# CHOICE HOTELS CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### JOSEPH HARRIS • F R-Sr. • Coastal Carolina Lejeune, N.C.

Harris recorded his 31st career double-double with 21 points and 17 rebounds in the Chanticleers' 70-59 win over SoCon South Division preseason favorite College of Charleston Friday night. Harris went 9-of-17 from the floor, grabbed six of his 17 rebounds on the offensive front, and added four steals, an assist and blocked shot. It was his 13th consecutive 10-rebound game, dating back to last season.

### NICK BARBOUR • G So. • High Point Danville, Va.

Barbour went 10-of-11 from three-point range and finished with a career-high 38 points in leading High Point to a 104-72 victory over UNC Pembroke on Saturday night. He was 13-of-16 overall from the floor, scored 20 points in the first half and 18 in the second, and made nine consecutive three-pointers to close out the game, including all six of his attempts in the second half. His 90.9 three-point percentage is the highest in a single-game in Big South history. Barbour also had two assists, two rebounds and two steals on the night.

### BLAKE SMITH G • Radford Charlotte, N.C.

Smith scored 17 points and had eight rebounds in his collegiate debut, helping the Highlanders to a 76-65 season-opening win over Navy. He was 7-of-11 shooting, including one three-point bucket, and added three assists, one blocked shot and two steals in 33 minutes of action with no turnovers. Smith also made a halfcourt shot just prior to intermission and had a break-away dunk with 44 seconds left to put the game away.

### BIG SOUTH AGAIN INCLUDED IN ESPN'S 24 HOUR HOOPS MARATHON

Liberty hosts No. 22 Clemson Tuesday morning at 10:00am as part of ESPN's second annual 24-Hour College Basketball Tip-Off Marathon. The Big South participated in last year's inaugural event when ESPN televised the earliest Big South season opener in League history -- Liberty at UNC Asheville.

### PARAKHOUSKI NAMED PRESEASON MID-MAJOR ALL-AMERICAN

Big South Preseason Big South Player of the Year **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** was named to the *Collegeinsider.com* Preseason Mid-Major All-America Team last Friday, the lone Big South player on the list. The team consists of 25 players and honorable mentions, and Division I coaches and NBA scouts are part of the selection process, but the final decisions are made by the *Collegeinsider.com* staff.

### **BIG SOUTH'S MID-MAJOR MANIA**

Following its 76-65 win over Navy in the season opener, Radford has moved up to No. 23 in the *Colleg-einsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll after opening the season at No. 25. Coastal Carolina's 70-59 victory over College of Charleston last Friday landed the Chanticleers in the "receiving votes" section and in the 35th position. The Big South has already had three teams receive votes this year, as UNC Asheville received votes in the preseason poll.

### WELCOME MAT

The Big South's two new head coaches picked up their first wins with their respective programs during the season-opening weekend. New High Point head coach **SCOTT CHERRY** earned his first win with the Panthers' 104-72 victory over UNC Pembroke Saturday night. New Liberty head coach **DALE LAYER** collected his first win with the Flames with Saturday's 89-53 win over Southern Virginia.

### NATIONAL COLLEGE BASKETBALL WRITER TABS THREE AMONG HIS TOP SHOOTERS

*FOXSports.com* senior writer **JEFF GOODMAN** ranked three Big South men's basketball players on his Top 50 three-point shooters list. Goodman ranks Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** at No. 19, VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** at No. 22 and Gardner-Webb's **GRAYSON FLITTNER** at No. 41.

### **HARRIS POLL**

Following his season-opening performance against College of Charleston, Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS** has jumped into fifth-place on the Big South's all-time rebounding list. He now has 833 career boards, and needs 12 to move into a tie for fourth, while standing 181 shy of breaking the all-time record of 1,013. Harris also needs 32 points and 167 rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Below is a look at the Conference's top 5 all-time rebounders.

