Edwards had the hot hand in two Big South wins this past week to help the Chanticleers clinch the regular-season title. He shot 68.4 percent from the floor (13-of-19), 57.1 percent from three-point range (4-of-7) and averaged 16.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game. In the 71-48 win over Liberty that clinched the No. 1 seed, Edwards scored a team-high 13 points and dished out three assists. Edwards then led the Chants with 20 points to go along with seven rebounds and six assists in the 101-71 win over VMI. He was 8-of-11 from the field, 3-of-4 from three-point range and had a steal in the victory over the Keydets.

TOURNAMENT TIME IS HERE

The 2010 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship tips off Tuesday, March 2 with two quarterfinal games in the Palmetto State, one in the mountains of North Carolina and one in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Coastal Carolina, Radford, Winthrop and UNC Asheville are the top four seeds, and went a combined 30-6 (.833) at home during the Conference season. Asheville is hosting for the third consecutive season, while Radford is hosting for the second-straight year. The bottom four seeds -- High Point, Liberty, Charleston Southern and VMI went 10-26 (.278) away from home during the League season.

HISTORY ON ITS SIDE?

Coastal Carolina will have home court advantage throughout the 2010 Conference Tournament as the No. 1 seed. The Big South began having its No. 1 seed host throughout the postseason in 2004, and since that time, the No. 1 seed has reached the Championship game every year for six-straight years, winning five titles. The 2008 postseason was the first time that the Big South's No. 1 seed did not win the Conference Tournament during the current format.

COASTAL CAROLINA RE-WRITES HISTORY

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to improve from eighth-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The Chanticleers have re-established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the previous best was accomplished just last season when Radford improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE

Coastal Carolina is the Big South's regular-season champion for the 2009-10 season, its first regular-season crown since 1990-91. The 19-year span between titles was the second-longest drought in Big South history, just behind Charleston Southern's current streak of 23 years since its last regular-season championship. The Chanticleers, which have assured themselves of at least an NIT berth, are the No. 1 seed for the fifth time, and last won the Conference Tournament in 1992-93.

TURN BABY TURN

Coastal Carolina enjoyed a Big South record-tying turnaround from last season's 11-20 overall mark and 5-13 Big South record. The Chants are +15 in the overall win column from a year ago and +10 on the Conference win side -- the best year-to-year improvement in Conference play based on the same number of League games the previous season. Liberty first set that record with a 6-win improvement during a 12-game Conference schedule in 2002-03. That year, the Flames went 8-6 in the League after going 2-12 in 2001-02. Coastal Carolina matches the Big South's best ever year-to-year improvement in overall wins of +15, which was first achieved by Radford in 1990-91. That season, the Highlanders finished 22-7 after posting a 7-22 mark in 1989-90. In Big South games, the Chanticleers also equaled the League's top overall year-to-year win improvement of +10, which was accomplished by Radford in 2008-09. Last season, the Highlanders went 15-3 after going 5-9 in 2007-08.

TV TUNER

For the fifth consecutive year, ESPN2 will televise the Big South Tournament Semifinals live from the site of the No. 1 seed, while ESPN2 will broadcast the Championship game live from the arena of the highest remaining seed. **JON SCHIAMBI** and former Notre Dame and NBA standout **LaPHONSO ELLIS** will call both the Semifinals from Coastal Carolina and the title game from the campus of the highest remaining seed.

ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10

The Big South had six teams win 10 Conference games this season, tying the League record that was first accomplished in 1993-94. UNC Asheville won 10 Big South games for the third consecutive season -- the first time in school history and just the third Big South program to accomplish the trifecta. The Bulldogs join UNC Greensboro (three times from 1993-96) and Winthrop (nine times from 1999-08) as the only schools with three-straight 10-win Conference seasons.

STEADY EDDIE NETS OVERALL WIN RECORD

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the Big South's all-time winningest this past Saturday in the Bulldogs' 89-86 win over Gardner-Webb in the regular-season finale. The victory was his 195th overall win at Asheville, breaking the previous League record of 194 wins that was established by former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** from 1998-07. Earlier this season, Biedenbach became the Big South's all-time leader for most regular-season Conference wins on Thursday, Jan. 21 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, which was his 110th Big South victory, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Biedenbach now has 117 regular-season Big South victories.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TIDBITS

Since the Big South adopted its current home site Conference Tournament format in 2003, the home seeds are a combined 31-12 (.721) in 43 possible home games. This total does not include games that were played on a neutral floor in 2003 (semifinals and finals) and 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 (semifinals).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 19-9 (.679 percent) on their home courts after last year's top four seeds were all victorious in the same season for the second consecutive year.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

Coastal Carolina has broken two school records and one Big South record for victories. The Chanticleers have won a school-record 26 games this season -- the most regular-season wins in Big South annals. The League's previous record for most regular-season wins was 25, which was set by Winthrop in 2006-07 prior to the Big South Tournament. The Eagles finished that year with a Big South single-season record 29 victories. Coastal Carolina's 15 Big South wins also is a school mark, and ties the League record for most Conference victories in one season. The Chants are the fourth team with 15 Big South wins in one season.

