Harris led HPU with 15 points against UNC Asheville, then scored a season-high 20 points in High Point's win over preseason favorite Radford. He hit key shots in both games and was 11-of-20 from the field, including 7-of-13 from three-point range. Against Asheville, he made five three-pointers, including three in the second half. Against Radford, Harris was 6-of-8 from the field and 6-of-6 from the foul line. He also hit a momentum-changing three-pointer at the buzzer before halftime that put HPU ahead for good. Harris went 4-of-4 from the foul line down the stretch, including two with seven seconds remaining.

Sexton averaged 18.3 points, 59.4 percent from the floor, and 63.2 percent from beyond the arc in three games. In CSU's first win over Winthrop in eight years, Sexton tallied 19 points on 7-of-10 shooting, including 5-of-7 from three-point range. At UNC Asheville, Sexton scored 15 of his 18 points in the second half and overtime. After scoring 10 points in the final 10 minutes of regulation, Sexton hit the go-ahead three-pointer with 31 seconds remaining in overtime.

Greenwood averaged 14.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 2.3 steals in three Chanticleer wins last week. He was 13-of-23 from the floor and 14-of-17 from the line. He then added 12 points and eight rebounds at UNC Asheville, and wrapped up the week with 17 points, three assists and three steals at Gardner-Webb on Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA FASTEST TO 15 WINS IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY

Coastal Carolina became the fastest team in Big South history to win 15 games in a season, as the Chanticleers claimed their 15th victory in their 17th contest, breaking the previous record of 18 games. Three teams set the initial mark of 15-3 -- Liberty in 1991-92, UNC Greensboro in 1994-95 and VMI in 2008-09. Off to its best start in school history at 16-2, Coastal Carolina is challenging the Big South record for best start after 20 games, which is 17-3. The same 1991-92 Liberty Flames and 2008-09 VMI Keydets share this record.

ONE TEAM REMAINS UNDEFEATED IN BIG SOUTH PLAY

Coastal Carolina and Radford both opened 4-0 in Big South games for the first time in several years. Radford won its first four League contests for the first time since 1999-00, when the Highlanders opened 6-0 in Big South action. Coastal Carolina is 6-0 in Conference play for the first time since 1990-91 when it opened 11-0. The Chanticleers are the sixth Big South team since 2005-06 to open 6-0 in Big South games, and enters this week looking to become the first team since UNC Asheville in 2007-08 to start 7-0.

ROAD BLOCK

Radford's Big South-record tying 11-game Conference road win streak came to an end this past Saturday at High Point. The Highlanders, which set a Big South single-season record with nine road League wins in 2008-09, tied Winthrop's mark of 11-straight Big South road wins, which was accomplished from Jan. 10, 2005 to Jan. 30, 2006. Liberty had the next-longest streak behind Radford, but its five-game Conference road win streak ended this past Saturday at Winthrop. Coastal Carolina takes over the current streak, having won its last four Big South games away from home.

TWO MILESTONES WITHIN REACH THIS WEEK FOR COASTAL'S HARRIS

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS** enters the week needing seven rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds, as well as 21 rebounds to become the Big South's all-time rebounding king. Harris, who opened the season tied for seventh on the League's career rebounding chart, jumped into third-place after just four games and surpassed **JOE SPINKS** (954) for second on Dec. 29. Harris is on pace to break the record of 1,013 career rebounds (held by former High Point Panther **ARIZONA REID**) on Saturday, Jan. 16 at home against High Point.

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** leads the nation in rebounding at 12.9 per game and is on pace to break his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. If he should continue at his current pace of 12.9 rebounds in Radford's next 16 games, Parakhouski would finish with 387 rebounds through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. His per game average is pacing +1.5 ahead of the League record of 11.4. Meanwhile, Parakhouski is the only player to rank in the top five nationally in both scoring (3rd) and rebounding (1st).

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (24.1), rebounding (12.9) and field goal percentage (63.2), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Should Parakhouski maintain his averages for the duration of the season, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

ALL ABOUT MARGINS

Coastal Carolina has won 15 of its 16 games this season by 10-or-more points, and owns a +17.1 scoring margin -- pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers own a +11.7 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +15.2 margin against League foes in 2006-07.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE ROAD

The road teams have claimed 11 of the 27 Big South games played thus far this season, or 40.7 percent. The success could mark the third time in the past four seasons that the road teams won at least 40.0 percent of the League contests, including last year, when the road squads won 42 of the 90 total Big South games played for a .467 winning percentage away from home.

CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE

Of the first 27 Big South Conference games, 15 have been decided by less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those games being 3.9 points. Of the 12 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory is 16.2 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands at 9.1 points.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday at High Point. He is currently 10th all-time on the Big South's career list with 503, and needs seven to reach the eighth spot. Now just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists, Johnson is 65 assists away from breaking the Big South career record of 567, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08), and is on pace to surpass the mark Feb. 16 at Liberty. Meanwhile, Johnson leads the Big South with 5.42 assists per game and is looking to become the first player since Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** in 2001-02 and 2002-03 to lead the Big South in assists in back-to-back seasons.

