Montgomery posted two doubledoubles and averaged 12.0 points and 11.3 rebounds in helping UNC Asheville to a 2-2 record last week, including a win over Big South foe Coastal Carolina. She posted three games with at least 12 points and highlighted her week with 14 points in a win over Lafayette on Dec. 30. In the post, the forward was in doublefigures in rebounding in three games, including 13 boards against the Leopards. She shot 44 percent from the floor in the four-game span to go along with four assists. Defensively, Montgomery came away with six steals and turned away eight shots.

Buckhannon shot 67 percent from the floor and averaged 14.7 points per contest in three games for Radford last week. Her best shooting night came on Jan. 4 at Gardner-Webb as she connected on 71 percent of her shots from the floor to go along with 3-of-4 from downtown to finish with 13 points as Radford downed the Lady Bulldogs, 68-53. Buckhannon got her week started with 16 points and five rebounds against Hampton on Dec. 23 and followed with 15 points and one board at Marshall on Dec. 31. For the week, Buckhannon connected on 6-of-8 from downtown to finish with a 75 percent clip and added five assists and six steals.

With the games on Saturday, Jan. 2 and Monday, Jan. 4 all the Big South Conference teams have begun Big South play.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored Big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Flordia 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

With Winthrop's win over Utah Valley, Lady Eagle mentor **BUD CHILDERS** became the school's All-Time winningest coach with 60 wins at the helm of the Winthrop squad.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. KATIE TULL led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate KELSEY WASMER connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied thier own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

1ST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

History was made with co-favorites being selected for the first time in the Big South's annual preseason poll. Liberty and High Point tied for the top spot with 160 points in the voting by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Lady Flames garnered nine first-place votes to the Panthers' seven top bids.

TOP DOGS

High Point's JURICA HARGRAVES was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to recieved the honor, joining KATIE O'DELL who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two(tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantasitc Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach CAREY GREEN is among the nations elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. VIVIAN STRINGER, VAN CHANCELLOR and SYLVIA HATCHELL. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Charleston Southern went 2-2 over the winter break, claiming victories over Savannah State University (66-51, Dec. 22) and UNC Asheville (67-50, Jan. 4)...The two losses came on the road against College of Charleston (64-59, Dec. 29) and High Point (68-56, Jan. 2)...The Buccaneers are now 7-6 this season and are sitting at .500 (1-1) in conference action...KATIE TULL averaged 12.5 points over the four-game stretch and KELSEY WASMER added 9.3 points and 5.5 rebounds...Wasmer led CSU against High Point, scoring 17 points against the Panthers...HELEN TERRY averaged 9.3 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.3 assists in 31.0 minter correct the four-partner tretch during the business the State of the specified file totals. Che placed well is the first Figh Point, scoring 17 points against the Paintners...HELEN TERRY averaged 9.3 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.3 assists in 31.0 minutes per game over the four-game stretch during the winter break. She also recorded five steals. She played well in the first three games before exploding for a career high 18 points against UNC Asheville Jan. 4. She finished that game 6-for-11 from the field and hit a career-high four three-point field goals...LeCHELL RUSH averaged 6.8 points and 7.3 rebounds, she also blocked five shots (including a career high four against SSU) and recorded five steals (including a career high three against UNC Asheville). She had nine rebounds against HPU, which was one off her career high, and the 31 minutes she played against the Bulldogs was a career high.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers ended 2009 and the non-conference schedule on the right foot, defeating Elon 61-49. For the first time this season, the Chants made a comeback after being down 27-19 at halftime. Senior ELIZABETH WEAVER sparked the Chants with nine points and four rebounds all in 13 minutes of the second half. Junior SYDNEI MOSS finished with a gamethe chants with nine points and four repounds all in 13 minutes of the second natr. Junior SYDNEI MOSS finished with a game-high 18 points, while senior AMANDA STULL followed with 11. Junior KATIE WHITE had a career-night posting career-highs with nine rebounds, six assists and five steals, and tying her career-high in blocks with seven. She also finished the game with nine points. The Chanticleers then went on to start their 2010 and conference portion of the schedule on the against UNC Asheville. The Chants struggled from the field and lost lost 59-48. Moss finished with a game-high 20 points and five rebounds in the loss. The Chants continued the road swing at High Point, where they struggled some more, losing 79-39. Sophomore **OLIVIA IRICK** was the only one in double figures for the Chants with a team-high 10 points and four rebounds.

The Lady Bulldogs continued the program's best start, moving to 12-3 overall with a 2-1 record over the Christmas break. Gardner-Webb came back from the holidays to open up a five-game home stand with a 72-58 win over Longwood on Dec. 30. The Lady Bulldogs then kicked off the new year and the new Big South Conference season with a huge win, a 70-65 victory over the Liberty Lady Flames on Jan. 2. The win was the Lady Bulldogs first over Liberty in four tries and marks the first time since ine Liberty Lady Frames on Jan. 2. The will was the Lady bulldogs first over Liberty in four thes and marks the first time since joining the Big South last year, that GWU won its opening Big South conference game. However, the thrills and cheers would stop abruptly on Monday night, Jan. 4, as the Lady Bulldogs shot 29.8 percent for the game and watched its eight game home winning streak snapped as the Radford Highlanders defeated GWU 68-53. Coach Reeve's squad will look to bounce back from its worst performance of the season in the loss to Radford, GWU scored a season low 53 points on 17-of-57 shooting, as the Lady Bulldogs will wrap up its five-game home stand his weekend with UNCA at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday and High Point at 7 p.m. on Monday night.

