BIG SOUTH SENDS MULTI-TEAMS TO POSTSEASON FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT YEAR

For the third consecutive year, the Big South Conference has two men's basketball teams playing in the postseason in the same year. Winthrop received the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while Coastal Carolina is the Conference's second-ever participant in the NIT. Last season, the Big South had a team in the NAAs (Radford) and *Collegeinsider.com* Postseason Tournament (Liberty), and in 2007-08, the Big South had participants in the NCAA Tournament (Winthrop) and NIT (UNC Asheville).

WINTHROP HEADED TO OPENING ROUND GAME FOR SECOND TIME

Big South champion Winthrop will play in the NCAA Tournament Opening Round game for the second time and will face Arkansas-Pine Bluff of the SWAC Tuesday night in Dayton, Ohio. Winthrop first appeared in the Opening Round game in 2001, falling to Northwestern State by four points, 71-67. It is the third time overall that the Big South Conference will open the postseason in Dayton. In 2003, UNC Asheville defeated Texas Southern in overtime to become the first team in Big South history to win an NCAA Tournament game.

COASTAL CAROLINA HEADED TO UAB FOR NIT FIRST ROUND

Regular-season champion Coastal Carolina will make its debut in the NIT Tuesday night against second-seeded UAB at 8:00pm ET in Birmingham, Ala. The Chanticleers are the second Big South team in history to appear in the NIT, which is the school's first postseason appearance since 1993. Coastal Carolina owns the most wins of any team in this year's NIT field, and its No. 7 seeding is higher than the Big South's previous NIT representative (UNC Asheville was a No. 8 seed in 2008). The winner of Tuesday's Coastal Carolina-UAB game would play the winner of South Florida-North Carolina State.

WINTHROP CAPTURES 2010 BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE

The No. 3 seed Winthrop Eagles defeated No. 1 seeded Coastal Carolina, 64-53 in the Big South Tournament Championship game to advance to the NCAA Tournament. It is Winthrop's ninth berth in the Big Dance in the past 12 seasons, as well as its 10th overall Big South Tournament title – extending its Conference record. Winthrop is just the second No. 3 seed to win the Big South Tournament, joining the 1992 Campbell Camels.

AN A-PEELING NOTE

Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** is now just the second coach in Big South Conference history to make three appearances in the NCAA Tournament. Peele led former member UNC Greensboro to the Big South title and NAAs in 1996, and repeated the accomplishment in his first season as Winthrop's head coach in 2008. Meanwhile, Peele has won his three Big South Tournament Championships on the home floor of his opponents. In 1996, Peele and UNC Greensboro defeated Liberty in the title game in the Vines Center, and in 2008, Peele and Winthrop downed UNC Asheville in the Championship game at Justice Center.

ELLIS NAMED A FINALIST FOR HUGH DURHAM AWARD

For the second-straight year and third time in four seasons, a Big South Conference coach is among the finalists for the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year Award, as Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of 15 finalists for the 2010 honor. Last season, VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** and Radford's **BRAD GREENBERG** were finalists, while former Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** won the award in 2007. The 2010 winner will be presented with the award at the 2010 Final Four in Indianapolis.

ELDER STATESMAN

Big South Coach of the Year and Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has now directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons, and has reached 25 victories for the fifth time in his coaching career. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 664-390. Ellis has amassed 586 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 28 wins this season exceed his combined total from his first two years leading the Chanticleers (24). This will be Ellis' 20th postseason trip, as he has eight NCAA Tournament appearances and now 12 NIT appearances to his credit.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT RECAP

For the third consecutive season, the top four seeds advanced to the Semifinals of the Big South Tournament, marking the 12th time overall -- as well as the first time in Tournament history that all top four seeds advanced with quarterfinal wins for the third-straight year. Meanwhile, the No. 1 seed advanced to the title game for the seventh-straight year, and the Championship game featured No. 1 vs. No. 3 for just the fourth time. In addition, Winthrop and Coastal Carolina met in the Finals for the third time, with the Eagles now 2-1 against the Chanticleers in the title game.

BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history through last season:

COASTAL CAROLINA RE-WRITES HISTORY

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to improve from eighth-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The Chanticleers re-established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the previous best was accomplished just last season when Radford improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE

Coastal Carolina won its first regular-season crown since 1990-91, and the 19-year span between titles was the second-longest drought in Big South history, just behind Charleston Southern's current streak of 23 years since its last regular-season championship. The Chanticleers were the No. 1 seed in the Big South Tournament for the fifth time.

TURN BABY TURN

Coastal Carolina enjoyed a Big South record-setting turnaround from last season's 11-20 overall mark and 5-13 Big South record. The Chants are +17 in the overall win column from a year ago and finished +10 on the Conference win side -- the best year-to-year improvement in Conference play based on the same number of League games the previous season. Liberty first set that record with a 6-win improvement during a 12-game Conference schedule in 2002-03. Coastal Carolina establishes the Big South's best-ever year-to-year improvement in overall wins at +17, which surpasses the +15 achieved by Radford in 1990-91. That season, the Highlanders finished 22-7 after posting a 7-22 mark in 1989-90. In Big South games, the Chanticleers equaled the League's top overall year-to-year win improvement of +10, which was accomplished by Radford in 2008-09. Last season, the Highlanders went 15-3 after going 5-9 in 2007-08.

DOUBLE DIGIT WINS BY DOUBLE DIGITS

The Chanticleers won 12 of their 15 Big South games by 10-or-more points -- including three by at least 30 points, for the second-most double-digit wins in Conference games in League history. UNC Greensboro established the record of 14 such wins in 1994-95, as the Spartans won all 14 of their Big South games by at least 10 points that season. Coastal Carolina's average margin of victory in their 15 Conference wins was 16.6 points, and the team owns an overall scoring margin of +14.6, which is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers posted a +12.9 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +15.2 margin against League foes in 2006-07.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

Coastal Carolina broke two school records and one Big South record for victories this season. The Chanticleers have won a school-record 28 games in 2009-10 -- the second-most wins in Big South history and includes the most regular-season wins in Big South annals with 26. The League's previous record for most regular-season wins was 25, which was set by Winthrop in 2006-07 prior to the Big South Tournament. The Eagles finished that year with a Big South single-season record 29 victories. Coastal Carolina's 15 Big South wins also is a school mark, and the Chants are the fourth team with 15 Big South wins in one season.

RELAX THE BACK

Coastal Carolina is the first Big South team since Winthrop in 2006-07 to not lose back-to-back games during the season.

CHEAPER BY THE DOZEN

For the second consecutive season and for the fourth time in Big South history, three teams won at least 12 Conference games in the same season. Coastal Carolina tied the Big South record for most League wins with 15, while Radford is just the third team in League annals to win at least 13 Conference games in back-to-back seasons. Winthrop won 12 Big South games this year. The Big South record for most teams with at least 12 Conference wins is four, which occurred in 1993-94.

CHARTER MEMBER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** recorded 10 steals in three Big South Tournament games, and became the 12th player in League history to reach 200 career steals during the Chanticleers' Semifinal win over UNC Asheville. Harris is the Big South's all-time leading rebounder with 1,147, and is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 200 steals and 100 blocked shots. Harris became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARI-ZONA REID** just two seasons ago. Meanwhile, Harris became the Big South's all-time leader for most games played during the Tournament, and his record total stands at 133.

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **LOGAN JOHNSON** was named to the 2010 *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III First-Team on Feb. 4. Johnson's selection marks the fifth consecutive year that the Big South has had an Academic All-District honoree.