RELAX THE BACK

Coastal Carolina is the first Big South team since Winthrop in 2006-07 to not lose back-to-back games during the season.

MEMBERS ONLY

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 20th player in Big South history to grab 700 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark on Feb. 16 at Liberty. Parakhouski is now 11th all-time in League annals with 752, and needs three to move into the top 10. He also is the seventh player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

PUNCHING THE TIME CLOCK

Presbyterian College played five overtime Big South games this season, but went 1-4 in those extra session contests. It is nothing new for the Blue Hose, as PC took three Big South foes to overtime last season.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME?

The road teams won 34 of the 90 Big South games played this year -- a .378 winning percentage, thanks to the home teams going 19-7 in the final 26 Conference games of the season. Here is a look at how each team fared in home and road Big South games in 2009-10, in final standings order:

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, the school's all-time leading shot blocker, became the fifth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Feb. 23 at Winthrop. He became the 56th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds on Feb. 11 vs. Liberty, and is now just one of four players in League history with 500 rebounds and 200 blocked shots. Williams is fourth all-time with 205 rejections, and needs 10 more to move into a tie for third-place.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has now directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons, and has reached 25 victories for the fifth time in his coaching career. He collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College, and owns a lifetime record of 662-389. Ellis has amassed 584 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 26 wins this season exceed his combined total from his first two years leading the Chanticleers (24).

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** has grabbed 383 rebounds this season, breaking his Big South single-season record of 369, which he set last season. The first player in Big South history with 350 rebounds in back-to-back seasons, Parakhouski needs 17 to become the first player in League history with 400 in one season. His per game average of 13.2 is pacing +1.8 ahead of the League record of 11.4. Meanwhile, Parakhouski enters the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship ranked in the top 10 nationally in rebounding (1st - 13.2) and field goal percentage (10th - 58.3), and is 9th in scoring (21.6).

CHARTER MEMBER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is the Big South's all-time leading rebounder with 1,115 and he is seven steals away from becoming the 12th player in League history with 200. He is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. Harris became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** just two seasons ago.

HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 31 games, dating back to 2008-09. In addition, Parakhouski leads the nation with 24 double-doubles -- including 16 in 18 Big South contests.

FEBRUARYS IN ROCK HILL

Since the 2004-05 season, Winthrop is 38-12 (=76.0 winning percentage) in the month of February, including a 33-10 mark in League games (=76.7 percent).

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb sophomore forward **JOSH HENLEY** surpassed 500 career rebounds Feb. 20 against Elon, becoming the 57th Big South player to reach the milestone and just the second to do it in his sophomore season. Henley joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** as the only sophomores to reach 500 career rebounds. Spinks totaled 523 in his first two seasons with the Camels en route to becoming the Big South's all-time leading rebounder from 1994-2008. Henley's total after two seasons is... 523.

I WANNA BLOCK

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 5.76 blocks per game and 167 total blocked shots, which is the second-most in a single-season in Big South history. The Bulldogs now own the top three marks -- 196 in 2007-08, this year's total with at least one game remaining, and 165 in 1997-98. **JOHN WILLIAMS** leads the Conference with 2.79 blocks a game, and is looking to become the ninth Bulldog player to lead the Big South in blocked shots, the last being **KENNY GEORGE** in 2007-08 (3.3).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point sophomore **NICK BARBOUR** is 51 points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 949 points in 58 career games played. Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 99th player in Big South history with 1,000 points when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 2 at VMI -- and tied as the sixth-fastest player in League annals to score 1,000 career points (55 games). Trifunovic has 1,022 career markers, including 686 in two seasons at Binghamton (he has 336 in 25 games with the Highlanders). He also has 586 career rebounds (208 at Radford). Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College and ends his career with 1,223 points (604 as a Big South member).

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **LOGAN JOHNSON** was named to the 2010 *ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-Team* on Feb. 4. Johnson's selection marks the fifth consecutive year that the Big South has had an Academic All-District honoree.

SWEEPS SEASON

With 45 Conference series completed, 28 resulted in season sweeps (62.2 percent). Coastal Carolina swept six League foes this season, followed by Radford, Winthrop, UNC Asheville and Liberty with four each.

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (21.6), rebounding (13.2) and field goal percentage (58.3), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Parakhouski is trying to become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

EUGENE HARRIS ENTERS 250/250 CLUB

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers (282) and 250 career assists (260). He is eighth in Big South history with a school-record 282 career three-point field goals, and joins Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST) on the League's 250 three-pointer, 250 assist list.

WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** continues to lead the Big South in steals per game with 2.21, and is third in the League in rebounding at 8.5 as well as fifth in field goal percentage (50.5) -- the only Big South player to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. He also is 10th in the Big South with 14.0 points per game. Martin's 64 steals this season are a career-high, and he is two away from 100 in his young career. He is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04, and could become the third player in Big South history to lead the Conference in steals per game while averaging 8.0 rebounds a contest.

DOUBLE DIGIT WINS BY DOUBLE DIGITS

The Chanticleers won 12 of their 15 Big South games by 10-or-more points -- including three by at least 30 points, for the second-most double-digit wins in Conference games in League history. UNC Greensboro established the record of 14 such wins in 1994-95, as the Spartans won all 14 of their Big South games by at least 10 points that season. Coastal Carolina's average margin of victory in their 15 Conference wins was 16.6 points, and the team owns an overall scoring margin of +15.5, which is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers posted a +12.9 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +15.2 margin against League foes in 2006-07.

ONE RECORD DOWN, ANOTHER ONE WITHIN REACH

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** became the Big South's all-time assist leader on Feb. 13 against Coastal Carolina, as he broke the record of 567 career assists in the game. He now has 593 helpers in his collegiate career and is just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists. His 472 career rebounds are the most of the 1,000-point/500-assist club members, and he is seven rebounds away from becoming the first player in League history with four consecutive seasons with 100 assists and 100 rebounds.

CRUZZING TO NEW HEIGHTS

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is the first player in Big South history to block at least 65 shots in four consecutive seasons, and could also become the first player since at least before the 2004-05 campaign to record a blocked shot in every game during the season. Daniels enters the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship second all-time in League annals with 297 career blocked shots, and he has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 34 consecutive games, averaging 2.74 blocks in that span (93 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 18 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 650 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

CONFERENCE SEASON HEATED UP IN FEBRUARY

The last 26 Big South Conference games of the regular season were decided by an average margin of 8.69 points, with 17 of the contests decided under 10 points. In addition, the home team went 19-7 in that span. Of the 90 Big South Conference games played in 2009-10, 49 were decided by less than 10 points (54.4 percent) -- including 32 by five points-or-less. The average margin of victory in games decided by less than 10 points this season was 4.59 points. Of the 41 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory was 17.24 points. The overall margin of victory in League play in 2009-10 was 10.51 points. Last season, the average margin of victory in Conference games was 8.96.

KEEP AN EYE ON...

UNC Asheville sophomore guard **J.P. PRIMM** and Liberty sophomore point guard **JESSE SANDERS**. Primm enters the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship needing three assists for 300 in his young career. He also has 110 steals in less than two seasons. Sanders has been the Flames' top rebounder in 13 of 30 games this season, and already has 368 boards in his career. He also is 14 assists shy of 300.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 72 of his 76 career games and has made 254 total for a 3.34 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 53 of his 59 career games and already has 169 in his career, an average of 2.86 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern junior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 257 three-point field goals in his career, good for 10th on the Big South's all-time list. Warren broke the CSU mark of 234 (**BRETT LARRICK**, 1993-97) on Feb. 4. Meanwhile, Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** has 197 career threes, while UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** has 190 treys in his career, second-most in school history.

COACHES CORNER

Gardner-Webb head coach **RICK SCRUGGS** needs one more win for 200 as the leader of the Runnin' Bulldogs. In addition, Presbyterian College's **GREGG NIBERT** is one win shy of 350 in his coaching career. PLANNING AHEAD

Presbyterian College is in the second-to-last year of its transition to Division I and will become full-fledged members of the NCAA's top division in 2011-12. PC will be eligible for the Big South's postseason tournament and automatic bid that same year. Therefore, head coach **GREGG NIBERT** redshirted three of his top players this season -- **AL'LOUNZO COLEMAN**, **JOSH JOHNSON** and **PIERRE MILLER**, so all three will be fifth-year seniors in 2011-12. The trio combined for 946 points last season -- 54.7 percent of the Blue Hose's season total, and Coleman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors after averaging 15.0 points and 8.4 rebounds.

OH-MAN, OH-MY

Liberty senior **KYLE OHMAN** scored a career-high 39 points Feb. 20 against High Point, including 18-of-25 from the free throw line. Ohman's effort was the fourth-most free throws made in a Big South single-game, while his attempts were the second-most in a League contest. The single-game records for free throws made and attempted are held by the same two individuals. Both Towson State's **DEVIN BOYD** (Feb. 27, 1993 vs. UMBC) and UNC Asheville's **ANDRE SMITH** (Feb. 1, 2003 vs. Elon) went 22-of-26 from the charity stripe. The other player to make more free throws in a game than Ohman was former Liberty Flame **MATT HILDEBRAND**, who made 19 vs. Charleston Southern on Feb. 19, 1994.

