DEFENDING CHAMPION RADFORD PICKED TO REPEAT IN 2009-10

Radford, last year's Big South regular-season and Tournament champion, has been voted to repeat in 2009-10 by the League's head coaches and media panel in the annual preseason poll. It is the first time since 1999-00 that the Highlanders are the Big South's preseason No. 1, and they enter the season with four starters back from last year's NCAA Tournament squad that finished 21-12. UNC Asheville, which was picked ninth in last year's poll, finds itself as the preseason No. 2 this season with 191 points. It is the Bulldogs' highest placement in the preseason poll since being tabbed the favorite in 2002-03. Winthrop was third in the voting with 179 points and received the remaining first-place vote.

PARAKHOUSKI TABBED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** is the 2009-10 Big South Conference Preseason Men's Basketball Player of the Year. He is the first Radford player to be voted Preseason Player of the Year since **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** in 2001-02. Parakhouski burst onto the scene last year, averaging 16.2 points and 11.2 rebounds in earning Big South Player of the Year and Tournament MVP honors. He led the Highlanders to the Big South regular-season and Tournament championship last season, and was named an Honorable Mention All-American by the *Associated Press*. Parakhouski set the Big South single-season record with 369 rebounds and ranked ninth nationally in rebounding average. He also was second in the Big South in field goal percentage (.537). Joining Parakhouski on the preseason team are teammate **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR**, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS**, Gardner-Webb's **GRAYSON FLITTNER**, with **JAMARCO WARREN** (Charleston Southern) and **NICK BARBOUR** (High Point) tying for the final spot.

BIG SOUTH'S MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford is ranked No. 25 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Preseason Mid-Major Top 25 poll, while UNC Asheville received votes in the opening poll of the season. In 2008-09, the Big South Conference had two teams ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, a first in League history. The Conference had two teams ranked in 13 consecutive weeks from Dec. 8 - March 2, and just missed having three teams in the Top 25 the week of Feb. 16. VMI was the League's highest-ranked team last year at No. 11 the week of Jan. 12. Liberty was next-highest at No. 12 (two times), while Radford cracked the Top 25 the final four weeks of the regular-season. The Big South has had a team ranked in the 10-year old Mid-Major Top 25 poll for five consecutive seasons.

HARRIS POLL

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS** enters his final season tied for seventh-place in Big South history with 816 career rebounds, and he needs just 198 caroms to break the all-time record of 1,013, which is held by **ARIZONA REID**. Harris reached the 800 rebound milestone in the Chanticleers' 2008-09 regular-season finale at Winthrop on Feb. 28, and he surpassed the 500, 600, 700 and 800-career rebound plateaus last season. Harris grabbed at least 10 rebounds against every Big South opponent in 2008-09, recorded a double-double against every League team, and carries a 12-game streak with 10+ rebounds into 2009-10. Harris also needs 53 points and 184 rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2008-09 for the third consecutive season, becoming just the third team since 1948 to lead the NCAA in scoring offense three consecutive years. The Keydets joined Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) on the list. No team has ever led the country in scoring four-straight seasons.

KEYDETS SURPASS OWN NCAA THREE-POINT RECORD

VMI averaged 13.69 three-pointers per game in 2008-09, breaking its national record of 13.39 set during the 2006-07 campaign. The Keydets made 438 three-pointers a year ago, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history with two seasons of more than 400 treys. VMI established the national record of 442 three-point field goals in 2006-07.

3 X 20

The Big South Conference had three 20-win teams for just the third time in League history in 2008-09. VMI won 24 games last season -- second-most in school history and tied for the third-highest win total in Conference annals. Liberty had 23 wins in 2008-09, its most since winning 23 games in 1996-97. Radford surpassed the 20-win plateau during the Big South Tournament and concluded the season with 21 wins, its highest victory output since 22 wins in 1991. The two previous times the Big South had three 20-win teams were 1993-94 and 1985-86.

BULLETIN BOARD

High Point's **CRUZ DANIELS** is five rebounds away from becoming the 52nd player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds. Also approaching the club are Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (459), Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** (388), Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** (369) and UNC Asheville's **JOHN WILLIAMS** (341).

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FIFTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 19-20. A League-high four members will represent the Big South in 2010 -- Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, Radford and Winthrop. Winthrop, which will make its fifth-straight appearance in the series, and PC will play road contests, while Gardner-Webb and Radford will host games. The Big South is 5-6 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006 and 2007. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances in each of the past three years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU).

PLAYING BOARD GAMES

Gardner-Webb sophomore **JOSHUA HENLEY** was the nation's leading freshman rebounder last season at 10.3 caroms per game and was the first freshman in Big South history to grab 300 rebounds in a season. He broke the Big South freshman rebound record of 262 on Feb. 18 vs. Winthrop, which was held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in 1990-91. In addition, Henley's per game average supplanted Spinks' League freshman record of 9.36.

BABY LET'S CRUZ

High Point redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 222 career blocked shots. Daniels had a career-high 83 swats in 2008-09 -- the 9th-highest single-season total in Big South history, and his second consecutive season with 70+ blocks. Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** is the Conference's all-time leader with 366.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** enters his final season in 2009-10 with 438 career assists, which ranks 13th all-time in Big South history. Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** is the Big South's career assist leader with 567 -- just 129 ahead of Johnson's total.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is already 16th in Big South history with 127 career blocked shots. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history.

ROAD WARRIORS

During Conference play in 2008-09, the road teams won 42 of the 90 Big South games played -- a .467 winning percentage. It is the most Conference road wins since the Big South Conference Tournament format changed to home sites in 2002-03. The previous best road winning percentage was .411 in 2006-07 (23-33 in a 14-game schedule).

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** made 119 three-pointers last season, the second-highest single-season total in Big South history. He has made a three-pointer in 47 of his 48 career games, including 41-straight to open his collegiate career. He has 176 career treys for a 3.67 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 106 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just four League victories to surpass former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 181 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 13 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

CRACK THAT VERGE

Six players will likely join the Big South's 1,000-point club this season. High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** is nine points away from the milestone, while Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 53 points away from the magic number. Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** is 66 points shy of 1,000. Also on target to reach 1,000 career points in 2009-10 are Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (887), Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** (741) and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** (718).

WELCOME MAT

The Big South welcomes two new coaches to the sidelines in 2009-10. Former North Carolina Tar Heel **SCOTT CHERRY** takes over the reigns at High Point in his first head coaching job. One-time Liberty assistant **DALE LAYER** brings his 16 years of head coaching experience to Lynchburg as the Flames' new leader.
