Wasmer also chipped in seven boards, three assists and one steal.

TOP DOGS

With its win over Liberty on Feb. 8, Gardner-Webb secured possession of No. 1 in the Big South standings. The win at the Vines Center snapped a 17-game home winning streak for the Lady Flames, dating back to the 2007 season. Gardner-Webb took both games in the regular-season series with Libery becoming just the second team in Carey Green's 11 seasons to do so.

For the second-straight week, Gardner-Webb is ranked No. 30 in the USA Today ESPN Division I Top 25 Coaches' Poll. Gardner-Webb recieved a season-high 13 votes in this week's poll.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's KATIE TULL has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She currently has 84 treys on the season. If she stays on pace she will likely take over the over the No. 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10. She is currently No. 2 on the single season list. Tull is also ranked No. 5 in the country with 3.6 treys per outing. Her mark is currently tops on the single three-point field goal per game list.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 70 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 13 in the country with 2.9 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 5 all-time in the Big South record book with 201 career blocked shots and is ranked 10th the single season top ten.

UNC Asheville's LINDSEY MONTGOMERY has picked it up in the post for the Bulldogs. She is currently averaging 10.4 boards per game to rank No. 18 in the country. Her average is currently ninth on the Big South single season list. She is the only player in the Big South averaging double-digits in both scoring and rebounding.

OUEENS OF THE CAROMS

With its +15.7 rebound margin, Libery is currenlty ranked No. 1 in the nation. Stanford ranks No. 2 with a +13.7 margin with the undefeated UConn Huskies in third with a +12.6 margin.

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Flordia 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow range and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. KATIE TULL led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate KELSEY WASMER connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied thier own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homestanding Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

High Point's JURICA HARGRAVES was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to recieves the honor, joining KATIE O'DELL who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's MACKENZIE MAIER, MARGARET ROUNDTREE and DOMINIQUE HUDSON of Gardner-Webb and KYMESHA ALSTON from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two(tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantasitc Fan" card.

Liberty head coach CAREY GREEN is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as C. VIVIAN STRINGER, VAN CHANCELLOR and SYLVIA HATCHELL. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Charleston Southern has now won four of its last five games in the conference as the Buccaneers stayed home and took care of UNC Asheville and High Point this past weekend... Čharleston Southern has now reached 13 wins this season, which is the most in the JULIE GOODENOUGH era and tied for the third-most in a single season in school history... CSU defeated the Bulldogs 90-87 and took down the preseason favorites 66-60 thanks to some late heroics by multiple players... ALI SCHWAGMEYER shot 88 percent from the free-throw line and had one of her best weekends as a Buccaneer, as she averaged 9.5 points and 13.5 rebounds...Against UNCA, she grabbed a career-high 15 boards and has now hit double-digit rebounds in each of the last three games... KELSEY WASMER shot 52 percent from the field and 73 percent from the free-throw line over the two games... She averaged 18.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.0 steals in 36.5 minutes... She recorded 20 points and six assists against UNCA, and scored 7 of CSU's last 10 points to power the comeback in the final minutes... She scored 17 points and grabbed seven rebounds, while shooting 6-for-6 from the line, against High Point... KATIE TULL shot 44 percent from the field, 50 percent from downtown (9-for-18) and 89 percent from the free-throw line...Tull averaged 19.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists in 35.5 minutes... She dropped 25 points against High Point, drained five treys and went 6 of 6 from the line... Tull now has 84 made three-pointers this season, which extends her single-season school record.

COASTAL CAROLINA

It was the week of revenge for the Chants as they beat High Point, 67-60 and UNC Asheville, 14-8, whom they previously lost to in the beginning of conference play. The Chanticleers improved their home record to 10-1, outscoring its opponents nearly 15.1 points per game in Kimbel Arena. Against High Point, the Chants had four players in double-figures with KATIE WHITE leading the way with a career-high 17 points. SYDNEI MOSS posted her fifth double-double of the season with 14 points and 12 rebounds, while DEVIN RIVERS had her first with 13 points and 10 rebounds. OLIVIA IRICK went 4-for-4 from beyond the arc, where she scored all 12 of her points. In the win over UNC Asheville, Katie White continued her significant play by scoring 11 points off the bench, putting away five blocks, and grabbing two rebounds. Senior AMANDA STULL had a team-high 12 points and five rebounds, while Sydnei Moss followed with 10 points and five rebounds.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb pushed its winning streak to seven games in a 59-56 win over Liberty in its lone game last week. With the win, the Lady Bulldogs moved to 8-1 in conference play and took sole possession of first place for the first time this season. Gardner-Webb shot over 50 percent for the contest, using a late three-pointer by DOMINIQUE HUDSON and two clutch free throws by senior MARGARET ROUNDTREE in the final 19 seconds of the game to upend Liberty in the Vines Center in Lynchburg, Va. The win snapped Liberty's winning streak at 10 and handed the Lady Flames its second conference loss of the season, both coming by way of Gardner-Webb. The Lady Bulldogs had four players in double figures in the contest and continued to distribute the points evenly, as four players are averaging over 10 points per game on the year. Gardner-Webb will now continue its roughest road trip of the season, as the Lady Bulldogs will take on Radford on Wednesday, February 10, in Radford, Va. at 7 p.m., a postponed contest from last Saturday. GWU will then turnaround and face off with High Point in High Point, N.C. on Saturday afternoon, February 13, at 2 p.m.