### **BULLETIN BOARD**

High Point redshirt senior **CRUZ DANIELS** became the 52nd player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone with seven caroms in the Panthers' season-opening win over UNC Pembroke. He now has 502, and needs 10 to move into the 51st position. Meanwhile, Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (470) and Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** (398) are the next likely players to join Daniels in the League's 500-rebound club.

### STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 106 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just four League victories to surpass former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 181 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 13 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

### SPEAKING OF WINNING COACHES...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is three wins away from 100 in his collegiate coaching career. He won his 97th game as a head coach and 60th with VMI when the Keydets defeated Army in their season opener. Baucom is already the fifth-winningest coach in VMI history after just four-plus years at the helm.

### **SHOOTING FOR 1,000**

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** became the 93rd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club after scoring 13 points in the Panthers' season-opening win over UNC Pembroke, pushing his career total to 1,004 points. Five other players are likely to join Harris in the exclusive club this season. Below are the individuals and their career totals following the opening weekend of the 2009-10 season.

### **BOOM GOES THE DYNAMITE**

High Point sophomore **NICK BARBOUR** made 10-of-11 three-point shots in High Point's season opener, becoming the eighth player in Big South history with double-digit three-pointers in a game. The last **Big South** player with at least 10 three-point field goals in a game was Winthrop's **MICHAEL JENKINS**, who tied a Big South single-game record with 12 treys vs. North Greenville in the 2006 season opener. Barbour's 90.9 percentage from three-point range against UNCP is a Big South single-game record.

### **AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE**

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 48 of his 49 career games, including a streak of 41-straight to open his collegiate career. Has has 177 career treys for a 3.61 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08.

### **BABY LET'S CRUZ**

High Point redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 224 career blocked shots. Daniels had a career-high 83 swats in 2008-09 -- the 9th-highest single-season total in Big South history, and his second consecutive season with 70+ blocks. Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** is the Conference's all-time leader with 366.

### FROM THE LAND OF THREE

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the Big South's active three-point field goal leader with 212, and he is 30 away from cracking the League's all-time top 10 in the category. Meanwhile, three other players are looking to joing the Big South's 200 three-pointer club, which currently stands at 23 members: VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** (177), Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** (177) and Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** (170).

### FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** enters his final season in 2009-10 with 438 career assists, which ranks 13th all-time in Big South history. Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** is the Big South's career assist leader with 567 -- just 129 ahead of Johnson's total.

### **BLOCK STEADY**

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is already 16th in Big South history with 127 career blocked shots. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** ranks 21st in League history with 111 career blocks.

### **ROAD WARRIORS**

During Conference play in 2008-09, the road teams won 42 of the 90 Big South games played -- a .467 winning percentage. It is the most Conference road wins since the Big South Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule).

### BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FIFTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 19-20. A League-high four members will represent the Big South in 2010 -- Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, Radford and Winthrop. Winthrop, which will make its fifth-straight appearance in the series, and PC will play road contests, while Gardner-Webb and Radford will host games. The Big South is 5-6 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006 and 2007. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances in each of the past three years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU).

### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern tipped off the 2009-10 season at Maryland, and despite shooting 43 percent from beyond the arc, the Bucs struggled overall from the floor (29 percent) and had 22 turnovers ... CSU trailed by 12 at halftime (37-25), but the Terps opened the second half with a 14-5 run to put the game out of reach ... KELVIN MARTIN just missed a double-double with nine points and eight rebounds.

### **COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina outrebounded the College of Charleston, 49-30, scored 17 second-chance points and had 20 points off Cougar turnovers in its season-opening win ... CHAD GRAY made his anticipated Coastal Carolina debut with 17 points on 8-of-17 shooting. He also grabbed eight rebounds, blocked one shot and had two emphatic dunks in the final minutes of the win ... JOSEPH HARRIS needs two blocked shots for the school's all-time record.

