



TIS THE CONFERENCE SEASON...

The Big South Conference season begins this week with nine games on the slate, as the Conference debuts its new Thursday-Saturday playing format. All but UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb will play two League games this week, as those two teams will meet in a Friday night tilt. Below is a team-by-team look at Big South openers:

BIG SOUTH TELEVISION PACKAGE TIPS OFF THIS WEEK

The Big South "Royal Purple Game of the Week" television package officially tips off this week with two broadcasts on the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN). The network will televise Thursday's Coastal Carolina at VMI contest live at 9:00pm, as well as Friday's UNC Asheville at Gardner-Webb game live at 7:30pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call Thursday's game, while Hogue and **RALPH PATTERSON** will handle the call of Bulldogs-Bulldogs on Friday.

ROAD WARRIORS

With the Big South season set to begin this week, the Conference takes a look back at League play in 2008-09, when the road teams won 42 of the 90 Big South games played -- a .467 winning percentage. It was the most Conference road wins since the Big South Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule).

HARRIS CONTINUES ASCENSION

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who opened the season tied for seventh on the Big South's all-time rebounding chart, jumped into third-place after just four games. He now has 897 career boards and is three away from becoming the third player with 900. Harris needs 57 rebounds to move into a tie for second, and stands 117 shy of breaking the all-time record of 1,013. He is currently averaging 11.6 rebounds a game, and is on pace to eclipse the record Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville. Harris needs 103 rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Below is a look at the Conference's top 3 all-time rebounders.

WELCOME TO THE CLUBS

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the 94th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 21 against Voorhees. He is just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. He joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS**, who accumulated 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 220 steals and 155 blocks for the Camels from 1990-94. Harris is three rebounds shy of becoming the third player in League annals with 1,000 points and 900 rebounds.

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** scored 26 points and grabbed 20 rebounds Sunday at Duquesne. He is the first Highlander to reach the 20-20 mark in a game, and is the first Big South player to do so since Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** had 33 points and 22 rebounds against VMI on Feb. 14 of last season. Parakhouski leads the Big South in both scoring (25.0) and rebounding (16.0) and is looking to become the first player since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 to lead the Big South in both categories, a feat that has been accomplished just three times in League history. Meanwhile, Parakhouski's 16.0 rebounding average ranks first in the nation and is pacing way ahead of the Big South single-season record average of 11.4.

TOP DOG IN THE DEAN DOME

Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** tied a Dean Smith Center record with nine three-point field goals in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 93-72 loss at No. 11 North Carolina last week. Flittner equaled the mark set by Georgia Tech's **DENNIS SCOTT** and **DREW BARRY** and finished the night with 32 points. Flittner needs 56 three-point field goals to become Gardner-Webb's all-time leader, and 80.9 percent of his field goals this season have been from beyond the arc (17 of 21 overall FG).

SHOOTING FOR 1,000

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** became the third player this season and 95th in Big South history to reach 1,000 career points, when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at Air Force. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers and their respective rank in League history, as well as additional players closing in on the milestone.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,047 points in his career (428 as a Big South member).

BULLETIN BOARD

High Point redshirt senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is currently 51st in League history with 514 career rebounds. He needs eight to move into a tie for 50th. Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** is seven away from becoming the 53rd player overall and second this season with 500 career boards, while teammate **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** is 67 away from the milestone.

BABY LET'S CRUZ

High Point redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 235 career blocked shots. He is averaging a career-high 3.25 blocks a game this season and has recorded a blocked shot in his last nine contests -- just one away from matching his career-long streak of 10 games (2007-08). Daniels has blocked at least five shots in a game 15 times in his career, and finished with 70+ blocks in each of the last two seasons. Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** holds the Conference's all-time blocked shot record with 366 from 1994-97. Daniels is one of just three players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots, joining Aluma and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1989-94).