STEADY EDDIE NETS OVERALL WIN RECORD

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the Big South's all-time winningest coach in the Bulldogs' 89-86 win over Gardner-Webb in the regular-season finale on Feb. 27. The victory was his 195th overall win at Asheville, breaking the previous League record of 194 wins that was established by former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** from 1998-07. Earlier this season, Biedenbach became the Big South's all-time leader for most regular-season Conference wins on Thursday, Jan. 21 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, which was his 110th Big South victory, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Biedenbach now has 196 overall wins at Asheville and 117 regular-season Big South victories.

ART GALLERY

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** has been named to the United States Basketball Writers Association's (USBWA) All-District III team, which covers Division I programs in Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Maryland. He is the lone Big South player on the team that is comprised mostly of ACC players and one SEC player, and is the Big South's first USBWA All-District honoree since High Point's **ARIZONA REID** in 2006-07. Meanwhile, Parakhouski is the fifth two-time Big South Player of the Year in Conference history, and the fourth to win in consecutive years.

HE WAS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** was the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and recorded the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 33 games, which dated back to 2008-09. Meanwhile, Parakhouski still leads the nation with 26 double-doubles -- including 16 in 18 regular-season Big South contests.

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, the school's all-time leading shot blocker, became the fifth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Feb. 23 at Winthrop. He became the 56th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds on Feb. 11 vs. Liberty, and is now just one of four players in League history with 500 rebounds and 200 blocked shots. Williams is fourth all-time with 209 rejections, and needs six more to move into a tie for third-place.

A WORK OF ART

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the first player in Big South history to grab 400 rebounds in a season, as the senior center amassed a Big South single-season record 414 caroms in 2009-10. The first player in Big South history with 350 rebounds in back-to-back seasons, Parakhouski continues to lead the nation in rebounding with a Big South single-season record average of 13.4, which is +2.0 ahead of the previous record of 11.4. He is looking to become the first Big South player to finish as the Division I leader in rebounds per game. Parakhouski finishes his career 10th all-time in Conference history with 783 career rebounds, and is one of seven players in League annals with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb sophomore forward **JOSH HENLEY** surpassed 500 career rebounds Feb. 20 against Elon, becoming the 57th Big South player to reach the milestone and just the second to do it in his sophomore season. Henley joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** as the only sophomores to reach 500 career rebounds. Spinks totaled 523 in his first two seasons with the Camels en route to becoming the Big South's all-time leading rebounder from 1994-2008. Henley's total after two seasons is... 523.

I WANNA BLOCK

UNC Asheville led the Big South with 5.74 blocks per game and 178 total blocked shots, which is the second-most in a single-season in Big South history. The Bulldogs now own the top three marks -- 196 in 2007-08, this year's total, and 165 in 1997-98. **JOHN WILLIAMS** led the Conference with 2.73 blocks a game, becoming the ninth Bulldog player to lead the Big South in blocked shots, the last being **KENNY GEORGE** in 2007-08 (3.3).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point sophomore **NICK BARBOUR** will enter the 2010-11 season just 26 points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 974 points in 59 career games played. VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** has 908 points to his credit as well. On Feb. 2 at VMI, Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 99th player in Big South history with 1,000 points -- and tied as the sixth-fastest player in League annals to score 1,000 career points (55 games). Meanwhile, Radford's **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** reached 1,000 points in his collegiate career Feb. 20 against UNC Wilmington, making Radford the only active NCAA Division I team with four 1,000-point scorers. Trifunovic has 1,037 career markers, including 686 in two seasons at Binghamton (he has 351 in 27 games with the Highlanders). He also has 598 career rebounds (220 at Radford). Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College and ends his career with 1,223 points (604 as a Big South member).

SWEEPS SEASON

Of the 45 Conference series this season, 28 resulted in season sweeps (62.2 percent), up from 26 last season. Coastal Carolina swept six League foes this season, followed by Radford, Winthrop, UNC Asheville and Liberty with four each.

