TWO IN THE POLLS

The Big South Conference had two schools recieve votes in the Week 4 USA TODAY/ESPN Division I Top 25 Coaches' Poll. Rick Reeves' Lady Bulldogs of Gardner-Webb notched five votes in the poll while Carey Green's Liberty Lady Flames pulled down one vote.

SEEING CLEARLY

UNC Asheville's LINDSEY MONTGOMERY was seeing very clearly for the Bulldogs in their 91-63 win over Southern Wesleyan on Dec. 11. Montgomery put in 29 points and ripped down 20 rebounds for Asheville in the win, becoming the first UNC Asheville player since 1984 to do so.

NUMBER 1 STUNNERS

Coastal Carolina's AMANDA STULL and KATIE TULL of Charleston Southern have found themselves ranked atop the nation's elite this week in the NCAA stats. Stull is connecting on 66.7 percent of her tries from downtown to lead the nation in that category, while Tull is averaging 4.4 treys per contest to lead all of Divison I.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

With Winthrop's win over Utah Valley, Lady Eagle mentor BUD CHILDERS became the school's All-Time winningest coach with 60 wins at the helm of the Winthrop squad.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. KATIE TULL led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied thier own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season.

1ST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

History was made with co-favorites being selected for the first time in the Big South's annual preseason poll. Liberty and High Point tied for the top spot with 160 points in the voting by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Lady Flames garnered nine first-place votes to the Panthers' seven top bids.

TOP DOGS

High Point's JURICA HARGRAVES was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to recieved the honor, joining KATIE O'DÉLL who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's MACKENZIE MAIER, MARGARET ROUNDTREE and DOMINIQUE HUDSON of Gardner-Webb and KYMESHA ALSTON from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two (tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantasitc Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach CAREY GREEN is among the nations elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. VIVIAN STRINGER, VAN CHANCELLOR and SYLVIA HATCHELL. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern returns to action after taking 12 days off with a home meeting with Bethune-Cookman University...The Buccaneers are 4-1 all-time against BCU... KATIE TULL maintains her lead as the nation's best three-point shooter, averaging 4.4 three's made per game.

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers are on a current five-game win streak. In their only game last week, Coastal beat Converse 65-47 at home on Sunday, Dec. 13. In the first half the seniors AMANDA STULL and DEVIN RIVERS accounted for all but four of the Coastal's 27 points. Stull finished with a team-high 17 points, and a .667 (4-for-6) three-point field goal percentage. Rivers finished with a career-high 15 points. Katie White played a big part coming off the bench by putting away five blocks and grabbing nine rebounds.

GARDNER-WERR

Gardner-Webb dropped only its second contest of the season on Sunday afternoon, falling at No. 11 North Carolina 81-65 in non-conference action. The Lady Bulldogs, who recieved five votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top-25 Coaches Poll last week, its first ever votes in a national poll in the program's history, had its winning streak snapped at eight with the loss. Gardner-Webb had four players score in double-figures for the contest and overcame a dreadful first half in which GWU had 20 turnovers and only seven field goals to get to as close as six points of the nationally ranked Tar Heels midway through the second half. The 8-2 Lady Bulldogs will took to get back on the winning track this week, as Gardner-Webb will host Converse College on Friday night, December 18, at 7 p.m. The Lady Bulldogs will then travel to West Lafayette, Indiana to face off with the Purdue Boilermakers on Monday, December 21, at 7 p.m.

High Point went 2-0 in the first two games of its three-game homestand with wins over Campbell and UNC Wilmington. HPU opened the week with a 78-57 win over Campbell as senior ASHLEE' SAMUELS grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds and four different HPU players scored in double figures. Samuels' 14 boards placed her in a tie for tenth most rebounds in a single game in HPU's Division I history. The senior bested her previous career-high of 13 rebounds which she set against King College on Nov. 10, 2007. Junior FRANCES FIELDS grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds to go along with her five points and team-best nine assists. As a team, HPU's 51 rebounds was the most the team has grabbed this season and the highest total since Feb. 7, 2009, when the Panthers pulled down 54 boards against Coastal. High Point followed up its win over Campbell with a last second, 67-66 win over UNC Wilmington. Trailing by one, 66-65, with just six seconds remaining in the game, Fields took the ball at her own free throw line and dribbled down the court towards the right baseline before lofting a running jump shot with three hands in her face. The ball fell through the net with just 0.9 seconds remaining to give High Point the 67-66 win. Fields tied her career-best with 17 points in the game to lead all scorers.

LIBERTY

Liberty did not play any games last week, as the Lady Flames are in the midst of a 10-day break for final exams Liberty did not play any garnes last week, as the Lady Flames are in the mist or a 10-day break for final exams ... Liberty is 6-1 to start the season, marking the sixth time in program history that the Lady Flames have won at least six of their first seven games ... Redshirt freshman guard **DEVON BROWN** is averaging a Big South-best 19.3 ppg, which ranks No. 3 nationally among freshmen ... Liberty will play at Auburn Tuesday at 7 p.m. Eastern ... The Lady Flames will attempt to defeat a SEC opponent for the first time since Dec. 12, 1998, when they claimed an 80-76 victory at Kentucky.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College broke into the win column with a midday matinee win over South Carolina State, 61-47. The Blue Hose broke their nine game skid in the 2009-10 season and 14-game overall losing streak with the victory. PC scored 29 points off turnovers as well as committed a season low 18 turnovers in the win. MARIAH PIÉTROWSKI (two-time BSC Freshman of the Week) leads the Blue Hose with 13.0 points per game and has dropped over twenty points twice this season.

After two straight road games, Radford returns home briefly after finals for a contest against Davidson. Following Friday's matchup, Radford will play its next four games on the road, including the final three non-conference tilts against Richmond, Hampton and Marshall. Radford forced 26 turnovers against No. 11 North Carolina and have forced 21 or more miscues in six of eight games this season. Highlander opponents have coughed it up 22.6 times on average this season. **DENAY WOOD** and **KAYLYN CROSIER** both netted career highs of 16 and 13 points respectively at VCU on Saturday

UNC Asheville began a three-game homestand with a 94-63 victory over Southern Wesleyan. It was the first time the Bulldogs scored more than 90 points since a 90-71 victory over Western Carolina on Dec. 2, 2008. LINDSEY MONTGOMERY became the first Bulldog player since SHELIA FORD (1984) to score 20 points and grab 20 rebounds in a game. Montgomery set new career higs with 29 points and 20 rebounds against the Warriors. She was 10-for-13 from the floor. It was the second time in her career she had 10 field goals in a game. Linda Aughburns added a season-high 17 points as the Bulldogs scored 49 points in the paint. GRACE BLAYLOCK hit three three-pointers to match her season-high of nine points.

WINTHROP

Winthrop, despite missing its starting point guard and shooting guard, was able to take care of Augusta State handedly. Even without the two starters the Lady Eagles posted a season-high 73 points. Nine different players scored and Winthrop dominated the boards 54-39. SHELLY HANKINS had a solid game with nine points, five assists and five steals. It's the second time this season Hankins has had five or more steals in a game. She is nearing 150 steals for her career as she currently has 141. She will need to reach 166 career steals to crack Winthrop's all-time Top 10. Junior LACEY LYONS connected on four treys in the second half of the win over Augusta. Lyons, who totaled 115 threes in her first two years at Coastal Carolina, is 8-for-18 on the year and passed Radford's KELLI TULL for 23rd on the Big South's All-Time List
