Hudson averaged 20.0 points per game and shot 52 percent from the field to lead the Lady Bulldogs to a 2-0 record in League play last week, including a win over High Point who came into the game unbeaten in League play. Hudson got her week going with 19 points on 5-of-9 from the floor, 3-of-4 from down town and a perfect 6-of-6 from the line in Gardner-Webb's win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 9. The guard also chipped in one rebound, dished out five helpers and came away with three steals in the win. Two days later against High Point, Hudson stayed hot as she poured in 21 points on 50 percent from the floor, to go along with four boards and three assists to propel the Lady Bulldogs to the 67-56 win over the Panthers.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She currently has 51 treys on the season. If she stays on pace she will likely take over the No. 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10. She is only 20 treys off from the No. 10 position. Tull is also ranked No. 3 in the country with 3.6 treys per outing.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 41 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 18 in the country with 2.4 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 7 all-time in the Big South record book with 172 career blocked shots and is eying the single season top ten.

RECORD (RE)SETTERS

The Charleston Southern Bucs set the single season three point standard last season as they 260 treys on the year. Their current pace of 9.1 per game, which ranks No. 4 in the nation, says they'll reset the record that they set a year ago. The Bucs currently have 128 on the year and are looking to finish with 264 total three-pointers at the pace they're going.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored Big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

With Winthrop's win over Utah Valley, Lady Eagle mentor **BUD CHILDERS** became the school's All-Time winningest coach with 60 wins at the helm of the Winthrop squad.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

1ST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

History was made with co-favorites being selected for the first time in the Big South's annual preseason poll. Liberty and High Point tied for the top spot with 160 points in the voting by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Lady Flames garnered nine first-place votes to the Panthers' seven top bids.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to receive the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two (tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantastic Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. **VIVIAN STRINGER**, **VAN CHANCELLOR** and **SYLVIA HATCHELL**. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern's comeback fell short as the Bucs dropped to 2-5 on the road when they fell to Coastal Carolina 74-68 Jan. 9...CSU currently sits at 7-7 this season and 1-2 in conference action...There were a ton of fouls in the game, and it led to the most free throws attempted this season by Charleston Southern...The Buccaneers finished 26-for-31 from the line... **SHAY JONES** led the way with a 7-for-7 performance from the line and a career-high 13 points...**KATIE TULL** finished 7-for-8 from the line and scored a team-high 19 points...**TINA DeCARVALHO** was 6-for-6 from the line and **LeCHELL RUSH** was 2-for-2 from the line...Rush finished with her first-career double-double, scoring 12 points and grabbing a career-high 12 rebounds in a career-high 33 minutes of action...**KELSEY WASMER** pulled down a career-high eight rebounds against the Chanticleers, and also added eight points...The usually stellar three-point shooters struggled from downtown, shooting just 4-for-28 from behind the arc.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers won their first conference game against Charleston Southern at home on Saturday, January 9, 74-68. The Chanticleers are now 6-0 in Kimbel Arena. Junior **SYDNEI MOSS** led the Chants with a double-double career-high 29 points and 10 rebounds. Senior **KENDRA REYNOLDS** also tallied her first double-double of the season with 10 points and 12 rebounds. Senior **AMANDA STULL** tallied double figures with 13 points, and going 2-for-2 from beyond the arc in the crucial parts of the game. Sophomore **TAYLOR EPLEY** grabbed for a career-high six boards. For the first time in six games, the Chanticleers out rebounded its opponent 44-40. The Chants also held the number one scoring offense in the Big South to shooting 32.8 percent from the field and Katie Tull, who is number two in the NCAA in three-pointers to only two three-point field goals.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU's record setting season continued last week with two wins, both coming over in-state conference foes. Gardner-Webb had four players in double-figures and used a 20-0 run in the second half to defeat the UNCA Bulldogs 70-54 on Saturday, January 9. The Lady Bulldogs same four players scored in double figures, headlined by a double-double by both forward **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and center **SANDRA VAITKUTE**, as GWU outscored High Point 42-10 in the paint to defeat High Point 67-56 on Monday night, and hand the Panthers its first conference loss of the season. Coach Reeves' squad has had four players average double figures in scoring this season led by junior guard **DOMINIQUE HUDSON's** 11.9 points per game. In fact, GWU has had at least two people score in double-figures in every game this season and has had 10 different players score 10 or more points in a game this year. Gardner-Webb is 10-2 at home this season and will now look to take its winning ways on the road, as its next three contests will be road conference games in the Palmetto State. The three-game road swing tips off at Charleston Southern on Saturday, January 16, at 5 p.m. Gardner-Webb is 2-1 in true road contests thus far this season with the lone loss coming to then No.11 North Carolina.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 1-1 on the week, defeating Radford 78-67 before losing at Gardner-Webb, 67-58. Against the Highlanders, HPU came back from 15 points down with 15 minutes to play to pick up the win. Five different players scored in double figures for the Panthers led by junior **AMY DODD**, who scored 15 in the win. Junior **MACKENZIE MAIER** scored 14 for HPU and tied her own High Point Division I single-game record for the second time in three games with seven blocks. The Panthers saw their six game win streak come to an end in Boiling Springs, N.C. where they fell to Gardner-Webb for the third straight time. Freshman Erin Reynolds came off the bench to score a team-best 14 points for High Point while Maier added 12 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