### **GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb had its Division I-best 20 steals in its season-opening win over Covenant College. Those steals ignited a fast break that produced 10 dunks, a 25-2 scoring edge on the break and 30 points off of 28 Covenant turnovers ... Freshman STEFON JOHNSON scored eight points on four dunks in the win ... GRAYSON FLITTNER started his first game at point guard and finished with six assists (no turnovers) and two steals ... AURYN MacMIL-LAN had 17 points, 11 rebounds and six blocked shots in 20 minutes.

### HIGH POINT

High Point opened the season with a win for the first time since 2004-05 ... The 104 points against UNC Pembroke was the 78th time in HPU history that the team scored 100 points in a game ... NICK BARBOUR's 38 points was the most scored by a High Point player since ARIZONA REID scored 42 against VMI on March 1, 2008 ... Barbour's 10 three-point field goals and .909 three-point percentage are the most three-pointers and best three-point percentage since at least 2001-02, based on available school records.

### LIBERTY

Liberty hosts No. 22 Clemson on Tuesday, marking the first time that an ACC opponent has ever visited the Vines Center ... The Flames will face two players on the 2009-10 Naismith Award Watch List this week in Clemson's TREVOR BOOKER and Notre Dame's LUKE HARANGODY. The match-ups will occur just five days apart ... KYLE OHMAN scored 23 points in the season opener at George Mason and scored 15 points the next night at home against Southern Virginia. He was 10-of-10 from the free throw line against SVU.

### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC opened the season at a Top 25 school (#23 Clemson) for the second consecutive season, having opened at Duke to start the 2008-09 campaign ... Freshman ZACH FAIRCLOTH became the first PC student-athlete since moving to Division I to record a double-double in his first career game with his 14 points and 10 rebounds at Clemson ... CHASE HOLMES had a near double-double against the Tigers with nine points and eight rebounds ... KHALID MUTAKABBIR had a team-high three steals in the season opener.

### **RADFORD**

Radford's win over Navy was its first non-conference Division I victory since defeating Campbell on Dec. 8, 2007 ... JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR and ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI have now recorded double-doubles in the same game four times ... Lynch-Flohr had 21 points on 8-of-15 shooting vs. Navy, was 5-of-6 from the line, and grabbed 11 rebounds ... Parakhouski had 20 points and 13 rebounds as Radford came back from a 37-31 halftime deficit to win.

### **UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville dropped its season opener at Charlotte, 86-70, and was without **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who missed the game due to illness ... CHRIS STEPHENSON led the squad with 22 points off the bench, going 8-of-15 from the field and 3-of-6 from beyond the arc ... J.P. PRIMM also made three treys en route to 15 points ... Asheville stays on the road and travels to No. 10 Tennessee on Tuesday before hosting Campbell on Saturday.

VMI won its second-straight season opener after knocking off Army, 93-86 Friday night at Cameron Hall ... Last year, the Keydets opened their season with a 111-103 win at Kentucky ... The Army win gave VMI its first home season-opening win since defeating Southern Virginia, 71-33 on Nov. 22, 2004 ... VMI is now 7-4 all-time against Army in basketball, and has now taken three of the last five in the series ... It also was VMI's first win over Army at home since a 91-67 victory on Feb. 22, 1995 ... RON BURKS had his first career double-double in the win with 15 points and 10 rebounds, in addition to six steals ... Freshman STAN OKOYE started his first college game and contributed 14 points and five rebounds.

The Eagles survived an upset bid by Limestone on Homecoming Day by overcoming a seven-point deficit with 2:34 left in the game to win on a last-second layup by MANTORIS ROBINSON ... Robinson had his second career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds ... The win was Winthrop's 12th-straight home opening victory and improves its home-opening record to 25-7 ... Despite shooting just 33 percent (18-of-54) and being outrebounded 41-35, Winthrop won the game on points off turnovers as it converted 24 Limestone miscues into a 23-8 advantage.