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 49 of his 52 career games, including a streak of 41-straight to open his collegiate career. He has 180 career treys for a 3.46 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the Big South's active three-point field goal leader with 220, and he is 22 away from cracking the League's all-time top 10 in the category. Meanwhile, three other players are looking to join the Big South's 200 three-pointer club, which currently stands at 23 members: Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** (188), VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** (180) and Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** (179).

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is already 16th in Big South history with 138 career blocked shots. He needs one more to move into a tie for 15th place. Williams is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is tied for 21st in League history with 112 career blocks.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** is currently 12th in Big South history with 451 career assists. He needs 18 to move into a tie for 11th, and 49 helpers to become the 10th player in Conference annals with 500 in a career. Johnson is 116 assists away from reaching the League's all-time record of 567 assists, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08).

FREQUENT FLIERS

Charleston Southern junior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a three-point field goal in 36 consecutive games and in 52 of his last 53 contests. VMI sophomore **KEITH GABRIEL** drained his 100th career trey in his 36th career game, and now has 103 as a Keydet. He has nailed a three-pointer in 32 of his 36 career appearances.

RADFORD, COASTAL CAROLINA AMONG TOP MID-MAJOR PROGRAMS

Radford was ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll for the first three weeks of the season, and remains on the cusp of the national ranking this week, as the Highlanders find themselves in the 37th position. Coastal Carolina also received votes this week and is in the 48th slot. The Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 six consecutive years now, and below is a week-by-week look at this year's rankings among the Conference members:

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 106 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just four League victories to surpass former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 181 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 13 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

SPEAKING OF WINNING COACHES...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is two wins away from 100 in his collegiate coaching career. He won his 98th game as a head coach and 61st with VMI when the Keydets defeated West Virginia Wesleyan on Nov. 18. Baucom is already the fifth-winningest coach in VMI history after just four-plus years at the helm.

PLANNING AHEAD

Presbyterian College is in the second-to-last year of its transition to Division I and will become full-fledged members of the NCAA's top division in 2011-12. PC will be eligible for the Big South's post-season tournament and automatic bid that same year. Therefore, head coach **GREGG NIBERT** has redshirted three of his top players this season -- **AL'ONZO COLEMAN**, **JOSH JOHNSON** and **PIERRE MILLER**, so all three will be fifth-year seniors in 2011-12. The trio combined for 946 points last season -- 54.7 percent of the Blue Hose's season total, and Coleman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors after averaging 15.0 points and 8.4 rebounds.

COMING FULL CIRCLE

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FIFTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 19-20. A League-high four members will represent the Big South in 2010 -- Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, Radford and Winthrop. Winthrop, which will make its fifth-straight appearance in the series, and PC will play road contests, while Gardner-Webb and Radford will host games. The Big South is 5-6 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006 and 2007. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances in each of the past three years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU).

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Artsiom Parakhouski, Radford

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-1 last week. The Bucs registered points from 13 different players in the win over Trinity College, while shooting 47.7 percent as a team. Freshman **JEREMY SEXTON** led four players in double figures as he hit five treys for a team-high 17 points in addition to a game-best seven assists ... Charleston Southern led virtually the entire first half at Air Force and despite a late run, could not overcome a 33.3 percent shooting effort and 45.0 clip from the free throw line. **JAMARCO WARREN** finished with a team-high 18 points (five threes) and six assists against the Falcons.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina shot a sizzling 84.4 percent (27-of-32) from the free throw line in its 77-62 win over Indiana State. The Chants made their first 16 free throws and made 24 of their first 25 freebies against the Sycamores. It was the most free throws in a game by CCU since Feb. 25, 2006 against Radford (33) ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** pulled down his 889th rebound in the first half against Allen to set the school's all-time rebounding mark. Harris needs one blocked shot to break that school record ... Coastal had 62 points in the paint and 18 fast break points vs. Allen.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU dropped its first two games of the season, falling at No. 11 North Carolina last Monday and at home vs. Western Carolina on Saturday ... The two losses came to teams with a combined 12-2 record ... Gardner-Webb averaged 26 turnovers in its two losses last week, including a Division I era-worst 30 vs. WCU ... The Runnin' Bulldogs are averaging 19.0 assists per game so far in 2009-10 and 78.4 points in five outings.

