The guard got her week going with a career-high 20 points on 60 percent from the floor, to go along with 10 rebounds and three helpers as Radford downed UNC Asheville on Jan. 16. Two days later against Presbyterian College, Wood shot 50 percent from the floor and canned 2-of-2 from downtown to finish with eight points in Radford's 59-34 win over the Blue Hose. She also chipped in five rebounds, five assists and four steals in the win.

Antic shot 78 percent from the floor and averaged 13.3 points per contest to help Liberty to a 3-0 record in last week, including a pair of Big South wins. Against Longwood on Jan. 12, Antic poured in 19 points as she connected on 73 percent from the floor and ripped down 10 boards for the Lady Flames. On Jan. 16 against Presbyterian College, Antic stayed hot from the floor as she nailed all seven of her tries to finish with 14 points. She closed her week out with seven points on 60 percent from the field and four rebounds against UNC Asheville. Her hot shooting fueled the Lady Flames to a 37-point average margin of victory during the three-game span.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She currently has 64 treys on the season. If she stays on pace she will likely take over the over the No. 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10. She is only seven treys off from the No. 10 position. Tull is also ranked No. 3 in the country with 3.7 treys per outing.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 48 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 14 in the country with 2.7 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 7 all-time in the Big South record book with 179 career blocked shots and is eying the single season top ten.

RECORD (RE)SETTERS

The Charleston Southern Bucs set the single season three point standard last season as they 260 treys on the year. Their current pace of 9.0 per game, which ranks No. 3 in the nation, says they'll reset the record that they set a year ago. The Bucs currently have 150 on the year and are looking to finish with 264 total three-pointers at the pace they're going.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored Big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

With Winthrop's win over Utah Valley, Lady Eagle mentor **BUD CHILDERS** became the school's All-Time winningest coach with 60 wins at the helm of the Winthrop squad.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

1ST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

History was made with co-favorites being selected for the first time in the Big South's annual preseason poll. Liberty and High Point tied for the top spot with 160 points in the voting by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Lady Flames garnered nine first-place votes to the Panthers' seven top bids.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to receive the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two (tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantastic Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **VAN CHANCELLOR** and **SYLVIA HATCHELL**. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern had a solid week outside of Big South action, going 2-1 overall and 2-0 against non-conference opponents... The Buccaneers got the week started with a huge 69-36 victory over Savannah State University Jan. 12, and also defeated Wingate University 62-59 Jan. 18...CSU also dropped a league contest 58-45 to Gardner-Webb... The 36 points allowed against Savannah State was the seventh-lowest total CSU has ever allowed a game in the history of the program...The Buccaneers also wrapped up non-conference action, finishing with a stellar 8-5 mark outside of league play... **KATIE TULL** was a force offensively in every game this past week...Tull, who is third in the nation in three's made per game, kept her pace going by knocking down 13-of-26 treys in the three-game stretch... She was 5-for-6 from downtown against both Savannah State and Wingate, and knocked down three three's against Gardner-Webb...Tull shot 44 percent (18-for-41) from the field this past week, 50 percent from behind the arc and 100 percent from the free-throw line (8-for-8)...Her best game came against Wingate, when she led all scorers with 25 points on an efficient 8-of-11 shooting from the field and 4-for-4 from the free-throw line... She also tied her career high with five steals against the Bulldogs...Tull averaged 19 points per game this past week in 36.3 minutes... **LeCHELL RUSH** has been dominant over the past month and a half, and she is only getting better. She had one of her best games of the season against Wingate, shooting 9-for-14 from the field and dropping a career-high 19 points... She also went a career-high 8-for-10 from the free-throw line against Gardner-Webb...Rush averaged 11 points and six boards a game in 24 minutes...She also recorded four steals in the three games...Rush shot 48 percent from the field (11-for-23) and 73 percent from the free-throw line (11-for-15).

