Brown averaged 24.5 points and 11.0 rebounds to lead Liberty to a 2-0 record last week in Big South play. Brown got her week started with a career-high 29 points, including 19 points in the second half to help the Lady Flames overcome a seven point halftime deficit. The guard shot 71 percent from the floor against the Panthers and ripped down 11 rebounds. Defensively, Brown added two blocks and one steal in the victory. Two days later at Radford, Brown stayed hot as she poured in 20 points on 50 percent from the floor and 8-of-9 from the line. She also pulled down 11 caroms and came away with three steals and one assist in the win over the Highlanders. Liberty's two wins last week pushed the Lady Flames to a tie for the top spot in the Big South. The honor is Brown's second Big South Player of the Week plaudit this season.

DIALED IN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been shooting the lights out from downtown all season. She currently has 75 treys on the season. If she stays on pace she will likely take over the over the No. 1 spot on the Big South single season top 10. She is currently No. 5 on the single season list. Tull is also ranked No. 4 in the country with 3.7 treys per outing. Her mark is currently tops on the single three-point field goal per game list.

THE DIVA OF DISALLOWANCE

MACKENZIE MAIER of High Point has established herself as one the League's premier defensive threats in the League. She has racked up 60 blocked shots on the season and currently ranks No. 11 in the country with 2.9 rejections per game. She has moved up to No. 5 all-time in the Big South record book with 191 career blocked shots and is eying the single season top ten.

GLASSMASTER

UNC Asheville's **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** has picked it up in the post for the Bulldogs. She is currently averaging 10.7 boards per game to rank No. 14 in the country. Her average is currently fifth on the Big South single season list. Montgomery also ranks No. 21 in the nation with nine double doubles on the season. She is the only player in the Big South averaging double-digits in both scoring and rebounding.

BCS BUSTERS

Gardner-Webb and High Point scored Big wins over BCS schools on Dec. 21. Gardner-Webb pulled out a nailbiter 56-55 over Purdue, while High Point took down Florida 75-68. The win marked the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent, while the Panthers' win was their first-ever win over a BCS school.

LIGHTS OUT, UNCONSCIOUS... WHATEVER YOU WANT TO CALL IT

The Charleston Southern Bucs traveled to then No. 4 North Carolina on Nov. 29 with the mindset of "if I am in the gym, I am in range" and they stuck to that game plan. Charleston Southern knocked down 17 three pointers against the Tarheels in a narrow 76-67 loss. The nine-point loss to UNC was the closest win of the season for the Tar Heels, and it was also the first single-digit loss by CSU in the eight-game all-time series. **KATIE TULL** led all three-point shooters with six and finished with a total of 18 points. Teammate **KELSEY WASMER** connected on five treys and totaled 19 points. The Bucs' 17 total threes tied their own Big South single game record and set a record with 49 total three-point attempts. Charleston Southern outscored North Carolina in the second half 31-30.

TAKE'N HOME THE HARDWARE

The Liberty Lady Flames took home the tournament crown at the Navy Classic with wins over Tulane and Navy. Liberty held the homesteading Midshipmen to just 11 second half points in their first loss of the season. High Point snatched the Gator Holiday classic with wins over William & Mary and Florida.

1ST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

History was made with co-favorites being selected for the first time in the Big South's annual preseason poll. Liberty and High Point tied for the top spot with 160 points in the voting by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Lady Flames garnered nine first-place votes to the Panthers' seven top bids.

TOP DOGS

High Point's **JURICA HARGRAVES** was selected the Big South's Preseason Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Hargraves is just the second High Point player to receive the honor, joining **KATIE O'DELL** who picked up the honor during the 2005-06 season. Other players on the Preseason All-Conference team were High Point's **MACKENZIE MAIER**, **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** of Gardner-Webb and **KYMESHA ALSTON** from Radford.

BIG SOUTH GIVING PROPS TO ITS "FANTASTIC FANS" THIS SEASON

The Big South Conference and its nine women's basketball playing member institutions have created a "Fantastic Fan" program for the 2009-10 season. The conference-wide program, created from a grant awarded by the NCAA Women's Basketball Grant Program, aims to increase attendance by an average of 20 percent at Big South Women's Basketball games by developing relationships between teams and fans, by rewarding loyalty. The program offers attendance-based prizes, with a grand prize trip for two (tickets, hotel and airfare) to the 2010 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas, courtesy of the Big South Conference. Fans who attend a total of eight games will be eligible for the grand prize with the winner being randomly selected from the list of fans that successfully completed the "Fantasitc Fan" card.

