The forward got her week started with 18 points on 67 percent from the floor to go along with 16 boards as the Lady Flames downed Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. Two days later at Coastal Carolina, Warley connected on 6-of-9 field goals and canned three from the charity stripe to finish with 15 points in the win over the Chanticleers. She also ripped down 12 boards and came away with one rejection in the victorv. Her work in the post helped the Lady Flames outrebound Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina by a combined 42 boards.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's KATIE TULL has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She currently has 70 treys on the season. If she stays on pace she will likely take over the over the No. 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10. She is only one trey off from the No. 10 position. Tull is also ranked No. 4 in the country with 3.7 treys per outing. Her mark is currently tops on the single three-point field goal per game list.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 56 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 13 in the country with 2.6 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 5 all-time in the Big South record book with 187 career blocked shots and is eying the single season top ten.

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored Big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Flordia 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

With Winthrop's win over Utah Valley, Lady Eagle mentor BUD CHILDERS became the school's All-Time winningest coach with 60 wins at the helm of the Winthrop squad.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. KATIE TULL led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate KELSEY WASMER connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied thier own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

History was made with co-favorites being selected for the first time in the Big South's annual preseason poll. Liberty and High Point tied for the top spot with 160 points in the voting by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Lady Flames garnered nine first-place votes to the Panthers' seven top bids.

High Point's JURICA HARGRAVES was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to recieves the honor, joining KATIE O'DELL who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's MACKENZIE MAIER, MARGARET ROUNDTREE and DOMINIQUE HUDSON of Gardner-Webb and KYMESHA ALSTON from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two(tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantasitc Fan" card.

Liberty head coach CAREY GREEN is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. VIVIAN STRINGER, VAN CHANCELLOR and SYLVIA HATCHELL. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Charleston Southern was unable to knock off the powerful Liberty Lady Flames in the first game of the week, but the Buccaneers took care of Radford in a huge 67-61 victory... CSU is now on a 26-game losing streak to Liberty, but the Bucs ended a three-game conference losing skid by beating the Highlanders to improve to 2-4 in Big South action... Charleston Southern knocked down 15 three-point field goals in the two-game stretch, and converted 74 percent of the team's free-throw chances... KATIE TULL shot 41 percent from the field and 38 percent from behind the arc in the two games... She averaged 15.0 points per game, 2.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and also had three blocks from her guard position... She also knocked down three trey's against both teams... She led all players with 19 points and 39 minutes in the Radford victory... KELSEY WASMER scored 18 points against Radford, with three three's and a 7-of-7 performance from the line in 37 minutes...Her 18 points was the most she has ever scored against a conference opponent... Lone senior TINA DECARVALHO earned her first start of the season against Radford... HELEN TERRY had 14 points and four rebounds in 17 minutes against Liberty... She knocked down two three's and went 6 of 8 from the line.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers started the week off with a win over Radford 62-49 on Saturday, Jan. 23. The Chanticleers hit 18 straight free-throws in the second half that helped them pull away from the Highlanders. Coastal ended up hitting 84 percent (21-for-25) from the line. Leading the team was junior SYDNEI MOSS who posted an 11-for-12 mark from the line and her third double-double of the season with 23 points and 10 rebounds. Senior DECIN RIVERS had a good showing by tallying 11 points, going 100 percent from both the field (4-for-4) and the line (3-for-3). With the win the Chanticleers improved their home win streak to 8-0. The Chanticleers eight game home streak was snapped by Liberty on Monday, Jan. 25, 57-38. The Chanticleers had a 10 point lead early in the second half, but Liberty utilized its size to dominate the boards 27-5 in the second half. The Chanticleers shot 100 percent from the line (6-for-6). Moss had a game-high 20 points and eight rebounds, while hitting 4-for-4 from the stripe.