HIGH POINT

NICK BARBOUR has led High Point in scoring in all four games this season, and 14 of HPU's last 17 contests, dating back to last season. He had a team-high 14 points at Auburn last Wednesday ... The Panthers outscored Auburn, 36-35, in the second half, marking the first time the Panthers have outscored an SEC opponent in a half in nine all-time meetings ... High Point's game against South Carolina State on Monday will be the first-ever meeting between the two schools. The only MEAC school High Point has ever faced is North Carolina A&T on four occasions.

LIBERTY

JESSE SANDERS grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds against Mississippi Valley State last Friday, besting his previous high of 10 ... **KYLE OHMAN** is now ranked 23rd on Liberty's all-time scoring list with 863 points. Ohman scored 23 points in Liberty's win over Tennessee State, including the last 11 points in the first half ... Freshman **PATRICK KONAN** posted 16 points in Liberty's victory over Mississippi Valley State ... The Flames played their first eight games in a span of 15 days.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Redshirt-freshman **JAKE TROYLI** has scored in double figures in six consecutive games to open his career, becoming the first PC student-athlete since the school moved to Division I to accomplish this feat. In three games last week, Troyli averaged 18.3 points, 5.7 rebounds, 52.6 percent from the field (20-of-38), 83.3 percent from beyond the arc (5-of-6) and 71.4 percent from the line (10-of-14) ... **TRAVIS SMITH** nearly posted a double-double in his second game of the year, tallying 15 points and a PC Division I record nine assists against Southern ... Three players scored in double figures against Southern, including **CHASE HOLMES'** season-high 22 points ... Presbyterian College plays its first home game of the season Monday against Montreat.

RADFORD

ART PARAKHOUSKI ranks first nationally in rebounds per game (16.0) and is tied for seventh nationally in points per game (25.0) ... Parakhouski became the first player in Radford's men's basketball history to record 20 points and 20 rebounds in a contest, as he charted 26 points and 20 rebounds (nine offensive) in 40 minutes of action at Duquesne on Sunday ... Freshman **BLAKE SMITH** has scored in double figures in all four games this season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville is off to its worst start since opening the 2001-02 season at 0-5 ... Things do not get any easier as the Bulldogs play at unbeaten and No. 4-ranked Kentucky in Louisville Monday night ... The Bulldogs have used five different starting lineups in their five games this season ... Sophomore **J.P. PRIMM** is Asheville's leading scorer with a 12.3 scoring average ... **CHRIS STEPHENSON** scored a career-high 23 points in the season-opening loss at Charlotte ... **MATT DICKEY** scored a career-best 26 points vs. Campbell.

VMI

Freshman **STAN OKOYE** produced his first career double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds at UNC Wilmington last Tuesday. Okoye was not expected to play after spraining his ankle in practice the day before, and made 7-of-13 shots and grabbed seven offensive boards ... VMI looks to start 3-0 at home for the fourth consecutive year if it can defeat Lynchburg College Monday night ... Sophomore **MICHAEL SPARKS** scored 13 points after intermission and finished with 17 points at UNCW for his third double figure scoring game in four contests ... Through four games, VMI is averaging just 14.8 assists per game, below the 18.16 that ranked third in the nation last year.

WINTHROP

Winthrop took a seven-day break from games during the Thanksgiving week after dropping a 102-66 decision at No. 19 Clemson last Monday. The 102 points were the most allowed by Winthrop to a non-Conference opponent since falling at Syracuse, 106-51, in November 1996 ... After going 1-of-28 from three-point range in the first two games, Winthrop has connected on 6-of-14 in the last two contests (=42.9 percent) ... The Eagles are expecting **CHARLES CORBIN** back after serving a four-game suspension for disciplinary reasons.