High Point struggle din its two-game road trip against Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern. The Panthers fell behind early in the game against the Chanticleers and trailed by ten with less than four minutes left in the contest. HPU went on an 8-1 run to pull within three but could not catch the Chants, who hit four of six free throws in the final 20 seconds to pick up the win. Sophomore SHAMIA BROWN scored 19 points to lead High Point. Following the loss to CCU, the Panthers headed to Charleston, S.C. to play Charleston Southern. HPU led by eight with nine minutes left but were outscored 24-10 the rest of the way, losing 66-60. Down three with 17 seconds left, freshman ERIN REYNOLDS had a good look at a game-tying three but the shot fell just short and CSU grabbed the rebound and hit a three at the buzzer to pick up the win. Reynolds scored a career-high 18 points and had a career-high five steals. Junior Mackenzie Maier had seven blocks to tie her own HPU Division I single-game blocks record for the fourth time in nine conference games.

Liberty saw several streaks snapped during a 59-56 home loss to Gardner-Webb on Monday ... Prior to the setback, the Lady Flames had won 10 straight games overall and 17 consecutive Big South home contests ... Liberty had also kept 105 straight opponents from shooting 50 percent from the field, before the Bulldogs made 52.3 percent of their field goals ... The Lady Flames have clinched their 14th winning season in a row ... AVERY WARLEY recorded double-doubles in both of Liberty's games last week, giving the redshirt sophomore five double-doubles in her last six games ... Warley is already ranked No. 30 on Liberty's career rebounding list (441 boards) and No. 50 on the Lady Flames' all-time scoring list (498 points) ... Liberty now plays only one game in the next 11 days, a Feb. 15 tilt at Winthrop.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose are on their longest winning streak since making the move to Division I play with wins over Winthrop and Coastal Carolina. PC will look to extend the streak to three games on Tuesday night, hosting Allen University (NAIA) before returning to the Big South campaign on Saturday afternoon against UNC Asheville. The game against the Bulldogs can be seen live across Western North Carolina and the Upstate on WMYA-40.

Radford finally begins the second half of Big South play when it hosts first place Gardner-Webb on Wednesday. Due to the area's third winter snowstorm, the Highlanders contest against the Runnin' Bulldogs scheduled for Feb. 6 was moved to the Feb. 10. And as a result of that, Radford has not stepped on the court since Feb. 1 when it faced Liberty at home. It will be the second straight contest against a team with a significant winning streak. The Bulldogs, coming off a win at Liberty, have won seven straight. The Lady Flames defeated the Highlanders last Monday for their ninth straight victory.

UNC Asheville lost two tough games on the road this weekend. The Bulldogs fell at Charleston Southern, 90-87 on Saturday and 60-41 at Coastal Carolina on Monday night. LINDSEY MONTGOMERY continued her good work as she scored 18 points at CSU and 14 points plus eight rebounds at Coastal Carolina. She continues to lead the Bulldogs in scoring (12.8), rebounds (10.3), blocked shots (27) and steals (33). She's shooting 50 percent from the field (45-of-90) in league games. Sophomore guard LINDSEY THOMPSON had a streak of three games scoring in double figures but was injured against Coastal Carolina. Her status is day-to-day. Junior guard KENDALL SHEPARD scored in double figures in back-to-back games. Asheville plays five of its final six games at Justice Center starting with a TV games vs. Presbyterian Saturday afternoon at 2 p.m.

SHANICE COLE scored 21 points in the loss to Presbyterian on Saturday. It was the second straight 20-point game for Cole and the fourth on the season. She currently leads the team in scoring at 12.5 points a game and is 5th in the conference, but leads the Big South at 16.3 per game in conference games only. This season Winthrop is 1-10 on the road and 2-12 away from the Winthrop Coliseum. In the 11 road games, Winthrop is averaging 48.5 points a game, shooting 35 percent from the field, 27 percent from three and shooting 62 percent from the foul line. The team is averaging 22.9 turnovers a game and Cole leads the team in scoring at 11.9 per game. She is shooting 40 percent from the field on the road and 74 percent from the foul line. JESSICA FANSLER is averaging 8.8 points a game on the road, but shooting just 30 percent from the field.