The Runnin' Bulldogs are doing just that this season, improving to 17-3 overall and 6-1 in conference play with two lopsided wins last week. The 17 wins matches its win total of all of last season and also ties the program's NCAA Division I record for most wins in a single season. The Lady Bulldogs improved to 6-1 in conference play, only one win shy of last year's seven conference wins in its inaugural season in the Big South Conference. In the Lady Bulldogs two wins this past week, GWU did it with defense, as Coach Reeve's squad held Winthrop to only 23 points on eight made field goals in the second half to pull away with an 80-39 road win and followed that up with a lockdown performance at PC in which GWU forced 29 turnovers, tallied 18 steals and held the Blue Hose to 28.9 percent shooting from the floor for the game. Gardner-Webb has four players averaging double figure scoring this season and have had at least two people score in double figures in every game this season except for one. The Lady Bulldogs will look for some redemption on Saturday afternoon against Coastal Carolina, as the Lady Chanticleers defeated the Lady Bulldogs in both regular season meetings last year. Tip-off is slated for 4:30 p.m.

High Point increased its winning streak to three straight with a 2-0 road swing through Presbyterian and UNC Asheville. The Panthers opened the weekend with a hard fought 69-64 win over the Blue Hose and followed it up with a 77-63 win against Asheville. Junior MACKENZIE MAIER scored 21 points and sophomore SHAMIA BROWN recorded her second double-double of the season with 15 points and 12 rebounds in the win over PC to lead High Point. The Panthers were led by junior AMY DODD in the win over UNC Asheville as the Apex, N.C., native went off for a career-high 28 points. Dodd shot 10-15 in the game and 4-6 from behind the arc to break her previous career high of 18 which scored against Livingstone College in 2007. She also grabbed five rebounds and picked up four steals. The 28 points are the most scored by any active High Point University women's basketball player in a single game. Maier blocked six shots in the contest, making it the fourth time in seven conference games that the junior has blocked at least six shots.

Liberty went 2-0 on the South Carolina "Beach Trip" for the 11th consecutive season ... The Lady Flames extended several streaks, as they have now won seven straight games overall, 26 straight contests against Charleston Southern and 32 straight games versus Coastal Carolina ... Liberty's 65-52 win at Charleston Southern on Saturday was No. 250 of CAREY GREEN's 11year coaching career. He is now 251-81 ... The Lady Flames' Monday victory over Coastal Carolina came in their 300th game against a Big South opponent since joining the conference. Liberty is now 232-68 versus Big South opposition ... Liberty trailed Coastal Carolina by 10 points with 17:06 remaining, before outscoring the Chanticleers by a 39-10 count the rest of the way.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College lost two home games this week against two of the league's best teams. On Saturday, the Blue Hose proved their mettle against a tough High Point squad, making it a one possesion game in the final minute but ultimately falling, 69-64 to the Panthers. Against Gardner-Webb on Monday night was a different story as the league's top team soundly defeated RONNY FISHER's troops 80-39. PC returns to action this weekend against two teams that sit just above the Blue Hose in the league table in Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern.

RADFORD

Radford hit the road for the first time since, Jan. 4 this past weekend and fell in both contests at Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern. The Highlanders had their three-game winning streak snapped. Despite the defeats, Radford continued to force its opponents into several miscues. After forcing 20 and 23 turnovers against Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern, the Highlanders' swarming defense has forced 20-plus miscues in 13 games this season, including the last three. Sophomore KAHEALANI VICK matched career-highs with eight points and eight rebounds at Charleston Southern. Freshman VICTORIA HAMILTON dropped in a career-high 11 points at Charleston Southern, her first double figure scoring game of her young career.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville ended a five-game losing streak with a 64-58 victory over North Carolina Central Friday night. CHIOMA OKOLI established a career-high 24 points and grabbed a career-best 14 rebounds in the victory. LINDSEY MONTGOMERY had her seventh double-double of the year with 13 points and 14 rebounds vs. N.C. Central. Asheville fell to High Point on Monday at home, 77-63. Montgomery had yet another double-double, her eighth, with 15 points and 18 rebounds. Okolia finished with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

WINTHROP

Senior guard/forward SHANICE COLE scored 14 points in the loss to Gardner-Webb on Saturday and in the process passed the 500 point mark of her career and now has 513. This is the first year Cole has been a starter and is averaging 11.8 points, 2.3 assists and 1.3 steals a game while shooting 43 percent from the field.