GOING GREEN

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is among the nation's elite women's basketball coaches of all-time. Green is currently ninth all-time among NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his .755 winning percentage, ahead of renowned coaching legends such as **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **VAN CHANCELLOR** and **SYLVIA HATCHELL**. His squads have averaged more than 23 wins a season during his tenure.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern garnered a split on the road this weekend by beating Presbyterian College 64-49 and falling to Winthrop 58-48... The Buccaneers hit 14 three's against the Blue Hose and knocked down six trey's against the Lady Eagles... CSU's contest against Winthrop was televised live on SportSouth, and the TV appearance was the first for the Buccaneers in the JULIE GOODENOUGH era... Charleston Southern moved back into second place in the NCAA in three's made per game... **KELSEY WASMER** stepped up and had two monster games for the Buccaneers... She averaged 16 points in the two-game stretch, and hit seven three's overall... She shot 12-for-31 (39 percent) from the field and 7-for-19 (37 percent) from downtown in 31.0 minutes per game... She recorded career highs with nine rebounds against Winthrop and four steals against PC... The 21 points she scored against the Lady Eagles was her highest total ever against a conference opponent... **KATIE TULL** led all scorers with 16 points against PC, and hit three trey's... She is just one three-pointer shy of tying the school record for three's in a single season... She averaged 9.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.5 steals in 37.5 minutes... **HELEN TERRY** scored 10 points in both games this week, and knocked down three three's against Presbyterian College... She also averaged 3.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 3.5 steals in the two-game stretch... **TINA DeCARVALHO** played in her 100th career game against Presbyterian College, and she has also started the last three games... She scored nine points (second-highest total of the season) and knocked down three three's (season high) against PC... **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** recorded 11 rebounds against Winthrop.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers struggled on the road this past week by losing both games against Gardner-Webb 78-33 and Presbyterian 56-46. The Chanticleers have posted a 2-7 record away and have not won an away game since Dec. 20. Against Gardner-Webb, the Chanticleers were led by **SYDNEI MOSS** with 11 points. **KATIE AHAUS** followed with seven points all scored in the first half. In the Presbyterian loss, Moss had a double-double with a game-high 15 points and 10 rebounds, her fourth of the season. Redshirt junior **LAUREN GROCHOWSKI** posted a career-high 13 points. The current three game losing streak is the longest of the season for the Chanticleers.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb Lady Bulldogs used a 19-0 run to start the second half and held the Lady Chanticleers to only 13 points in the final 20 minutes of play to blow out Coastal Carolina 78-33 in Big South Conference play. With the win, the Lady Bulldogs set a new GWU Division I record for the most wins in a single season with 18, while Coach **RICK REEVES** moved into sole possession of third among the League's winningest coaches with 159 wins as a Big South Conference member. The 11 home wins ties the Lady Bulldogs record for most home wins in a single season, matching last years total, while the seven conference wins matches the number of conference wins that GWU had all of last year in its first year in the Big South. The win is the Lady Bulldogs sixth win in a row and third straight 20 point victory. Gardner-Webb will return to action on Saturday, as the Lady Bulldogs will tip-off a four-game conference road trip on Saturday, February 6, at Radford University at 3 p.m. GWU is 4-1 on the road in conference play this season, a huge improvement on last season in which the Lady Bulldogs won only one conference game all year.

HIGH POINT

High Point fell to Liberty, 75-62, in the team's only action this past week. The Panthers led by seven, 41-34, at the half but shot just 24 percent (6-20) in the second half. Junior **JURICA HARGRAVES** and sophomore **SHAMIA BROWN** each scored 13 points to lead HPU in the loss. It was Hargraves third straight game scoring in double figures. Junior **FRANCES FIELDS** dished out a game-best six assists. The loss was just the second in the past 10 games for High Point and only its second of the season in the Millis Center where HPU is 7-2 this season.

LIBERTY

Liberty's road wins at High Point and Radford extended the Lady Flames' longest winning streak of the season to nine games ... The Lady Flames are now 92-5 in their last 97 games during the month of February ... **DEVON BROWN** (29 points) and **VERY WARLEY** (26 points) both posted career highs for points at High Point Saturday, becoming the first Liberty duo to score 20 points in the same game since **MEGAN** (22 points) and **MORIAH FRAZEE** (20 points) did so versus High Point, Jan. 29, 2008 ... Liberty has outrebounded 10 consecutive opponents by at least 10 boards, helping the Lady Flames remain the nation's No. 1-ranked team for rebound margin ... At 16-4, the Lady Flames have clinched their 14th consecutive winning season.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College moved out of the cellar on Monday night with a 56-46 win over Coastal Carolina. The Blue Hose led by as many as 13 in the game where PC equaled their season low in turnovers with 18. PC will enter the second half of the season on Saturday afternoon when Winthrop comes to town. The game will be the fifth in a string of six straight home contests.

RADFORD

Radford had its three-game home winning streak snapped on Monday against Liberty. Prior to Monday's contest, Radford had won four-of-five at the Dedmon Center. During that stretch Radford shot 45 percent from the floor and averaging 36 percent from long range. Take out a 1-20 performance against Southern Virginia on Dec. 5., RU was shooting at a 44 percent clip from three-point land.. Defensively, Highlander opponents were shooting just 33.2 percent from the field. After forcing 24 turnovers against Liberty on Monday, Radford opponents have committed 20-plus miscues in 13 games this season. The Highlanders forced a season-high 37 turnovers against Southern Virginia, along with 26 against Presbyterian and then-No. 11 North Carolina. Last season, the Highlanders forced 20-plus turnovers in 15 contests.

UNC ASHEVILLE