PARAKHOUSKI SCORES RATE TRIPLE CROWN

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** led the Big South in scoring (21.4), rebounding (13.4) and field goal percentage (58.1), becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Nationally, Parakhouski is No. 1 in rebounding, eighth in field goal percentage and 13th in field goal percentage.

250/250 CLUB

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** ends his career as the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers (283) and 250 career assists (263). He is eighth in Big South history with a school-record 283 career three-point field goals, and joins Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST) on the League's 250 three-pointer, 250 assist list.

WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** led the Big South in steals per game with 2.13, and finished third in the League in rebounding at 8.4 as well as fifth in field goal percentage (50.5) -- joining Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** as the only Big South players to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. Martin also is 10th in the Big South with 14.0 points per game. His 64 steals this season are a career-high, and is the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04. More impressive is that Martin is the third player in Big South history to lead the Conference in steals per game while averaging 8.0 rebounds a contest.

CRUZZING TO NEW HEIGHTS

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is the first player in Big South history to block at least 65 shots in four consecutive seasons. He saw his 34-consecutive game streak with a blocked shot end in the Quarterfinals at UNC Asheville, as he fouled out in just 11 minutes of action. Daniels departs as the second-leading shot blocker in Big South history with 297, and is one of just two players in Big South history with 650 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** ends his career as the Big South's all-time assist leader with 604 -- the only player in League history with 600. He broke the record of 567 on Feb. 13 against Coastal Carolina, and is the only player in League history with 1,000 career points and 600 career assists. He finished three rebounds shy of becoming the first player in League history with four consecutive seasons with 100 assists and 100 rebounds.

KEEP AN EYE ON...

...UNC Asheville sophomore **J.P. PRIMM** and Liberty sophomore **JESSE SANDERS**. The talented point guards will enter 2010-11 with a chance to etch their names in the Big South record books. Primm surpassed 300 career assists in the Bulldogs' Quarterfinal win over High Point and has 311 through two seasons. He also has 113 career steals. Sanders has been the Flames' top rebounder in 14 of 31 games this season and already has 375 boards in his career. He also is 11 assists shy of 300.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 73 of his 77 career games and has made 256 total for a 3.32 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 54 of his 60 career games and already has 173 in his career, an average of 2.88 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern junior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 257 three-point field goals in his career, good for 10th on the Big South's all-time list. He will enter 2010-11 needing 47 to become just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes. Warren broke the CSU mark of 234 (**BRETT LARRICK**, 1993-97) on Feb. 4. Meanwhile, Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** has exactly 200 career threes, while UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** ends his career with 197 treys, second-most in school history.

GARDNER-WEBB'S RICK SCRUGGS NOT RETAINED

Gardner-Webb University will not retain **RICK SCRUGGS** as head coach of its men's basketball program, the school announced on March 5. Scruggs recently completed his 15th season as GWU's head coach, and compiled a record of 199-218 during his time with the Runnin' Bulldogs. Scruggs has gone 377-333 overall in 23 seasons as a college head coach.

BIG SOUTH'S ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER REACHES NBA

REGGIE WILLIAMS (VMI '08), the Big South's all-time leading scorer with 2,556 points, became the third Big South player to reach the NBA when he signed a 10-day contract with the Golden State Warriors on Tuesday, March 2. He made his NBA debut that night in Miami against the Heat, scoring 10 points with five rebounds and five assists. In just his fifth career game on March 8, Williams scored a career-high 28 points in the Warriors' loss to New Orleans. He signed a second 10-day contract on Friday, March 12. Williams joins former Liberty standouts **JULIUS NWOSU** and **PETER ALUMA** as the only Big South players to play in the NBA.

ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10

The Big South had six teams win 10 Conference games this season, tying the League record that was first accomplished in 1993-94. UNC Asheville won at least 10 Big South games for the third consecutive season -- the first time in school history and just the third Big South program to accomplish the trifecta. The Bulldogs join UNC Greensboro (three times from 1993-96) and Winthrop (nine times from 1999-08) as the only schools with three-straight 10-win Conference seasons.