The High Point University women's basketball team stretched its win streak to five straight games with wins over Mercer, Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina. Against Mercer, the High Point offense scored a season high 81 points, led by senior ASHLEE' SAMUELS who posted her second double-double of the season with a career-high 15 points and a team-best 12 rebounds. The PAnthers shot 50 percent (8-16) from behind the arc in the win. HPU then opened conference play with a 68-56 win over Charleston Southern. Freshman ERIN REYNOLDS and junior AMY DODD each scored 14 for High Point in the win and Samuels again led the team in rebounding with 12 boards. The Panther defense held the No. 2 team in the country in made three pointers to just four in the contest. High Point improved to 2-0 in conference with a 79-39 win over Coastal Carolina, its biggest win over the Chanticleers in team history. Reynolds again led the Panthers in scoring with 15 points, besting her previous career high of 14 from the previous game. She also had a career-high five rebounds and registered five assists to tie her career high from the game against CSU.

All seven of Liberty's wins this season have come by 11 points or more, while all four of the Lady Flames' losses have come by 10 points or less ... AVERY WARLEY made the all-tournament team af the Marriott Cavalier Classic, after averaging 11.0 ppg and 7.5 rpg while helping Liberty finish as the tournament runner-up ... Gardner-Webb became the first team to beat the Lady Flames in their Big South Conference opener since Elon in 1999-2000 and also snapped Liberty's 17-game January winning streak ... The Lady Flames are on a 37-game January home winning streak ... Tuesday's home game against North Carolina A&T will be Liberty's first home tilt in exactly a month ... After claiming a 70-40 win over Cornell in the opening game of the Marriott Cavalier Classic (Dec. 28), the Lady Flames have now won 86 straight games when scoring at least 70 points.

Presbyterian College opened league play on Saturday afternoon with a 40-57 loss to Winthrop that saw the Blue Hose enter the second half with the Eagles tied at 24. On Monday night, head coach RONNY FISHER's troops return to Clinton for the conference home opener against UNC Asheville. PC is 1-1 this year at home and will look to extend their home winning streak to two games against the Bulldogs. Following the home game, PC takes to the road for a two-game trip to Virginia against Liberty and Radford before returning home for six consecutive home dates.

RADFORD

Radford began the New Year on the right track with a conference opening victory at Gardner-Webb on Monday night. The Highlanders snapped a five-game slide as they defeated the Bulldogs in their season opener. With the victory, Radford won its six straight Big South opener and improved to 18-6 in league openers, including 5-1 on the road. After playing six straight on the road, the Highlanders return home to host High Point on Saturday to start a four-game homestand, the longest of the season. KYMESHAALSTON had a career-game at Marshall on Dec. 31. Along with tying a career-high with 23 points, she set new career marks with five steals and an 11-for-14 performance at the charity stripe. For just the second time this season, four Highlanders reached double figures. Alston netted a game-high 23 points, while ASHLEY BUCKHANNON added 15. KAYLYN CROSIER and JEWELL KINLAW chipped in with 12 points apiece.

UNC Asheville goes into this week with a two-game winning streak... The Bulldogs won the consolation game of the James Madison Invitational on Wednesday with a 50-43 victory over Lafayette and then managed to defeat Coastal Carolina on Saturday at home 59-48... LINDSEY MONTGOMERY earned a spot on the all-tournament team at James Madison... Montgomery has grabbed at least 10 rebounds in six straight games...she has double-doubles in four of the last six games and two straight... The Bulldogs played great defense the past two games limiting their two opponents to less the 50 points (45 points per game).

Winthrop lost to Mercer following Christmas Break and a 66-60 road win at Campbell on Dec. 22. It was the sixth straight year in which Winthrop has lost its first game returning from Christmas Break. The last time Winthrop won its first game after the holiday break was Dec. 30, 2003 at home against Mercer, 71-61. Senior SHELLY HANKINS is getting after it defensively this season. She has 33 steals in 13 games this season while she had 34 in 30 games last year. She stole a career-best 52 as a red-shirt freshman in 2006-07 and is on pace to better that mark. She is also doing a good job of dishing the rock as she leads the team with 29 assists, which includes 12 in the last five games (2.4). In her career she has had 16 games of three or more assists and eight games of five or more assists. She is closing in on Winthrop's all-time Top 10 list for steals as she has totaled 156. That is 10 away from 10th place. In her career she has had 23 games with three or more steals and 12 games of four or more steals. JESSICA FANSLER and SHANICE COLE have picked up their scoring a bit as of late. In the last five games, Fansler leads Winthrop with 14.0 points per game. She is 16-for-18 from the foul line and is averaging 1.8 assists and 1.2 blocks in the five-game stretch. Cole is averaging 13.0 points and is also pulling down 9.0 rebounds a game to go along with 2.6 assists and 1.6 steals. The two of them have been splitting duty at the point guard with the absence of KATHI RYSKA. Winthrop's Big South opening victory over Presbyterian was the third straight season in which the Eagles have started 1-0 in the conference.