LIBERTY'S KYLE OHMAN ON DOORSTEP OF BIG SOUTH'S SCORING CLUB

Liberty senior and former walk-on **KYLE OHMAN** enters this week needing three points to become the 97th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers and their respective rank in League history, as well as additional players closing in on the milestone.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,113 points in his career (494 as a Big South member).

CHARTER MEMBER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 94th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 21, is about to become the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots once he reaches the rebounding milestone. Harris and Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** are currently the only players in League history with 1,000 points, 900 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots, as Spinks accumulated 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 220 steals and 155 blocks for the Camels from 1990-94.

ANOTHER HARRIS MAKING A NAME FOR HIMSELF

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the Big South's active three-point field goal leader with a school-record 248 -- good for 10th in Big South history and seven away from ninth-place (254 - Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER**, 1990-95). Harris also has 234 career assists, and is on track to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. The other four are Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST).

BULLETIN BOARD MATERIAL

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the third player this season and 54th in League history to reach 500 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone at Louisville on Dec. 27 -- in just his 43rd career game with the Highlanders. He is officially the Big South's career leader for rebounds per game, as the category is based on a minimum of 500 rebounds. Below is a look at the Big South's active players with 500 rebounds, their rank in League annals, and their current career per game average, through games of Jan. 9:

Based on this season's averages, Harris is on pace to finish with 1,130 career rebounds and Parakhouski is on track to amass 756 in just two seasons. Meanwhile, Daniels needs 24 rebounds to become the 29th player in Big South history with 600 and is on pace for 668 in his career, while Lynch-Flohr is projected to finish with 665 rebounds.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

UNC Asheville has endured the agony of defeat during the early going of Conference play. All five of the Bulldogs' Big South games have been decided by 8 points-or-less, with one being a 2-point victory at Gardner-Webb in December. Since that Conference opening win, UNC Asheville has dropped four-straight League games by a combined 16 points (4.0 average). The last team to lose four-straight Big South games by 8 points-or-less was Coastal Carolina in 2002-03, when the Chanticleers dropped five-in-a-row by a margin of 4 points-or-less.

COASTAL CAROLINA MOVES UP IN MID-MAJOR POLL

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 15 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, up six spots from last week and 10 spots since debuting in the poll Dec. 28. Radford was ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 poll for the first three weeks of the season and has received votes in five of the last seven weeks. This is the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25, and the second-straight season that more than one team entered the poll. HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Big South at 16 games, dating back to 2008-09. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** owns the next-longest streak of double-figure scoring at 11 games.

38 SPECIAL

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is on track to become the third player this season and 39th overall in the League's 1,000-point/500-rebound club, as he is 129 points away. Teammate **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** entered the club on Dec. 13 when he reached the 1,000-point mark, while Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** was the first to enter this season when he scored his 1,000th point on Nov. 21. Parakhouski would become the 11th Radford player on the list, the most of any Big South member.

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** became the 24th player in Big South history with 200 career three-point field goals when he reached the milestone Dec. 12 at Seton Hall. Kenon now qualifies for the Big South's career record for three-pointers per game, which is based on 200 career treys. He has made a three-pointer in 58 of his 61 career games and has made 210 total for a 3.44 per game average, which trails the current Big South career record of 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 40 of his 45 career games and already has 134 in his career, an average of 2.98 per game.

CRUZZING ALTITUDE

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 261 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 19 consecutive games -- bettering his previous career-long streak of 10 games, and is averaging 3.00 blocks in his current string (57 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 16 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

THIS EAGLE IS CLOSE TO LANDING INTO DEFENSIVE CLUB

Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** recorded his 100th career steal Dec. 12 in the Eagles' victory over Barton College. He is approaching 500 career rebounds (479) and 100 career blocked shots (78) as well, and should he reach both milestones, he would become just the eighth player in Big South history with 500 rebounds, 100 steals and 100 blocks. Robinson is trying to become the third Winthrop player with 100 steals and 500 rebounds.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College. He now owns a lifetime record of 652-386. Ellis has amassed 574 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 16 wins this season already exceed last year's total (11) and Ellis' win total in his first season as the Chanticleers coach in 2007-08 (13). The Chanticleers are four victories away from recording 20 regular-season wins for the first time since 1990-91.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** became the 25th player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he reached the milestone at College of Charleston on Dec. 16. He now has 223 treys in his career. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** is approaching the 200 three-point field goal barrier as he enters this week with 191.

TERRIFIC TRIFUNOVIC

Radford 6-8 junior forward **LAZAR TRIFUNOVIC** missed the first four games of the season due to injury and after shaking off some early rust in his first three outings (10.3 points, 6.3 rebounds, 32.5 FG percentage), he is averaging 14.4 points, 9.7 rebounds and 52.5 percent from the field in his last seven appearances. On the season, Trifunovic is averaging 13.2 points, 8.7 rebounds and 45.8 percent from the field, which would rank 14th, 3rd and 5th, respectively, among the Big South leaders if he met the games played requirement of 75 percent of his team's games. He is just two games away from qualifying for the leaders (12 of 16 games).