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won their second consecutive Big South game against Winthrop 59-57 on Monday, January 18 in Kimbel Arena-Conway, S.C.The game was tight all the way through, consisting of 14 lead changes and a tied score six different times. Redshirt-junior **LAUREN GROCHOWSKI** played just 22 seconds, but scored the game-winning three-pointer off of her first shot with 18 seconds remaining in the game. Senior **KENDRA REYNOLDS** sealed the win by hitting two key free-throws with four seconds left in the game. Coastal went 8-for-8 in the final five minutes with the score being no more than four. The Chants finished the game shooting a season-high 12-for-13 (92.3 percent) from the charity stripe. Reynolds also posted her second straight double-double of the season, tallying 10 points and 12 rebounds. **AMANDA STULL** led the Chanticleers with 18 points, two rebounds, three assists and two steals. Stull also went 4-for-6 from beyond the arc. The have posted a 7-0 record this season in Kimbel Arena.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Lady Bulldogs overcame a bad shooting night at Charleston Southern by way of its defense, as GWU held the Buccaneers, the top scoring offense in the Big South Conference, to a season low 45 points on 19.1 percent shooting. In the win, the Lady Bulldogs had three players score in double-figures highlighted by junior forward **LATROYA POPE's** double-double of 15 points and 10 rebounds. The 58-46 conference road win was the Lady Bulldogs first of the season and is a great start to Gardner-Webb's stretch of 7-road games out of the next 8 contests. Last season, the Lady Bulldogs were 1-7 on the road in conference play and will look to continue to improve on that record this year with a win in its road conference opener. This week the Lady Bulldogs will play on the road twice, as first GWU will face off with Winthrop at 4 p.m. on Saturday, January 23, in Rock Hill, S.C. and then will travel to Clinton, S.C. to square off with Presbyterian College on Monday night, January 25, at 7 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point bounced back from its loss at Gardner-Webb with a 69-60 win over Winthrop at home. Junior **MACKENZIE MAIER** led High Point with 22 points, nine rebounds and seven blocks. The 22 points were the most scored by any HPU player this season and two short of her career high of 24 which she scored against CSU last season. It was the third time in five games that Maier tied her own HPU DI single-game blocks record with seven rejections. The Panthers never trailed in the game.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 3-0 last week, winning its games by an average of 37 points per contest to finish off a perfect 5-0 homestand ... The Lady Flames extended a number of streaks, including overall wins (5), Big South home wins (17), January home wins (42) and consecutive games holding opponent under 50 percent from the field (100) ... The last time a Liberty opponent shot 50 percent from the floor was Dec. 29, 2006, when Marist made 50.0 percent of its field goals against the Lady Flames at the Terrapin Classic ... Freshmen **JELENA ANTIC** (19 points, 10 rebounds) and **DEVON BROWN** (16 points, 13 rebounds) both posted double-doubles against Longwood on Jan. 12, becoming the first Liberty duo to notch double-doubles in the same game since Megan and Moriah Frazee did so versus Houston at the National City Xavier Invitational on Nov. 24, 2007.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College returns home for a six-game home stand following a disappointing tour of Virginia. The Blue Hose fell on Saturday to Liberty, 73-27, followed by a loss to Radford on Monday by a 59-34 margin. Two Blue Hose set new career highs in the game against Radford when **SHONDA BURNSIDE** scored 12 points and **CHELSEA PARKER** netted nine. PC returns to the friendly confines of the Templeton Center against High Point on Saturday where the Blue Hose have won two games on the trot.

RADFORD

Radford has turned things around since conference play has begun. The Highlanders have won three straight and four of their first five conference games. Two key factors have been their offensive and defensive output. In league play Radford is averaging 62.4 ppg (44.8 fg pct) and holding opponents to 52.6 ppg (32.0 fg pct.), compared to 48.1 ppg (32.6 %) and 63.2 ppg (44.3%), going from a -15.1 scoring margin to a +9.8 margin. Also, their three point shooting has improved from 21.7 percent to 48.8 percent. In its victory over Presbyterian Monday evening, Radford held the Blue Hose to a school record low five points in the first half, the fewest since holding Liberty to eight on Jan. 21, 2001 in Lynchburg. Also, it was the fewest points allowed (34) in a contest since Jan. 3, 2008 against USC Upstate. **DENAY WOOD** has been on fire from downtown hitting 12 of her last 18 attempts (.667), which included a career-best 4-for-6 performance against UNCA. Radford has dished out 51 assists in its last three games, lending a helping hand on 76.1 percent (51 of 67) of its baskets. Radford assisted on 18 of 22 against Winthrop, 17 of 23 against UNC Asheville and 16 of 22 versus Presbyterian.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville has lost five straight. The Bulldogs continue to get great play from junior forward **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY**. She leads Asheville in scoring (12.4), rebounding (9.9), blocked shots (22) and steals (25). She has six double-doubles on the year and leads the Big South in rebounding. The Bulldogs continue to struggle to score. Asheville has gone eight consecutive games without scoring at least 60 points in game. The Bulldogs are out-rebounding their opponents 39.3 to 36.8.

WINTHROP

Junior guard **LACEY LYONS** returned to her old stomping grounds on Monday in her first return to Coastal Carolina since transferring. Lyons scored 11 points off the bench as she was a perfect 4-for-4, which included 3-for-3 from behind arc. She now has 139 career treys and is ranked 18th all-time in the Big South. Shanice Cole scored 16 points and now has 499 career points. The senior forward/guard has been a substitute in her entire career until this year and has stepped up offensively so far. She leads the team at 11.7 points per game and is averaging 15.4 points in five conference games. She is also closing in on 400 career rebounds and she now has 388.