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKET BUSTING

The Big South made its fifth consecutive appearance in the BracketBusters on Feb. 20, and for the third time, the League won two of its match-ups -- both coming from its first-timers. Radford defeated UNC Wilmington at home, while Presbyterian College won at Jacksonville State to snap a 27-game overall road losing streak and 13-game non-Conference road skid. Winthrop, which made its fifth-straight appearance in the series, lost at Eastern Kentucky, while Gardner-Webb fell at home to Elon.

HOME ON THE RANGE

Coastal Carolina (15), Radford (12), High Point (12), Winthrop (11), Charleston Southern (11) and UNC Asheville (10) have all won at least 10 home games this season. It is the most home wins for Coastal Carolina on record, the most for Radford since winning 12 last season, for Winthrop since winning 12 in 2007-08, for High Point since winning 13 in 2007-08 and for Charleston Southern since winning 11 in 1987-88 as Baptist College.

COASTAL CAROLINA RECEIVES HIGHEST RANKING IN MID-MAJOR POLL

Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 11 in last week's *Collegiansider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, the team's highest position in the poll this season. The Chants' previous best ranking was No. 14 the week of Jan. 25. This is the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25, and the second-straight season that more than one team entered the poll, as Radford was ranked the first three weeks of the season. BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (21.6 points/13.2 rebounds), **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (13.4 points/8.3 rebounds) and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (12.0 points/6.4 rebounds) account for 62.3 percent of RU's offense and 62.3 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 47.0 points and 27.9 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 38 double-doubles this season.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Defending three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with an average of 89.1 points per game. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead the nation three-straight years.

COMING FULL CIRCLE

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

Charleston Southern closed out the regular-season splitting a pair of home games, taking a 95-85 win from VMI before falling 74-61 vs. Liberty in the regular season finale ... Against the Keydets, the Bucs shot 50.7 percent (34-of-67) from the field and were led by **KENNY MITCHELL**'s career-high 21 points. The win also clinched a Tournament berth and the No. 7 seed ... The Bucs struggled on offense at times against Liberty, shooting just 35 percent as a team and just 20 percent from behind the arc in the second half. **KELVIN MARTIN** did all he could, pouring in a season-high 22 points to go along with seven rebounds and two steals ... Despite the loss, CSU recorded an 11-3 record at home, the most home wins since the Bucs went 11-1 in 1987-88.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina clinched the school's fifth Big South regular-season title last Thursday, defeating Liberty, 71-48 ... With the win, Coastal Carolina will host the Semifinals of the Big South Men's Basketball Championships for the first time ... Coastal Carolina honored seniors **JOSEPH HARRIS**, **LOGAN JOHNSON** and **MARIO EDWARDS** before Saturday's game. The trio has combined for 2,810 points, 1,747 rebounds and 644 assists in their careers ... Coastal Carolina shot 59.2 percent from the floor in the 101-71 win over VMI on Saturday. It was the 16th time this season the Chants have shot 50 percent or better.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb tied with VMI for eighth-place in the Big South standings, but lost the tiebreaker to qualify for the Big South Tournament and ends its season at 8-21 ... Senior **ANTON SILVER** averaged 18.7 points over the final six games of the season, scoring 20 points in four of those contests -- including the final three games ... **BRANDON JACKSON** had a season-high 13 assists in the season finale at Asheville.

HIGH POINT

High Point posted at least one win over nine of the 10 Big South teams this season. The only team that swept HPU was VMI ... The Panthers went 10-8 in Conference play after going 4-14 last year ... **NICK BARBOUR** went 9-for-9 from the free throw line against Winthrop on Thursday, tying **DUSTIN VAN WEERDUIZEN** for the best single-game free throw performance in HPU's Division I history ... Barbour led HPU in scoring for the 19th time this season with 20 points against Winthrop -- the 14th time this season he had at least 20 points ... R-freshman **COREY LAW** had double-doubles in both games last week and has five in the last 11 games. He scored a career-high 18 points and tied his career-high with 15 rebounds against Presbyterian College on Saturday ... **CRUZ DANIELS** had five blocks against PC, the fourth time this season he blocked at least five shots in a game.

LIBERTY

In Liberty's win over Charleston Southern, **EVAN GORDON** and **JESSE SANDERS** each tied career-highs in scoring with 24 and 16 points, respectively ... **KYLE OHMAN** is currently 17th on Liberty's all-time scoring list at 1,119 points, 36 shy of surpassing **EVAN GORDON**'s father, **ERIC GORDON** (1,154) ...
