Roundtree averaged 16.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game to lead her Lady Bulldogs to a 2-0 record last week, including a win over Purdue on Dec. 21. Against the Boilermakers, the forward put in 18 points on 40 percent from the floor and 6-of-7 from the line. She also ripped down 10 boards and came away with three steals and three assists in the 56-55 win. She was also big in Gardner-Webb's win over Converse on Dec. 18, as she notched 15 points on 7-of-12 from the field and one from the line, to go along with nine rebounds and seven assists. Gardner-Webb's win over Purdue marked the school's first-ever win over a Big Ten team.

CONFERENCE PLAY SET TO OPEN

The Big South Conference will open up League play over the Christmas season. On Jan. 2 eight Big South schools start their conference slate with games on Jan. 2 and Jan. 4.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored Big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

R-E-S-P-E-C-T

Rick Reeves' Lady Bulldogs of Gardner-Webb notched five votes in the week 4 and week 5 USA Today/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll.

NUMBER 1 STUNNERS

Coastal Carolina's **AMANDA STULL** and **KATIE TULL** of Charleston Southern have found themselves ranked atop the nation's elite this week in the NCAA stats. Tull is averaging 4.7 treys per contest to lead all of Division I, while Stull is connecting on 59.5 percent of her tries from downtown to rank No. 2 nation in that category.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

With Winthrop's win over Utah Valley, Lady Eagle mentor **BUD CHILDERS** became the school's All-Time winningest coach with 60 wins at the helm of the Winthrop squad.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

1ST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

History was made with co-favorites being selected for the first time in the Big South's annual preseason poll. Liberty and High Point tied for the top spot with 160 points in the voting by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Lady Flames garnered nine first-place votes to the Panthers' seven top bids.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to receive the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two (tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantastic Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **VAN CHANCELLOR** and **SYLVIA HATCHELL**. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern hit the 90-point plateau for the third time this season as the Buccaneers rolled to a 90-72 victory over Bethune-Cookman University in CSU's lone game of the past week...CSU improved to 5-1 all-time against the Wildcats...The Buccaneers were led by **KATIE TULL** and **ALI SCHWAGMEYER**, who both set career highs for points in a single game...Tull knocked down a game-high 27 points with a career-high seven three point field goals on just 12 attempts...She also tied her career highs with a 6-of-7 performance from the free-throw line, and recorded a career-high-tying five assists...Schwagmeyer scored 22 points on 9-of-11 shooting, while knocking down her lone three-point attempt...She also pulled down nine rebounds...**HELEN TERRY** tied career highs with eight assists and six rebounds in 27 minutes of action...She scored 11 points and regained the Big South lead for assists, averaging 4.7 assists per game...**KELSEY WASMER** also filled up the stat sheet, scoring six points, grabbing six rebounds and recording six assists in a team-high 36 minutes...Tull currently leads the nation with 42 made three-point field goals and her 4.7 three's made per game is tops in the NCAA...CSU is currently second in the country in three's made per game, knocking down 10.8 treys per game...The team is one three-point field goal shy of tying for the nation's lead with Iowa State University...The Cyclones have made 98 and CSU has made 97...The Bucs maintain their conference lead with 76.3 points per game.

COASTAL CAROLINA

For the second week in a row, **AMANDA STULL** was ranked number one in the Division I NCAA for three-point percentage with .667, while the team was ranked seventh in the same category. In the first game against UNC Wilmington, the Chanticleers five game win streak was snapped 70-40 on Tuesday, Dec. 15 at Trask Coliseum. Junior **SYDNEI MOSS** led the team with 12 points and four rebounds. Senior **AMANDA STULL** scored nine points, including her 700th career-point. Stull also grabbed three steals, putting herself fifth on the all-time Coastal Carolina list for career steals with 184. The Chanticleers redeemed themselves on Sunday, Dec. 20 against Savannah State at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center as part of the Crescent Bank Challenge, 57-41. Junior **KATIE WHITE** had a breakout game by tying a career-high 13 points, grabbed four boards, and put away three blocks. Also, stepping up for the Chanticleers was senior **KENDRA REYNOLDS**, who had a season-best 11 points and nine rebounds.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb bounced back from its loss to No. 11 North Carolina a week ago with a home blow out of Converse College on Friday, December 18th, and a late comeback win over Purdue on the road on Monday, December 22nd. Gardner-Webb cruised past Converse College with a 79-38 win, as the Lady Bulldogs led from start to finish picking up 16 steals and five blocks on the defensive end in the non-conference home win. The Lady Bulldogs then traveled to West Lafayette, Indiana to face off with the Purdue Boilermakers of the Big Ten. Gardner-Webb played the Boilermakers tough, as the game saw six ties and seven lead changes during the 40 minutes of play. However, Gardner-Webb overcame a Purdue eight point lead in the second half and outscored the Boilermakers 10-2 in the final 1:17 of the contest to help put themselves in a position for the win. Junior guard **MONIQUE HUDSON** hit two three-pointers in the final 30 seconds to lift GWU past the Boilermakers for the 56-55 non-conference win. The win was the first ever win for the Lady Bulldogs basketball program over a Big Ten Conference team. The 10-2 GWU start is the best in the women's program history.