ANOTHER WINNING NOTE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** has led the Bulldogs to the Big South Tournament Semifinals 10 times in his 14 seasons, and his 14 Conference Tournament wins are second in League history to Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL**, who went 19-2 in the League's postseason event.

HOME ON THE RANGE

Coastal Carolina (17), Radford (13), High Point (12), Winthrop (12), UNC Asheville (11) and Charleston Southern (11) all won at least 10 home games this season. It is the most home wins for Coastal Carolina on record, the most for Radford since winning 13 in 1993-94, for Winthrop since winning 12 in 2007-08, for High Point since winning 13 in 2007-08, for UNC Asheville since winning 16 in 2007-08, and for Charleston Southern since winning 11 in 1987-88 as Baptist College.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Defending three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with an average of 88.6 points per game. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead the nation three-straight years.

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (21.4 points/13.4 rebounds), **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (13.0 points/8.0 rebounds) and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (12.3 points/6.7 rebounds) accounted for 62.8 percent of RU's offense and 62.8 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic averaged 46.7 points and 28.1 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio combined for 42 double-doubles this season.

PUNCHING THE TIME CLOCK

Presbyterian College played five overtime Big South games this season, but went 1-4 in those extra session contests. It is nothing new for the Blue Hose, as PC took three Big South foes to overtime last season.

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKET BUSTING

The Big South made its fifth consecutive appearance in the BracketBusters on Feb. 20, and for the third time, the League won two of its match-ups -- both coming from its first-timers. Radford defeated UNC Wilmington at home, while Presbyterian College won at Jacksonville State to snap a 27-game overall road losing streak and 13-game non-Conference road skid. Winthrop, which made its fifth-straight appearance in the series, lost at Eastern Kentucky, while Gardner-Webb fell at home to Elon.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs finished 2009-10 with a 13-17 overall record and 7-11 mark in the Big South, a four-game improvement from the 2008-09 season in both categories. CSU also recorded an 11-3 record at home, tying for the most home wins since the 1987-88 season, when the Bucs went 17-12 and 11-1 at home ... After three seasons, **JAMARCO WARREN** ranks first, second and fourth for three-point field goals made in a single season in school history ... **JEREMY SEXTON** was named Freshman of the Year, the second CSU player in the last three years to receive the award. The Bucs now have two Freshmen of the Year during the **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** era and three overall.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers will face UAB in the NIT, which will be the first time Coastal has played in the event and its first postseason action since 1993. It will be the first-ever meeting between the schools ... Coastal also played in the NIT Season Tip-Off this season, defeating Elon and Indiana State, while falling to Duke and Cal State Northridge ... Big South All-Tournament Team member **CHAD GRAY** averaged 17.7 points, 6.0 rebounds and 62.2 percent from the floor (23-of-37) in his three Tournament games ... **LOGAN JOHNSON** had a career-high 21 points in the opening-round win over VMI.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb tied with VMI for eighth-place in the Big South standings, but lost the tiebreaker to qualify for the Big South Tournament and ended its season at 8-21 ... Senior **ANTON SILVER** averaged 18.7 points over the final six games of the season, scoring 20 points in four of those contests -- including the final three games ... **BRANDON JACKSON** had a season-high 13 assists in the season finale at Asheville.

HIGH POINT

High Point posted a six-win improvement both overall and in Conference play, improving from 9-21 and 4-14 in 2008-09 to 15-15 overall and 10-8 in the Big South this year. It was the second-largest improvement in League play behind Coastal Carolina (10) ... High Point has posted winning records in Big South games in five of the last seven seasons ... HPU head coach **SCOTT CHERRY** has never had a losing season as a player, assistant coach or head coach ... HPU's loss to UNC Asheville on Tuesday was its first loss to the Bulldogs in the Big South Tournament, where High Point now holds a 3-1 all-time edge over Asheville ... The Panthers are 6-3 all-time in Quarterfinal games ... **NICK BARBOUR** led all scorers with 25 points in the loss to UNC Asheville, marking the 14th time this season that he scored at least 20 points and the 19th time he led HPU in scoring ... **COREY LAW** averaged 11.0 points and 8.3 rebounds while shooting 52.5 percent from the field over his last 14 games.