LIBERTY

Liberty opened its season-long five-game homestand with wins over North Carolina A&T and Winthrop ... The Lady Flames have now won 39 consecutive January home games ... **AMBER MAYS** tallied a career-high 10 assists against Winthrop, the most by a Lady Flame since Nov. 22, 2002, when **DAINA STAUGAITIENE** totaled 10 assists versus Morgan State ... **DYMOND MORGAN** scored a career-best 11 points versus Winthrop, becoming the eighth different Lady Flame to record a double-digit scoring effort this season ... **AVERY WARLEY** has grabbed five or more rebounds in 19 consecutive games, dating back to the 2008-09 campaign.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose broke back to the even water mark in league play on Monday night with a convincing 65-54 win over UNC Asheville. The thorough dismantling of the Bulldogs came as PC shot 52 percent from the field and 46 percent from the bonusphere. The hosts were led by **AMANDA MILLS** and **KRISTEN STEVENS** who each tallied 19 points. Stevens eclipsed her previous career high (14) at the 4:11 mark in the first half. The Blue Hose are now 2-1 at home and 1-1 in Big South play this season. PC has equaled last season's success of two wins against Division I teams before the halfway mark in the season.

RADFORD

Radford split in the opening two games of its season-long four-game homestand, falling to High Point before rebounding against Winthrop on Monday evening. **KYMESHA ALSTON** has registered double-figure points in her last five games and is averaging 18.4 points during that stretch. They include a pair of 20-point performances against Marshall (23) and High Point (21). The 23 points against Marshall tied a career-high. Radford put together a rare performance that led to its victory over a red-hot Gardner-Webb squad on Jan. 5. For just the third time this season, the Highlanders scored first, out rebounded its opponent and out shot its opponent. The last time Radford put all three of those together in the same contest, it defeated Southern Virginia a month earlier on Dec. 5.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville just couldn't get its offense going and only scored 54 points in defeats to Gardner-Webb (70-54) and Presbyterian College (65-54). **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** continues to have a great season for Asheville as she leads the Bulldogs in five different statistical categories. Montgomery leads the Big South in rebounding with a 9.9 average. The Bulldogs have out-rebounded four of their last five opponents. Asheville has more free throws made (250) than its opponents have taken (239). Freshman Grace Blaylock scored a career-high 15 points at Presbyterian College Monday night.

WINTHROP

Senior **SHANICE COLE** scored a game-high 22 points in the loss at Radford on Monday. It was the second 20-point game of her career and the most she had ever scored in a Big South contest. She also pulled down a career-high 15 rebounds. In the two games she averaged 16 points, 8.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists. The double-double was the third of the season and sixth of her career. Sophomore center **TAQUOIA HAMMICK**, a 6-3 center, missed the two games over the weekend. On the season she has averaged 5.2 points and 6.4 rebounds while shooting 50 percent from the field.