HIGH POINT

The High Point University women's basketball team won the 2009 Gator Holiday Classic with wins over William & Mary and host Florida, finishing the week with a 2-1 record. On Monday, High Point picked up its first win over a BCS team since joining Division I with a 75-68 win over Florida. Junior **LATEISHA DEAN** led all scorers with 17 points, junior **MACKENZIE MAIER** chipped in 12 points and seven rebounds and junior **AMY DODD** added 11 points and a career-best nine assists. High Point finished shooting 46.2 percent (24-52) from the floor and 61.1 percent (11-18) from behind the arc. The 11 three pointers by the Panthers were the most since Jan. 27, 2007 when HPU hit 11 in conference play at Winthrop. In HPU's first game in Gainesville, Fla., senior **ASHLEE SAMUELS**, playing in her 100th career game, scored a season-high 13 points and grabbed a career high 15 rebounds to lead High Point to a 66-58 win over the Tribe. Samuels' 15 rebounds is tied for the fourth-highest single game total in HPU Division I history. Dodd earned Tournament MVP honors after averaging 10 points, five rebounds and 5.5 assists in the two games and both Dean and Samuels joined Dodd on the All-Tournament team.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames have 13 days off between their most recent game (70-64 loss at Auburn on Dec. 15) and their next contest (Marriott Cavalier Classic opener versus Cornell at Virginia on Dec. 28) ... It is Liberty's longest gap between games since a 15-day break between Dec. 14-29, 2003 ... The Lady Flames will be returning to John Paul Jones Arena for the Dec. 28-29 Marriott Cavalier Classic, for the first time since Nov. 20, 2006 ... That evening, Liberty defeated Virginia, 75-71, becoming the first visiting basketball team to win at John Paul Jones Arena ... Auburn scored 70 points against the Lady Flames on Dec. 15, becoming the first Liberty opponent in the last 35 games to reach the 70-point plateau.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose reach the Christmas break at 1-10 following their first win of the season on December 14. **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** paces the team in scoring with 12.5 points per game and ranks as one of the league's top freshmen players. Top rebounding honors go to fellow freshman **DRIA DAVID** who has paired 4.7 boards per game with 7.5 points per game. Both players have started every game for PC this season.

RADFORD

Radford is in the midst of a six-game road swing when it hits the court on Wednesday evening to take on Hampton. The Highlanders were supposed to break up this stretch with a home game on Friday vs. Davidson, but that contest vs. the Wildcats was cancelled due to the snowstorm that dropped 15 inches on Radford, the most snow since 1996. Following Christmas break, Radford returns to action on New Year's Eve at Marshall. The noon matinee concludes the Highlanders' non-conference schedule as they begin Big South play on Jan. 4 at Gardner-Webb. Radford which is averaging three blocks a contest, swatted away a season-high six at Richmond on Monday. Six different Highlanders recorded one rejection.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville dropped a pair of home games to Georgia Southern and Elon this week. The Bulldogs will have a week off for Christmas before returning to the court on Dec. 29, at the James Madison Holiday Tournament against Western Michigan. **LINDESE MONTGOMERY** led the Bulldogs as she just missed posted double-doubles in both games this week. She had a 14 point, 10 rebound games against Georgia Southern to give her three double-doubles this year and 10 for her career. She had nine points and 14 rebounds against Elon as she averaged 11.5 points and 12 rebounds for the week. Red-shirt freshman **KELLI RILES** scored a career best 15 points and grabbed nine rebounds against Elon while true-freshman Grace Blaylock scored a season-high 11 points against the Phoenix.

WINTHROP

Sophomore **TAQUOIA HAMMICK** is starting to become a consistent impact at the center position for Winthrop. In the Lady Eagles two games this week she averaged 6.5 points and 9.0 rebounds while recording a career-high four blocks against NC State. She shot 60 percent from the field and also had two steals. In the win at Campbell she pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds. Shelly Hankins played a big role in helping Winthrop pick up its first road win of the season at Campbell on Monday. It was just the fourth time the Lady Eagles had ever beaten Campbell in 23 meetings. Hankins finished with three points, a career-tying 11 rebounds, a career-high seven assists and four steals. Hankins is averaging 2.3 steals on the year and has 148 in her career. She is 18 away from reaching Winthrop's All-Time Top 10 in steals.