LIBERTY

KYLE OHMAN finished his career at Liberty with 1,141 total points, ranking 17th on Liberty's all-time scoring list. He also ranks fifth all-time in school history for most three-point field goals made with 200 ... The Flames won at least 15 games for the third consecutive season, their best such streak since accomplishing the feat during their first three years of Big South membership from 1992-94.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose ended the season with losses at Radford and at High Point ... **RYAN HARGRAVE** came off the bench to score 11 points in 13 minutes of play at Radford, connecting on 4-of-5 shots. He then notched 12 points at High Point, and just missed a double-double with eight boards ... PC canned seven shots from behind the arc in both games.

RADFORD

ART PARAKHOUSKI tied the Big South Tournament Semifinal record with 18 rebounds against Winthrop ... **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** moved into 10th on Radford's all-time scoring list ... **AMIR JOHNSON** is just two steals shy of tying **ROD COUSIN**'s all-time school record of 192.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville finishes its second straight season with a 15-16 overall record. The Bulldogs tied a school record for Big South wins with 11 ... Asheville advanced to the Semifinals of the Big South Tournament for the 11th time in 15 years ... The Bulldogs reversed their season as they opened 3-12 in the first half of the year and went 12-4 in the second half of the campaign ... **JOHN WILLIAMS** blocked 82 shots on the year, the second-most in school history for a single-season ... The Bulldogs carry a nine-game home winning streak into the 2010-11 season.

VMI

STAN OKOYE set a VMI freshman record for blocks in a season with 44. Okoye's eight double-doubles were the most by a VMI player since **REGGIE WILLIAMS** posted 12 in 2007-08 ... **AUSTIN KENON** has moved into the school's Top 20 list in scoring and now has 1,253 points, which ranks 19th. He needs just three points to move past **DENNIS JOHNSON** (1,253 points - 1977-81) into 18th place. Kenon also cracked the Top 20 in NCAA Career 3-Pointers Made Per Game this season, ranking 19th at 3.32 ... **STEPHEN SARGENT** finished the season with a career-high 34 blocks, which ranked in the top 10 in the Big South and was second on the team to Okoye's 44 ... VMI went 0-15 in games when trailing at the half this season and was 0-17 when trailing with 5:00 left in the game.

WINTHROP

Winthrop will meet SWAC champion Arkansas-Pine Bluff in the NCAA Opening Round. The Eagles have never faced an opponent from the SWAC in their 32-year history ... Winthrop won its fifth Big South Tournament in the last six years ... Head Coach **RANDY PEELE**'s record in Big South Tournament games is now 8-2 (2-1 at UNC Greensboro and 6-1 at Winthrop) ... In the Big South Tournament, two-time Big South Defensive Player of the Year **MANTORIS ROBINSON** limited Liberty's **EVAN GORDON** to 5 points in the Quarterfinals, Radford's **LAZAR TRIFUNOVIC** to 1 point and 0-7 FG shooting in the Semifinals, and Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** to 3 points and 1-6 on FGs in the finals ... The Eagle defense held Radford to a season-low 46 points in the Semifinals.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TIDBITS

Since the Big South adopted its current home site Conference Tournament format in 2003, the home seeds are a combined 36-13 (=.735) in 49 possible home games. This total does not include games that were played on a neutral floor in 2003 (semifinals and finals) and 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 (semifinals).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 23-9 (=.719 percent) on their home courts after this year's top four seeds were all victorious in the same season for the third consecutive year.
