; Loss snapped four-game OT win streak; First home OT game since Feb. 25, 2006 vs. Birmingham-Southern (W, 60-56); First OT loss since Dec. 21, 2005 at Kent State (76-87, 2OT); First home OT loss since Dec. 12, 2004 (Gardner-Webb, 58-60); RU is now 5-7 in multiple overtime contests. Freshman **VICTORIA HAMILTON** recorded her first collegiate double-double with 11 points and a game-high 11 rebound vs. Gardner-Webb on Feb. 10. Nine of her points and rebounds came after halftime. Junior **DENAY WOOD** dropped in a career-high 23 points against Gardner-Webb on Feb. 10. She also recorded career-highs in field goals (7) and free throws made (7). Her night included a perfect 5-for-5 first half shooting performance which included both of her three-pointers. For the first time this season, five Highlanders tallied double figures in points (Wood, **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER**, **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON**, **VICTORIA HAMILTON**, **KYMESHA ALSTON**) against Gardner-Webb. The last time this happened was last season on Jan. 19 at Presbyterian when Alston, **RACHEL MORRIS**, **JOHNETTE WALKER**, **VANDY PULLEN** and **TALEIA MOTON** hit the double figure mark.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville ended a nine-game BSC losing streak with a hard-fought 66-59 win over Presbyterian College on Saturday afternoon. The Bulldogs trailed 29-20 at halftime but roared back to win its second league game of the year. It marked the third Asheville had trailed at the break and rallied to win in the second half. **CHIOMA OKOLI** scored a game-high 18 points in the win. **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** posted her 10th double-double of the year with 12 points and 13 rebounds. **GRACE BLAYLOCK** added 13 points, including four treys. The Bulldogs battled against conference-leading Gardner-Webb on Monday but fell 74-63. **KENDALL SHEPARD** scored in double figures for the fourth straight game with 16 points against the Runnin' Bulldogs. Montgomery pulled down 12 rebounds.

WINTHROP

Winthrop went 2-1 on the week by defeating North Carolina Central and Radford at home before falling to Liberty on Monday. Winthrop is now 8-3 at home on the year. On the week Winthrop averaged 43.7 points offensively and its 18 points against Liberty was a school record low. On the flip side, Winthrop's defense was very solid all week, allowing only 47.7 points per game and held Liberty to its second lowest scoring total of the year. Opponents shot only 28 percent from the floor and 24 percent from three. **JESSICA FANSLER** has 99 career three-pointers and with her next one made, will become just the fifth player in Winthrop history to make 100 three-point field goals in a career.