HAVING A FIELD DAY

In his last seven games, Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is hitting 73.5 percent of his field goals (72-of-98), including four games over 80.0 percent from the field. His recent swing has vaulted him to second nationally in field goal percentage. Meanwhile, the Highlanders' front trio of Parakhouski (24.1 points/12.9 rebounds), **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (13.5 points/6.9 rebounds) and **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (13.2 points/8.7 rebounds) account for 64.6 percent of RU's offense and 60.7 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 50.8 points and 28.5 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 17 double-doubles this season.

HAPPY DAYS

UNC Asheville 6-10 freshman center **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** has seen his playing time increase the past seven games, as he is averaging 28.7 minutes a game compared to playing 18.3 minutes in the first eight contests of the season. He has responded with 11.9 points, 9.1 rebounds and 1.6 blocked shots in his current span, to go along with three double-doubles. In his first eight games of the season, Cunningham averaged 4.1 rebounds and 5.4 points.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** has swatted away 159 shots in his career, 11th-most in Big South history. He needs four blocked shots to move into a tie for ninth all-time in League annals. Williams, who blocked a personal-best 76 shots last season, needs 41 rejections to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 19th in League history with a school-record 123 career blocks.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 107 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just three League victories to surpass former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 184 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 10 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

SPEAKING OF WINNING COACHES...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach when the Keydets defeated Charleston Southern on Dec. 5. It was his 63rd as VMI's head coach, and he is already the fifth-winningest coach in VMI history after just four-plus years at the helm.

Prior to the game, Winthrop was the only team in the Big South that CSU head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** had not defeated ... **KELVIN MARTIN** scored 21 points on 9-of-13 from the field in the Bucs' loss at Gardner-Webb. Charleston Southern lost a 13-point second-half lead and scored just nine points in the final 11:15 of the game ... At UNC Asheville, a high scoring overtime saw two ties and six lead changes before **JEREMY SEXTON** hit the go-ahead three with 31 seconds remaining.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina's 12-game win streak is tied for the longest in school history, as the Chanticleers reeled off 12-straight wins from Jan. 24-March 6, 2006 ... **CHAD GRAY** scored 15 of his 18 points in the second half of a 58-57 win at UNC Asheville last Thursday. This included the game-winning jumper with 5.2 seconds remaining to give the Chants the one-point advantage ... Coastal Carolina is 4-0 when five players score in double figures, including last Monday's win over Presbyterian College. **LOGAN JOHNSON** led the team with 16 points while **DANNY NIEMAN** had 14.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb snapped a grueling 10-game losing streak with its comeback win over Charleston Southern last Thursday, closing the game on a 27-10 run to win 64-61. Freshman **THOMAS STATON** scored four of his six points in the final two minutes, including the go-ahead layup with 59.8 seconds remaining ... **JONATHAN MOORE** has led GWU in scoring in each of the past three games (14.0 average), the only Bulldog player to lead the team in scoring in consecutive games this season ... Freshman **STEFON JOHNSON** scored a career-high nine points in his second career start Saturday vs. Coastal Carolina.

HIGH POINT

High Point's 4-1 Big South start matches its second-best start through five games since joining the Conference in 1999-00 ... HPU's win over Radford this past Saturday was its first since 2007-08 after three losses last season. The Panthers are now 8-3 in their last 11 games against Radford ... **EUGENE HARRIS** posted his seventh career 20-point game with 20 points against the Highlanders. **NICK BARBOUR** led HPU with 23 points against RU, giving the Panthers two 20-point scorers for the first time since Feb. 18, 2009 ... Barbour went to the free throw line a career-high 13 times against Radford ... **TEHRAN COX** scored 10 points against UNC Asheville, his first double-figure scoring effort of the season.

LIBERTY

KYLE OHMAN is set to become the 21st member of Liberty's 1,000-point club, as he is three points away from the milestone ... Freshman **ANTWAN BURRUS** made his first career start in Liberty's 77-67 win at Presbyterian College, and notched his first career double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds against the Blue Hose.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC went 1-2 last week, but established multiple firsts in the win over VMI. The Blue Hose came back from a 17-point deficit to defeat the Keydets in overtime, having trailed by that amount three times in the game. **WALT ALLEN** and **JAKE TROYLI** each recorded their first career double-double in the contest, marking the first time in PC's Division I history that two players recorded a double-double in the same game. UNC ASHEVILLE

In both losses last week, UNC Asheville had the lead with less than one minute remaining, and in its four Big South losses this season, the Bulldogs led late ... Freshman **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** had career-highs of 15 points and 15 rebounds against Charleston Southern, including 11 on the offensive glass ... **SEAN SMITH** is now tied for second-place on the UNC Asheville career list with 162 three-pointers ... The postponed Bluefield College game from Dec. 18 has been rescheduled for Monday, Jan. 18 at 2:00pm.

VMI

VMI will play seven of its next 10 games at home after playing seven of its first 13 games on the road ...
